CENAR was entered to compete Sunday but acted up in the gate and had to be scratched; he draws the challenging inside post here for this second career start.

DARK ALE raced well in his second career start when third beaten a length and the winner came back to score; most recently, he won a pace battle through the stretch but a deep closer beat him at the last moment; he fits with these with Husbands aboard again.

SILKEN THOMAS a homebred for Paul O'Brien, goes for Dan O'Callaghan; he is a son of Old Forester who has worked from the gate in recent trials getting ready.

LILLZ NOT CRYING an auction purchase by Victor's Cry, will debut for Ricky Singh; he worked a half mile November 13th in 48.2 with some speed.

SHAKING THE STAGE a homebred for Pietro Armata, is by Strut The Stage, and from a dam who won twice on the synthetic surface; he attempted a rally in work November 20th in 1.02.3 getting ready.

WHERE'S THE GOLD last competed October 15th and once he made it around the turn safely, he was able to continue on in contention and finish an ok fourth; he comes off the shelf for this event.

EMPTY THREATS a debut runner for Martin Drexler, is by Milwaukee Brew, and has just six furlongs with which to move; he has worked over a half mile on a regular basis.

JOVIAL JESS became very aggressive to be part of a pace chase November 5th but he folded late when Dark Ale was second and the winner rallied from far back.

NUPOGODI a homebred for Greenoaks Farm, is a half brother to the local speed winner, Ratface Macdougall; he had his two fastest works on the training track getting ready for Angus Buntain and travels six furlongs here.

PALEFACE had a useful fourth place finish last time when he moved outside at the top of the stretch; he travels a furlong farther today.

SPANISH EXPRESS a debut runner, is from a very significant dam who was a multiple stakes winner locally; he did work a half mile November 19th in 48b getting ready for Frank Huarte; he starts from the widest post.

O WANDERLUST was out of the money on turf in a protected spot last time; he now drops sharply to go for just \$16,000 with the move to Tapeta in hopes of a wake up.

CRUSHIN HARD was out of the money on turf last time when getting a belated seasonal bow for \$37,500; with that return out of the way, he now plunges for \$16,000 on Tapeta.

BRAVEMAN set a pace two starts ago that was not sustainable and he slipped back to third; most recently, he opted for seven furlongs on turf where he was again aggressive but he slipped back on the edges; he gets back down to the \$16,000 mark on Tapeta with a chance to show speed which may help his mate, Bourbon First.

BOURBON FIRST has now won two in a row here; when he doubled up November 16th for \$11,500, the late pace was quite good; he should have a good pace to target.

SOMBRERO DE COPA had a slow departure from the gate November 23rd and that sealed his fate for the evening and he was not a factor; he drops down.

SMOOTH STONE was aggressively handled when losing at 3-5 two starts ago; most recently, he engaged in a pace fight with the seventh place finisher and slipped out of contention in the prep for the Valedictory; he cuts back in distance and drops into a more reachable spot.

MALIBU TIDE got in a pocket last time and then hung at a crucial stage when Bourbon First was the winner; he attracted a claim and now goes for Martin Drexler.

UNCATCHABLE FIRE couldn't keep up with such a fast group in a protected race at the first allowance level when sprinting last time; he drops down and stretches out.

DIVINE SONET took a plunge two starts ago and missed narrowly against a key winner; he took a further drop last time but his form slipped when he was fourth beaten two lengths after drafting behind runners; he goes off the claim for Ricky Griffith.

MOONSHINE MARTINI is a legitimate stretch drive runner who can be a factor here with a drop from the \$20,000 level where he missed by a length last time.

SIR BRONX is one of several in here looking to adjust to a longer distance; he had a maiden win two starts ago at six and a half furlongs for \$32,000 and then was just on the edges last time in a six furlong sprint.

GIGANTIC BREEZE figured to wake up and win November 26th with a drop for \$20,000 but after setting the pace along the inside, he grew weary at the most inopportune time and finally finished fourth beaten less than a length; he doubles in price today.

THE ACCUSER came out of the B. C. Derby to run here November 12th for \$40,000 against non winners of two and the slow early pace saw him race closer in the early furlongs and he was finally an ok third against a front running winner with Biigon in second and he meets that rival here; he fits.

BIIGON doubled in price for his latest and closed a good gap against a front running winner to be second beaten a half length in a race that gives him standing here.

TRANSFORMATIVE closed such a good gap at seven furlongs for \$40,000 against non winners of two last time that he now goes into a route with some added expectations; Boulanger rides once again for Mark Casse.

LAND HO had a peak performance two starts ago but a letdown last time when he met a much tougher field and finished a weakening fourth as the favourite; he attracted a claim and now goes up in value for Kevin Attard; he is accustomed to running up front in routes; speed is likely.

ARTISTICO was in a highly rated race on turf last time and finished eighth beaten ten lengths and showed some interest at the end; he now plunges for \$40,000 and moves to Tapeta.

AULT finished just in behind Transformative last time when he was also moving forward in the stretch at seven furlongs; he did win going long back in August.

THUNDER POINT was in for \$20,000 trying to repeat last time at a route but he closed too late in fourth in an ok effort which was taken by Timberline who is in race eight today.

BAR DOWN will have to adjust to route racing here; he closed willingly on the outside to be just a couple of lengths back when Transformative and Ault were in front of him last time; the blinkers are off.

ONE DESTINY will be turning back in distance from a route where he finished third against the rallying Classic Bryce who is beside him in the gate; he took both of his wins this season at Fort Erie.

CLASSIC BRYCE went from seven furlongs when on the edges to a route last time where he won with a substantial late bid; he will now shorten to seven furlongs which is more of a challenge but he does have a rallying technique and fits. **YER BLUES** is without a share in recent races and will now be stretching out to seven furlongs; he has faced key winners in a series of races.

RISING DOUGH was a distant third for \$6,000 last time behind a winner who has already come back to repeat and beat some of these; he extends to seven furlongs.

WAR FAN had the inside post at seven furlongs last time when an unusually slow opening quarter developed and then the pace quickened after that and he was behind in double digits; he has since had a half mile work.

BRING ON THE BULL dropped from a win for \$10,000 to go for \$6,250 last time but hung and finished fifth; the fourth place finisher, Classic Bryce, is here and has already come back to win; he goes off the claim today.

MACHITO was getting down in value to a spot where he figured to be one of the contenders last time but he had a poor departure from the gate and then couldn't keep up on the turn in a disappointing performance; a move is now made to Boulanger and Olguin will handle Rising Dough.

PECOS BUD came from Presque Isle and was in a route race here November 16th trying to beat the bias by running in front, yet, he folded late after setting a middle pace that was much too quick; he now shortens to seven furlongs.

TRUE EXECUTIVE has had trouble getting around the turn in consecutive events and has finished behind in double digits; the blinkers are off today.

IRUSAN made an outside move last time and was finally fifth of ten without threatening against a key winner; the third place finisher came back to run well in the finale Sunday.

SCOTTY'S EGO has been protected in three consecutive Ontario sire events and was asked to come from the inside post in each one of those difficult races at enormous odds and not much was expected; he now gets in for \$6,250 hoping for the wake up.

CAPE ZAVATA hasn't been far away in recent races and was in against a key winner last time when a slow pace developed; he ran well at seven furlongs two starts ago at this price range and can be considered for a prize.

VILLAGEOFVIBANK specializes in running away in the stretch; that was the case last time when the early fractions were slow and he built up momentum to be clear at the end to beat non winners of three despite laying in; he now faces multiple winners; he must go seven furlongs; speed is his strength.

MATTANGEL was in an Ontario sire race recently where he was fifth beaten only five lengths against a key winner, Regal Remark, who is an enormous reference; three starts ago at seven furlongs, he also ran strongly; he now drops sharply looking for his second win of the year and he figures to be a contender from a wide post.

ANOTHER BID tried to rate behind rivals last time but was finally sixth beaten two lengths behind a key winner in a route.

CLASSY KID went from seven furlongs to a route last time and was similarly on the edges and now shortens up.

MAHOGANY CAT is one of the speed elements in this race; he dropped down for \$7,500 last time and shortened to five furlongs and made the lead for much of the stretch until he was passed at the last moment by a longshot winner; he must lengthen to six furlongs in this spot and has the challenging inside post; Mey's Flash also has speed.

PHILANTHROMISTER was steady into the turn last time and then moved outside and closed well at five furlongs to be second against a front runner; he now lengthens to six furlongs.

MEY'S FLASH is a speed component much like Mahogany Cat and that should be a pace battle in the making; he was second best for \$8,000 two starts ago at this distance.

NEVER WORN had some speed two starts ago but backed away; she tried a middle move last time but lost by double digits in the stretch.

D'S DOUBLE EAGLE is worth a look because of his ability to close late and land on the edges; this will be his first start since late October.

REBELLION'S DREAM is certainly one to consider; he couldn't crack through at Fort Erie two starts ago but ran willingly here last time in third beaten two lengths and the runner up has already come back with a big victory; Wilson takes over.

ARCHER TRIUMPH'S advanced to fifth spot in a field of thirteen last time then went flat in the stretch when seventh; he shortens in distance.

POINT LOAD had a good performance last time for \$10,000 at six furlongs when he moved from the third flight late and got fourth money when Rebellion's Dream was in third; the runner up has already come back to win big.

R BOOTS HALL attended a pace that was quite brisk in a route November 9th and fought with the winner in the early stages but couldn't stay late; he goes shorter here.

GOLDEN JIGGS set off on a speed mission at seven furlongs last Saturday but ran out of fuel when passed by a dominant winner.

R QUICK ARCH endured some bumping last time but raced well in fourth in a field of eight when Philanthromister was second.

SCHLOSS SCHNEEBERG had some early enthusiasm last time but lost it through the stretch against a dominant winner.

BEST OF THE BOBS has indicated enough speed to be in front early in both races only to lack enthusiasm through the lane; he drops down for Norm McKnight.

FORTY'S SWEETHEART found the right range and doubled up November 4th for \$40,000; she attracted a claim by Mark Fournier from Mike Doyle and will now jump to a first allowance event here; in that last event, she was able to get off the rail and close best and kept her well regarded mate in second; Boulanger who was aboard for a recent work, now takes over; she rates a look.

I'LL TAKE THE CAKE dropped in for \$40,000 back on August 19th and that was her ticket to win; she also dropped for \$40,000 November 23rd and took a second claiming win.

NERVE LINE has been out of the money in a series of events against some difficult winners; she was fifth against Forty's Sweetheart two starts ago.

EKATI MORNING a well bred individual for Charles Fipke, had a successful debut September 20th at Fort Erie at four and a half furlongs when showing sharp speed and beating her stable mate back into second; she indicates three works in November including a move November 13th in 1.13.1 getting ready for Michaela Neubauer; Husbands has been attracted in this spot and lasix is added.

ELUSIVE SUZY attracted a claim when winning for \$20,000 last time at five furlongs and she made all of the running; she added lasix for that last win; there are other speed sources here.

LITTLE CHRISTY won big early in the summer time at just five furlongs when she was in against Ontario sire company and she managed to make the pace; she has been getting ready since the middle of October and has posted some fast works on the training track for Mike De Paulo; she also had a recent Tapeta work in 1.00.2.

PRINCESS MACY was in the Victorian Queen Stakes at this distance two starts ago where she was fourth beaten three lengths; in her latest, she opted to go out to seven furlongs and she was taken off the pace and then she moved in third; her rider claimed foul against the runner up but that was not upheld; she now has the luxury of cutting back to six furlongs.

BOATHOUSE VIEW ran well for new interests last time; she was claimed for \$32,000 October 14th and then put into the Glorious Song Stakes by Mike Mattine last time where she was fifth beaten only two lengths against a well regarded winner; she goes shorter today.

KHAWLAH kept focusing on the task at hand last outing to repel the runner up and was game enough through the stretch for Steve Attard; Olguin takes over here.

EURO PRINCESS broke to the outside last time and had an isolated trip there without producing against Forty's Sweetheart.

ALL IRISH had a couple of summer runs including a winning opener for \$32,000 and then a double digit loss in a protected spot; she was in a key race on that occasion and the runner up came back to win the Natalma; she comes off the shelf.

LOOKINGFORANEWHOME had a good enough race two starts ago when on the edges for \$40,000 but has run only once since then and scratched from a race September 23rd; this will be his first start since August 19th and he should welcome the move in against easier company.

GRAY PHANTOM won at a route two starts ago with a deep closing style; last Sunday, he competed at the first allowance level where the slow early pace worked against him but he moved up inside only to hang; he cuts back to six and a half furlongs and drops back down for \$20,000.

BETWEEN DRINKS is without a share over his last several races including an Ontario sire event last time where he was prominent only early.

BEAR SKINNED attracted a claim for \$10,000 three starts ago and in an Ontario sire race last time, he was second against a well regarded winner; Contreras retains the mount for Jim Ensom.

BETTIN' ACES is a middle speed component most times; he was third last time in this category as closers took over late.

CENTREFIRE came from Edmonton and had an excuse at the break October 23rd then closed late to get the lead with about seventy yards remaining but was passed by a runner from the outside; he deserves another chance.

BOLDGENT won for \$10,000 then jumped to this level last time and was fourth beaten about five lengths with an ok move on the outside when Bettin' Aces was better in third.

TITANICO is a one time winner facing non winners of three; against non winners of two for \$20,000 last time, he ran well in second but was out rallied by a longshot winner.

DIXIE WHISTLER caused interference at the break last time when he came in sharply and impeded a rival and then wasn't heard from the rest of the way; he was in a key race the time before against a winner who repeated.

SPANISH BRIGADIER is a one time winner who ran with more confidence last time than in his previous race and his turn speed was supreme; he faces a tougher challenge with a jump in value here.

BUTTERFLY STRIKE was able to keep up a high velocity chase and take over the pace in the stretch November 4th for \$37,500 against non winners of two and he prevailed; he now goes for \$19,000 here against non winners of three.

DEEP FREEZE was in a pace duel that was not sustainable last time and he understandably folded out of the money for \$20,000 while Bettin' Aces was better in third.

PRIZED BOURBON typically commits to sprint races but for an opportunity to run late in the season, she will now go long; she had a good race in this category last time when she took over the lead in the stretch to win a pace fight but the winner got by her from the outside at the end.

RYOAN is accustomed to running in routes and has been in this category in consecutive events; most recently on Tapeta, she came from fifth to be second narrowly beaten but it was a slowly run race and she was a beaten at the last moment by a late moving winner.

PHIL'S GLORY raced willingly two starts ago in this category; she shortened to seven furlongs last time and was a strong second but the slow pace structure worked against her late rally; she now gets out to a route again and has had a quick interim work in 1.00.1; she seeks her first win of the year.

SLI'S HALO did not come out of the gate well November 26th and was far behind throughout at a low level.

ZERMATTA has been out of the money in three consecutive turf races since a peak performance September 3rd on Tapeta in the La Lorgnette when she was second best behind Moonlit Promise; any trace of that form, will make her a factor here with the return to Tapeta.

AUDACIOUS BEAR attracted a claim for \$20,000 August 17th and two months later, won for \$20,000; most recently, she went to this category at a route where she was passed late and she settled for third in a slowly run race.

STRUTTIN MY STUFF was close by on turf two starts ago where she narrowly missed with a late run; most recently, she elected to go into open company on turf and lost in double digits; she now gets back with Ontario sire company but on Tapeta.

TIMBERLINE looked smart winning against the boys for \$19,000 November 25th when she took her third lifetime win and it was the first time in her career that she had used blinkers; she was winning first time off the claim for Kevin Attard; she now jumps in value with her current momentum and looks for her fourth route win of the season.

FLAMENCO DANCER was in a slowly run race last time and closed mildly to be fifth when Ryoan was second.

MAXIMUM ENTROPY was in for only \$10,000 at a route last time where she got delayed behind runners at the top of the stretch and then angled out and missed second by a diminishing margin.

GYPSY JAZZ ran well last time on Tapeta to take a maiden score and she came off the rail with a surge; the fifth place finisher came back recently to win; she rates a look.

TEATOE loves route racing on Tapeta; the first part of this campaign was dedicated to racing at Fort Erie; she now looks for her third win on Tapeta in a row but must jump in value.

PERFECT ELLA attracted a claim for \$20,000 three starts ago and won for \$20,000 last time for Jamie Attard; she now goes up in value.

PRINCESS ROYAL typically commits to sprint races now and at six furlongs last time in this category, the time was quick and she moved late in fourth when Prized Bourbon was second; she now stretches out to a route.

SWEET CITY WOMAN was in for only \$9,500 last time when she passed a few runners without threatening.

LITTLE CHRISTMAS raced well in this category last time when stretching out after two sprints to finish fourth but it was a slowly run race and Ryoan was second.

LIGHT MY PATH is one of the best in here and it is just a case of converting like she did three starts ago; in her latest, she was in a protected spot and did well to finish fourth against a key winner and the runner up has already come back to win big for \$37,500; she goes now for only \$10,000 with Hernandez.

SMOOTH SPIRIT was on her feet and running nicely through the stretch last time and was not far out of third spot; she stretches to seven furlongs.

KISEKI is getting her first start since October 2nd at Fort Erie when she was behind by a wide margin; she has been here prepping for Darwin Banach.

APACHE GAL was driving on the pace last time as part of an aggressive group and had nothing left for the stretch drive.

NEEVES was at seven furlongs two starts ago and finished fifth of seven; most recently, she had an excusable trip behind rivals and then she tried a late run inside; she stretches out again.

GLEAMING SUNRISE made a four wide approach last time without being a threat and seeks a breakthrough win.

IZITLEGAL picked a race at five furlongs last time and was just on the edges; she now will elect to go seven furlongs.

SHE'S MESSI is one to consider; a race at seven furlongs two starts ago was just fine; she rallied prematurely and then landed second; one can perhaps look beyond her latest where she was driving alongside the winner who was too good for her at a route.

THALIAS FIRE had a strong run in her previous event when beaten just a couple of lengths in a race that will give her some standing here; in her latest, she closed too late against Teatoe who was entered in race eight; she shortens to just seven furlongs.

PINCH MY CHEEKS was in against a key winner last time and the runner up came back to win at an elevated level; she quickly drops down to the price of her previous event.

GLIB MARYLIN has dedicated herself to route racing and was second best last time with a deep closing style; she was in against a key winner and now shortens in distance.

FUNNY FUNNY RIDDLE had a good enough race at seven furlongs two starts ago when she committed to the lead but gave it up late; most recently, she tried an outside bid at six furlongs but hung.

WRECKHOUSE is worth considering; her win two starts ago was salvaged at the last moment; she came from near the back on the turn; she was in against too good a group last time which featured a key top pair.

PRIDDY FAIR had specifically trained for her race November 13th with three consecutive works leading to that effort; she won from post fourteen at six and a half furlongs with late energy; she has freshness as an asset.

MISS TIAGO won easily at a route two starts ago; when she was put up in value last time, she rated off the pace and not much was expected; it is an adjustment for her to go seven furlongs but she has done that effectively in the past when shortening from a route.

BUCKDEN HOUSE has committed to a series of shorter events and had consecutive good race in early November; she gets back down to the \$10,000 mark here and extends in distance.

SHOWING SIN started to run a bit last time but wasn't a factor when overmatched; he now drops significantly in value and gets more room which should be a help.

SKYLANDER BOY moved late on the outside for \$20,000 two starts ago but was only sixth; most recently, he stayed close to the pace and was just five lengths back for \$16,000 when facing some of these; Husbands moves in.

PUSH BACK MAC hasn't been able to threaten in either race; he will now add lasix and stretch out.

BITE THE BIT was close by for \$9,500 two starts ago at a route when fourth when Dynamite Kid was second; against some of these last time, he finished just a half length by Skylander Boy.

DYNAMITE KID was in against some of these last time and was just ready to make his move to contend a furlong from home when he lost his path and was eliminated; he still finished fourth; Hernandez will take over here for Pat Parente.

SARAN IS AWESOME started a move last time but hung at the most critical time; he is up in value for a chance to start here.

CAPTIVATING MAN has been far back in all races to date but was in a key race last time from which the seventh place finisher dropped to beat several of these; blinkers are added and he does have the benefits of a recent work.

RASTA MAN had good turn speed last time but faded in the stretch; that high velocity he has indicated in recent races, should carry him to a prominent placing on the pace at this longer distance.

MARCAVELLYS DREAM was last in the early going for \$12,500 when coming off the shelf November 16th but he improved his overall rating; he now goes from a sprint to a route.

HYPHE followed just in behind the leaders last time and was beaten only three lengths when facing some of these including the runner up, Fine Grit.

SOUL N' SPIRIT was poised on the outside last time but had an awkward trip through the stretch and lost ground; he remains at a route but is down in value.

THE CHEEKY CHARMER wanted speed last time and tried to steal the event for \$7,500 but a dropped down closer won it and he finally finished five lengths behind with Fine Grit in second.

CLOUD BANKER came off the shelf and dropped down November 23rd but lost in double digits in the same race as several of these.

FINE GRIT had his second consecutive runner up finish last time at a lower level but he stayed on well after a good middle speed display.

ESPIRITUGANADOR stumbled badly at the beginning two starts ago but had a better departure last time and was third beaten two lengths for \$7,500.

EXILE TRAIN had a slow departure from the gate in a quickly run race November 26th at seven furlongs; he now goes farther.
