**FLEETWAY** has made stakes appearances where he has been only a fringe player; he was fifth beaten five and a half lengths last time in the Clarendon when his mate won it and that was a race run in key time; he indicates two recent works getting ready for this drop in value.

**SILENT FLASH** couldn't handle stakes company two starts ago but when he came off the shelf November 19<sup>th</sup> he was in peak form and took a maiden win with a perfect off the pace style under ideal handling from Moran at 6-5; that win came at only five furlongs.

**WAR FACTORY** made a mistake leaving the gate November 16<sup>th</sup> from the rail for maiden \$20,000 but found a spot on the inside through the stretch to rally and won it under Alderson; he has been sold since that opener and now jumps in value for his new trainer, Steve Attard.

**ROCKY PALACE** engaged in some bumping on the turn last time and was finally third with Waubaushene clearly better in second.

**WAUBAUSHENE** is a big strong individual who ran well in an Ontario sire race last time with the lead but he was taken down by a rallying winner and kept Rocky Place a couple of lengths behind him; he goes shorter here.

**GATOR SPY** was perfectly prepared by Renee Kierans when he had a successful debut October 26<sup>th</sup>; he did his best running in the stretch and was bold at that juncture; he did have a good comeback work November 12<sup>th</sup> in 49; he jumps in value.

**SILENT VISION** had plenty of momentum at the top of the stretch for \$40,000 last time but when he swung to the outside, he suddenly stalled and was unplaced; he stretches from five to six furlongs.

**ONE FLASHY CAT** was in this category two starts ago and couldn't keep up; for \$32,000 last time, he gave away the lead gradually to the favourite and finished third.

**TIZOVER** came off the shelf November 12<sup>th</sup> for her first run since August and she was aggressive on the pace at a route but she faltered; the winner has come back to score; she shortens to a sprint.

**SWEET RETREAT** debuted November 20<sup>th</sup> for maiden \$23,500; she was last in the early going at this distance then followed a wall of rivals and closed to be beaten a long length in a good showing; she is up in value here.

**LOVE ON TIDES** returned from considerable time away for her local bow September 23<sup>rd</sup> and she was second best on turf behind a winner who repeated; most recently, she went to Tapeta at seven furlongs where she followed traffic and then made her move to the lead only to have the winner come up the rail and steal it away; she did keep Salty Mo behind her in third.

**BROKEN MEADOW** debuted in March at Gulfstream at long odds and raced well near the pace at seven furlongs to be third for John Mattine; she makes her way back now at just six furlongs and has been prepping locally; Bahen gets the call.

**LUCKFROMABOVE** is a well bred individual by Excellent Art, a Group 1 winner at a mile; she is from a dam who won on the turf in France; her opener came October 30<sup>th</sup> on the lawn at Laurel; she was third beaten less than a length as the favourite; trainer Michael Dickinson has had success in recent weeks bringing in runners for local wins; Husbands who was recently aboard Giovanna Blues for this stable, gets the call.

**SALTY MO** departed a four race turf schedule to go to Tapeta October 22<sup>nd</sup> and ran well on the pace but gave up the advantage late to a couple of ralliers including the runner up, Love On Tides.

**MINNIE APPLE IS** a big strong filly, came off the shelf October 8<sup>th</sup> and added blinkers and understandably went too fast on the pace with a half in 44.3 then lost out late; she returns from another absence here with a couple of quick five furlong works to her credit and Boulanger rides.

**ROXY RED** was in a race Sunday where the late pace faltered and she gave up the advantage through the stretch and landed third beaten two lengths; Mosqueira takes over here.

**DESTINY'S COVERGIRL** a debut runner for Mario Williams, is by the well bred, Dance To Destiny, and will come from the outside post here; she did some locally training through September and into the beginning of October then shows a subsequent work November 26<sup>th</sup> getting ready for this launch.

## JIM BANNON'S JOURNAL DECEMBER 3/2016

### RACE #3

**CUMMINGS ROAD** was plunged in for \$10,000 hoping to add another victory but slipped back to be fourth beaten a length and attracted a claim by Edwin Knight who doubles him in value for this event coming right back at seven furlongs.

**SPADINA ROAD** was able to win at six furlongs when coming off the shelf November 19<sup>th</sup> and was asked to move forward three furlongs from home and made it just in time to displace Bear On Fire with Speedy Fox just behind him in third; his big test now will be stretching to seven furlongs but he did win the Deputy Minister at this distance a couple of seasons ago; he has been resurgent with blinkers added.

**PUGSLEY** is coming off a wide loss when ninth beaten twenty seven lengths in a recent route; he was part of an unsustainable pace with the fourth and tenth place finishers and the race belonged to closers; he is trying the route to sprint angle here.

**TOO MANY EGBERT'S** broke in and caused some interference against the eventual winner last time and then was fourth beaten two and a half lengths in a starter event; he must travel seven furlongs here off the shelf for Preston Ferris.

**ALPINE GATHERING** has had a couple of local starts including a nine furlong race last time where he had a duel with the eventual runner up but he faltered; he drops for \$20,000 and shortens in distance.

**IMPERATORE** is a contender here; his race two starts ago at seven furlongs, featured a soft pace which assisted his close up approach on that occasion; he was finally third beaten four lengths; most recently, he was in a difficult starter event at a route where he did well to finish third beaten two lengths after electing a speed approach while closers dominated; Hernandez rides in the place of the absent Garcia.

**SPEEDY FOX** was in a six furlong race last time where he attended a fast pace and stayed willingly to be third beaten less than a length with Spadina Road the winner and Bear On Fire second; he must adjust to the seven furlong distance.

**BEYOND SMART** finished on the edges first time off the claim for Mark Fournier when traveling a route but will now peel back to go just seven furlongs in hopes he can sustain his power.

**BEAR ON FIRE** went seven furlongs earlier in the campaign but visibly gave up the lead late; he has been quite thorough in recent races at six furlongs when losing narrowly in fast times; he once again gets a wide post.

**AXIS MUNDI** had early speed for \$10,000 at seven furlongs but was off her feet at the end while Boots Are Made For was second best; she is up in value but shortening in distance.

**TORKOVA** is from the same dam who produced the stakes winner, Lapsang, and this one is by Court Vision and goes for Suzanne Drake; she has occupied her time recently with moves from the gate sharpening up and has attracted Patrick Husbands.

**GABBY'S BALLERINA** a debut runner for Willie Armata, is a homebred for Pietro Armata by War Cry and from a dam who was a four time winner; she stretched out to work five furlongs recently.

**FLEEK** debuted November 20<sup>th</sup> and had support for \$25,000; he was reserved back after an early burst then finished on the edges; Olguin may well be able to take advantage of her speed in this spot.

**BOURBON BABE** showed potential in her opener; second time out, she rated early then couldn't corner properly and caused some grief to outside horses in the vicinity of the 3/8<sup>th</sup> pole; she comes right back at a reduced evaluation with Hernandez now aboard.

**D'S BENEFACTION** had early speed last time but couldn't continue on for \$30,000 and was far behind late; the fifth place finisher has come back to win; she drops for \$15,000.

**SPEEDY IT'S ME** had some early velocity last time along the inside but stalled and then finished far behind.

**TORNADO CAT** was behind early last time for \$30,000 when coming off the shelf then lost by a wide margin; she halves in value here.

**ANGEL'S GATE** has been in for \$10,000 in recent events and was fifth beaten four and a half lengths last time when she showed some ambition late while Boots Are Made For was better in second; she is up in value here.

**TIMELESS STYLE** advanced but then hung last time for \$10,000 when taking support for the first time in her career.

**R MOUNTSBERG** had a poor break last time; she came out slowly and to the inside but she did manage to beat some rivals with some late energy; she goes shorter here.

**SUMMER MAGIC** was in for \$30,000 on a drop two starts ago but lacked room and finished fourth; most recently, she went into a higher classification where she couldn't keep up; the runner two spots in front of her, Rainbows Ahead, came back to win recently and that reflects positively on her own chances with the big drop today.

**BOOTS ARE MADE FOR** has been in at low levels recently with a runner up finish for \$8,000 two starts ago and a second place finish for \$10,000 last time when she had perfect positioning but gave up the lead.

**RHODA'S IMAGE** was running from off the pace in her debut at just five furlongs and advanced from seventh to be third against the favourite; she now gets to stretch from five to six furlongs but has the challenging inside post.

**NXT STOP FORT ERIE** was getting her second start October 29<sup>th</sup> while remaining in a protected spot and money showed for her but there was no improvement; the speed runners dominated; perhaps now that she drops for just \$25,000, she will perk up.

**COURT QUEEN** debuted in a protected race November 6<sup>th</sup> and was used alongside the eventual runner up but had nothing left for the stretch drive while lasix free; for this second start, she drops sharply, adds lasix and has had interim prepping.

**AWESOME REKHA** a debut runner for Pat Parente, was an inexpensive daughter of Awesome Again from a multiple stakes winning dam; Alderson gets the call in this six furlong opener for \$25,000; she has prepped mainly on the training track with a few recent visits to Tapeta.

**BIG BROWN BEAUTY** had a good race for \$20,000 two starts ago but couldn't repeat it last time when she had a faulty departure from the gate.

**DOLLY STORMY** had a flawed departure from the gate in her debut and didn't threaten; now that she drops so substantially and adds blinkers, she has a chance to run much better; Mosqueira is named for Sid Attard.

**OCEAN COURT** was in against a tough group in her opening sprint then went a route when protected last time and was in against a key winner; she was bumped at the break and then reserved in traffic and she finally finished sixth beaten only eight lengths; changes are made here; lasix is added and the blinkers are off, she drops for \$25,000 and Moreno is brought in.

**MISS TRINITY** debuted October 23<sup>rd</sup> but was behind at the break and didn't threaten in an added money race; she now goes for Peter Berringer with blinkers on and drops for a claiming evaluation; she has been busy with interim works.

**CALLIELIKEDHERBREW** a debut runner for Lone Pine Farm by Milwaukee Brew, will travel only six furlongs here for Preston Ferris, she has been posting works on the training track getting ready and has attracted Contreras.

**DAUGHTEROFTHEWOODS** debuted November 13<sup>th</sup> for \$20,000 and did not threaten; lasix is added here and she has had interim prepping.

**BULLET THEBLUE SKY** a debut runner, is a homebred for William Sorokolit by Sky Conqueror and from a dam who has produced six winners; she had four works during November getting ready and has attracted Da Silva.

**I GOT SILENT EGO** was expected to win last time when dropped for \$20,000 with lasix added but she finished second in a peak performance; interestingly enough, she loses her rider and Singh will move in here.

**GLOBAL ATTENTION** raced greenly last time for \$40,000 in her debut and was finally behind in double digits against a quick group; she drops sharply.

**RASPBERRY WILD** was fourth last time and gave up a position late; she drops in value with Hernandez.

**MISS BONDAGE** was a better fourth second time out but she went long on that occasion and now must go short.

**MISS MARCH** has not been a factor to date; she will need a couple of scratches to draw in.

**DANGER BAY** does his best when he can control the pace from the half mile pole home but last time, another took the early lead away from him and he had to work hard in the middle stages to get it back and then had little left for the stretch drive; this event is top heavy with several speed types.

**ENTWISTLE** took the plunge for \$20,000 last time and opted for an aggressive style taking over the lead on the turn but finally giving way through the stretch when Hampstead Heath made a nice run to get second; he was finally fourth beaten a length and a half and now doubles in value.

**HAMPSTEAD HEATH** likes to run late and this event should have conflicting speed types on the front end which should help his late energy at ten furlongs; he halved in value for his latest when second and now doubles in price.

**BROTHER PAT** looked terrific when he won at a mile and a quarter October 21<sup>st</sup> when introduced here; he galloped at a brisk pace in front and kept going to beat Easy Indygo; most recently, he tried the same aggressive tactics but the pace was too quick and he had no resistance late in that marathon; he finished a distant second; he is hoping the cutback in distance to ten furlongs will be the answer but this event has other speed horses in it.

**PATRIOTICANDPROUD** galloped around in front for \$40,000 at a mile and a sixteenth last time; that was his second win in his last four appearances; he now goes out to a mile and a quarter which is a comfortable venue for him.

**BIG YUM** has made an instant impression locally; after escaping at 19-1 in his debut, the public piled on last time and he won again at 9-5; he now looks to leave turf where he has taken all of his career wins and go to Tapeta with a drop back down in value.

**NIIGON'S GLORY** likes to run late and the pace should be ideal for his style; he was second in a tough starter event last time when he closed a gap at the end.

**TESSERON** made a good middle move last time suggesting productive form is approaching and now that he drops for \$40,000 for this second race off the shelf, he rates a look.

**ROYAL INTRIGUE** went from out of the money on turf to Tapeta to win big at long odds in September and is using that angle here after a ten length loss on the grass last time.

**EASY INDYGO** is worth entertaining as he can run late and there is plenty of speed in the race here; Bahen has now been named on this late runner.

**KADLEY** had a less than ideal journey last time and was squeezed early and was looking for room on the second turn; she did well to stay on to be fourth beaten only three lengths against Ontario sire company; she worked forwardly November 26<sup>th</sup> getting ready for this; Boulanger rides while Moreno is aboard Maritimeconnection.

**LOST POINT** had an exciting debut October 28<sup>th</sup> at seven furlongs on turf at long odds; she was in a tangle at the break and then closed vigorously in the stretch to miss narrowly against the favourite; she has been moved from trainer, Saul McHugh over to the stable of Ramon Dominguez Jr.; she looks to be a natural route runner and is by Gio Ponti, the sire of this year's Queen's Plate winner; she has been busy with interim works getting ready for the shift away from turf.

**TALE OF ICE** has lost by wide margins in both races to date on turf; she has worked well in recent preps on Tapeta and will now shift to that footing.

**SOPHIAS DREAM** dropped in for \$40,000 last time and was asked to move forward but was finally fifth of seven; she now goes farther.

**SCOTTISH SKY** debuted for Mark Casse November 12<sup>th</sup> and was only ninth while her more fancied stable mate was third; for this second start, lasix is added and Husbands takes over.

**MATCHING VOWS** had developed an off the pace style but most recently, opted for a completely different approach against a much faster pace than she had encountered to date; she then gave up lengths through the stretch; she now goes long with Contreras.

**MARITIMECONNECTION** moved off the inside and to the outside and produced a good rally in second last time with blinkers added in this category; she came back with an acceptable work in 1.01.4 for Mike De Paulo.

**VICTOIRE** debuted on turf and was awkward at the start and was late getting going in eighth when Lost Point was second; she worked on Tapeta recently getting ready for the switch over in surfaces for Malcolm Pierce.

**WHISPERING SPEAKER** debuted at long odds sprinting and had a late burst to finish fourth; she now goes from a sprint to a route.

**FLASHY'S LEGACY** was in a tough position midway of the second turn November 12<sup>th</sup>; she was mired inside in the third flight; she worked her way into an opening and rallied to be an ok fourth with Maritimeconnection in second; she deserves a look.

**SHEZTENTHEHARDWAY** dropped for \$20,000 last time and attracted a claim but after attending the pace, she lost by a wide margin.

**READY'S PRINCESS** went from a sprint to a route and understandably raced closer to the pace last time but was finally tenth with Maritimeconnection second.

**LEIGHLIN ROAD** was in for only \$20,000 last time where she found a big opening to come through to lead only to be beaten by a deep closer.

**HEMMIN AND HAWIN** is a good galloping type who won going long for maiden \$40,000 last time; he stayed close to a slow pace and was overwhelming good through the stretch as the favourite; he came back with a strong work in company November 26<sup>th</sup> with Wilson aboard going out well.

**GUY CABALLERO** was in good position to strike in the Coronation Futurity but hung finishing fifth beaten about five lengths by King And His Court; he had won going long in his previous event.

**STOP WHO'S THAT** used a new and more patient technique when going from a sprint to a route November 12<sup>th</sup> and she encountered slower fractions than ever before but rallied from tenth to be clear at the end for Mike Doyle; she came back with a good work with Da Silva aboard going out well; she faces the boys.

**FLOWMOTION** woke up second time out when departing turf and going to a Tapeta route but gave up the lead very late; most recently, she used a more patient approach to take a maiden score and was determined to the end; she worked November 25<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.4 getting ready for Mark Casse.

**MY WAY TAPPER** a homebred for Ivan Dalos, won at first asking and that was not unexpected; he was the last to move in the six furlong race and rallied outside at 9-1 for Mike De Paulo; he now stretches to a route.

**PACHI CRUZE** added lasix last time for the Coronation Futurity when switching to PathFinder Racing and attended the pace but then faltered; he competes with blinkers off and has had an interim work at home at Laurel for Neil Morris.

**VANISH** is a big flashy chestnut who was second to a key winner in his debut; second time out at six furlongs in the Clarendon Stakes, he was locked in at the quarter pole but found room desperately late to salvage the victory; his challenges now are more significant; he must stretch around two turns; he did show a willingness to run on in his November 25<sup>th</sup> work in 1.01.1 for Mark Casse.

**KING AND HIS COURT** won the important Coronation Futurity last time when going first time for Mark Casse; he was bravely handled by Boulanger who rated him in seventh inside and he found room along the rail throughout to win it at the end; he was strong in the final furlongs and galloped out well; he worked November 26<sup>th</sup> in company in 49.2 getting ready.

**JUROJIN** was looking for room at the top of the stretch in the Coronation Futurity and finally finished seventh; he had won the Kingarvie going long earlier in the season; Olguin has been recruited here.

**RECOIL** comes in for trainer Cathal Lynch who last Sunday brought in Undulated following a turf race at Laurel to win here in the Swynford with a late move; he was a winner at a route on the turf at Laurel last time with a late move as the favourite; Moran has been hired here; he is a son of the Australian star, Lonhro.

**BELLA FABIANA** was moving at the quarter pole last time but stalled finishing sixth against a key winner who went very quickly; this will be her second race off the shelf and she gets to drop down.

**TRABACIOUS** won easily to take a maiden score two outings ago when she was the only speed in the race; most recently, she wanted control and was in front early but when challenged at the top of the stretch, she gave way and was finally ninth; she now runs for half the price and Bella Fabiana follows her down to this lower level.

**KATE'S WHISTLE** had a series of good races prior to her time off but when she returned November 13<sup>th</sup> in an Ontario sire route, she tried rating tactics in what was a slowly run race and she wasn't a factor at the end; after that failed experiment, she drops for \$20,000 and gets back to sprinting.

**MARILYNS LAST LOVE** fell out of contention early last time in a first allowance race and was beaten about six lengths; she now drops for \$20,000 and extends in distance.

**BUCKDEN HOUSE** was competitive two starts ago for \$10,000 but against Ontario sire company last time, was unable to keep her early positioning and was finally at the back.

**PARTYONTHEPATIO** went well in a non winners of three race last time; she was aggressive on the pace and went after the runner up when that one tried to steal it and then she didn't have enough resources right at the end but ran strongly in third and Pulled The Goalie was the winner; the runner up has come back to win big and she rates as a contender here against Pulled The Goalie.

**MY ROSEBUD** was close early last time at seven furlongs for \$20,000 but then gradually backed away.

**PULLED THE GOALIE** is a three year old who already has three lifetime wins and she gains eligibility here because of her age and she meets some older rivals who have yet to win three times; in her latest, she was ideally manoeuvred into a winning spot where she caught up with a sagging late pace and beat Capture Your Heart and Partyonthepatio with a deft late move under Wilson; there is a half furlong less today.

**LITTLE CHRISTMAS** sat off the pace in a slowly run route last time then gained gradually; she drops in value and shortens in distance.

**BELLA'S BALLERINA** moved far on the outside last time at just five furlongs and wasn't far away when Buckden House was second; the blinkers are on.

**GWENDOLINE H** did not have a good experience in a recent turf route; changes are made here; she departs turf, adds lasix, devalues sharply and shortens in distance.

**PATSY'S STAR** is a three year old with three lifetime wins and gains eligibility here because of her age; she was in for \$40,000 last time opting for a speed chase but she lost out and then faltered; she looked strong two starts ago beating Ontario sire runners.

**ANNA REGINA** ran second last time but attracted a claim by her former conditioner, Robert Tiller, and now goes up the ladder after that runner up finish.

**AMERITIME** was in a key race June 8<sup>th</sup> then dropped for \$19,000 last time where she finished an ok third; this will be her first race since July and she indicates three November works getting ready.

**GINGER CANDY** has been at higher levels with good speed in recent events only to falter and now she runs for half the price.

**LUMBER MAN** stayed on ok last time at nine furlongs in the non winners of two classification; he goes much shorter here against non winners of three.

**GOOD LOOKING LEO** failed a route experiment last time and now gets back to seven furlongs where he was just on the edges after giving up the lead late in his previous event; the route to sprint angle is a good one for the stable.

**FIRECRACKER DAY** fell out of contention early November 18<sup>th</sup> when getting back to the races for \$9,500 and he wasn't a threat.

**MIZZEN GEORGE** went much better in his second start locally at six furlongs; he used a new off the pace style and stayed to be third and had several of these in behind him; with Contreras handling Hey Bear, Boulanger takes over here; he rates respect **JIMMIES TRUCK** was close by two starts ago at six furlongs when Hey Bear was the winner; most recently, he ran against several of these and had a poor outing; he fell out of contention early and perhaps had an excuse.

**MISTER NADA** probably deserves another chance after searching for room along the inside at the top of the stretch last time and finishing sixth beaten five lengths as the favourite against some of these when he dropped down; Singh takes over.

**ONE FOR JACK** was beaten only two lengths in his previous event for \$20,000 when Fortis was the winner; most recently, he was in another tough event for \$19,000; he gets relief with today's big drop. **CONQUEST TOO SMART** dropped in for \$10,000 last time looking for his second win in his last three starts but he finished third behind a well regarded winner; he remains a factor; Hernandez now moves in here and Contreras moves over to Hey Bear.

**HEY BEAR** has attracted Contreras here while regular rider Moran is riding the drop down runner, One For Jack; he won for the third time in his career in his previous event and because he is a three year old, he is allowed back into this category; he ran a strong race against Ontario sire runners last time.

**HE'S NO SAINT** is worth a look; he went from a fringe sprint against Hey Bear to a route against a key winner last time when he was third and now he shortens back to a sprint with Mosqueira.

**BRILLIANT CHARLIE** has been supplying speed but not enough stamina lately; he broke sharply last time but couldn't continue.

**SCHOMBERG** offered sharp early speed last time when dropped in for \$10,000 but he couldn't continue against Hey Bear.

**SLEWSRIDINGSHOTGUN** had speed on the pace last time but faltered; it was just three starts ago that he was much more thorough with his second lifetime win.

**BROADWAY SENSATION** will put the blinkers on in this attempt to shorten up after a series of routes; he was in against a key winner last time.

**BEAREAGLE** ran well to take a maiden win two starts ago; most recently in a protected spot, he faded only gradually in an ok effort; he now faces non winners of three and seeks his second win.

**SHOT FOR SHOT** looked good beating non winners of two in his previous event going long; most recently, he used a different style when more aggressive and he couldn't continue against a key winner; he shortens to a sprint with a chance to run late.
