RITZY ROSE ran strongly on the turf in December at Gulfstream; she had a return to the races here April 23rd but didn't show much on Tapeta; getting over to the turf should be helpful.

ACIANO went better second time out when switched to the turf and she was able to contend through the stretch in an easier maiden classification while finishing a tight fourth; the runner up has come back to win; she goes up into a tougher classification.

VIA ANN was involved in some crowding a half mile from home on the turf last time; the result was allowed to stand and she was an ok fourth beaten only two lengths when You're Mine was second and Heart Rush was third.

PLAYA BLANCA camped in behind runners last time then was unable to improve her position through the home lane; she gets more room here.

MARITIMECONNECTION had run well on Tapeta in her previous event against a key winner; improvement was expected on turf last time but after a long pre race delay, she did not come close to running her best; she gives turf another try.

SPLASHTACKULAR missed considerable time and got back in the game June 10th on turf only to have a gate malfunction ruin her chances and she was declared a non starter; she is getting a route on turf here.

YOU'RE MINE went better than most expected in her June 17th debut judging by her long odds and her close up finish for Pin Oak Stable and Malcolm Pierce; she was bearing down for the advantage in the stretch when the preferred winner came barrelling from the outside to win it all.

DYNA'S MISCHIEF had a positive enough opener but let that race slip away; second time out, she was on turf and closed belatedly outside against some of these.

HEART RUSH opted for a speed style when on turf last time and she held the advantage until very late when passed by the runner up, You're Mine, and then the eventual winner, Sister Nation, who was favoured; she can be a factor once again.

RIVERINE had a poor result in her debut on turf; for this second start, she will compete only if the event goes on Tapeta.

AMBER BREWSKI had her best chance last time and finished only a distant second at low odds; Contreras will now ride Leighlin Road; a move is made to Da Silva here at a route.

PATMOS took the big drop second time out June 23rd but her overanxious approach on the lead opening up a six length advantage did not work in her favour and she understandably fatigued in the stretch finishing fourth with Sweet City Woman in second; now that she has had two races, she has an opportunity to be more thorough and Garcia takes over.

LEIGHLIN ROAD takes the plunge; she started this year for \$20,000 with a win but since that time, has been protected in situations where she has been long odds and non threatening; she now goes for just \$9,500.

OLIVIA'S SMILE beat no one last time on grass; she halves in value looking to improve with the move back to Tapeta; she did win on this surface last September.

SWEET CITY WOMAN showed some improvement in her seasonal bow and went even better second time out at the meet when she rallied in concert with the eventual winner and missed narrowly; the runner directly behind her has since come back to be second for \$19,000; she remains at the \$10,000 mark.

JUICYCREST has had a couple of races but has not been a factor in either sprint; she will stretch out around two turns here with Wilson aboard for John Charalambous.

LADY BRIE went from a sprint to a route last time and had a strong performance; she was in a pace battle with the fifth place finisher and then a strong older opponent ran by her in the stretch and she was finally second; she now goes to the turf and runs farther than ever before; her sire does get turf and stamina runners.

KADLEY will be moved over to turf for the initial time after a good late finish last time when missing one of the better prizes to the pair of I Look Incredible and Ryoan who all finished just about together in pursuit of a clear winner.

RYOAN was on turf last October and had a strong effort when second when narrowly beaten; she has had three runs this season including two good performances and last time, was third and had I Look Incredible in front of her and Kadley in behind her; she should welcome the move to the grass.

I LOOK INCREDIBLE took a maiden win on turf two starts ago using a new and confident off the pace style; she won the much faster split while, Niigon's Bay, captured the slower split.

ALICE'S WAR ran well on turf two starts ago to begin this campaign; she entered for turf last time but when the race was taken off the lawn, her chances disappeared and she finished next to last.

NIIGON'S BAY received a perfect winning ride from Husbands for Chiefswood Stable last time; she was allowed to find her best stride from far off the pace on turf and she used her size to mount a good stretch drive outside; she was up just in time to win in the slower split; the runner up has since come back to score; she now joins the lasix program and remains on turf at a longer distance; Husbands was aboard for a recent work in 49.4.

SCATTER THE SILVER received a perfect winning ride from Ryan last time out to win for maiden \$20,000 on the turf; she ran by the others in the stretch when dropped down and she found relief as the favourite; she goes up in value here.

KHAWLAH has had just a single run this season and didn't keep up in a Tapeta sprint; she has had exposure to the turf before and now goes long on the grass.

SCRAM CRACKER was going first time off the claim for Tino Attard and switched surfaces and extended in distance with blinkers on; early speed was obvious but he was unable to continue in contention; the blinkers are off and he drops below his claimed evaluation here and shortens in distance.

SOUL N' SPIRIT was somewhat tentative on turf last time but moved late along the inside to finish third beaten three lengths for \$19,000; he will shorten in distance and go up in value.

MASTER MACDUFF was given a good chance to improve second time out at the meeting but his advancement was minor and he finished fourth while He Started It was second; he does have five turf winning siblings and perhaps the improvement will take place with this transfer to the lawn.

HE STARTED IT was getting his second start of the campaign June 16th and it looked much like his opener; he finished second narrowly beaten; the winner took sharp support in that event with a wake up performance; he does have two turf winning siblings and now gets over to the grass for the first time.

R QUICK ARCH was on the turf last summer and had early prominence; this will be his fourth start of this campaign and he is without a share this year.

SHOWING SIN had an awkward break from the gate two starts ago; most recently on Tapeta, he angled off the rail and made a run in third at a lower level against a heavy favourite.

ZACKEROO a homebred for R. M. C. Stable, is by a sire who liked the grass; he has had a variety of five furlong works getting ready in his last trio of moves and Campbell will ride here for Nick Gonzalez.

MISSED HIM is getting his first start of the year for Paul Buttigieg and is up in value after going unplaced while dropping down last autumn; he has had a series of five furlong works dating back to early June.

HEAD HUNTER ran June 30th for \$30,000 when stretching to one mile and was looking to build on his very good race of the time before when second; however, he hung in that last event; he gets a quick comeback and shortens in distance and devalues for \$23,500.

PRINCE IN DISGUISE a debut runner for Ballycroy Training Centre and B. A. M. Racing, is working with quite a pedigree being by the popular, Lonhro and from a dam who was not only a stakes winner in England but also a Grade 2 winner in California on turf; he debuts here for \$23,500 and worked on the grass recently for Blair Miller.

GORDIE MAC rushed away from post fourteen on turf June 30th but gradually fell back; he gets to drop here and shorten in distance with the blinkers on.

HOLTZ is running with a claiming evaluation for the first time and is moving to turf and does have one grass winning sibling; the blinkers are off here; he faced a key winner on Tapeta last time and was overwhelmed; there were some positive points to his previous event.

AUGUSTO B competed last time in a race dominated by late closers at nine furlongs and he was always up chasing the pace and finished third while taking sharper support than usual; he remains at this low level and Ryan once again has the mount.

VINTAGE TIME took a big drop July 1st but that event featured a key winner who is also dropping down; he finished a flat fifth; he takes the blinkers off and goes from a sprint to a route and wins the services of Contreras who perhaps had another option in this race.

FIERY BEAR had a route win back in the middle of May; most recently, he was down to this level and ran with Augusto B close to the pace but both were eclipsed late when the chargers took the top prizes; he finally faded to fifth.

LION OF JUDAH was not a factor in his second start of the campaign when he dropped to this level at six furlongs; he now stretches out.

CANDY RIDE CAT has now had a couple of sprints and will stretch out on this occasion; his lone win came going long on the turf at Fort Erie last October; a move is made to Boulanger.

EXILE TRAIN made a good move on the outside June 24th but his advance wasn't as good as the top two who were rallying strongly; he had to settle for fourth, one position behind, Augusto B, who followed the pace; Wilson now rides.

NOW YA WANT ME was behind early and trailing last time in a six furlong race; he will stretch out here.

ASTERISM is accustomed to running long; he was getting his second start of the campaign June 25th and received a smart winning ride from Contreras in a sprint who planted him behind traffic and at the last moment when room was available he quickly moved away from that group; Contreras is riding Vintage Time and Da Silva will move in here on the stretch out.

UNCATCHABLE FIRE has had two runs this season at higher levels and was beaten only five lengths last time when he raced far on the outside through the stretch; he departs turf and moves to Tapeta with a drop for \$16,000.

TOBRUK attracted a claim May 26th when winning for \$6,000 and he repeated last time for Shana Lopez while competing for Anthony Powell and Dale Powell; that was his third lifetime victory; he now moves to the care of Noel Williams and had an interim work on the training track July 5th getting ready to go against multiple winners.

LUNAR LIGHT attracted a claim May 17th in his seasonal bow when he had an unlucky trip through the stretch and lost narrowly; he was put up into a first allowance race last time where he hung and he encountered a strong late pace; the fourth place finisher from that race, came back to win with a brilliant performance on turf; now that he drops to an intermediate level, he is looking to have his best stretch performance for Norm McKnight and Hernandez will take over.

VEGAS STRIP has been shut out in four trips this season and has run twice at the current meeting in starter events where he has finished third both times; he comes onto the open market for \$16,000 and has yet another rider switch with Wilson now taking over.

CHIEF CHATO attracted a claim here May 12th when fading out of the money at small odds; he took part in a five horse race at Fort Erie last time where he ended in a dead heat at 3-5; he now comes in for \$16,000.

SPADINA ROAD dropped in for \$16,000 last time but experimented with a route and got in a pace fight with Danger Bay and finished last while his rival was just one position in front of him; his previous events sprinting on Tapeta had merit and he finished sixth beaten four lengths in that key race from which the second, third and seventh place finishers have come back to win; he moves back to a sprint.

KITTEN CANDY is without a victory in recent times but finished fourth in a difficult starter event last time; he stayed a bit more willingly; yet another rider switch is made here.

FORTIS has yet to tip his hand that he is ready for a big stretch drive but on his best days, he has significant stretch influence and he is dropping down in this third start of the campaign.

RUN TO THE BANK is looking for a breakthrough victory this season; for \$20,000 on turf at a sprint two starts ago, he was an ok third; most recently on turf at a route for \$30,000, he got in against a key winner and finished fourth; the first place finisher has since come back with an even better win; he goes the other way in for just \$20,000 at a route and he has been successful here on Tapeta going long in the past.

HABEMUS PAPAM is getting his first start of the year and now goes for Julia Carey; he had light campaigning last season without sharing; he comes down in value to begin this campaign.

NIIGON ROAD was made the favourite last time following a fourteenth place finish and a twenty five and a half length loss and the backing was justified he galloped in front at tiny odds to beat non winners of three for \$19,000; now he tackles multiple winners and stretches from seven furlongs to a route for Norm McKnight.

KY CAUSEWAY is a five year old mare getting her third start of the year and she is in against the boys here; she narrowly missed at a route in her seasonal bow for \$23,500; she was protected when out of the money on turf last time but now comes over to Tapeta and that has been a winning angle for Kevin Attard.

TH ORIGINAL SCOTTY was in for \$15,000 going from a sprint to a route June 23rd in his third start of the year; he rounded rivals as if he would win but the first place finisher eventually found some space deep in the stretch and beat him back into second.

GRAY PHANTOM was out of the money on turf last time; he is just a two time winner facing multiple winners with this transfer back to Tapeta with the blinkers off.

PUGSLEY was out of the money on turf last time; it has been a potent angle for Martin Drexler to move runners off turf to Tapeta in recent campaigns with a high ROI; he goes around two turns here and has done that well in the past.

MOONLIGHT MALICE dropped into the right spot for a win two starts ago and overcame his problems at the gate to get a good position close to a slow pace; he won easily; most recently against multiple winners, he was in an event that featured a preferred winner who has already come back to win again; he now drops out of that longshot spot to go at an intermediate level.

MEGALIN CANDY typically offers sharp early speed, yet, often fades; she was in front early last time and lost out only late and when the winner was demoted for interference, she was handed second prize; that makes four consecutive in the money finishes at the meeting.

ELLA'S SPARKLE an inexpensive auction purchase by, Showing Up, is from a dam who had some speed and she produced the local winner, Me More; she debuts here for Ralph Biamonte with lasix at six furlongs for \$8,000 and has been here since April getting ready.

NORTHERN COLORS a debut runner for Julia Samulak, is a homebred by Old Forester and from the same dam who produced this year's winner, Midnight Brew; she has had a variety of riders in the morning and Zenteno will get the call here at six furlongs for just \$8,000; lasix is used.

PASTURE CURFEW was in for \$10,000 two starts ago and finished third when pursuing through the lane; most recently, she was asked for her best but faltered; she comes down to a new low with blinkers on.

ZLATICA had a good enough opening pair at abbreviated distances but when she stretched out last time, she wasn't as good; she comes off a freshening.

TITAN CITY is worth considering; she offered better pace positioning last time when the fractions were slower but she faltered late for Norm McKnight; she drops in value and shortens in distance.

THAT'S CLAIRE gave herself up in an all out speed duel last time for \$8,000 when dropped down and she gave away positions late at 20-1 to be a distant fourth; she shortens to six furlongs.

RHOSGOBEL was out of the money on turf in a couple of starts then dropped down and moved to Tapeta last time where she had no impact; she puts the blinkers on and drops down here; Contreras should have her running late.

SUPER CHILL has had three runs this season and was closer to the pace last time but couldn't carry on in contention; she comes from the widest post.
