VIVA NEVADA has had just a single start this season and beat non winners of two for \$9,500 going long on Tapeta; she has a different challenge here moving to turf for the first time and going up in value.

SARAH TOGA SAINT won her seasonal bow in 2016 when she was on turf and she provided a rally then; this will be her first start since last September and she gets to drop for \$20,000 for Steve Owens and Bahen will be aboard.

FLAMENCO DANCER made a gamble on getting through last time and made it in time for a narrow victory for \$20,000 against non winners of two and she handled turf just fine.

THIS IS MY NIGHT was on turf two outings ago and finished an ok fourth for \$40,000 in a key race from which the winner came back to be third in the Zadracarta and both the second and third place finishers came back to win; she was at a high level on Tapeta last time where she followed the pace and finished on the edges; she now drops for \$20,000 and gets to turf which gives her a chance for a wake up.

CAPE MIST was lapped by the winner last time and that made it difficult for her to continue in contention and she slipped back to fifth when Kate's Whistle was second.

OFELIA GIRL won two in a row including a race for just \$9,500 when claimed last time; she now goes to turf for the first time for her new conditioner Ramon Dominguez Jr.

SIERRA ANGEL used a galloping style on the outside on turf last time for \$19,000 but didn't have an impact.

SOLON'S WARNING took the big drop for \$20,000 June 9th and in her second start of the season, she moved prematurely to the lead and then was beaten late and finished third and attracted a claim; she now goes for Norm McKnight and comes right back at her claimed evaluation.

KATE'S WHISTLE was getting her second start of the year June 21st and was once again on turf and with a drop for \$20,000, she woke up with a peak performance; even though the winner got by her, she was trying hard right to the end; Hernandez moves in.

HEY HOWIE a debut runner for Nick Gonzalez, is by a sire that did win a stake as a two year old and is from a dam who won on the turf in France; he debuts here at five and a half furlongs on Tapeta and beat company in a gate work June 25th in 50.4bg.

ROCK THE HOUSE had a fast gate work June 23rd just before his debut July 1st where he gambled on a front end approach at five furlongs but the winner came up the fence and beat him at the last possible moment; he settled for second; Hernandez is once again aboard for Ian Howard.

SENT FROM HEAVEN a debut runner for Sam Di Pasquale, is by a sire who won as a juvenile and this one is from a dam who had speed; he prepped in company July 1st in 48.4 getting ready and earlier prepped from the gate.

HAZY DAVY a debut runner for Julia Carey, is by Silent Name and is from a dam who has produced three winners; he had a prompt work June 25th in 49.1.

BE VEVY VEVY QUIET a debut runner by Silent Name, is from the same dam who produced the recent winner, Jade Dragon; he worked from the gate June 25th in 49.1bg getting ready and had a quicker work from the gate earlier in 47.4bg for Robert Tiller; Ryan rides.

ZUCKER a significant auction purchase, debuts for Kevin Attard and is from a dam who has produced five multiple winners; he worked from the gate July 8th in 1.01.2bg getting ready and Campbell will ride from the outside.

LADY VIOLET M had a hustling speed approach July 1st and weakened in sixth for \$20,000; she comes down one level and moves to the turf for the first time. **MARY SUE WELOVEYOU** has not been a factor in either of her two races since coming from Gulfstream; she was exposed to the turf there; she is up in value, following a fringe try last time, for an opportunity to get back on the grass.

ARCTIC MIA is from a dam who has produced four turf winners and perhaps getting onto the turf will be a reason for some optimism after two wide losses against dominant winners on Tapeta.

BIG BROWN BEAUTY was on turf two starts ago and raced well finishing fourth for \$23,500; she shortened to six furlongs last time and ran ok with an inside move; Alderson will take over with the move back to the grass.

PIAZZA TIME a debut runner, is going for Paul Buttigieg and is from a dam who has already produced two foals that have both won on the grass; she went to turf to prep July 7th getting ready for this introduction which comes on the grass with Wilson.

LAKE MANITOU was in against some of these last time and found herself in fourteenth spot early after a bumpy beginning and was finally unable to threaten; she goes to turf.

R FLEET FOOT had an awkward departure from the gate last time and after running up to be part of the pace chase, she faltered; she now goes to turf for the initial time.

TALLIEVISION dropped sharply for \$8,000 trying to win a race last time but as the favourite, she won the pace fight but lost the race to a closer; she revisits the turf, a footing she handled ok as a juvenile.

ICRYWHENI'MDRUNK became overly enthusiastic as part of an aggressive pace July 5th in a failed route experiment; the top four were all closers and she faded in fifth; she is up in value and moves to the turf, a footing she handled well earlier this year at Gulfstream.

D'S BENEFACTION was just on the edges last time and inconvenienced slightly by the winner who was demoted for interference; she will now move to turf for the first time and worked recently on the grass.

SLOVENIA handled herself well enough on turf for \$19,000 last time when she was fifth in a crowded field and she stayed willingly.

MOON OVER VICTORIA was on turf two outings ago and raced adequately against much better than she will encounter here; she did take a drop in value last time but her lack of early prominence was very costly and then she moved well late while outside.

FOR U MIKE has been on turf in recent events against better without threatening and should welcome the drop down.

SEEWILL was close by on Tapeta two starts ago but didn't threaten; she was farther back last time and now drops and goes to turf.

R MOUNTSBERG was on turf last time where she was forced to endure a difficult situation and she retreated; she is hoping for a better journey.

DATING SOPHIE has been on turf in three consecutive events without threatening and now gets to drop down.

TOWER HILL began the year with a win but was out of the money last time and now goes to turf for the initial time for Steve Owens with blinkers added.

CHILL is dropping down into more reachable company here after a couple of out of the money finishes to begin this campaign; he is a one time winner on the turf and is a possible wake up candidate; Maragh takes over.

BELIEVE N MIRACLES had a June 23rd return to the races after more than a year away and should benefit from that race; he handled turf ok early in his career.

DZALA likes turf the best; he was on Tapeta late last season and his form deteriorated; this will be his seasonal bow for his new conditioner Anthony Pottinger.

NEIL'S DIAMOND goes for one of the hottest stables; his form slumped when he dropped for \$20,000 two starts ago and he was far back in a tougher type of race last time; the only time he tried turf, he finished near the back.

SPLASH WITH ME had a good enough sprint two outings ago but failed a route last time; he will now get back to sprinting and move over to grass, a footing he has handled only once and he was on the edges then.

BEARS TERMINATOR gets his first start since last October when he was out of the money at this price range on Tapeta; he now tries turf in this return.

INCREDIBLE DEE used an ineffective speed style last time and understandably withered in the stretch; he has had plenty of exposure to turf in the past without winning.

MCGARRETT has spent plenty of time prepping on turf this season and now gets over to turf in this second start of the campaign which comes with a big drop in value; he won a short race on grass last season.

GUATEMALA CITY is up in value for an opportunity to get onto turf; he was only third behind his stable mate last time for \$6,000 on Tapeta.

CANADIAN CLASS is getting his first start of the year and he tried turf last season without threatening; he does hit a new low level here.

COBILOCO is a newcomer to Woodbine; he made a start in January at Gulfstream on turf where he did not have a good beginning in a short distance race; he has been here for a series of works since the spring time and should appreciate this more wide open course.

OPENING REMARK was on turf just two starts ago with a solid second place finish that will recommend him here if he is fortunate enough to draw in.

MR CHANGUE was on Tapeta last time and unplaced with a big drop for \$6,250; he is without a win on turf.

MYSTERION is a one time winner on grass; he took a drop for \$10,000 and moved to Tapeta last time and had a wake up run in second; he moves back to turf.

SPEIGHTSTOWN TIME had a booming race on turf last time and if he is fortunate enough to draw in, he can be a strong factor.

RIVERINE debuted June 17th at a route on turf and was fanned wide and then could not keep up through the stretch in that key event; for this second start, she runs seven furlongs on Tapeta.

LOST POINT had her return to the races in May on turf and was just on the edges; she ran a similar type of race when stretched out on turf last time; she moves to a Tapeta sprint here for the first time in her career.

WHIP ME INTO SHAPE has now been second in three consecutive races; she was in the runner up spot last time against a debut runner from the Casse stable who was always better and kept her two lengths away; once again she looks like a main contender.

EDISTO ISLAND a debut runner, has plenty of stamina in her pedigree; she will debt here for Mark Casse at seven furlongs on Tapeta; she has been here last June getting ready and prepped July 8th in 59.4; Boulanger has the mount.

MALIBU BONNIE had a good race to begin this year April 15th at Keeneland when second best; since that time, she has had consecutive out of the money finishes on dirt; she comes off the shelf; she prepped recently on turf in 59.4 but will race on Tapeta for the first time here.

MUSICAL FLIGHT had a couple of races last autumn without threatening; she begins this campaign with lasix and blinkers and tries seven furlongs on Tapeta.

MUST BE DREAMING had a good opener last summer on turf but then caught a yielding turf course August 26th and did not handle herself well through the stretch; she is making her way back here for Roger Attfield and did work June 24th on Tapeta in 1.00; Garcia has the mount.

TWO TRIBES was planted in behind runners from the second flight along the inside last time and stayed willingly to be fourth beaten four lengths and Whip Me Into Shape was second best about two lengths better; blinkers are added.

LEISURE missed considerable time then relocated here June 3rd for a sprint on Tapeta and finished third after a fanning incident when Whip Me Into Shape, was better in second; she has had an opportunity to train up to this second local start.

MIDNIGHT BREW had a good charge on Tapeta three starts ago at seven furlongs to win with late energy; she had a subsequent good race at just six furlongs; she went to turf last time and was too late getting started; she comes back to Tapeta with a chance to provide a rally.

TORIAEZU NAMA seems to be able to hit peak races but to date, has been unable to repeat them; she had a booming race second time out with a high rating but when she failed as the heavy favourite last time, she wasn't as good as many expected, yet, ran capably; she looks like a contender once again; she takes a significant drop here.

RAINBOWS AHEAD won easily when dropped into the right spot for \$20,000 two starts ago and she was claimed; most recently for new interests, she went up in value where she was out of the money and Toriaezu Nama was better in second; like that one, she is dropping in value here.

SOUTHERN PUZZLE is getting her second start of the year and is looking to go up in value while some others in here are coming down in price; her June 16th seasonal bow featured some middle speed.

CLASSIC TALE has not been herself in either race this season; she was off the pace early last time then faltered; Da Silva who did get some run from her last year, will now take over with a drop for \$20,000 tonight.

I'LL TAKE THE CAKE started a run on the turn last time and was gradual with her response finishing fourth for Nick Nosowenko; she did have a Elusive Suzy in behind her on that occasion.

ELUSIVE SUZY had a good race May 26th over a surface somewhat helpful to speed types and she drew off; most recently against non winners of three over a surface more helpful to closing types, her speed was ineffective and I'll Take The Cake was better in fourth.

ENCHANTED was in this category last time traveling a route and sat outside with every change to quicken but she hung finishing fourth; she ran a similar type race the time before; she looks to be one of the better ones in the event.

PRINCESS BULLET had a seasonal bow sprinting and then went long last time in this category finishing just in behind Enchanted; for this third run of the year, she should be ready to run her best of the season.

CRUMLIN QUEEN went in routes regularly last season and with good results; she sprinted on Tapeta in her opening three races with some ok fringe prizes; she went to the Damsel Stakes at a mile on grass last time and despite acting up in the gate pre break, she was fifth only a few lengths behind at the end against a key winner; she now goes two turns on Tapeta looking for a breakthrough.

GYPSY JAZZ was in this category last time pursuing from the inside and she stalled finishing a couple of lengths behind Enchanted who is also here.

EVIL WOMAN opted for a clear speed style when going from two sprints to a route last time and dropping from the Lady Angela Stakes; she gave up some momentum late in that event against some of these; Campbell retains the mount.

LADY NICKY is getting her first race since the spring time when she ran seven furlongs on turf with some front end speed before retreating.

WINGAWAY was dropped down by Roger Attfield to compete June 21st for \$20,000 and she attracted a claim by Jamie Attard; she rallied nicely but hung near the end; she now gets over to Tapeta, a footing over which she won last October; Lermyte takes over.

LADY MARCHFIELD had a good enough seasonal bow sprinting on Tapeta; second time out, however, she was pressured on the second turn and was unable to keep up; she has been training on turf but enters for Tapeta here.

OUR VICTOR is getting his third race of the season and was out of the money on turf last time and now drops sharply for \$10,000 and adds blinkers; he offered some prominent rallies on Tapeta last year.

REBELLION'S DREAM is getting a belated first start of the season and now goes for Darren Glennon; he has been here prepping since the spring getting ready and opts to go for \$10,000 at six and a half furlongs with Mosqueira in this return.

KISS UP justified his favouritism with a June 21st win in his first try since last July; he got rolling in the stretch and his giant frame carried him to a two length win for Denyse McClachrie; he now tries non winners of two at one price lower.

WALL STREET WOLF competed over a surface last time very helpful to runners with closing ability; he opted instead for a front end attempt and gave up a clear advantage late to finish third beaten a length; he now drops in for \$10,000.

COURTISINSESSION has been out finished in recent races and has now gone to the stable of Niall Collum and Wilson will take over here; he was fifth of nine last time with just mild interest.

JOIN THE RUSH had a couple of spring starts and in his second run of the campaign, he dropped sharply and took significant support when a second time lasix user; he followed traffic and escaped to find a path deep in the stretch and won it in exciting fashion under Garcia for Don MacRae; he has been freshened and now returns at a drastically reduced evaluation looking to double up.

ROCKY PALACE experimented with a route two starts ago and had early prominence; once again around two turns last time, he enjoyed only early prominence.

ROCK RIVER got into an appropriate spot last time but had a difficult journey and finished a belated fifth; both the second and fourth place finishers have come back to win; Campbell moves in here.

IDA'S WARRIOR gets Hernandez here; he has been out of the money in two consecutive turf races and now plunges for \$10,000 with the move to Tapeta; he is a wake up prospect.

CASE IN POINT was a winner on Tapeta at seven furlongs to open up this campaign for \$8,000 but at this price range last time, he was sent a route on the lead and didn't have enough resources; he cuts back in distance and has had an opportunity for some interim prepping.

PADRE PIO was at Fort Erie last time and finished fourth in a turf event where he hung in the stretch; he seeks a breakthrough win.
