RACE #1

SHEZ A TEN I KNOW is taking a substantial drop here after a fourth place finish against a dominant speed winner at the beginning of June; she will be trying turf for the first time and is a daughter of Court Vision; she returns from time away and Boulanger once again has the mount for Mark Casse.

FLAMENCO DANCER is also taking a drop down in value and she was on turf two starts ago where she finished fourth against a key winner; in a race that came off the grass and went on Tapeta last time, she had an ok race but weakened late and now she goes for just \$20,000.

ZDENKA started the year at this elevated level and was not a factor on turf; she is a one time winner on the grass however and has taken some other shares.

GLIB MARYLIN is getting onto turf for the second time in her career; she has several fringe prizes to her credit at lower levels this year and with the move to the grass, she is doubling in price.

SHE'S NO MEENY is a one time winner on turf and did handle the grass ok June 9th when she stepped up for \$19,000 and ran second after finally getting clear in the stretch.

STRING BIKINI had a seasonal bow June 21st and sprinted on turf with a late response going well along the inside; she now extends from a sprint to a route on turf.

BABY GIRL BURT was in the same most recent race last time as She's No Meeny when traveling a route on turf and she attempted a rally and stayed on to be fourth beaten four lengths but her rival was two lengths superior.

VIEW THE STAR dropped in for \$8,000 when coming off the shelf June 18th and checked hard midway of the first turn then had difficulty settling; she finally finished fourth and is now up in value.

ABOGADA was getting her first route June 7th and it was a nice step forward; she was up in price and finished second to a well regarded winner; this will be her second time with lasix.

DIAMOND VISION was off her feet and beaten a wide margin to start the season; second time out, she dropped down and stretched out and had a better performance to be two lengths behind the runner up, Abogada.

MISS VIVI was overwhelmed in a couple of sprints to start her career; she now drops in half and extends in distance with a move to Tapeta for Francine Villeneuve and Boulanger stays aboard.

NIPISSING RIDGE debuted June 16th in a tough spot on turf at long odds and was pinched back early then started to run when in behind some traffic; she finally finished tenth; coming to Tapeta should help.

ICRYWHENI'MDRUNK had such a strong performance May 14th at Gulfstream on turf when second for \$12,500; after a bad result there May 28th, she was sent here; she will depart lasix with the arrival at the Debra Rombis barn; she does show local works here.

CALLIELIKEDHERBREW like her stable mate, Miss Vivi, is taking the big drop; she had a couple of races earlier this season but lost in double digits both times; a move is made to Ryan for this run around two turns.

SONNET BOOM debuted in an open maiden event on turf and that group was too quick for him; when he dropped down second time out to face Ontario sire and also claiming types, he was thought to have a good chance to improve and with blinkers added, he won at 15-1; he now gets a real hike in class.

EMINENT FORCE had trained forwardly June 9th on turf and nine days later, was in the winner's circle for \$30,000 and he was well clear at the end and attracted a claim by Dale Desruisseaux; he goes for new interests here and Campbell will ride once again.

STRUT N STOMP had a May 28th seasonal bow in the same race where Best Bard was better in second; that rival has already come back with an in the money finish and is here; he is looking to move forward in this second start of the year in search of his third win on turf.

TROUBLE IN PHOENIX seemed to take an edge in his seasonal bow when dropped in for \$20,000 to win going away; in his second start, he jumped significantly and moved to turf and won big by quickening smartly at the end; he may have more potential as he comes off the shelf following a freshener.

PORTREE returned to the races June 10th and with that out of the way, he will move over to turf at the same distance; he does have a win on grass and has attracted Hernandez for Stuart Simon.

BEST BARD is noted for his turf wins and close up finishes; he has been in the money in his last pair; most recently, he had every chance with a half furlong remaining but missed by a length; he departs that difficult second allowance group and now falls into a more reachable category.

SAN NICOLA THUNDER has taken huge support in both wins off the claim; he won on turf in his last start with an obvious quickening stride deep in the stretch; when the occasion called for it in his previous event, he dominated the pace throughout.

BEAR AT LAST will compete only if this event comes off the grass and he has taken all of his career wins on the synthetic surface here including a score last time at the first allowance level when the race set up perfectly for him and he rallied best.

ARCHER TRIUMPH'S was in against a tough winner last time who was dropping down to take an edge; he did well to run on to be fourth behind that dominant winner; he handled the turf well and he comes right back under the same terms.

D'S DARK KNIGHT was in for \$23,500 at seven furlongs on turf last time and advanced behind a wall of runners then did some nice running at the end in fourth beaten two lengths; more room is available here and Boulanger moves in.

STORM HAWK is certainly bred for turf and has had a number of tries on turf including his last start for \$20,000 where he got overanxious on a quick pace and then did not have much left for the stretch drive; Lermyte takes over here.

SILENT WARRIOR was unable to keep up in a May 22nd opener going long on Tapeta and will now shift over to turf and drop for \$20,000 with lasix added.

HESASHREWDDUDE debuted June 11th for John Ross and finished twelfth without threatening but he did take a hint of support; for this second start, he drops in value and enters for turf at a route distance.

LASER FOCUS had a seasonal bow June 9th and discovered turf in that event and was sixth beaten only eight lengths by Sonnet Boom who was entered in race three today; he can certainly build on that performance.

PROFESSOR HARTWICK had difficulty finding a level stride last time for \$16,000 when sprinting on Tapeta; he goes long on turf here; he handled turf at a short distance last September; he was forced to scratch June 21st and will go here instead.

INQUISITIVE is a four year old homebred for Colebrook Farms by Niigon; he has had a variety of works on different surfaces getting ready and has won the services of Contreras in this turf debut from the outside post.

MC DREAMY a debut runner for Colebrook Farms, is a son of Leonnatus Antreas and from a dam who has produced five winners including a stakes winner; Zenteno will ride from the rail at six and a half furlongs. **D'S DOUBLE EAGLE** looks like a threat here; he has put together a series of good results and was second last time for \$15,000 when pushed up in value; he drops in value for this event and Contreras is brought in to this bright spot.

KINDA CHAOTIC made a late move on the inside June 25th in his second start of this campaign to net fourth money in an ok effort when the winner closed sharply also; he is up in value.

TEIAIAGON has run so poorly through the stretch in his last two races to end far behind; the blinkers are off and he departs turf and goes to a Tapeta sprint.

CHEROKEE KNIGHT concluded last year with a poor event for \$10,000; he has tried to build momentum in workouts getting ready for this seasonal bow and has attracted Hernandez in this spot for \$12,500.

MIDNIGHT ECHO debuted May 26th in a protected spot and had no prominence; he comes down in value with Ramsammy taking over in this spot and he has had interim prepping.

BRADY O'BRADY competed in an event last time where the top two were fighting it out well removed from the rest; he finished a distant fourth in that seasonal bow and did his best running when he got to the outside; he can improve here.

JIMBO FIVE sat quietly off the pace last time and didn't muster a response and D's Double Eagle was much better in second; he wasn't far away the time before when Wardo was better in second.

KYSLIOS'S JUSTICE is getting his first start since May of 2016 and he wasn't a factor at that time; he has been here for a series of works since returning from Florida.

WARDO took the big drop two starts ago and ran well in second; most recently, he was boosted back up in value and at long odds, he finished out of the money but steadied at the quarter pole and is looking for a better trip here; Boulanger returns after a one race absence with today's big drop.

CALL ME GIZMO has been on turf for both races this season and lost by a wide margin last time against a dominant winner; the blinkers are off and he drops for \$11,500.

BLUTARSKY was a winner to start the year for \$9,500 and most recently at the same price, was just on the edges when rallying belatedly and Jimmies Truck was better in second and that one is here; he gets a little more room.

BETTIN' ACES takes the plunge for a hot stable; he trailed in the early going last time and beat just a single runner at long odds; when he was more heavily bet in his previous event for \$19,000, he finished third and now he goes for only \$10,000 on the plunge; Perfect Forester also has speed.

JIMMIES TRUCK was at six furlongs last time where he closed on the outside belatedly to be third beaten a length and a furlong is added here.

REIMAGINED got back to better form in his third start of the year; he stretched to seven furlongs and dropped sharply for \$10,000 and was second best; he won a speed duel but was passed when Beareagle rushed at the end to win it; he remains a one time winner.

ONE FOR JACK is getting his third start of the year and is hoping for a move forward in form but it has been an extended time without a win.

BEAREAGLE used exciting late energy for a win June 14th for \$9,500 against non winners of two and once he got to the far outside, he quickened past Reimagined who had already won a mid stretch duel; he now faces non winners of three.

PERFECT FORESTER was preferred last time and was able to win at five furlong race in a pace duel; he stretches all the way out to seven furlongs here for Norm McKnight and jumps in value; Bettin' Aces also has speed.

BOLDNPOSSIBLE is getting her first start since April of 2016 when she went off form; she lists a series of works for an extended time getting ready to come off the shelf for Denyse McClachrie; she is just a one time winner.

GERTIE T ran so well in consecutive sprints to start this year taking victories; she was put into the Oaks last time at 44-1 and finished a distant eighth; she looks to start over here with a \$40,000 tag traveling seven furlongs.

GREEN FREEDOM had a nice win second time out this season and that was expected; most recently, she had a letdown in performance when her isolated trip on the outside did not pay dividends; she worked recently with Wilson .

TRABACIOUS is getting her first start of the year and she is noted for good early speed; she competes for the claiming portion of this event against non winners of three and is seeking just her second lifetime win; she competes for Sid Attard.

MADISON WAY had the exact same pattern happen this year that worked last year in that she won second time out and by a clear margin; in that most recent event, she woke up nicely and was full of run through the stretch under Husbands who keeps the mount here.

PHIL'S GLORY won her second lifetime race June 7th in her third start of this year when she went from a sprint to a route and she marched away with a four wide draw under Moran for Paul Buttigieg; she shortens in distance here.

CLASSIC TALE had a June 7th seasonal bow and acted up in the gate pre break; once underway, she was used up duelling with the seventh place finisher and both faded; for this second start of the year, Contreras will take over with the stretch to seven furlongs; she has won at the distance in the past.

CONQUER THE COURSE made a move outside last time to try and challenge the front runner, Madison Way but slipped back to fourth and remains just a one time winner facing non winners of three.

TRINI BREWNETTE hasn't won in recent seasons and when she seemingly had a good chance to score at 2-5 last time, she hung in the stretch; she was going from a sprint to a route and it was a significant letdown; she peels back to a sprint in hopes of a breakthrough performance.

PICASSO MOON took her second win three starts ago and since that time, she has been moved over to turf with consecutive out of the money finishes; she gets back to Tapeta here and her only try on this surface was a winning one.

DEEP BLUE SEA made a move inside on the turn last time trying to rally but finally finished fourth; both the fifth and sixth place finishers have come back to win; she competes for the \$40,000 tag here.

SCHLOSS SCHNEEBERG had a good result sprinting on Tapeta for a maiden score May 13th when producing the best rally; a subsequent race with a boost to the \$19,000 mark and a move to turf left him a willing third; after a letdown performance on grass last time, he now drops sharply for just \$6,000 and goes to Tapeta.

ME MORE ran a strong race two starts ago at five furlongs but was second against ,Perfect Forester, who dropped down for that event and he was entered in race six tonight; most recently, he lengthened out to six furlongs but landed third against a winner new to Woodbine; he drops back to the \$6,000 mark.

MR CHANGUE enjoyed some early prominence last time for \$19,000 but faltered; after two starts, he now devalues.

SILENT VISION has been in for \$10,000 in consecutive events but has finished eighth in both events; he comes down in value.

EASTER GOLD is getting his first start of the year and he has been busy with a series of works; Bridgmohan will ride for Marilyn Johnston.

EXECUTIVEGUTS was behind early from the inside in a June 25th return after a month away; he then lost in double digits when Me More was third.

CONN'S REWARD was behind early in his latest when dropped down and he couldn't get within range and lost in double digits.

BIT'S LOVER BOY is going second time off the claim here and dropping back down to his claimed evaluation after an eleventh place finish last time where he faltered.

CONQUEST TOO SMART was getting his third start of the year and he took the big plunge in for \$6,250 and had a nibbling of support but showed little against a key top pair including the runner up, Me More.

KAT'S GOOD SCOUT steadied into the turn in a five furlong race last time and then stayed on to be fourth with Me More in second; he is looking to build on that good race but must go a furlong farther.

MINERS DANCE was asked from the second flight last time but did not pick it up; he will drop significantly and Moran will take over here.

KAYEZ has some ability as he showed two starts ago for \$6,000 when second and he also went ok last time when boosted in price finishing one spot behind Me More.
