HEMMIN AND HAWIN was on turf last time and was in behind runners at the top of the stretch but made his way forward willingly to be fourth just two and a half lengths behind the third place finisher, Nello; he seems to be coming up to a good effort.

PANTHER KEY had a recent start to the season and with that race out of the way, he now becomes more of a contender and ;Contreras is brought in; he makes a move to turf and extends in distance.

ROCKET PLAN was getting his second start of the season June 4th and was moved over to turf and extended in distance; he landed near the back; he now comes up for a tag and for just \$20,000.

NELLO was on turf two starts ago and handled himself well with a deep closing style to be third beaten a length and a half; he subsequently moved up in value for his latest where he landed on the edges on Tapeta and that should be an ideal bridge race to get him to this more acceptable spot.

BLOW OVER trailed in the early going in his second start of the season June 23rd which came off the turf and he was finally ninth without threatening; he extends in distance and goes to turf, a footing with which he is familiar.

CLEVER SOUL needed to get down to the \$16,000 mark to produce a winning race at seven furlongs last time and it was a demonstrative score; he had been out of the money on turf the time before although he does have some appreciation for the lawn.

BUBBA BOY has tried the turf only once and that was his latest for \$19,000 when he made a bid but hung; Moreno takes over; he is one of two in the race for Sam Di Pasquale.

CLOSE IMAGE a debut runner for owner/trainer, Sylvain Pion, is by the useful, Badge Of Silver, a multiple stakes winner who also liked the grass; she will travel five furlongs on Tapeta from the rail post.

WEDDING RING a debut runner for owner/trainer, Noel Williams, is by Where's The Ring and traveling five furlongs here; she has used the gate extensively for works over short distances getting.

GIMBALA debuted June 17th and along with the winner, Mega Monster, was part of the leading group; she was finally second to the well regarded winner; for this second start, she tries blinkers added.

ESSENTIAL debuted June 17th in the same race as the runner up, Gimbala, and came from ninth in the early going to be fifth beaten six lengths in late fashion; Wilson retains the mount for Nick Gonzalez.

MISGUIDED PASSION got into a quickly run race in her debut June 10th and the winner who was starting for the second time, showed significant improvement to dominate the pace; she ruined her own chance by breaking so awkwardly then showed life on the outside to be third; a better start from the gate could result in a better performance.

DIRTY GIRL a significant auction purchase, is by Giant Gizmo, and from a dam who was a six time sprint winner; she will debut here at five furlongs and worked July 1st in 47.3 getting ready for Mike De Paulo.

SILENT DAMSEL debuted June 17th against some of these including the runner up, Gimbala, and raced outside and out of contention; she gets a little more room in this second start.

DONTDROPURCROP a debut runner, is one of two in the race for John Ross along with Miss G Note; she was an auction purchase and is a daughter of Kentucky Bear; she worked willingly June 14th in 1.01.4hg getting ready.

MISS G NOTE debuted June 17th in the same race where Gimbala was second and she indicated an efficient stride but a desire for more room; she ran out of real estate when fourth; she gets a half furlong farther here.

WILD N CLEVER is one of many speed runners in this race and was able to win a starter event on turf last time at six and a half furlongs by hogging the lead and the runner up chased throughout; she seeks her third win on turf.

MISS FORESTER moved off to Fort Erie June 11th to get her first win of this season and it came as the heavy favourite on the turf at Fort Erie and that was her initial turf score.

KASUGA has a wealth of early speed but she moved to a route last time and was given to rating tactics while clear on the front end and she had nothing left for the stretch drive; she will shorten in distance and devalue and move to turf.

GREEN DOCTOR is one of several in here preoccupied with speed; she was able to sit just off the early pace in a couple of her smart wins on grass last season; she exits a race on turf where she was below her best when weakening late in the stretch; she encounters several speed types here.

DISCREET BEAR finished far on the outside without threatening last time in a Tapeta first allowance race and now comes down in value and moves to the grass.

SUPER SARAH is getting her first start of the year and she has had lots of local prepping; she seeks her initial share on the lawn; her chasing style may well help as there is speed to track here.

VEAISHA a notable speed runner, is looking for her first win on the turf in this her second try on turf; her introduction to grass racing last september was a positive one; she has been given to rating tactics this spring and stayed on to be third last time in a tougher category than this; she may be able to stalk from the outside here and move in early stretch.

CATCH YOUR BREATH debuted June 24th for \$8,000 at long odds and had an awkward departure from the gate and raced from behind along the inside without threatening; for this second start, she goes from a sprint to a route and is bred to be a stayer by Milwaukee Brew.

SHE'S ACTING UP a debut runner for Bruno Schickedanz, goes for Norm McKnight around two turns at first asking; she is by, Patriot Act, a stamina source; she has had a series of works getting ready and has attracted Hernandez in this launch.

R FLEET FOOT debuted June 17th at six furlongs but was behind in double digits without threatening at long odds; she drops down, goes farther and is bred to be a stayer.

BID'S KID attracted a claim May 19th and for new interests last time, attracted Hernandez and took support; she was close up early then lost momentum in the middle stages but was running again late; she was finally fifth of ten and will now extend in distance with a move to Wilson with blinkers off.

FAITHHOPELOVEABIDE was not a factor in any of her three starts last season; she comes in at a much lower level to begin this campaign with blinkers off and Rainford riding.

COURT QUEEN was forced to scratch from a race June 18th and this will be her first try since June 3rd when she lost by a wide margin; she will extend in distance here.

SIGNORITA had a couple of sprints to open this campaign and wasn't a factor then; she then went long last time and was far behind for \$7,500.

SHEZTENTHEHARDWAY had a useful performance last time in her fifth start of the year; she was sent long for the second time and got up on the pace and was being used on the second turn and continued in contention to be the runner up.

QUEENS HONOR lacked room behind rivals in a one mile race on turf against some of these last time and is looking for a more enterprising journey; the runner up in that last race, Orphan Queen, is in here.

RASPBERRY WILD had a positive start to the year and then stretched to six and a half furlongs last time and was a distant third when the top two ran away from the others; she is by Showing Up, a distinct source for turf; she goes to the lawn with a stretch around two turns.

SOPHIAS DREAM had all kinds of difficulty in her seasonal bow on turf in a race that is best excused; in her second run on turf this season, she dropped for \$20,000 and was running on nicely to be fourth when Orphan Queen was second.

BRIGHTER IDEAS was on turf for \$32,000 last time and had no luck finding room in mid stretch and then ran on late to be sixth beaten two and a half lengths; she is hoping for a better trip.

TORNADO CAT was on turf last time and was eliminated at the gate when the sixth place finisher broke to the outside and caused significant interference.

ORPHAN QUEEN improved radically second time out with a drop in value and a shift to turf and an extension in distance; she got in a hectic pace fight and while she won the early duel, she lost the race to a closer and settled for second; she adds lasix for this third career start.

HOT GOSSIP a debut runner, is a homebred for Colebrook Farms, by Leonnatus Antreas traveling a route on turf in this launch; she did work on Tapeta June 24th in 48.4 getting ready and had some earlier prepping on the training track.

BULLET THEBLUE SKY debuted at short odds last December and well beaten; she was to start this campaign June 4th but was forced to scratch and will go here instead for just \$19,000; she is bred for the turf and perhaps getting to the turf will be a bonus.

WINTERVELD seemed to lunge at the break last time then moved up gradually on the outside with a third place finish; she will now get to turf; she must jump considerably in value.

LAILAS PRINCESS caused significant interference at the break in her previous event; most recently, she finished first but a claim of foul by the rider of the fifth place finisher, resulted in her being disqualified for interference in mid stretch; she moves to the turf.

RARE GEM was on turf for \$32,000 in her local introduction and got in tight at the top of the stretch looking for room and finally finished eleventh; she drops in for \$20,000 with a move to Husbands looking for improvement here.

R MOUNTSBERG returned after more than a month away June 18th and attended the pace going long then faltered; she now goes to turf.

DANZIG RAINBOW was in for \$32,000 last time and advanced behind runners at the top of the stretch and was finally seventh beaten five and a half lengths; a move is made to Contreras with the drop for \$20,000.

THE OTHER BOLEYN has had some issues pre race; once underway last time, she closed willingly to be third and the runner up, Sheztenthehardway, was entered in the previous race today.

NORTHERN HAMMER is getting his first start in over a year and was narrowly beaten at Fort Erie at that time; he is taking a significant drop here for just \$8,000 hoping to end his winless streak; he has been here prepping for an extended time.

BRILLIANT CHARLIE plunged in for \$5,000 last time and tried to steal the event on the front end but was attacked by the eventual winner on the turn and then was finally second to that tough rival; he now goes off the claim for Willie Armata.

WATCH IT BUSTER did not get out of the gate cleanly last time and that eliminated him from consideration; he continues to make his way down the ladder and goes for only \$8,000 now.

DR. HARKNESS was on the turf at Fort Erie last time and was in a speed try but finished second; in his previous event here, he got locked in a speed duel with Bold Summit and both were beaten by a closer at the end.

MACHITO is getting his first start of the season and he won his opener last year which came later in September; Moran has the mount here in this return; he did go sharless in his final races of last year; he has been here prepping for Michael McDonald.

BOLD SUMMIT got in a speed duel last time with Dr. Harkness and both runners were beaten late by a closer and he settled for second; he was forced to scratch June 18th.

CONCORSO went off to Fort Erie last time in hopes of a second win for this campaign but did not get out of the gate efficiently in an abbreviated event and finished third.

SNOWY LEGACY had a fine opener when second; next time out, he had a difficult time of it early then tried to make a run up the inside but that did not produce a good result; he drops all the way down to the \$8,000 for this third run of the year.

DAN'S REVENGE has had a case of diminishing returns lately; in his most recent start for \$10,000, he was rallying in the stretch when the third place finisher was judged guilty of bothering him and he was elevated to third; he drops a level.

PRIMORDIA has been on turf for recent events; she was in a difficult spot last time against a key winner when beaten in double digits and Extremist was much better in fifth that day beaten only four lengths.

AWFULLY SINFUL had a good result on turf two starts ago in a starter event when second best behind a wake up winner; she moved well on the outside on that occasion; most recently in a \$10,000 starter on Tapeta, she looked to be the best horse but was victimized by a slow pace and a late move; Hernandez has been lured here with the move back to turf; she seeks her first win of the campaign and her initial career score on turf.

WOLVERINA'S WILLA is a one time winner on turf; she was on the grass here June 2nd for \$19,000 but was beaten six lengths without threatening; she dropped down and went to Fort Erie last time and lost by a wide margin.

RUNAWAY BRENDA is getting her first start of the year; she dedicated herself to racing on the Fort Erie turf course late in her campaign last year with good results.

CHEDINGTON was getting her second start of the campaign June 24th and through no merit of her own, was put up into second spot after finishing third beaten a length; the winner was demoted for early interference against two other rivals; she drops back to a claiming event and goes to turf, a footing over which she is a four time winner.

EXTREMIST was slumping on Tapeta and then moved to turf last time at 48-1 where she finished fourth beaten only four lengths with an outside close; she seeks her fourth win on the grass and comes down in value for this; Husbands now rides.

ANOTHER GIRL is dropping down and going to turf for this second start of the campaign after a fringe performance when she opened her season; she is by Old Forester who liked the lawn.

CONQUER THE COURSE is certainly bred for turf and has been on the grass just a couple of times and has been a fringe player; she attracted a claim two starts ago and for new interests, showed improvement last time at an elevated level; with the drop down and shift to the turf, Moreno is brought in by Alexander Patykewich and they are a successful jockey/trainer combo.

ALILACTION quite likes the turf; she checked in the stretch when a rival came in last time then she continued on for \$30,000 and was sixth beaten five lengths; she now goes for half the price with a shift to grass.

LAKE MARION is getting her first start since April 27th when she had a poor result; she has had an opportunity for a few June works getting ready to come back here at a reduced evaluation.

ONE HOT MADAMME is an obvious one to entertain if she can transfer her good form at five furlongs last time where she chased a winner who was taking a big edge and reported second at five furlongs; she had won the time before at six furlongs.

STARLIGHT ANGEL went a route in her seasonal bow and travelled too quickly and was overly aggressive and then had nothing left for the stretch drive; she attempts the route to sprint angle with a drop in value.

COURT DEPUTY had a nice win for \$9,500 two starts ago on a drop in her second lifetime start; most recently, she was back thirteen days later and lost by a wide margin when One Hot Madamme was second.

BIG TIME NANNY opted for a determined speed approach last time but got into a pace fight and understandably faltered in the lane; she drops down.

GET SAUCY was going first time off the claim for Scott Fairlie last outing and when she made her rush on the outside, the late pace was weakening and that highlighted her stretch advance; she looks to double up with a drop in value.

GRETNA GRACIE had a mild offering through the stretch for \$9,500 last time and finished fourth; Bahen retains the mount at this lower evaluation.

ANGELACREST competed two starts ago in a race where the late pace faltered and she hung; when she shortened to five furlongs last time, she was able to continue on better in third but the runner up, One Hot Madamme was superior; she stretches to six furlongs.

SHERWOOD FORESTER opted for a speed approach in a five furlong race last time then faded in the stretch at long odds when One Hot Madamme was better in second.

SING TO RUN is worth considering here now that she drops down; her race to begin the season was a good one and her most recent start was excusable; she had an awkward departure from the gate and it took her a while to get to the outside to make her move; she gets to start in the clear from an outward post here.

MESSY MARIE comes out of a key race last time when fifth and the first, third and sixth place finishers have all come back to win; she has been freshened by Paul Buttigieg and indicates one returning work.
