LOST IN THE CLOUD dropped down to take a big enough edge in a May 31st seasonal bow at six and a half furlongs when winning easily with a quick late thrust; freshness is still an asset here following a freshening and an extension to a route; she has handled two turn racing quite well.

STARSHIP GAMBLER drifted out early in her latest at seven furlongs then stayed on ok to be third against Queenstown in a seven furlong race and that winner is here.

ARTICULATE came from Tampa and had a run June 18th at Fort Erie where she was third beaten just two lengths as the heavy favourite; she gave up the lead on the second turn; she is a four time winner on the synthetic surface and makes her way home to Woodbine.

REBEL LIONESSE is without a win in recent seasons and was far behind in a recent starter event where she reportedly had some early difficulty and the winner was demoted.

TEATOE should be in for a more productive run now that she drops so substantially; she departed turf and went to Tapeta in a protected race last time and wasn't a threat; she now runs for just \$6,000.

SWEET ESCAPE attracted a claim for \$10,000 June 4th when third; most recently, she did not have an alert beginning and then finished on the edges in a difficult starter event; now that she plunges underneath her claimed evaluation, she rates consideration with Husbands.

QUEENSTOWN a winner here in May, was at Fort Erie last time and finished out of the money at a route for \$8,000; Wilson will take over.

MY SILENT PRESENT an Ontario sire runner, was in a restricted race to begin June 17th where a couple of well regarded rivals took the top prizes and she reported in third; the runner up, Gimbala, was entered for Friday; she now goes to turf at six furlongs in an open race; she is a half sister to, Heart to Heart, a noted stakes winner on turf

CELTIC SINGER debuted against her own gender June 10th and was fourth against a dominant winner; she was following a wall of runners around the turn when the winner breezed by from the outside and she was left with fourth; she came back to work July 1st in 1.00.4.

SAFE TO SAY a debut runner for Mark Casse, is by Justin Phillip, a Grade 1 winning sprinter at Saratoga; she will debut here at six furlongs on turf and worked June 30th in 1.01.3 with some speed.

MO BIG CAT debuted June 10th and was fifth in the same race where Celtic Singer was fourth; she got in behind rivals in that event but showed some interest at the end; the move to turf should suit her as should the longer distance

GOSUDARINA debuted June 17th in a restricted race and was moving late along the inside in sixth; she now goes to turf and her sire loved the lawn.

STARRESHA a debut runner for Barry Holmes, is conditioned Kelly Callaghan and will be ridden by Simon Husbands; she has unique Paint-colouring; she will depart from the outside on turf and her sire was good on the grass; she worked July 2nd in 48.2 in company.

GAELIC REBELLION ran well enough in her previous event when fifth beaten six lengths to be a factor here; she moved into an easier category last time with lasix added where she was with the early pace only; she now gets to drop substantially for \$12,500; she was scratched from a race July 2nd.

HALO EXPRESS was out of the money on turf last time; she did race close up to the pace but faltered at a crucial time; she had been second on Tapeta for \$10,000 the time before.

SAFE AT DANEHILL was showing some promise in her debut June 3rd; her second start came thirteen days later and on the turf at a higher level where she was sacrificed in a speed duel and had nothing left by the top of the stretch; she moves back to Tapeta.

SINGING BROOKE a debut runner, is a four year old by Singing Saint and from a dam who has produced a couple of winners and she goes for Jason Marocco; she has generally prepped over short distances but did lengthen out to have a five furlong work recently in 1.02.2.

REDSTRIPECONQUEROR has had lots of experience but has only a single share; she made an outside move three furlongs from home last time at a route but couldn't improve her position; she shortens to a sprint and is up in value.

ARCTIC MIA is a well bred individual and from the same dam who produced the multiple winner, Ted W; she debuted June 7th and ran a bit at the head of the lane but then was beaten a wide margin; for this second start, she stretches in distance.

WINTERVELD was far behind early in her debut and didn't have an impact; second time out, she lunged at the break and found herself in eighth early but was third finally in a much improved performance that makes her a contender today.

LOW IN THE FOREST had a good early burst to be up on the pace last time against better than he is facing here but he retreated in double digits; the winner came back to run second on turf; he now goes to the lawn.

HAMMERSTEIN missed a month and returned June 18th on turf on yielding terrain for \$30,000 and at long odds, he chased the pace of the winner while a strong front running winner dominated; he seeks out easier here for just \$16,000 and with lasix added.

SOMBRERO DE COPA competed on ground with some give to it May 19th and he loved that terrain and won off for \$15,000; most recently, he got onto a firmer surface where faster times were produced and he couldn't catch up in the stretch for \$20,000 and he finished fifth beaten two lengths for \$19,000; he comes back down in value here.

ANOTHER BID started a run last time and was second by six lengths at the top of the stretch and was finally fourth beaten three lengths as the leader quit and a dominant winner, Piston Broke, took over.

CRUSHIN HARD is sent out by Sandy McPherson who has had significant results this season and perhaps that momentum will carry over to this one; he made only one start last year and finished eleventh on turf in that only outing.

PISTON BROKE knows how to win races and has won three in a row at the meeting with significant off the pace rushes; he now goes to turf in hopes of continuing the streak and he is up in value.

DUPES saw his form deteriorate last time at a route on Tapeta in a starter event against a rallying winner; he will now drop for \$16,000 and go to turf, a footing over which he is a three time winner.

MACHO BREW took a big drop and moved to turf last time where he closed well on the outside to be fourth beaten about two lengths; he seeks his initial win on turf and comes down one price range.

COSMIC CHARLIE has been on turf in recent events without producing; in a starter event last time, he couldn't keep up and was finally eighth; he now comes down in value.

UNCORKED SPIRIT is hopeful of finding a more level stride here in this first try for Martin Drexler; he is coming off the shelf and going up in value for a chance to get onto the turf.

MISTER NADA wasn't far away on turf two starts ago in a claiming race but didn't do as well last time in a protected event; he now runs for just \$15,000 with a drop.

WAR FAN was asked for his best last time for \$15,000 on Tapeta but he was fifth beaten seven lengths; he had finished fifth beaten five lengths on turf the time before when Sombrero de Copa was the winner.

BAY NUMBERS is a newcomer here and is running first time under the direction of Mark Casse; he last competed in August of 2016 at Monmouth on turf when second; he was prepping earlier at Keeneland and has had one half mile work here since arriving.

LILLZ PEARL was steadied at the break when a rival came in on him May 31st; he is typically right up on the pace but the early incident last time had him running from the second flight and he was ineffective.

HIPP SMITT was keen to chase the pace in a five furlong race last time then weakened in the stretch; he has been busy with three works getting ready and now stretches to six furlongs for Scott Fairlie.

WORBOTHOR tried hard last time but wasn't good enough for a first allowance event when sixth beaten five lengths; he comes back at the same level but at a furlong shorter; the fourth place finisher from that race has since won.

ETHANOL was hemmed in last time but in typical Contreras fashion, he was able to edge out of traffic and win with a late surge; that came in a starter event for \$10,000; he is in an allowance event here.

IRON SHORE made a run up the inside last time but couldn't keep up into the stretch and gave up positions in a first allowance event at seven furlongs; he shortens in distance here.

BOLD HOPE was forced to scratch from a race June 10th; his May 14th opener was a good one as he persisted on the pace under a hustling ride; he has been freshened and indicates a couple of recent works getting ready.

FIREBALL MERLIN has had three runs this season and two in the money finishes; both good races have come at five furlongs but he must stretch to six furlongs here; he was a rallying second last time as the favourite; he has kept up with works on the training track getting ready.

UNDERCOVER CAT opted for an aggressive speed style last time over a surface more helpful to closing types and he withered with the advantage and finished fourth; he can contend.

CALIDEZ dropped into the correct spot for a win second time at the meeting June 10th for \$10,000 against non winners of two and despite some tense moments in the stretch, she found room late to salvage the victory along the inside; she now tries non winners of three.

FLASHY PATCH worked hard to get a portion of the lead last time but the winner came up the rail to beat her at the last moment; she had dropped down for that event and ran well and that was expected.

ATHDARA was in against non winners of three last time trying to build on her good race of the time before; she opted to go up in value and was out of the money; she comes back down to the price of her previous good race when she was a solid second.

THALIAS FIRE is getting her first start of the year and she concluded with four consecutive out of the money finishes last season and she went winless for the campaign; she seeks her first win here since October of 2015.

FAIR ASTRONOMER duelled on the outside in her seasonal bow then weakened; she wasn't able to reach contention last time when fifth while Athdara was second; she meets that rival here.

EURO PRINCESS was allowed to drop down two starts ago and she raced in a disappointing fashion; when she jumped all the way up to the \$19,000 mark last time for an opportunity on turf; she now drops in value and returns to Tapeta.

SAN NICOLA BREEZE was outside on the turn and offered a mild rally but hung in the stretch; she drops for half the price here.

RED EXPLOSION has run strongly in both races this season; she acted up pre race last time, yet, still performed well in second narrowly beaten by her own mate; this will be her first time on turf this season; she tried it once unsuccessfully last year.

ROCKPORT DANCER returned from considerable time away June 11th and on turf, pressed the pace then faltered against a key winner; she has stayed busy in the morning getting ready for this second start of the season.

NEW TRIER was on turf to begin this campaign June 11th but was too excitable running with the lead and set unsustainable fractions and then weakened to a sharp closing winner; she was finally sixth in that event.

COREY'S BEST is getting her first start of the year and she concluded last season with good form including a turf race November 11th when third but she failed to win during that campaign; Campbell rides for Ron Sadler.

PRIZED BOURBON has now had a return race June 10th and finished an ok third; she should be ready to progress in this second race following the long layoff.

LYLA LORRAINE disappointed last time after getting good early positioning on Tapeta; she was somewhat tentative inside and slipped back.

SILENT SONET won as expected first time out and then second time, was put into the Alywow on a three week return; she advanced inside and was getting closer towards the end but was lacking some room between rivals and had to settle for fourth beaten a length and a half; that event points her out as a short priced contender here.

RED CABERNET won last time when moved to turf and that was no surprise; she moved from the inside to the outside and galloped out strongly; for this second start of the season, she shortens in distance on turf.

PRINCESS NIIGON reasserted herself in front in the run down the backstretch last time then weakened and eventually lost in double digits; she now goes for Andrew Smith and has been busy with interim works.

WONDERLAND is getting her third start of the campaign and she was unable to threaten in her second start; the blinkers are on.

LOOKINGFORANEWSHOT has had interrupted campaigning this season but progressed second time out when runner up and just in front of Prized Bourbon; she now goes to turf for just the second time in her life.

TIGERBEACH is a newcomer to Woodbine and raced well second time out in an upper claiming even at Churchill to be second; most recently, he went to Indiana Grand and won at five furlongs on turf for a maiden score; he has been moved to the stable of high percentage trainer, Larry Rivelli.

AFTERBURNER debuted for Ron H. Potts May 21st at Presque Isle and was able to run down the speed for a victory at first asking in a race where the heavy favourite did not perform up to expectations; the runner up has come back to win; he has been prepping on the synthetic surface at Presque Isle getting ready for this second start.

TENACITY ZIP won as expected first time out; he made all of the running but he proved a difficult ride laying in a bit but Campbell was able to keep him straight enough to win over his stable mate, Like What I See; he came back to work June 28th in 48b with his mate getting ready for Nick Gonzalez.

LIKE WHAT I SEE debuted June 11th against his stable mate Tenacity Zip but he fell out of contention and had to start all over again and then came with a bountiful rally in the stretch to miss by a length; he has had a similar half mile work in 48 with his mate; he gets a half furlong farther with which to work.

BLUEBLOOD an expensive purchase and a well bred individual, had a successful debut May 19th at four and a half furlongs with front end speed while lasix free; for this second start for Mark Casse, lasix is added and he stretches to five furlongs; he worked June 25th in 48.1b and had worked the week prior to that in 1.00.1 getting ready.

ADIOS MUCHACHO debuted May 28th and ran adequately despite laying in through the stretch and that made it difficult for the rider to keep him straight and he ended third; he puts the blinkers on and adds lasix for this second start and Lermyte takes over; he worked June 24th in 1.01.1hg and had a nice interim work in 49 for Nathan Squires; he is a homebred for Rowling Oaks Farm.

CHIRICAHUA SIGNAL had a good warm up pre race but his chances were ruined when he was squeezed between rivals departing the gate and he finally recovered to be third with Who's Got It a length better in second and the winner has already come back with a good race; this will be his third start of the year.

AYE AYE CAPTAIN put the blinkers back on and that made a suitable difference June 24th; he competed on turf with a rally from far on the outside to be second despite typically laying in a bit; he tries seven furlongs on Tapeta in hopes of ending his winless streak; he looks to be one of the contenders.

ITSTARTSWITHADRINK has committed himself to route racing with good results; he was claimed for \$10,000 and last time was third beaten a length and a half for \$20,000; he now goes for \$40,000 with blinkers on with a cutback in distance.

NEIL'S DIAMOND was inconvenienced early in the stretch run June 2nd and never did recover; the blinkers are on and he doubles in value; he faces non winners of three in search of his second win.

CHEBURASHKA was a claim by Norm McKnight May 28th and since that time, he has had a series of works and equipment is changed for this event and he is doubled in value; Hernandez is brought aboard.

PARTY AT EIGHT was fortunate to find room in the stretch June 18th but Contreras was riding with confidence on that occasion and the race went his way at the end; he departs turf and goes to Tapeta and will now shorten to seven furlongs and Contreras stays aboard.

WHO'S GOT IT ran yet another good race June 9th; he committed to the rail early and was finally second when the winner flew by on the outside; that first place finisher has already come back to run well; he now gets the outside post; he must stretch to seven furlongs.

FAITH AND DESIRE was competing at Fort Erie last time and unfortunately stumbled and lost the rider; he did not threaten in previous events here.

I GOT SILENT EGO moved to turf for the initial time June 7th and was used up on the pace and had nothing left for the stretch drive in the same race where Court Reporter was second.

HOLDONWEREGOINHOME competes for Ian Black who won earlier at the meet with Red Cabernet in that one's third start and this one is now starting for the third time; she closed belatedly on turf in her debut and closed belatedly on Tapeta last time.

MILWAUKEE THUNDER is now moving to turf and is from the same dam who produced San Nicola Thunder, a stakes winner on the grass; she is getting her second start of the season after an early pace contribution last time.

LYLA D has lost by wide margins in both races this season on turf; she is asked to travel farther on turf with Slade Callaghan now aboard.

BOO looks like a contender; she was on turf last time and finished just a length behind Court Reporter; she made the pace for much of the way after a duel with the eventual eleventh place finisher, I Got Silent Ego; she goes a bit shorter.

CAROLINA GRACE had a debut on Tapeta at six furlongs June 3rd suggesting more room would be in order and now she gets added distance and shifts to turf, a footing over which her sire excelled; in her opener, she was inconvenienced early when a rival came over in her path; she looks to be a logical one to wake up under today's terms.

WHITE MOON is dropping in value after being in an open maiden event on turf last time when sixth beaten five lengths after a good middle move; Bridgmohan retains the mount here with the drop in for \$40,000 for Steve Owens.

NORTH GALE a three year old filly, is bred for turf by North Light and will try a mile on grass at first asking for Borders Racing Stable and trainer Dan Vella; Hernandez has been enlisted here; she worked on turf June 11th in 1.01.1.

ELDORADO'S SOUL a debut runner for Preston Ferris, is by Perfect Soul, a Grade 1 winner on turf and is from the same dam who produced the local winner, Thunder Point; her work on soft turf June 25th was acceptable in 49.3.

FLASHY'S LEGACY is getting her second start of the campaign and will hopefully move forward in this race; she couldn't keep up with the second and third place finishers, Court Reporter, and Boo last time; Campbell now takes over.

STORMBEAM was running ok late last time when fifth of ten on Tapeta; she did have a good race on turf last September and should welcome the move over to the lawn; she could wake up.

COURT REPORTER is a logical one to contend again; when she ran at seven furlongs on turf two starts ago it became apparent she needed more room; most recently, she raced just beyond today's distance and hung at the last moment when beaten; she shortens back to one mile; she worked June 22nd with Da Silva in 1.01.1 for Robert Tiller.

EASTERN PRIDE a debut runner, is a homebred for Chris Harris and is from the same dam who produced the local runner, Timberline who is an effective galloper; she goes a mile at first asking for Rachel Halden and has prepped on the turf.

KLASSY DELIGHT was in for \$32,000 on turf last time and made a good middle move and finished just on the edges for Chris Steve.
