TWO STEP FLOR attracted a claim in April and is just now getting back to the races and comes in two levels underneath her acquired price; trainer Dale Desruisseaux, won Wednesday with Eminent Force first time off the claim and is looking to do it here again from the inside post.

SKIPPY IS BACK had extensive campaigning in Florida and then three more races here through June 7th and so a freshening was in order; her winning streak was stopped for \$15,000 last time when the winner rushed by to displace her but she did keep Capture Your Heart in third.

ESSENCES BEST is getting her first start of the year and she was without momentum late last season in light campaigning.

STARSHIP SABRINA just recently got her season underway and a futile pace fight with the sixth place finisher softened her up and the winner ran by and left her second; she should be better for that activity and should be more thorough here at just five furlongs.

MARILYNS LAST LOVE was at Fort Erie June 11th for a race on turf where she stayed willingly throughout from just behind the leaders and landed on the edges; she is seeking a breakthrough win.

LETTER FLY took a big drop down to the \$10,000 mark last time but got caught up in a speed duel and while she won the pace fight, she lost the race to an aggressive stalker; she shortens to five furlongs.

SPLENDID GLORY is quick in the early going and likes five furlong events; she was out of the money at Fort Erie last time.

LOUISE THE LASER will be departing the lasix program here after a distant third place finish at Fort Erie last time.

CAPTURE YOUR HEART was third last time but Skippy Is Back was much better in second; both runners have been freshened coming to this event.

WINSTANLEY was able to win second time off the claim for Bill Tharrenos when in for \$8,000 and making all of the pace to beat Runaway Pepper and the third place finisher has come back to win; she is up in value following a freshening and remains at seven furlongs.

GOLDEN RIDGE was a surprise pace maker in race seven on Queen's Plate day then faded, yet, was beaten only six lengths; he is back on a tight timeframe shortening to seven furlongs in hopes of a good late run through the stretch with this drop in value.

BEAR ON FIRE got into a speed duel with the eventual sixth place finisher last time and slipped back all the way to eighth; he drops in for a claiming evaluation with Contreras taking over; this race is top heavy with speed.

MOON DOGGIE has run competitively in a series of races at a distance shorter than today's more demanding seven furlong venue; he committed to a speed style last time where he was softened up and then the winner got by him at the end and he settled for second at this price.

ANOTHER BID settled in behind runners in a route last time and then went to make his move when the late pace was good but he finally finished fourth beaten three lengths; he had run well at seven furlongs when one spot behind Winstanley two starts ago.

BOLDGENT was forced to scratch here June 16th and was in action a little later at Fort Erie where he was just on the edges; he had won at six and a half furlongs in here May.

PEYTON makes his way back to Woodbine after an extended and unproductive stay in other locales; he now rejoins the Mike Doyle stable; on his best day, he has plenty of stretch energy.

RUNAWAY PEPPER was second for \$8,000 at seven furlongs two starts ago; most recently for \$9,500, he was no match in a disappointing display and Moon Doggie was better in second.

CAT ZAPPER got into a hectic pace battle with the ninth place finisher last time and expended energy then slipped to seventh; following that out of the money finish on turf, he comes over to Tapeta and did win at seven furlongs last November.

HOLY MCNASTY had a June 3rd seasonal bow for \$20,000 on turf and slipped back late and was judged guilty of interference to an inside runner and was demoted; changes are made here; he drops for \$10,000 and lengthens to seven furlongs with a switch over to Tapeta.

WEST L. A. GIRL has looked good at seven furlongs in a couple of races at the meeting this year with a win in April and a solid third last time; she will shorten all the way to six furlongs here and come from the rail for Mark Casse and she has had interim prepping in 48.4.

NORTHERN KISS is getting her first start of the year and she was without much momentum late last season; she trained with Hernandez aboard July 1st in 48.2 and he has the mount for Blair Miller in this return and the stable has enjoyed more momentum this season.

JIM BANNON'S JOURNAL JULY 9TH, 2017

EDGEHILL ROAD was able to win for just \$16,000 June 7th beating Skippy Is Back who was entered in race one today; she will now jump in value looking for her fourth win her last five races dating back to last November; six furlongs has been a good distance for her.

FROSTY VIXEN moved over to turf last time and had a good performance; she moved up inside late to be just on the edges against a tough speed winner; she departs turf and goes to Tapeta and had a peak performance three starts ago at six furlongs on this footing.

MADISON WAY produced a better race in her second start of the campaign June 10th when she had an opportunity to be on the pace and she dominated the front end; circumstances forced her to scratch Wednesday.

WAY TO VERSAILLES was nicely prepared by Gail Cox and perfectly ridden by Boulanger for a winning debut June 3rd on the front end; she has been freshened over a month and makes her way back after a five furlong work July 2nd where she went easily beating company; she scratched from a race July 5th and will go here instead.

SUGAR JONES had a good enough race last time to be considered here on a repeat; she came flying off the turn to run to the advantage through the lane at six furlongs for her third lifetime win; the race had some key elements to it as the fourth, fifth and sixth place finishers have all come back to win; Contreras retains the mount for Mike Mattine.

ROYAL KATY was bumped an inconvenienced at the start last time and the fifth place finisher was demoted for the infraction; she finished about five and a half lengths back in that event on turf and now goes in a claiming race on grass with Contreras now up.

SO MIESQUE was on turf to begin this campaign and made a middle move but hung; she ran the same type of race last outing when seventh beaten about three and a half lengths and she is looking to continue more thoroughly with this drop in value.

DATING SOPHIE was on turf last time but raced three wide from the second flight and couldn't reach contention.

DIVA ON A DIME got quite rank in her latest when in traffic and didn't settle properly and finished fourth when Afleet Doll was second; she now goes to turf.

SPEEDY IT'S ME is getting her first start of the year and she failed to share in her races last season including a run on grass.

SAMMY JO BLUE had a good enough race second time out this season when moved to turf and finished third on that occasion; she went back to Tapeta last time and couldn't keep up with the runner up, Afleet Doll.

SAYYESTOXCELENCE is getting her second start of the year and is dropping down and going to turf; she is by the popular, Into Mischief, and the blinkers will go on here.

THAT'S ONE COOL CAT finished ninth in her seasonal bow on turf without threatening and blinkers will be added for this second start.

AFLEET DOLL has had plenty of chances and has now had three consecutive runner up finishes; she did get some exposure to the turf in Florida and revisiting the grass here should be quite helpful; she looks like one of the main contenders.

CONQUEST RAPIDUNO closed a big gap last time on turf for \$20,000 and had aim at the front runner but that one was too stubborn and then another came from eleventh to win it all and that left her with third money; this will be her second time off the claim and she remains on grass at a shorter distance.

SKY VISION suffered a significant fanning incident last time when getting her second start of the campaign and she was fourth beaten four and a half lengths; she now moves over to turf, a footing for which she is bred and she is a wake up candidate.

TYPICALLY is getting her first start of the campaign and she had some exciting stretch kicks last season and this course is generally kind to that type of style; Da Silva rides for Sid Attard in this return for just \$20,000 on a big drop.

SEEWILL was going forward in her seasonal bow when fourth but second time out, she had a wide and ineffective trip; she has been returned to the stable of Abraham Katryan and now looks to go forward; she has been posting recent works.

PRIDDY FAIR returned after some time away June 17th but wasn't a factor when sixth and was claimed when beaten five and a half lengths by, Canna Red, who is here.

PATSY'S STAR took the big drop last time and lost by sixteen lengths as the favourite when Canna Red was the winner.

CANNA RED was getting her first start of the year for trainer Phil Gracey, a powerful angle this year, and posted a win at long odds after stalking the speed of Patsy's Star; she now jumps in value for this second start of the campaign.

OUR GABRIELLE was claimed here last December and after an out of the money finish to begin this campaign in a near impossible spot, she went to Fort Erie for her latest where she was narrowly beaten; the winner of that race came back here to be fourth for \$12,500.

NO SOUP FOR YOU had an encouraging seasonal bow May 21st and when she jumped in value last time, she was thought to be good enough but she finished a flat fifth beaten four lengths with no late energy in the same race where Partyonthepatio was the winner and that one is here; she now drops in below the level of her previous good race.

INPERSON started the year with an out of the money finish on turf and with that out of the way, she drops for \$15,000 and goes to Tapeta where she won three in a row late last season.

FUNNY FUNNY RIDDLE was perfectly positioned to double up June 14th in a starter event but when it came to producing in the stretch, she slumped back to third against a key winner; she now moves back to Tapeta.

PENNY STAMP has already had a busy and successful campaign and took her third win of the season June 30th and was finally claimed and now moves from the stable of Laurie Silvera to that of Willie Armata; she caught the speed last time and the runner up, Starship Sabrina, was entered in the opener today.

CLARKSTON HOPE is getting her first race since last August when she was without momentum; she competes for Bradscot Farms and Shana Lopez and will return from considerable time away to run six and a half furlongs for just \$16,000 on the big drop.

PARTYONTHEPATIO attracted a claim for \$20,000 in May and moved up to a first allowance event June 18th to collect that top prize of \$36,600 and she now drops below the price for which she was claimed two outings ago looking to make it three wins in a row for Martin Drexler and Bruno Schickedanz.

CATCH SOME ZS followed in traffic last time and found some room to rescue the victory for her second consecutive score this year; she jumps in value here and tackles multiple winners.

IRIS WILL started a nice run three furlongs from home in a June 21st race on turf but she couldn't continue against that difficult group; she drops in value and departs turf.

ELLAS MY LOVE a debut runner, was an auction purchase and goes for Bill Tharrenos; he is one of two in here debuting by Pool Play along with Water Polo, and that sire won the Grade 1 Stephen Foster and did run locally with success; he has tried the gate in consecutive half mile moves getting ready and Boulanger was aboard July 1st in 49bg.

BEHOLD HE COMETH debuted from the rail post against a key winner May 19th and was sixth beaten seventeen and a half lengths; changes are made here as he adds lasix and takes the blinkers off; he does have the benefits of recent prepping.

MISS DANIELLE a debut runner was an auction purchase and is by Old Forester and is going for Ricky Griffith; she worked a half mile June 17th in 47.4b getting ready and just prior to that had prepped from the gate in 48.1hg; those preps came under the name, Wow Factor, but a recent name change now has her competing as Miss Danielle.

INGE a debut runner, is a homebred for True North Stable going for Lorne Richard by Victor's Cry and her dam did produce Perlarana who had a third place finish earlier this year and he competes in race ten today; he beat company from the gate July 1st in 49.1bg getting ready.

CRY BAO a homebred for Anecchini & D'Alimonte Holdings, competes for Mike De Paulo; her dam did produce a winner earlier at the meeting; she worked June 24th in 1.01.3 getting ready; Contreras rides.

WATER POLO a second representative here of Pool Play, debuts for Laurie Silvera; she is from a dam who did produce the juvenile winner, Grange Hill; she has indicated several short preps getting ready.

ESKIMINZIN a homebred for Jecara Farms, is by Cold Harbor, a five time route winner on the synthetic surface; this one is from a dam who did win as a two year old; she has used the gate a few times getting ready; he earlier prepped a half mile in 47.1; Husbands rides for Analisa Delmas.

LEGAL GUMP ran well in his debut against an unbeatable winner and second time out, was in against an unbeatable winner on turf and promptly reported in second; he meets more reachable rivals here for Ralph Biamonte with the move back to five furlongs on Tapeta.

STRETCH DANCER a homebred for Joseph Pirone, goes for Jennifer Shafer; he is from a dam who produced the two year old winner, Nerve Line; he worked from the gate June 14th in 48.1bg and had a subsequent work July 2nd in 1.01.3.

HANDSOME LIKE ME a debut runner for Tucci Stables, is a homebred by Giant Gizmo and from a dam who won as a two year old; he worked in late June in 1.01.2 getting ready; Wilson suits his style.

MARTINKELLY a homebred for Ten Lee Mah Stable, is by the millionaire sprinter, Judiths Wild Rush; he has generally worked over short distances and worked a half mile July 5th in 49.1bg for Reade Baker.

SEE YOU IN COURT a debut runner for William Tharrenos, must come from the difficult outside post in this debut; he was an auction purchase and is by, Court Vision, and worked from the gate June 24th in 49.4bg.

DANI'S VICTORY was out of the money in consecutive events then dropped down and made a switch to Boulanger last time; he dropped sharply in odds from his morning line quote to go off as the 6-5 favourite and won as if much the best for maiden \$25,000; he scales back up the ladder now and moves over to turf.

SNICKER is an import for Pegasus Stud and competes for Mark Casse; he had some good results on the turf at Gulfstream and was a winner there in April; this will be his first start since May 10th and he has had enough time for one work at five furlongs since arriving; he runs shorter than usual.

RATFACE MACDOUGALL had his best career race just the other day on turf at six furlongs where a hotly contested pace was set and he stayed more willingly than imagined at 33-1 and took third prize; he makes a quick comeback in hopes that grass is the answer.

YES DARLIN has good interior speed; he campaigned at Gulfstream earlier this year and was able to win when he moved here April 22nd; since that time, he has been a fringe performer and was in a key race last time; he now goes over to the grass and does have three turf winning siblings.

BATTLEOFBURLINGTON handled the turf adequately last season; following a considerable time away, he returned for a couple of ineffective runs in protected categories this spring; he has been freshened and now he drops down in hopes of recovering his best form and competes for just \$40,000.

OUR VICTOR gets his first start since the spring when he was considerably overmatched for new interests; he now drops for \$40,000 in his second start of this campaign and Contreras will ride for Ralph Biamonte; he had some sizeable rallies last season including a good move on the turf in July of 2016.

NAPAYSHNI had an isolated trip last time without producing a good result; he is from a dam who liked the lawn and now gets to the turf for the first time.

LOWI VENE had three consecutive good races to begin his campaigning here then went into a stake last time and finished at the back; he looks to start over here against limited winners.

AREOCENTRIC had a tentative approach with three and a half furlongs to go last time then when he got room in the stretch, he did some significant running to be third beaten only a length when the late pace faltered; the runner up has since dropped down to win.

IDA'S WARRIOR checked in his previous event; last time for new interests, he was reserved early but did not produce a good result; he once again seeks his second lifetime win.

IT'S A BREEZE had a good race July 1st when he closed inside to take third prize against a heavy favourite; he is from the same dam who produced, Daylight Breeze, an allowance winner earlier in the year; he now goes to turf for the first time.

LOGIC OF ABSURDITY a maiden, debuted June 24th and hung in that event at six and a half furlongs on Tapeta; she will now stretch around two turns; she is a half sister to the Grade 1 winner, Stormy Lucy, by Bodemeister, sire of this year's Kentucky Derby winner.

GHOSTLY PRESENCE achieved a lot when she won last November in the Princess Elizabeth; she hasn't been as good in three races this season including a double digit loss in the Oaks last time; she did have a good stride in a work July 1st in 47.3 for Roger Attfield; Hernandez has been named today.

ERIN COMMODITY was getting her seasonal bow at a route May 27th and sat off the pace but got into a tight spot and checked; she finally finished fourth beaten three lengths and the winner has come back to score as has another in the race; she once again goes around two turns and Contreras will now ride; her dam did produce the Breeders' Stakes winner, Camp Creek for Hillsbrook Farms.

ENSTONE was second in the Fury and fourth in the Oaks but opted to skip the Queen's Plate and be ready for this; in the Woodbine Oaks, she made a good move from sixth to get the lead but was displaced at the top of the stretch and gradually slipped back in fourth about six lengths behind the runner up, Mythical Mission, who is here; she worked June 30th in 1.00.3 for Mark Casse.

CINDERVELLA competed in the Woodbine Oaks and made a nice run from off the pace starting her advance from the quarter pole and moving past several rivals to be fifth; the seventh place finisher has come back to win a stake; she came back July 2nd to work with Campbell aboard in 1.00.2, out in 1.14.

MYTHICAL MISSION improved second time out this season when she went to the Woodbine Oaks and she made a strong move from off the pace trying to steal the event but Holy Helena got by her in the stretch at the last moment; that rival went on to easily win the Queen's Plate; she opted to miss that rich event and build up here; she must improve upon her behaviour pre race; she competes for Sam-Son Farm and trainer Malcolm Pierce.

DECISION DAY had a couple of nice front running wins last season; in his May 31st seasonal bow, the front end was occupied and he had to stalk instead and then wilted in the prep for the Dominion Day; the winner came back to win the Dominion Day and the runner up came back to win the King Edward; he now goes two turns at nine furlongs in this second start and will be looking for the front end; he should get the early advantage.

ULTIMATE DESTINY has had three runs this season and was at a route last time where he came from a wide post but made his way forward to be fourth beaten just about three lengths; he came back to work June 30th in 1.12.4.

CONQUEST DYNASTY is a four year old filly here against the boys; she went to a route June 9th and finished third after a good middle move against, Gamble's Ghost, who was runner up in the Oaks last year; she faces the boys here.

SEEKING THE BAY has had one run this season and tried to make his move on the far turn when the pace was quickening and he was fanned; he is hoping for a better result second time out; Wilson was aboard for a comeback work in 1.01.4.

BIG BAZINGA took substantial support last time and was simply second best behind a dominant winner on turf and that one came back to run even better Wednesday night with another win; he now moves over to a route on Tapeta and has had success moving off the grass in the past.

BEAR AT LAST was able to win a first allowance event June 11th and the runner up has come back with a disappointing performance; it was his best race and he looks to build on that for Kevin Attard.

TOUR DE FORCE won his opening three races in New Orleans but in his last three losing attempts, he has had trouble at the gate each time; in his latest at Churchill Downs going long on dirt, he overcame some problems at the beginning and tracked the pace of the heavy favourite then faltered; he has been here for two works including a move June 30th with Boulanger aboard in 59.2; he tries a synthetic surface for the initial time for Mark Casse.

NIIGON'S GLORY was fourth in his opener on Tapeta and fourth on turf last time in solid offerings; he is looking for a breakthrough at this difficult level as he goes a route on Tapeta for Sylvain Pion; Moran will ride from the outside.

BANGOR RIDGE had a highly promising opener June 16th at six furlongs on Tapeta when advancing from a distant eighth to be a challenging third for \$25,000 and he galloped out well; he is up in value for this and has subsequently trained on turf.

ATHENA'S LEGACY was looking for room along the inside when showing speed at a route last time then wilted and finished out of the money; he moves to turf for the first time. **THESPIS** debuted June 17th sprinting on Tapeta and was not a factor against a key winner who has already come back to win; he is bred for turf and now goes to the lawn.

SEATTLE AFFAIR was on the edges on turf last October; he has had just a single start this season and was running well through the stretch in second against a key winner who has already come back to win again; he is a natural to go to turf now at a mile for Chiefswood Stable.

D'S BEN a homebred for York Tech Racing, will debut here at a mile on the grass for Santino DiPaola; he trained in company on turf June 25th in 1.02.2 on soft terrain and had an earlier work on grass getting ready.

GREENFIELD is one of the better ones in here; he was on turf at a route last time where he closed a big gap and finished second against a winner who always had better positioning and he landed a good third; he has come back to work on turf for Mike Wright.

B J'S SOUL suffered from a bad departure from the gate June 17th in a Tapeta sprint and was finally far back; he now goes to turf for Beverley Chubb.

PERLARANA broke on top from a wide post last time but tracked from just off the pace and was finally fourth against a key winner and Seattle Affair was better by about two lengths in second; Wilson was aboard for a good comeback work in 49; he is by Court Vision and now goes to turf at a longer distance.

BUTTERMILK PIKE debuted June 11th and was an active item on the odds board; he is from the same dam who produced, Mick The Conquer, who is on the also eligible list; he will look to find a more level stride with the move to turf; he has subsequently had a work on the training track dirt in 46.2 for the James Perron Racing Stable and trainer Dan Vella.

THORNLEY a debut runner, is a homebred by, Strut The Stage, who loved the lawn; he worked June 30th in an easy 1.01 getting ready and Moran will ride here at a mile on the lawn.

PLEAD GUILTY had an awkward break last time; he went to the rail and then eventually moved outside where he closed from eleventh to be fifth; the blinkers are on and he goes to turf with Boulanger now aboard.

ROCKBARTON fell out of contention early June 17th at six and a half furlongs on Tapeta then passed some runners when fifth against a key winner and Seattle Affair was second; he gets more room and moves to the turf.

DARK ALE slipped back in a race at six and a half furlongs on Tapeta last time against an overwhelming favourite who romped by almost eight lengths; he gets in with more his own kind here and moves to turf with a stretch out.

SILENT BLAZE a debut runner for Joey Gee Thoroughbreds, is going for Andrew Smith; he is by Silent Name and from the same dam who produced, Ultraflame, who won on Queen's Plate day to open the card; he worked on turf July 5th in 48.4; he is a runner of some size.

REDWOOD LEIF was seventh on the turn last time and made his way forward to be second finally at a mile on grass for \$20,000; a move is made to Bridgmohan; the fifth place finisher has since dropped to win.

MICK THE CONQUEROR was on turf last time at a mile and a quarter where he raced three wide from the second flight and four wide in the stretch and finished second beaten just a length in a good try; he should be at his best here.
