MO BIG CAT a debut runner for Gary Barber, is a daughter of Uncle Mo; she competes for Mark Casse from the rail in this four and a half furlong debut with Husbands aboard and blinkers and lasix are used; she worked from the gate May 24th in 1.01.4bg getting ready.

MISGUIDED PASSION a debut runner for Charles Fipke, is by his Queen's Plate winner, Not Bourbon; she travels four and a half furlongs for Nick Gonzalez in this opener with Contreras and beat company in a recent work in 49bg.

SIREN SPELL has the benefits of an opener against some of these May 19th; she was in no hurry in the early going and was finally about a length behind Belle Danseuse; this will be her second start and Boulanger has been named.

CELTIC SINGER a debut runner for Mike Doyle, is by Wilburn, a stakes winning three year old; she has used the gate extensively getting ready and then had a five furlong work June 3rd in 1.02.4.

BEAUFILS is a second representative here for Nick Gonzalez; she is by Dialed In, a Florida Derby winner; she was a local purchase and goes for Mike Ambler; she had some turn speed in a work May 31st in 49.

JAMAICA ME HOME was tentative early in her debut when she got behind rivals and finished fifth at long odds with Belle Danseuse better in third.

BELLE DANSEUSE debuted May 19th and made a move on the turn to get the lead and raced with a length advantage but was finally third behind the even money favourite; she has had an interim five furlong work.

PRIZED BOURBON goes for Darwin Banach in this seasonal bow after a failed route experiment in her finale in December; she had run so much better the time before at six furlongs when up on the pace fighting till the end in second; she draws the rail here at six furlongs and can be a pace contender.

LYLA LORRAINE has improved noticeably in her opening two races this season; she had a bias assisted win in her first try of the campaign; most recently, she found some room late and advanced from seventh to be third against a key winner; she is cutting back in distance and once again faces non winners of two with Bridgmohan aboard for Krista Cole.

UNCLAIMED TREASURE concluded last season with a win at six furlongs for maiden \$25,000 with Crausaz aboard and she rides here for Daniel Birtch in this return; she indicates a couple of recent five furlong works.

FOREST LOVE hasn't started since 2015 when she was a winner but trainer Mike De Paulo won Sunday with longshot, Hidden To Win, coming off a similarly long layoff; she indicates a series of works at five furlongs getting ready for this return.

MADISON WAY is hoping for the type of explosive improvement she showed in her second start last year; she was out of the money in her seasonal bow this time around and is looking for the pattern of last year to repeat here with a big improvement in this second start of the campaign.

LOOKINGFORANEWSHOT was forced to scratch from a race May 28th but did come back with a five furlong work and now tries non winners of two for the second time this year.

CONQUER THE COURSE was a disappointment in her May 12th seasonal bow as one of the favourites; she took an isolated path outside and was behind in double digits; she attracted a claim for a highly successful stable and Hernandez remains aboard.

IKERRIN ROAD is making a quick comeback after starting last weekend when he ran strongly against one of the best local sprinters; he closed a gap from the outside; he is accustomed to running on turf and now goes from Tapeta to the grass at a mile for Vito Armata.

HONORABLE GUEST was getting his first start in an extended time May 13th and he lacked any prominence on the pace at six furlongs but that was understandable given the high velocity of that race; for this second start, he gets to stretch to a mile and he goes to turf, a footing over which he seeks his initial win.

BIG YUM ventured here last October and was ready made for success on the turf and won twice in a row; when he was put on Tapeta for his final start of the local session, he went much too quickly on the lead and understandably folded up; he is on the turf to begin this campaign for Mike De Paulo and Campbell knows him well.

ENTWISTLE couldn't handle Hampstead Heath in April at Gulfstream but came back with an equally good performance on the turf there and then also ran well here May 20th; he was challenged late from both sides and yielded the advantage at the last moment; he remains a contender.

HAMPSTEAD HEATH is formerly a stakes winner on this turf for Pat Parente who reclaimed him April 2nd at Gulfstream from a winning race; he jumps in value looking to reproduce his strong Florida form on turf; he fits.

TESSERON ran twice on the turf at Gulfstream February 15th and March 29th and wasn't far away in either race; he has never won on this turf course but has run competitively and has been here working for an extended time.

DON CAMILLO returned from time away and exited the Grade 2 Sky Classic to run for \$40,000 in his seasonal bow on Tapeta; he was fanned wide on the first turn by the winner and never did recover and attracted a claim and now goes for Bruno Schickedanz; he seeks his first win on the grass; he has had an interim gate work for Norm McKnight.

EASY INDYGO will compete only if this event goes on Tapeta; his lone win of last season did come in a route here in the summer time when he closed a big gap; this will be his second start of the campaign.

HOLD'EMFORRANSOM is a debut runner for Ian Black who won recently with a first time starter, The Young Lord; he is by Regal Ransom, a stakes winner as a three year old and is from a dam who was a stakes winner locally as a two year old and she has produced a couple of stakes winner; Wilson has been aboard in the morning; he goes a route here **ROCK YOU** walked out of the gate in his April 21st opener; second time out, he acted up in the gate and that spoiled his chances in the Queenston; he now goes long with blinkers added.

BOURBON EXTENSION debuted April 8th at Keeneland and veered out at the start where the rider lost his stirrup and he was finally eleventh beaten twenty nine lengths; he is hoping for a better start here and did practice from the gate recently in 1.00.4hg for Roger Attfield; Campbell now rides.

STOP THE PARADE ran strongly for Joe Walls in his May 22nd seasonal bow with blinkers on and closed from an impossible position to be second late; lasix is now added for this second consecutive trip around two turns at the meeting,

CROSS BORDER showed some interest deep in the stretch last time when facing some of these and now gets more room; he has had an interim work in 1.00.4 for Robert Tiller.

COOL CATOMINE made an advance inside and between rivals last time to land third money and was in front of some of these; he now goes from a sprint to a route.

WOLF STRIKE improved when he got to Woodbine May 13th; he started up from ninth and finished fourth while Cool Catomine was third; he is a son of Smart Strike stretching around two turns for Mark Casse.

DISCREET DAN found an opening late and darted through along the inside against some of these last time to be only about three lengths behind when Cool Catomine was third; he now goes long.

GLENCAIRN had two losses at Gulfstream and is starting over locally for Roger Attfield; lasix is added and he worked recently in 1.00.3 going out well.

AURORA WAY a homebred for Chiefswood Stable is by Giant's Causeway and from a dam who won the Selene Stakes; he has had repeated practice at the gate and effective start will be essential for him; Hernandez will be riding in this route opener for Stuart Simon.

COLEYVILLE was crushed at the gate in his May 19th seasonal bow but as expected, he had some late power and finished third; he looks to be a natural route runner who will now jump in value for this second start.

CARLOS SIXES went from a sprint to a route last November and was prominent throughout and he was finally a tight third; he understandably goes long in this seasonal bow for Kevin Attard.

JIMMY HOT has developed in recent works for Renee Kierans; he has drawn an unfortunate post here in his debut at a route; Bahen has been aboard in the morning.

FIERY BEAR had a big race on Tapeta last time when dropped down to take an edge and he rated kindly and then moved willfully to be three lengths the best; he went from a sprint to a route in that event; he now goes long on turf and sees this footing for the first time.

BIG GILLETTE has tried the turf in the past and is in good form now after finding a lucrative spot in his seasonal bow where he was so much the best, he was five lengths in front at the lowest odds; the move to the turf should be fine; Contreras takes over for Denyse McClachrie who claimed him from that opening event.

BUBBA BOY has turf in his pedigree and will be on the grass for the first time after a big race on Tapeta at a route last time where he closed strongly.

FOREST CASTLE caused interference at the break last time when he came in on rivals; he finally finished at the back; he drops sharply for today's event and goes to turf, a footing over which he has breakaway speed and he is likely to have that strong early presence today.

RED AT LAST disappointed May 22nd when getting his second run of the meeting and his outside trip was ineffective; he now goes to turf, a footing over which he was just on the edges at Gulfstream in March; Gulfstream turf form has reproduced nicely at this meeting.

KAYEZ had a big rally from last to second for just \$6,000 last time; he now goes to turf for just the second time in his life.

NELLO had a good gain in his seasonal bow advancing from ninth to be third narrowly beaten from far on the outside; he is accustomed to running on turf and now has peak Tapeta form to motivate him.

HEMMIN AND HAWIN had improvement in his second start when he went from a sprint to a route but he visibly hung in the last seventy yards; he will be on turf for the second time in his career here.

AUGUSTO B likes the turf; he was overmatched on turf last time but now gets to drop for \$19,000 in search of his second win on the lawn; he did score in Tampa in March for \$16,000.

MYSTERION checked early in his latest and his chances were ruined; on his best day, he can produce speed on turf and Forest Castle also likes that style.

SCHLOSS SCHNEEBERG stayed along the inside last time and salvaged third money in a race where the winner took a big edge; he goes from a sprint on turf to a route on turf.

SING TO RUN was reserved early last time in a tough situation but lost by a wide margin; a move is made back to Moran who was aboard for his win two starts ago against much better than he faces here.

CRY HAVOC dropped in for \$10,000 for her second start of the campaign but was beaten a wide margin; she added blinkers for that event.

CALIDEZ performed well at Gulfstream and came here with a drop in value to try six and a half furlongs but after making the lead in the stretch, two deep closers went past and left her with third prize; she had used a more patient approach early in her career for a better result.

BREWS TOONIE TOSS has now had a couple of races and is a wake up prospect to run late in the stretch here in this third start of the year.

SWEET RHAPSODY won at 3-5 for Norm McKnight May 20th when getting off the rail to go outside and produce a sufficient late kick; she now faces non winners of two.

JUICYCREST encountered a late pace that was faltering May 20th and her off the pace move resulted in an improved fourth place finish but Calidez was four lengths better in third; there is more room here.

MISTY SPIRIT had the elements against her when trying to run from behind a slow pace last time and she was not effective; she had won the time before with a more enterprising trip.

COOL CAT JAZZ was tenth beaten nineteen lengths when put up to the \$20,000 mark to begin this meeting; she had run so much better at Gulfstream the time before; she now comes underneath the value of that peak race to go for only \$10,000.

A C EFFERVESCENCE had a couple of sprints last summer then went long and woke up with a peak race; she begins this campaign in a sprint.

MY PAL KATHERINE has been in consecutive routes in the runner up spot; she will now shorten to seven furlongs from the outside.

PLAYA BLANCA showed potential in her first start which came on the turf at Tampa; second time out, she regressed at Keeneland when adding lasix and facing a heavy favourite; she looks to start over now and has had a series of local works for Roger Atfield.

TURBO DRIVEN DIVA had an opener last October on grass but that event should not be held against her; she looks to start over here in this seasonal bow for Barbara Minshall and has a chance to go forward after a series of works both on the training track and Tapeta.

AVIE'S ZIP a homebred for Ivan Dalos, is by City Zip, a turf influence and is from a dam who liked the grass; Contreras has been aboard for morning works for Josie Carroll; she travels seven furlongs on the grass at first asking.

SPLASHTACKULAR had just two starts last season and was aggressive on the pace both times only to fade in the crunch; she has been here since late May getting ready for Mark Casse and worked from the gate June 4th in 59.4bg; she requires more stamina; she stretches out on turf.

SURELY DIMPLE was last early in her debut May 19th at six and a half furlongs on the turf and gained some momentum in the stretch but was overwhelmed by the runner up, Matching Vows; she goes farther.

LILLZ SO PRECIOUS debuted last December and passed some runners without threatening; this will be her seasonal bow and she has worked recently on turf getting ready.

ROYAL KATY has found comfort in claiming company in her last two events; she had a perfect trip last time for \$32,000 but the winner responded better and she was finally a tight third.

KIM KIM has not been a factor in either race to date and gets her first local start here; she is bred for the grass and now discovers this turf course.

MATCHING VOWS was on turf for her second start of the meet and it was a much improved effort; she moved smartly on the outside but she couldn't catch a preferred front runner; there is a little more room here.

AUTONOMIC has had interrupted campaigning and made just two starts last year but handled the turf quite well with a rousing runner up finish in July; she returns from considerable time off for Malcolm Pierce.

JACKS ESCARPMENT should move forward in form now that he has had a race in the New Providence where he moved late on the outside against Pink Lloyd; he went strongly in his second race last year for Nick Gonzalez.

CONQUEST TSUNAMI competed on opening day in the Jacques Cartier and supplied the early pace but slipped back late against a key top pair; the winner, Pink Lloyd, is here and the runner up, Commute, has come back with a win and a runner up finish in the Connaught; he has taken the time for some good preps including a move May 28th in 59.3 for Mark Casse.

BOREAL SPIRIT competed May 6th in the restricted New Providence and was eager on the pace battling with the eventual seventh place finisher, Phil In The Blank, before fading to fourth in the lane behind, Pink Lloyd; he has been getting ready with quick works on the training track for Jennifer Shafer. **SHAFT OF LIGHT** started his career here at Woodbine where he was a winner; he is now an accomplished sprinter with eight lifetime wins and comes off a stakes victory at Charles Town where he won by four lengths last time at seven furlongs; he travels just six furlongs in this race for Ontario bred and Contreras will ride for Jorje Navarro; he now competes for Monster Racing Stables.

THOR'S ROCKET is getting his first start of the year; he did win four races last year including the Vice Regent on Tapeta at a route; Moran has been aboard in the morning for Paul Buttigieg.

PINK LLOYD has won both of his starts this season including the opening day feature in the Jacques Cartier; the runner up has come back to do well; most recently in the New Providence, he used a patient off the pace style where he bounded through the stretch to be clear against, Ted W who, was second recently against this one's stable mate; Da Silva was aboard for his work May 31st in 47.1 for Robert Tiller; he competes for Entourage Stable.

SWEET GRASS CREEK has competed twice at the session and has similarly been on the edges and most recently, was in the New Providence when he stalked behind runners and stayed willingly in third against Pink Lloyd.

ARPISTA had a good race on turf to begin his season last year; he wasn't as good in his following two events and had an abbreviated campaign; he was entered in a likeable spot May 21st but that race came off the grass and he scratched; he comes back into this tougher event after a recent work on Tapeta in 48; he now competes for Barbara Minshall.

CITY BOY a three year old, looked sharp in his debut against a key winner who has yet to lose; second time out, his margin of victory narrowed when the runner up closed with a rush but that was a nice step forward; he has been freshened about three weeks and worked recently on grass getting ready for Mike Keogh; this will be his second trip on lasix.

GROM has had a couple of fringe runs on Tapeta to start this campaign and now goes over to turf, a footing over which he has yet to share; Alderson takes over.

HOLY WHIRL WIND is a one time winner on the grass but is without a victory in recent times; he attracted a claim for \$25,000 last October and exits a runner up finish in his seasonal bow against a key winner, Circle Of Friends, who has come back to score a big win; trainer Jim Ensom won recently on turf with a claimed runner.

THREE RING CIRCUS is a middle speed element; at five furlongs last time, he earned a high rating with a fourth place finish beaten two lengths; he tries a left handed turf event here.

REGAL MARK won four of his final six starts last year but was disqualified on one occasion; he begins this campaign with a move to grass for the first time in his career for Kevin Attard; he worked a half mile May 28th in 46.3.

BOLD HOPE scored at 18-1 in his seasonal bow when taking his third lifetime score; he came from the extreme outside to hug the rail with the lead and was game; Garcia takes over here.

COLTON'S CORNER opted for the Queenston Stakes in his seasonal bow and at long odds, he finished a distant seventh; for this second start, he goes to turf and Hernandez is sticking with him for Sid Attard; he has had an interim work in 1.00.

SPEIGHTSTOWN TIME returned from considerable time away February 18th at Gulfstream to run on the pace on the turf and he was finally fourth; he again went well in his next turf event but came up inches shy; this will be his first start for Roger Atfield and his first try since April 8th at Aqueduct when he did not respond through the stretch on dirt; he worked here May 28th on Tapeta in 59 getting ready; his style conflicts with that of City Boy.

OAKTON is going second time off the claim for Pat Parente and is dropping back to the price for which it was acquired after an eighth place finish in the Eclipse; Husbands is aboard.

SOMETHING AWESOME has had a couple of sprints at the meeting and closed wilfully last time to be second against a winner who has repeated; he now goes long.

BORN IN A BREEZE is one of two in here for Dan Vella along with Something Awesome; he went from a sprint to a route May 2nd for his second start of the meeting and had a runner up finish in the Steady Growth Stakes; he ran strongly in that event with late power; he is without a win in recent times and it is just a case of having a breakthrough performance.

MAXSMIRACLEJOURNEY has had a couple of races to start this campaign and was beaten about five lengths in the Steady Growth; Contreras who was aboard for all three wins last season, is now brought in by Kevin Attard.

BADJEROS BOY started the season sprinting on turf and that should be an ideal primer to get him to this two turn race on Tapeta; he did win going long on this surface last November.

FORESTER'S DESTINY had a strong performance November 27th winning a first allowance event on Tapeta going long; he started this season on turf and was simply second best to a dominant front leader.

MARTEN LAKE went from a five furlong race to a route in the Steady Growth and picked the inside path at the top of the stretch and finished fifth while Born In A Breeze was second and that one is here.

GIGANTIC BREEZE was challenged at the top of the stretch in a first allowance race last time and had a significant response to gallop away from the runner up; he now looks to make it three wins in a row for the hot combination of Hopefield Farm and Sandy McPherson.

NEVAEH'S VALENTINE won as expected at tiny odds in his seasonal bow when taking his third lifetime score and he understandably commanded the pace; he had a quick blowout for this on Wednesday morning with Bahen aboard in 35 for Earl Barnett.

BEAR'SWAY is getting his first race in thirteen months; he was doing well at that time with a win in Wando Stakes followed by a nose loss in the Marine; Moran has the mount in this return for Bear Stables; he worked June 3rd in 1.00.2 getting ready.

PORTREE developed positive consistency from mid season on last year; this will be his seasonal bow for Chiefswood Stable; he goes long for Stuart Simon; Moreno will now ride.

SEEKING THE BAY is getting his first start of the season and he did win his opener last year but that was in an easier spot; Wilson takes over here for Larry Cappuccitti.

ULTIMATE DESTINY ran a good race last time to be third in this category; he waited for the runner up to clear and then made his run and came strongly in the stretch; he has since trained forwardly for Alec Fehr; he rates attention.
