LIKE WHAT I SEE goes for the hot stable of Nick Gonzalez and is one of two entered here along with Tenacity Zip; he was an auction purchase and is from a dam who won regularly; he prepped May 24th in 47.2bg getting ready; he competes with lasix from the rail with Wilson.

ADIOS MUCHACHO opened his career with a run May 28th; he is a runner of some size who laid in during that race; perhaps the addition of blinkers will help him keep a straighter line.

YALLHAVEANICEDAY had worked quickly for John Ross heading a May 19th opener where he ran third with speed from the outside against a favourite winner from the Casse stable while the runner up was from the Wesley Ward stable; for this second start, lasix is now added and blinkers are put on; he has had a fast interim work on the training track in 1.00.3.

CRUMLIN NIGHT a debut runner for Mike Doyle, is from the same dam who produced Crumlin Queen, a stakes placed runner for the stable; he worked June 3rd in 1.02 getting ready and has Moran aboard.

THIRD REPUBLIC a debut runner for Ricky Griffith, is by Dominus, a son of Smart Strike who was a stakes winner at three and four years of age; he has used the gate a couple of times in local works getting ready and has attracted Husbands.

TENACITY ZIP is one of two entered for Nick Gonzalez who has been doing well with his first time starters lately; this one is from the same dam who produced the extra fast, Quality Lass; he worked from the gate with Campbell aboard June 2nd in 48.3hg out in 1.01.3.

RARE APPEAL has tried to build some momentum in works for new trainer, Kai Wing Hau; he tried turf during his juvenile campaign but did not have a good experience then but he did progress later in the season.

CAPE ROMANCE a homebred for Ivan Dalos, is by Cape Blanco who won the Irish Derby and also succeeded at the highest level in North America; he showed a level stride in a work June 4th in 1.03.3b getting ready for Josie Carroll.

SWEET ROMANCE had a poor departure from the gate May 20th when moved over to grass for his second lifetime start but he mostly recovered to run third just in behind the late running Mr O'Prado who is here.

STORM RULER a debut runner for Sid Attard, is by Stormy Atlantic, a distinct turf source and this one is from a dam who has produced one runner who did win frequently on the turf; he has had a variety of riders in the morning getting ready and it will be Boulanger in this introduction which comes on the turf at seven furlongs. **SPRING EDITION** was somewhat rank while inside last outing and was looking for room and he finally finished about three lengths behind with Mr O'Prado second and Sweet Romance third; he will be looking for a better trip. **MR O'PRADO** came home from Florida and was getting his second run of the season May 20th and had an explosive run on grass to finish second to the heavy favourite; it took him a while to get into the clear but once he had space, he quickened at 63-1 to beat Sweet Romance for the place prize.

HURRICANE BEAR was significantly over bet when he debuted on Tapeta May 13th and he was unplaced; he has been made for turf and now gets over to grass for this second lifetime start.

BILOXI BAY debuted May 11th at Gulfstream and raced greenly on turf but had a nice gain; he has since had time for one local work for Mark Casse on Tapeta in 1.00.2; Florent Geroux rides.

RAYREADY was out rallied by the winner in his May 19th seasonal bow with a tag; he goes up in value looking for a chance to compete on Tapeta here.

SEEKING ALBERT is a newcomer to Woodbine and to the Mike De Paulo stable and competes for Robert Marzilli; he has been running on the turf at Lone Star with some late interest and now gets on to Tapeta for the initial time.

BOURBON FIRST was down around the lowest levels last summer but his win second time out this year, gives him four scores in his last five appearances; he won that starter event with a keen outside trip while Bear At Last got mired down inside while rallying; he competes for the hot stable of Denyse McClachrie; he seeks his eighth win.

BEAR AT LAST was getting his seasonal bow and was in a tough spot at the top of the stretch between rivals but found an opening down on the tougher footing inside and streaked to narrowly miss while Bourbon First took the path of least resistance on the outside and beat him a neck; he has had interim prepping and looks to turn the tables in this second start of the year.

SPANISH EXPRESS stretched out and added lasix for his second start of the campaign May 26th and was a winner at tiny odds in a seven furlong race; Contreras is handling Bourbon First here and Moran now moves in on this one.

EASY INDYGO had a lazy start May 13th and couldn't recover; he was in against a key top pair; for this second start, he has every chance to go forward with his late power.

SYNTHESIZE was used up winning a pace duel May 21st against Ault and then the winner scooped it away from him at the last moment; he stretches around two turns for this second start of the year.

CITO is a solid stayer in routes but he wins infrequently; he was fourth in his seasonal bow against key company and had Easy Indygo in behind him; he looks to progress here.

AULT attracted a claim in late April and had a new type of speed work May 13th and that resulted in a surprisingly aggressive style for new interests May 21st; he lost a pace duel to Synthesize and both were beaten by a stalker; he now goes from a sprint to a route which is suitable for him.

SILENT SONET was preferred when she debuted May 20th at five furlongs on Tapeta and she used her brutish size and stretch power to get away from that group; she came back with Contreras to work on turf with some style June 2nd in 1.01.2 and should make the transition to this surface; the race is top heavy with speed types and a stalking style would work well from the inside; she is a homebred for Ivan Dalos going for Nick Gonzalez.

R NAJA came off a win on turf in New Orleans to successfully compete here April 16th in the Star Shoot and she transferred her enthusiasm to Tapeta; she set all the pace and won a duel with the fifth place finisher to get clear; she now moves back to turf, a footing over which she has a victory in two lifetime starts; she competes for Michael Stidham and Murrill Mitchell will ride for DARRS Inc.

QUEEN DEL VALLE attracted a claim in June of 2016 and that race gained her eligibility to a series of Starter events where she has cleaned up on turf with a smart stalking style; she also won a stake a Gulfstream February 20th at seven and a half furlongs; she comes off a starter win March 15th at Gulfstream for Reid Nagle; she competes for Big Lick Farm and Edgard J. Zayas once again has the mount and knows her well; she seeks her eighth win on turf.

INDIA MANTUANA comes in for Chad Brown and Head Of Plains Partners LLC and Sterling Road Stables; she had three wins earlier and since taking on tougher opponents in her last pair, she has slipped back after getting a good early stalking position in those added money events on turf; heavily favoured closers dominated that last event; Joel Rosario has the mount.

VICTORY TO VICTORY was so smart when she won the Natalma Stakes last September using a quiet stalking trip and then devastating her opponents in the stretch with a quick move; she has switched running styles this year while competing around turf courses that feature two turns; she went to the lead at Keeneland on a yielding terrain to get a first allowance victory and most recently at Pimlico, tried to steal away but was reeled in as the favourite in an added money race; she did work well here June 4th in 48.2; she competes for Mark Casse and is a homebred for Live Oak Plantation; once again, Florent Geroux has the mount.

SUPERDUPER SKY came home from a winter campaign in New Orleans where she had won on turf and then scored on Tapeta April 22nd with a patient move; most recently in the Selene Stakes, she ran adequately well; she angled out and was beaten only three lengths while her stable mate, Enstone, was the runner up; she gets back to turf here and her style should work well; she worked in company with Enstone June 4th in 48.1 getting ready.

WILL SHE a homebred for Gustav Schickedanz, has now won three of five races and she looked good on Tapeta last time controlling the pace with an aggressive galloping style in her second start with lasix; she had slipped back in the Star Shoot against R Naja to begin this campaign but her latest was a more mature presentation; Campbell was aboard for her good work on turf June 2nd in 1.01 for Mike Keogh.

JUST BE KIND was highly motivated over her opening two races as a juvenile last season and won the Debutante; she had a difficult journey to close out her initial campaign in the Glorious Song and that event is best forgotten; she starts anew with blinkers back on and Hernandez aboard for Reade Baker and competes for a partnership which includes Jus Luk Stables and Rick Mah; she worked June 4th in 1.02.1 going out well; this will be her first trip on turf.

VICTORIAN LASS had her seasonal bow May 20th and was in against a runner she couldn't handle, Silent Sonet, who was entered in the Alywow in race four today; she rallied to take away the place award from Jupiter's Eagle and meets that on here at a longer distance; she needs more stretch resolve.

FRIENDSHIP RING debuted May 20th against a key winner and at long odds, broke last and did not enter contention; she has since had a fast work on the training track looking to move forward; she can progress.

FAITH AND DESIRE is without current momentum judging by her seasonal bow; she was at the back on that occasion when Victorian Lass was second.

MILWAUKEE THUNDER debuted last December and ran adequately in fifth in a field of twelve opening the door for improvement this spring; she needs to be on her best behaviour at the gate in this her seasonal bow.

RED HOT LOVE a debut runner for Colebrook Farms, is by Signature Red and from a dam who won her opening two career races and she produced the local winner, Our Victor; she easily beat company in a work May 20th in 1.01.4.

A PIC BY MRWILL had a good enough race two starts ago under these terms to be second against a dominant speed favourite; she was simply out of the money on turf last time; Da Silva takes over.

MISS BETTY TO U an auction purchase, has some residual value being from the same dam who produced last year's Oaks winner, Neshama; she had an acceptable work from the gate May 28th in 48.4bg getting ready for Mike De Paulo.

JUPITER'S EAGLE raced better than most expected in a May 20th seasonal bow ending third against Silent Sonet with Victorian Lass taking the place award away from her at the last instant; she looks to go forward in this second start of the meet.

SINFUL PLEASURES was in an unproductive pace duel last time and paid the price through the stretch retreating from second to be eleventh.

LADY VIOLET M came from Maryland to compete May 21st and was green in the early going then rushed late along the inside and missed narrowly; she is up one level.

LADY BRIE has had some difficulty in both races this season; she checked early in the stretch in her seasonal bow, yet, was second best behind a winner who repeated; most recently, she was sent long and she made a premature move to the lead then was subsequently disqualified from third spot; she shortens back to a sprint with a chance to have a real impact.

SKY VISION had the rider off leaving the saddling enclosure May 6th; once underway, she was beaten only three lengths by the difficult Greek Justice who has repeated and Lady Brie was second on that occasion.

HOLDONWEREGOINHOME had a big closing finish in a work May 15th but under race terms on turf, she didn't have much impact when she debuted; perhaps getting back to Tapeta will be the answer.

SPECIALCNSYDRATION looks like a top contender once again; she likes the turf and is already a two time winner on the grass and has four other shares; she was beaten by a 24-1 shot and had to settle for second in her seasonal bow on the grass; she has had interim prepping with Wilson aboard for Michelle Love.

FIRST TO GO was getting her second start of the year and her first try ever on the grass and she hogged the lead throughout and persisted by a length; pressing the pace in third was Inspired Vow who has been entered in the Woodbine Oaks.

SWEET CRIMSON had no thrust last time in a six furlong race on Tapeta; the blinkers are off and she goes to turf.

BEARSATLANTICMIST was seeking her second lifetime win April 22nd in her seasonal bow; she was in for the \$40,000 claiming evaluation; a lack of early pace saw her on the front end but she was displaced late by a wake up winner; she attracted a claim by Bruno Schickedanz and now goes for Norm McKnight to the turf.

ROCKPORT DANCER began in Vancouver then made Southern California her home; she was competitive in some claiming events there last year; she has missed considerable time and now comes off the shelf for new trainer Saul McHugh and she has been here posting quick works.

GENEROUS CONSORT is seeking her seventh lifetime win but her first score on grass; for new interests, she has now won two in a row including a run for \$32,000 last time where she had a perfectly timed rally; she missed narrowly on turf last summer and rates respect in her current productive form.

PICASSO MOON a three year old, competed on turf May 20th in what was essentially a speed race between the top two including the runner up Specialcnsydration; her late move left her on the edges but she had work to do; she is capable of an effective off the pace run.

NEW TRIER an Irish bred, had a couple of races in North America last year including a turf win at Arlington; this will be her seasonal bow and she is now in the care of Dan Vella and has been here working regularly since late May.

NO SOUP FOR YOU is in for consideration if this event comes off the grass given her positive Tapeta form in her seasonal bow.

TIZ A SLAM a homebred for Chiefswood Stable, won the Cup & Saucer on turf as a juvenile; he was here for the Wando in his second start of this campaign where he was heavily favoured; he had a comfortable stalking position and made his move in the stretch but King And His Court got through on the inside and beat him a length; he has had a mix of preps since then with an industrious trial coming May 22nd in 59.2 out in 1.12 while tracking company; most recently, he worked well in 1.00.2 out in 1.14.4 again with Da Silva aboard; he starts from the rail in this spot; Attfield has enjoyed considerable success in this race.

KING AND HIS COURT gained some notoriety when he went for new interests last November and scored in the Coronation Futurity by coming up the rail to steal it as the favourite; he reprised that role in the Wando Sakes when he got back to Tapeta and he beat Tiz A Slam a length with his pivotal inside run; getting out of the gate efficiently is a mounting problem; he worked well with Boulanger aboard May 28th in 59.1 with a rally out in 1.13.1; he competes for Gary Barber and Wachtel Stable and goes for Mark Casse.

STATE OF HONOR is one of three representatives here for Mark Casse and he is a homebred for Conrad Farms; he had the distinction of running second behind his new stable mate, King And His Court last November in the Coronation; he was runner up in the Grade 2 Tampa Derby and when he subsequently was second in the Grade 1 Florida Derby, he took down a prize of \$190,000 when chasing home the eventual Kentucky Derby winner, Always Dreaming; in the big event itself, he was overanxious on the pace setting unsustainable fractions and he finished nineteenth; he looks to start over again with the transfer home; he has significant size and a big galloping style; he had a rally in his work June 2nd in 1.01 getting ready.

EXPEDITION came home from Florida April 28th and was flat in a seven furlong race here; in his second start locally, he went from a sprint to a route and was perfectly handled to catch the speed in a race that moved forward his form significantly; he is a son of Pioneer of The Nile, looking to go forward here for WinStar Farm, China Horse Club International and SF Racing Group; Florent Geroux gets the call.

GUY CABALLERO is a leggy gelding with the knack for closing well in the stretch; that was the case in his seven furlong seasonal bow; he overcame some early bumping then got moving in the stretch against fractions that did not benefit his cause, yet, he secured second money; for this second start of the year, he goes from a sprint to a route; he is a homebred for Sean and Dorothy Fitzhenry going for Catherine Day-Phillips with Hernandez aboard and he was up for a work June 2nd in 1.00.1 rallying at a mate.

AVIE'S MESA came home after stops at Gulfstream and Keeneland to compete May 13th in a route; he looked like a sure winner at the top of the stretch as he rounded rivals; he was the only three year old in the race; however, the front runner found a new dimension in the stretch to hold him off and he had to settle for second best in what was a solid offering; he looks like a contender; he worked June 3rd in 1.00.4; he is a homebred for Ivan Dalos going for Josie Carroll with Contreras once again aboard and they won this race last year with Ami's Gizmo.

CHILL had his seasonal bow May 21st and attended the pace but stalled on the turn and then weakened; the sixth place finisher came back to win; the blinkers are back on. **IHAVEABETTERIDEA** had a May 21st seasonal bow and had an excusable trip while stalled behind a wall of rivals and he was finally only four and a half lengths back at the end; he is hoping for a more wide open trip in this second start of the year.

WAR FACTORY was second best in a vastly improved second start to the season with lasix added May 17th; he saved the place award when Where's The Gold was closing quickly in third and he is also here.

AREOCENTRIC opted for a speed approach in a race loaded with closers last time and he gave way and the stayers took over including a sharp winner who has repeated; the third place finisher has also come back to score.

MARTEN RIVER got in behind runners while drafting May 13th then after showing life at the top of the stretch; he went a bit flat towards the end; the three year old sprint division in stakes is very fast and he gets relief by moving into this classification; his speed conflicts with that of Bet On Mike.

MCGARRETT hasn't run since last July but has been going quickly in the morning with consecutive fast works at five furlongs getting ready for Beverley Chubb.

SPLASH WITH ME won his seasonal bow then second time out against this kind, he couldn't get motivated deep in the stretch.

GET'ERDONEBUD went eleven races without winning last year but took seven shares; this will be his seasonal bow and Bahen gets the call for John Ross.

CRUSHIN IT got shuffled back along the inside May 21st and then weakened as the favourite in this category; Wilson who had a good result with him two starts ago, takes over here.

DAILY BREW showed talent in his May 6th seasonal bow to win for veteran Ray O'Connor; in his second start, he got delayed behind traffic and that event is best tossed out.

BET ON MIKE dropped down second time out this year and added blinkers and lasix and that was his ticket home in that key maiden contest where he beat a well regarded debut runner who has already come back to win; he has kept active in morning preps for Roger Atfield getting ready for this third start of the meet; Marten River may also offer speed.

WHERE'S THE GOLD was rushing in the stretch when he finally got clear a furlong from home May 17th; he was getting a quick comeback on that occasion but has had more time between events leading to this race.

THE YOUNG LORD had some anxious moments behind the gate with his behaviour prior to his debut May 20th but once underway, he attended the pace in handy fashion and then rushed by in the lane; he has since had a good work in 48 for Ian Black.

STALLION HEIRESS comes in from Churchill Downs where she faltered on turf last time in a letdown effort; she competes for Stallionaire Enterprises and goes for Michael Stidham; Florent Geroux has the mount for the first time; she had a three race winning streak on turf prior to that last letdown and her strength is her speed; she has since worked on Tapeta at Fair Hill in 1.00 getting ready; the blinkers are on.

INFLEXIBILITY a smart looking Anderson Farms bred by Scat Daddy from a route winning dam, competes for trainer, Chad Brown, and Klaravich Stables Inc. and William H. Lawrence; she had a potent off the pace kick in her initial race at Gulfstream in January on turf when second against the favourite; she overcame early trouble in that race; in her second start on the wide open turf at Belmont, she measured her opponents as the favourite and cleared them late; Joel Rosario once again has the mount with the transfer to Tapeta.

GERTIE T has won both of her starts this season with off the pace sprint techniques and had an instant gain in the stretch May 6th at seven furlongs; she will now stretch around two turns with Hernandez taking over for Norm McKnight; Hernandez was aboard for a recent work in 1.00.1; she competes for Racer's Edge Inc. and CEC Stables Inc.

GHOSTLY PRESENCE a homebred for Chiefswood Stable, won big in the Princess Elizabeth last November; she faltered in the Fury to begin this year and most recently, was outside on the tougher footing in the Selene when unable to reach contention; Bahen was aboard for her good work June 4th in 59.4 out in 1.13.3 in company with Miss Adele for Roger Attfield.

HOLY HELENA debuted April 15th in New York and was second best but got a maiden win second time out catching up with a longshot speed runner who faltered; she is a daughter of Ghostzapper from a route winning dam who did produce the Grade 2 Stakes winner, Holy Boss; Contreras was aboard for a work here June 6th in 1.00.2 for James Jerkins who is currently the trainer of, Stronach Stable's, Shaman Ghost, also by Ghostzapper.

INSPIRED VOW went aggressively on the pace in a maiden contest on turf recently and finished third beaten less than a length; she competes for Mark Casse and goes for Breeze Easy with Boulanger aboard once again; she worked June 2nd in 47.1.

MISS ADELE was getting her second start ever May 12th and was seeing Tapeta under race terms for the first time and she rated on the lead then galloped away smartly from that group; Moran will take over here; she prepped in company June 4th in 59.4 out in 1.13.3 with Ghostly Presence for Roger Attfield who first won this race back in 1986 with Playlist.

FINANCIAL RECOVERY competes for trainer, Catherine Day-Phillips who won this race last year with Neshama; she seemed to be coming to hand in her seasonal bow in the Fury Stakes with an outside gain at seven furlongs and had a good gallop out; she went flat around two turns in the Selene after being inconvenienced at the break; she was without a sufficient response in deep stretch; a switch is made to Mike Smith; she competes for Narola and is also a homebred for Anderson Farms.

ENSTONE competes for East West Stables and trainer Mark Casse, a three time winner of this race in the past, and Husbands, who is a multiple winner of this event, has the mount; her race in the Fury was flawless; she took over the lead and widened at seven furlongs; most recently in the Selene, she ended up in an early pace duel with the eventual tenth place finisher; the winner rallied past her; she settled for a solid runner up finish; she was under restraint in her work July 4th in 48.1 out in 1.01.

MYTHICAL MISSION competes for Sam-Son Farm seven time winners of this event; she is by Giant's Causeway and from a dam who scored in the Wonder Where Stakes; she is a full sister to, Irish Mission, who won this race in 2012; her only start this year came in the Fury where she never did get a clear run from a stalking position in the second flight but she stayed willingly; she trained well May 28th for Malcolm Pierce in 59.3 with a rally; Da Silva who won this race last year with Neshama, has the mount.

ELLAN VANNIN was a sparkling winner of the Lassie Stakes in her second start last November and she handled two turns well to defeat Cindervella; her seasonal bow April 30th saw her typically off the pace but she hung against Enstone; she trained with stamina in mid May and had a more spirited speed work June 4th in 59.1 getting ready for Jonathan Lee and also trainer Tony Michael Gattellaro who had a sharp winner earlier this week.

CINDERVELLA has been unplaced in both stakes appearances this year; she went to the Selene at a route last time where she came in at the break; once straightened, she was reserved but her mild gain to mid stretch was not sustained; Campbell was aboard for a recent work in 1.00.4 for Mike De Paulo; she competes for Frank Anecchini and D'Alimonte Holdings.

LIONS BAY was in a key race May 13th when he got his seasonal bow and understandably was out of the money against a sharp winner and the runner up, Avie's Mesa, was in the Plate Trial today; he looks for his first win on turf with this sharp drop in value; he rates a look.

PUGSLEY was well below his best in his seasonal bow; he now goes to turf for the fourth time in his life and is seeking his initial share on the grass.

MACHO BREW was on Tapeta to begin this year in a protected spot against one of the best local sprinters; with that race out of the way, he now goes to turf seeking his initial win on the lawn.

SOMBRERO DE COPA was in for just \$15,000 in his seasonal bow and he managed to get into the clear through the stretch and beat Money Talks and Unikatt and he meets that pair again here at a higher price at a shorter distance.

BOLD ANIMAUX was beaten off for just \$5,000 in New Orleans in February but has been turned over to Kevin Attard for some local prepping hoping to build momentum and now seeks his sixth win on turf.

DEMAWATCHMI languished in behind rivals looking for room May 19th when Sombrero De Copa was the winner then he showed energy when space was available; he deserves a look here.

UNIKAT sat behind runners on the turn waiting for his moment in a May 19th race against Sombrero De Copa and ran well in third beaten only two lengths on the grass.

CHIEFROLL'NTHUNDER was in a key race last time and finished far behind; he makes his way back with a turf race and did have a peak effort on the turf when winning last September.

MONEY TALKS competed again Wednesday night and for the second race in a row, he couldn't find a clear path; he was second behind Sombrero De Copa two starts ago.

DEEP FREEZE was four wide in a May 7th seasonal bow and finished fourth; he now goes to turf and has handled the grass well enough.

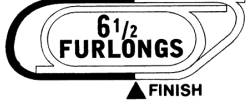
