RACE #1

BANNON

LOOKIN AT BRAVO debuted at a route and was bothered early in that event; he stayed on willingly along the inside; he now moves to turf with a chance to improve.

CROSS BORDER is bred for turf by English Channel and will be seeing the lawn for the initial time; he had two earlier starts on Tapeta at the meeting and was a fringe player both times; Da Silva takes over here.

ENGLISH CLASSIC has run twice on Tapeta and has finished on the edges; he is bred for turf and now goes to the lawn for the initial time; Banach had a sharp turf winner on Friday.

RED ROMEO raced well in his opener on turf in Maryland; second time out he broke poorly in a race here then recovered to finish second behind a winner in from Tampa; that last finishing position points him out as a contender.

MAJOR ECLIPSE did not get out of the gate effectively May 20th and as a result finished far behind; he now stretches out on turf with a rider switch to Campbell.

MICK THE CONQUEROR has had many chances and has often run well; he was second best in his seasonal bow on Tapeta when he moved too late; he is quite comfortable with this move to the turf. Husbands will take over for Stuart Simon.

RASPBERRY WILD needed more room than then her opener provided May 14th and she closed too late in third; she gets more room here for hot connections.

WINTERVELD a first time starter is by Bodemeister who is currently enjoying some fame; she goes for Dave Cotey and has had a regular series of preps getting ready.

WICKED WEST a 4 year old, will debut at six and a half furlongs for Julie Robillard and Husbands will be aboard; she has concentrated with a series of works at a half mile.

AFLEET DOLL came home from Florida to run here May 7th and was simply second best; most recently she had every chance to win but she was nosed out; she returns in the same classification as a contender.

BOURBON BABE got into an impossible spot in her seasonal bow which was taken by a dominant winner; she finished seventh of twelve and the race had some merit; now that she devalues she has a chance to have an impact.

SAMMY JO BLUE is a late runner for Joe Walls; she departs a turf race where she was third as the favourite and she moved well on the outside; she now shifts to Tapeta.

SANITY has had a local introduction and her speed was ineffective; she gets to devalue for this event going now for just \$25,000 and she should have an aggressive approach from the outside for Mark Casse.

AWFULLY SINFUL is without a career win on turf yet has run well on turf at intervals; she was close up on the grass at Tampa in April; this will be her second start of the meeting for Mike Wright and she moves into a Starter event at just seven furlongs on the lawn.

SWEET CORINNA is without a career win on turf but has taken some shares; this will be her first start since April when she competed at Parx and she was without momentum then.

UNSEEN ANGELS ran well here two starts ago but was second behind the dominant winner, Green Doctor, who is also entered here; she moved over to turf last time and won on the front end over a surface helpful to speed runners; she should get a good stalking trip here.

BEAR'S PRIDE was without momentum late last season when she was dropped down and she attracted a claim; she goes to a hot stable for this seasonal bow and she moves to turf a footing over which she has won regularly in the past; Husbands was aboard for her best spring work on June 3rd in 1.00.4

FUNNY FUNNY RIDDLE had a surprisingly good seasonal bow to win in late May with a big rush on the front end for just \$9,500; the elements are much tougher here with a shift to the grass and a big jump in value.

APACHE GAL has tried turf only once and was unplaced then; she looking to gain momentum by switching surfaces.

TAKE BACK YA POLLS had a May 6th seasonal bow for \$25,000 and ran willingly after chasing a pace that was too quick in the middle fractions; while she has yet to win on turf, she has handled it well; Campbell knows her well.

INPERSON is getting her first start of the year; she concluded last season with three wins in a row at low levels; she seeks her second win on grass in this return with a big jump in value.

GREEN DOCTOR had such an enormous class edge on the field in her seasonal bow in a Starter event that she dominated the pace and kept Unseen Angels in second; now she gets to go to the turf a footing she very much appreciates and her speed is to be respected in this Starter event.

LADY OF ST CLEMENTS was a winner in her previous race; she stepped up in value to run on grass last time where she did well to finish in a tie for second; it was an energetic performance; Hernandez stays aboard in this tougher spot.

SAN NICOLA BREEZE had a good race two starts ago in a Starter event when Green Doctor was the winner and Unseen Angels was second; she jumped in value last time while remaining on Tapeta and could not keep up behind an improved winner; she is a one time winner on the turf.

STORM HAWK is worth considering because he likes the turf; he had a peak race on the lawn last September and this will be his first start on the grass since that time.

TOXICOLOGIST a debut runner for Colebrook Farms has turf top and bottom in his pedigree; he had an opportunity to work on turf Friday morning getting ready for this debut which comes at a mile on the lawn.

SHOWING SIN lacked speed but showed some interest on the outside last time without threatening and now goes to turf.

DIRECT DRIVE used a new off the pace style last time and was finally fifth of nine behind a favoured winner; he now goes to the turf.

SOUL n' SPIRIT has been unplaced in both races this season; he has had some exposure to the grass but has not produced; he tried to build momentum in a recent workout.

REDWOOD LEIF debuted at a higher level without threatening against a key winner; he drops down and moves to turf and does have grass in his pedigree; the blinkers are on.

ABOVE ALL ODDS has not been a factor in three careers races; he puts the blinkers on and drops down and goes to turf.

BOIS BANDE is starting the second time and he was unproductive in his opener on Tapeta; he is bred for turf and now that he moves to the grass he could wake up.

TEIAIAGON has handled turf ok at times; he had a let down performance for new interests May 26th; perhaps the turf will get him going again.

PRECEPTOR is from a dam who has produced some turf winners; this stable has had some success moving runners to the grass and he makes that shift here after wide loss on Tapeta.

CLASSIC FORCE is beautifully bred but lost by wide margins in two races last season; his dam did produce a couple of turf winners and now he moves to grass in this seasonal bow in hopes of a wakeup; he drops from \$20,000.

VICTORY L. has some turf in his pedigree; he has lost by wide margins in both races this season; he was in a key race last time when overwhelmed; he has had recent prepping getting ready.

TRUE FORCE an auction purchase will debut here at reduced evaluation on turf; he is by a sire enjoying some current popularity; he has worked both on Tapeta and the training turf recently getting ready for Mark Casse.

CALL ME GIZMO was on the turf to begin this campaign and finished tenth of fourteen after tracking the pace; he should welcome the easier company and rates attention.

ARCHER TRIUMPH'S showed some life deep in the stretch on turf in his return race last time and more room is available which is helpful; he rates a look.

SPANISH BRIGADIER is fast an individual who went overly quick in the early furlongs last time and tired in the stretch when Jimmies Truck was second and Tuition was the third and they are both here.

NORRIS LAKE was a surprise winner in his seasonal bow; he overcame trouble on the turn and started over again with a deep close to win going away; there is plenty of speed to chase tonight and that should help his late style; Husbands rides once again.

CONCORSO is one of several speed elements in the race; he was in against a key winner two starts ago and slipped back late and finished fourth and the winner came back to score recently on the turf; following a subsequent failure, he now drops sharply for \$10,000 in search of the second win of the season.

BEEN WAITING was getting his second local start after arriving from Florida last time; he made ambitious run up the rail to reach for the lead only to have the top two finishers close better from the outside; he does like to run at the speed; Hernandez now rides.

TUITION has been third in three consecutive races; last time he closed late and was beaten just a length and was narrowly behind the runner up Jimmies Truck; the winner closed stoutly in that last race.

BETTIN' ACES is one of several speed runners in the race and will need ideal trip; he gets to drop in value following a third place finish for \$19,000 when going an extra half furlong; he goes for a hot stable; Wilson sets a rare ride for this stable.

TOBRUK dropped into the perfect spot for a win as the favourite last time and he was clear of the others and galloped out strongly; he attracted a claim and now competes for Shana Lopez, he is up in value.

ONE FOR JACK did not keep up in his first start of this year when Jimmies Truck was better in second; he is seeking a break through win.

JIMMIES TRUCK is without a victory this season but has been competitive on two occasions and has taken the runner up spot twice; he was out rallied by the winner last time in a strong effort at this price at a half furlong farther; he can stalk the speed.

STOP WHO'S THAT had an initial start this season at seven furlongs as a means to getting ready to stretch out for this longer race; she finished on the edges last time against Gertie T who was entered in the Woodbine Oaks; she has had interim prepping for Mike Doyle.

REBEL WITHA CHANCE looks like a strong contender in this second start to the season; she is making adjustments here going from turf to Tapeta and lengthening out from a sprint to a route; she often ran well going long on Tapeta last year despite her lugging habit at the top of the stretch.

TIMBERLINE attracted a claim by Kevin Attard last October; the blinkers were put on and she won two races in a row for her new interests and improved; this will be her first start of the season and she has had prepping in company getting ready.

PECHE MOBILEE failed to win in eight starts last season and by end of her campaign she was without momentum; this will be her first try of the season and she is in a protected spot.

PRETTY TWO FACED raced strongly in her first start of the meeting when sprinting; in her second start of the session she went to a protected level on turf where the strong late pace was too tough for her; she now moves to Tapeta.

CONQUEST SUPERSTEP came from Florida to compete here May 14th in a route on Tapeta and was the pacemaker until she grew weary late and finished fourth as the favourite; the runner up has come back with the big win; she looks to be more thorough here and she has had some interim prepping.

NEW SENSATION was beautifully trained by Robert Tiller for a winning seasonal bow and was ideally handed by Boulanger from off the pace; she moved precisely to win it with big stretch drive to take her first win; she seemed to enjoy that more patient style.

ME MORE is one the leading contenders here; he was out of the money on turf last time for \$20,000; he now competes for just \$6,000 with a sharp drop and moves to Tapeta and shortens to just five furlongs; he ran strongly at this distance when winning in his first start of the year.

A BIT OF WHO DO attended the pace at this price range last outing but he went flat and lost the place award to Kat's Good Scout.

KAT'S GOOD SCOUT dropped to this level last time and for the second time this time this year he took the show award but could not protect the lead at the most important time; he shortens in distance.

GUATEMALA CITY had front and speed in his first start of the season and was finally second beaten just one length; when the winner was disqualified; he was awarded first place; he shortens to five furlongs.

PERFECT FORESTER is one of two in the race for Norm McKnight; he is dropping down and shortening in distance; he ran a strong race when moving to this stable May 5th at this distance and he is one of the contenders; blinkers are add today.

ELMO SHRUGS was at Fort Erie last time at a lower level to compete at a short distance where he took third money; he faces a much tougher task here.

CONN'S REWARD began this season in a tough situation on turf and was last of fourteen; he makes changes dropping in value, shortening in distance and switching to Tapeta.

CONQUEST TOO SMART is getting his third race of the meeting; he is making changes by dropping sharply, shortening in distance and switching to Tapeta; he offered speed in his latest but didn't stay in contention; he departs the Lasix program.

DYLAN rates respect here now that he drops down for this second start of the meeting; he was beaten just a few lengths last time and the winner has since stepped up to win on the grass; the third place finisher has also returned to win; now he drops for just \$10,000 and extends in distance.

MINERS DANCE showed some life outside in the stretch in his seasonal bow May 26th and now goes farther against better.

BEAREAGLE made a bid along the inside with a furlong remaining last time and was finally second at this price; Lermyte now rides.

SILENT VISION overcame some traffic on the turn but couldn't improve his position in the stretch when dropped down last time; he seeks his first share of the meeting.

BIT'S LOVER BOY circled rivels but then hung last time and finished out of the money when claimed at a lower level; Moreno now rides.

REIMAGINED has made two starts at higher levels this season and should welcome the sharp drop for just \$10,000; his latest was good enough for consideration here.

BAKERSFIELD a claim back in April now comes underneath his acquired price; he was out of the money on turf last time and now gets in with more his own kind for Norm McKnight; Da Silva now rides.

ROCK RIVER showed no capacity for route racing last time; he has been moved to the stable of Dale Desruisseaux; the blinkers are now on; he runs shorter and devalues with a chance to wake up.

CANDY RIDE CAT is hopeful of improvement in this second start of the meeting and Hernandez is staying aboard; early speed was obvious last time; improvement is expected.

MILWAUKEE FLASH was given a good chance to do well last time and he typically closed to be on the edges; he can be a factor once again with his late style; Doyle and Moran won the finale on Friday.

SLAM was a winner for \$16,000 two starts ago; most recently he went up in value but broke off stride; he showed speed but faltered; he should welcome the big drop for just \$10,000, he comes from outside.
