ANGELACREST had a June 4th seasonal bow and was in prime position through the stretch just to the outside of the leader but the late pace faltered and she hung and retreated to fourth.

RAW SPIRIT is certainly one to consider here in her second start of the year; she drops sharply and shortens in distance for a chance to use her speed.

SHERWOOD FOREST was close only early last time in the same race where Angelacrest was better in fourth.

ONE HOT MADAMME dropped down so decisively May 26th that she was heavily bet and her measured rally from behind the pacemaker was successful FOR MAIDEN \$7,500; Hernandez stays aboard for Martin Drexler.

COURT DEPUTY was forced to scratch from a race May 19th; when she got back to the races June 3rd for her second lifetime approach, she came from just off the pace to win it smartly for Frank Huarte in a race where lasix was added; she now tries non winners of two.

DANCE WITH ME BABY was at Fort Erie June 6th against a front running winner and chased that one through the stretch without threatening.

HOLY PLAN is one to consider given her freshening and today's drop; she exits a key race from which the fourth place finisher has come back to beat Raw Spirit and both the second and fifth place finishers have since been second; she was a winner here April 16th.

EARLY RINGALING showed some life between rivals last time without threatening and has been freshened since May 7th.

ETHANOL was getting his third start of the year last outing and he dropped in for \$25,000 and ran a peak race but lost the photo to Cummings Road; he draws the rail here for this starter event.

SNOWY LEGACY ran well at long odds in his seasonal bow against a winner taking a substantial edge and he looks to build on that good race; the fourth place finisher, Deep Freeze, has come back to win; Bahen once again has the mount.

BOLD GENT worked quickly May 14th and then dropped sharply for a winning seasonal bow May 26th and attracted a claim by Anthony Adamo for \$10,000.

CUMMINGS ROAD narrowly missed in his seasonal bow then narrowly won his second start of the campaign at the expense of Ethanol; most recently, he got into a starter event but that race featured a big performance by the winner and he did well to be second for Edwin Knight.

BETTIN' ACES was entered for Wednesday but will perhaps entertain this spot after a couple of recent fades for \$19,000.

VILLAGEOFVIBANK won at a low level at just five furlongs to begin this campaign and second time out, went to an open first allowance race and as a winning longshot in that event, he collected a top prize of \$54,780.00; he traveled the five furlongs in 57.1; he must carry increased weight while attempting to extend his win streak; he lengthens to six and a half furlongs.

VEGAS STRIP competed here May 6th and raced well from the outside to be third beaten just two lengths when Cummings Road was second.

GENTLEMAN JACKSON looked good when he attracted a claim from a winning race May 17th; most recently, he was seventh beaten five lengths in a turf race where things did not go his way; he will exit turf and get back to Tapeta with more his own kind in this second race following the claim.

THE CRAIC was getting his seasonal bow April 22nd at five and a half furlongs and he was ready to move on the turn but he hung in the stretch finishing a distant third with Keep Your Head Up three lengths better; he faces that same rival here and must come from the inside; he stretches out a furlong; she rates a look.

BOATHOUSE VIEW is looking to improve on his trip here in this fourth start of the campaign; he was third in his latest behind Keep Your Head Up and Subzero Plus; he had finished second the time before against a key winner; Husbands retains the mount for Mike Mattine.

LEMON ZIP dropped out of the Fury Stakes to finish a weakening fourth at a route June 2nd against a dominant winner; she will shorten to six and a half furlongs here for Chiefswood Stable and Boulanger takes over and was aboard for a sprint win early in her career.

SUBZERO PLUS has had one race this season and had every chance to win it; she followed the path of the eventual winner, Keep Your Head Up, and reported in second as both rallied; she has Hernandez once again in this second start of the meet; this will be her second start on lasix.

FORTY'S SWEETHEART attracted a claim last November when winning; in her finale, she had a drafting trip in traffic; this will be her seasonal bow fro Richard Morden and she worked on the training track June 1st in 59.4.

KEEP YOUR HEAD UP received a perfect winning ride from Alan Garcia to score for Don MacRae last time in a first allowance event; she swung outside and commanded the late pace against Subzero Plus and Boathouse View; she comes from the outside.

RED CABERNET showed promise in her opener and then second time, added blinkers and added lasix and committed to a speed style and hung; the top two have both come back to win and the third place finisher, Hailey's Prize is here; she worked on turf recently and now goes to the lawn for Ian Black; she rates attention.

HAILEY'S PRIZE has had two runs this season and the results have been typical as she has landed on the edges; her latest was quite eventful; she checked with a half mile to go while in the slower split on turf and then when trying to jam between rivals deep in the stretch, she bumped Redwin Romp then continued on and claimed second money behind a winner who rallied from tenth; she remains on turf and has had a subsequent good work on Tapeta in 47.1.

MOON OVER VICTORIA had a May 22nd seasonal bow in the faster split of a turf race where she had every chance to do well but she finished sixth beaten seven lengths when Roxy Red was second.

WHATTA GIRL a debut runner by Stormy Atlantic, is a homebred for Donver Stable trying six and a half furlongs on turf and competing for the claiming portion; she has attracted Boulanger here for Josie Carroll; she travels six and a half furlongs on the lawn.

ROXY RED has had many chances and has often run well and that was the case on turf last time in the faster split when she was second best; she was always a threat in that event but the winner offered more.

LYLA D debuted May 22nd and raced greenly out of contention at seven furlongs on turf in the faster split; blinkers are added.

SATURDAY DANCER a debut runner for John Ross, was an auction purchase and will go here on turf at six and a half furlongs with Garcia aboard; she has had a variety of preps getting ready.

REDWIN ROMP was getting her second start of the meeting recently and despite a wide loss in her seasonal bow, a move to turf saw her take inordinate support; she ran better than most expected losing out only late and Hailey's Prize was just in front of her in second; she had to endure a bump from that runner up.

BAD NANA had a June 3rd seasonal bow and made a bid outside and finished third against a well liked winner; she should be able to build on that race and now goes to turf; the blinkers are on; the stable had a recent turf winner.

FOREST LASS was at five furlongs in her seasonal bow and lost in double digits against a key winner and wasn't a factor; the third place finisher came back with a good race last weekend; her dam liked the turf and now she goes to the lawn.

BLUE PEARLS debuted June 3rd and was last early but was on her feet at the end; she now moves to turf.

SO MIESQUE was on turf in a quickly run sprint May 19th and didn't factor into the outcome; she started her run on the turn but she visibly hung; the top two have both come back with in the money finishes.

FLASHY PATCH has run on the edges both times and now drops for half the price; she had surprising speed last time from a middle post then landed about four lengths back; she must come from the rail here as one of the contenders.

BUCKDEN HOUSE improved radically second time out at the meeting May 19th when she dropped in value and shortened in distance; she used a new running style from off the pace and advanced to third under Husbands who has the mount here; the winner has since been second and the runner up has since won; she stretches out.

SMOOTH SPIRIT closed well between rivals in her final start of last year; this will be her first try of the campaign and she has been prepared at Fort Erie.

LUCKBEALADY NOW trailed early after a poor break last time; she was in a much more difficult event than today and should welcome the drop down; she has since practiced from the gate.

FLIRTIN FOR CERTIN often has interruptions to her campaigning and returns from a long layoff here; she is noted for her significant speed; she did well in her opening races last season; she has been moved to the stable of Richard Morden and Johnson once again has the mount.

PINCH MY CHEEKS fell back early in a May 28th second start this season and was finally a distant fourth with Thirteen Diamonds better in second.

CATCH SOME Z'S returned from considerable time away and halved in value for a successful seasonal bow May 20th where she rallied between rivals while drifting as the favourite; she comes right back at the same price to face non winners of three.

HAVEAWONDERFULDAY had consecutive wins through May 7th; most recently, she went against multiple winning company and was overwhelmed; she gets back with limited winners here for one of the hottest stables at the meeting; she competes for a top jockey/trainer combo.

THIRTEEN DIAMONDS has run consistently well in her last three events and last outing, was third as the top two got away; she will shorten back to six furlongs, the distance of her peak performances in her previous two races.

SOUTHERN PUZZLE is getting her first start of the year and goes to the stable of Martin Drexler; Da Silva was aboard for her final win of last year and stays aboard here; she has had regular local prepping.

MISTER NADA stayed ok on turf last time but laid in and that may have hindered his progress when he was fourth beaten three lengths for \$19,000; Atypical was better in second on that occasion; he now goes to a starter event for an opportunity to remain on the grass.

BRILLIANT CHARLIE had a second start to the season that was much better than his opener; most recently, his third start of the year was even better than his second try of the session; perhaps the improvement will continue here as he moves over to the turf with a jump in value; he loses his rider as Husbands will be aboard Atypical and Boulanger moves in here and knows this one well.

MECHANICAL started the season in a key race and was completely overwhelmed at long odds against unreachable company; the top two have already come back to win in key fashion; he now drops sharply in value to a starter event; he likes the turf and a change in form is likely here.

CAT ZAPPER was awkward in the early going but closed nicely at the end to be fourth beaten two lengths in a Tapeta seasonal bow; he now goes to turf for the first time.

COSMIC CHARLIE was on the turf for \$30,000 last time and was behind and on the outside but he made his way forward gradually with lasix added in what was a much improved race; he now goes to a starter event.

BALDUR was on turf for his seasonal bow and got into the clear at the top of the stretch with every chance but he hung finishing eighth against limited winners.

SOROKOLITIS is a one time winner on the turf and this will be his seasonal bow he gave away some value at the end of his campaign last year; he has Moran for this return for Suzanne Drake.

GRAY PHANTOM went from two sprints to a route last time and woke up with a banner performance; he missed winning in a photo; the blinkers are on for this turn back in distance and this shift to the grass.

ATYPICAL was getting his second start of the season and he dropped from the \$30,000 mark against a winner who scored again recently to go for \$19,000 last time; he came with a rush in the stretch but had to angle out and that cost him some momentum and he was finally narrowly beaten; he showed a generous response on turf and now goes to a starter event as a likely contender.

FOREST BROTHER was getting his second start of the meeting and he raced well for the second time in a row; he was on turf in a first allowance event against better than he encounters here and was beaten only four lengths; he cuts back in distance and takes a big class drop to go to a starter event.

BEYOND SMART is worth considering; he likes the turf and is fresh for this seasonal bow; he now competes for Richard Morden; while he failed to win last year, he was competitive.

STARINTHEMAKING has unknown status currently after being introduced here May 6th; he ran for the claiming portion of the eligibility and finished eleventh as one of the favourites; both the third and seventh place finishers have come back to win; he now competes for just \$25,000 with blinkers on and has had interim morning activity.

ARMED ESCORT dropped down for his seasonal bow May 27th and at long odds, he fought throughout and was finally fifth beaten two lengths when Master Macduff was second; he comes back at the same price range.

HE STARTED IT had a May 17th seasonal bow for \$20,000 at five furlongs and he closed too late as the favourite and was second beaten a half length; he is up one price and more room is available here.

BANGOR RIDGE a debut runner for Cary Brooks, was an auction purchase and will have Alderson aboard in this launch; the stable just recently had a win with Lady Brie.

CRY IN THE WILD had a May 19th seasonal bow for \$32,000 and as a second time lasix user, hung finishing fourth; that was a key event and now he drops down for \$25,000 for this second start of the session.

WARDO had a couple of uneventful starts to this season then took a plunge in value June 3rd and ran better than in his opening two events to finish second for \$15,000 as the favourite; he is back up in value here and Crawford will now ride in this fourth try of the campaign.

ALERT GREEN is getting his first start since last August; he did have a good race last summer to be third against the now multiple stakes winner, King And His Court; he begins this campaign for just \$25,000 for John Cardella and his natural speed is to be respected.

MASTER MACDUFF had a good seasonal bow May 27th dropping in for \$25,000 and finishing second beaten a neck with a good surge between rivals; he remains at contender.

DANI'S VICTORY drew in last time in a race that came off the grass and from a wide post, he got into prime contention in mid stretch but hung; he now takes a significant drop for \$25,000 for this third run of the year.

SHEEGWEEHA a homebred for Paul O'Brien, will debut for Dan O'Callaghan; she is a daughter of Silver Train, a winner of the Breeders' Cup Sprint; she travels a mile on turf here and has had an opportunity to work on the grass.

DAWNING SKY a homebred for Walter Banach, goes for Darwin Banach; she is certainly bred for the turf and worked on the grass recently getting ready for this launch which goes at one mile; she does compete for one of the hottest stables at Woodbine and success on the turf has been one of its a hallmarks.

SOPHIAS DREAM was bothered in a chain reaction on turf May 22nd and couldn't recover; she drops in for \$20,000 for this second start of the meet.

QUEENS HONOR had trouble at the gate in her opener; second time out, she encountered a pace on turf that looked to be too quick for her and she slipped back to eighth; she now drops for \$20,000 and sees turf for the second time in a row.

ORPHAN QUEEN debuted May 20th and was used in the early furlongs for positioning but could not continue; she now goes to turf and has worked recently on the grass; her dam did produce the two time turf winner, Green Doctor.

SAFE AT DANEHILL debuted June 3rd at six furlongs on Tapeta for just \$16,000 and had an ineffective rail trip; she is bred for turf and now gets in with her own gender but must take a value jump here to get onto the grass; Campbell will move in for this second start for Norm McKnight.

HALO EXPRESS had a run on Tapeta at a low level to begin this campaign and started up and came with a significant rally to be second; she now goes up in value and shifts to the grass.

SCATTER THE SILVER was on turf in her seasonal bow and made a move outside to get into contention but then disappointed deep in the stretch, Ryan takes over for this second start.

CONQUEST RAPIDUNO was dropped down May 20th and attracted a claim for \$12,500 and she stalled inside on that occasion; she has been on the turf in the past with some fringe efforts and should welcome a return to the lawn.

NIPISSING RIDGE a debut runner, is a homebred for Cudney Stables going for Elizabeth Elder; she is bred for the turf top and bottom by Perfect Soul and from a dam who produced, Lafontaine, a two tie winner on the lawn; she goes for \$20,000 at a mile in this opener.

DEESE NIKE debuted April 7th on the turf at Tampa and was beaten just nine lengths at long odds; for this second start, lasix is added; she is from a dam who won six times on turf.

SLOVENIA is getting her seasonal bow in this spot and has worked regularly up to this event; she did get some exposure to the turf last season but didn't produce then.

DANZIG RAINBOW moved very late on the outside to get within two and a half lengths in her try on turf last time and now drops in for just \$20,000 and is hopeful of drawing into this event.

FOR U MIKE competes for a stable that has enjoyed success on turf this year; she was on turf last time but was eliminated at the gate in a bumping incident; she tries again at a lower level and this time with lasix.

DATING SOPHIE had an awkward departure from the gate and then was pinched last time when on turf in her seasonal bow, yet, was only six and a half lengths back at the end.

TORNADO CAT was part of problems at the gate on turf last time and she was severely compromised when the sixth place finisher initiated interference and she couldn't recover.
