LOVIN SPOON PHIL was perfectly prepared for a winning seasonal bow May 12th by Hall of Fame trainer, Robert Tiller; once she had cleared some traffic with five furlongs remaining in that route event, she swooped around the outside and was clear at the end; she came back to work June 7th in 1.01 getting ready; with Da Silva aboard Trini Brewnette, Boulanger takes over.

THIS IS MY NIGHT had deep closing power in a turf race June 2nd which was her third start of the season and she was finally fourth and doing her best running late; she moves to Tapeta.

SAVANNA CITY attracted a claim for \$20,000 May 26th when she was runner up with a driving move late in the race; she now goes to the stable of Katrina Vassilieva.

TRINI BREWNETTE had a May 12th seasonal bow at just six furlongs and it was not her best style to be chasing the pace of a superior speed runner ;she reported in second and the winner narrowly missed in a stake on Sunday; she now goes from a sprint to a route which should suit her ideally as she looks for a breakthrough win.

PRINCESS ROYAL went from a sprint to a route second time out at the meet and commanded the pace with Da Silva aboard; he is on Trini Brewnette here and Contreras will take over looking to double up.

BILKY BLUZ is accustomed to running well in route races but has lacked the winning touch in recent seasons; she was out of the money on turf last time in the same race where This Is My Night was better in fourth; she goes to Tapeta at a route with Moran aboard.

BENT CROWBAR a debut runner for Jecara Farms, is by Quick Kid, a noted router; he will compete here for Analisa Delmas at just four and a half furlongs; he must come from the inside post.

NOREGRETSFORNOW goes for the hot stable of Nick Gonzalez; this one is by a sire who won as a two year old and is from a dam who was a six time sprint winner; he has worked a half mile in consecutive preps getting ready.

CHANCEE a debut runner for John Ross, is by Wilko, a Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner and this one was an auction purchase; she has worked from the gate regularly getting ready.

SAVANNAH ROXANNA goes second time for Ricky Griffith and that has been a popular angle in recent years; she was only sixth in her opener but the fifth place finisher, Jamaica Me Home has come back to win; she adds lasix and has had interim prepping; the blinkers are on. **MISS HONEYPOTTS** a debut runner for Mike Doyle, is by the popular, Silent Name, and from a dam who won her only start; she has Ryan and has already had two five furlong works getting ready.

BARBICAN ROAD had a bit of an awkward break in a May 19th debut then was bumped and eliminated by a rival; he is by Sky Conqueror who has already had good representation at the meeting; he goes for Gord Colbourne who has already won with a second time starter at the meeting who improved significantly; he drops down.

FLASHY JOCK was last to depart the gate in a May 28th opener; he was finally fifth; he has had interim prepping; he drops for \$25,000 for a stable with positive stats in previous years.

X SQUARED is seeking her first win in an extended time; she had a limited campaign last season and was put away in the middle of July; she rejoins the lasix program for this return with the blinkers off and Alderson aboard for Ken Katryan; she indicates a series of half mile works.

PATSY'S STAR was out of the money on turf last time in the same race where Letter Fly was a couple of positions behind her; she had run well in her previous event at a much higher level when beaten two lengths by Generous Consort who was just recently a solid second; she tumbles all the way down to the \$10,000 mark for a hot stable and Husbands rides.

STRAWBERRY SCARLET was over the top of her best form late last season; this will be her seasonal bow and she helps herself by coming in at a reduced evaluation; she needed a couple of races last year before she hit a peak performance.

CANNA RED is getting her first start of the year and she did win at low levels last season; she encounters several here who are dropping down.

LETTER FLY gets all the way down to the \$10,000 mark; she had promising results in her opening two races on Tapeta this year then was out of the money on turf last time for twice this price; Wilson stays aboard with today's substantial drop.

GEOCENTRIC was in a near impossible spot in her seasonal bow, yet, was beaten only five and a half lengths; second time out in a more reachable spot, she retreated; she now drops in for \$10,000.

PRIDDY FAIR beat the bias in winning her April 22nd seasonal bow on the pace; second time out, she was in a protected spot where she wasn't far behind a key top pair and the runner up has come back to win; she tumbles back to the \$10,000 mark.

SWEET CORINNA often shows an aggressive style; she was competing at Parx and through April 11th, had made four starts there this year with just a minor share; for the return home, she rejoins the Scott Fairlie stable and drops in for just \$10,000.

NIGHT GATHERS had a May 19th return to the races after considerable time away and showed life late to be beaten only five lengths against a front running winner; the runner up has since been second.

LA SOUL returned from time away May 19th in a six and a half furlong race on turf where she was going quite ok at the end and she galloped out wilfully; the winner has since run well and the runner up has since been second; she goes longer.

VIA ANN debuted last November and had an awkward departure from the gate then showed some life at the end; she starts all over in this seasonal bow for Dan Vella with lasix added and she goes to the turf.

HEART RUSH campaigned at Fair Grounds over the winter and came here May 12th to run at seven furlongs on Tapeta where she was second against a wake up winner; she now goes to turf for the fourth time in her career.

DYNA'S MISCHIEF a well bred individual debuted April 16th on Tapeta and as expected sharp support showed and she understandably sagged late in that race; she has a challenge of a different kind here going long on turf.

RIVERINE a homebred, will debut here for Ted Burnett and goes for Mike Mattine; Hernandez has been involved in the preparations for this one and was aboard May 28th for a work in 1.14.1 with a good closing kick and a good gallop out; she tries a route on turf at first asking.

SISTER NATION is seven races into her career and has five shares; she has tried stakes company on a repeated basis and was second in the Star Shoot Stakes against a winner who was only seventh in the Alywow; in the Selene last time, she moved up late to be third and just in front of her in second with Enstone, who was recently fourth in the Oaks; she now moves to turf.

MARITIMECONNECTION had two opening sprints and then went long for a peak performance May 27th; she waited until the winner had moved by and then she initiated her own rally and it was good enough to be second just a half length shy.

YOU'RE MINE a debut runner, is a homebred for Pin Oak Stable from a dam who had plenty of stamina; she will go here for Malcolm Pierce at a route on turf and did work recently on the grass in 1.02.1 getting ready.

WHITE MOON had a May 13th seasonal bow and made a good middle move but couldn't continue; she is in a tougher maiden category here with this shift to the lawn, a footing over which she worked quickly last Sunday in 58.4.

A LA MODE worked last Sunday on turf in 47.3; she ran on turf May 19th with a good performance to be on the edges and she galloped out well and gets more room.

LOST POINT had a May 19th seasonal bow on turf and wasn't far away and showed some initiative at the end and now gets to go longer; she has had important interim prepping getting ready for Gail Cox.

CANADIAN EH was on turf to begin this season but after being rated back, she didn't have much stretch presence; this will be her longest race to date.

ACIANO moved to turf for her second lifetime race and it was an improvement as she finished a tight fourth at long odds; she gets even more room here.

BEAR SQUARED a debut runner, goes for Barbara Minshall; she is by a stakes winning sire and from a dam who was a triple stakes winner; she had some turn speed in her gate work May 28th in 48.1bg getting ready.

SILENT LIGHT a debut runner for Jal Dastur, is a homebred by Silent Name and from a dam who liked the grass; she worked from the gate June 3rd in 48.4bg.

ESSENTIAL is a homebred for Tucci Stable going for Nick Gonzalez; she is from the Nandi Stakes winner, Executrix, and will travel four and a half furlongs here; she handled herself well in a gate work May 25th in 49.2bg.

GOSUDARINA a debut runner, is a homebred for Goldmart Farms by Court Vision, going for Robert Tiller and she worked from the gate in company with Gimbala May 28th in 49.1bg.

GIMBALA a second representative here for Goldmart Farms, is a full brother to the local winner, Hipp Smitt; she worked from the gate May 28th in 49.1bg in company with her mate; she has since had a five furlong work in 1.01.1b getting ready.

SILENT DAMSEL a second representative here for Mike Doyle, is by Silent Name and is a homebred for C. Scott Abbott Racing Stable from a dam who was a six time winner; Moran was aboard for her good gate work June 3rd in 48.3bg.

MISS G NOTE a debut runner for John Ross, is from the same family as A Pic By Mrwill who ran third on Sunday; Ryan was aboard for a recent gate work and has the mount in this launch.

MY SILENT PRESENT a debut runner, is from the same dam who produced the million dollar winner, Heart To Heart, who was recently a close third in the Grade 1 Shoemaker Mile; she will try four and a half furlongs on Tapeta here and Boulanger has been aboard in the morning.

WITHOUT A DOUBT a debut runner for Ralph Biamonte, is a homebred by Court Vision and from a dam who was a six time winner; she worked with some speed from the gate May 22nd in 35.3bg.

MEGA MONSTER an auction purchase, will debut for Mike De Paulo and has the toughest post at this short distance; she had Contreras aboard for a work June 11th in 48.3; she also worked from the gate June 4th in 48.2bg out in 1.02.

ALICE'S WAR was thought to have enough to be a major contender in her seasonal bow but she was simply second best behind a winner who took sharp support in that second start of the season; she did finish in front of Donnas Sweet Heart and Flamenco Dancer; she looks to take another step forward in form in this second start of the year.

DONNAS SWEET HEART was getting her third run of the year and switched to turf last time; she sat off the pace and stayed willingly to be third with Alice's War was second.

KATRINA'S WAY showed speed in her seasonal bow but that style was unrewarding over that racing surface; most recently, she carried her speed more effectively with a drop in value for maiden \$32,000; she now goes to turf, a footing for which she is bred.

FLAMENCO DANCER has tried turf several times and had a good result May 28th in her second start this year when fourth with a late outside move; Alice's War was second in that event and Donnas Sweet Heart was third.

RYOAN raced well enough in her seasonal bow to be third and the winner, Lovin Spoon Phil, was in the opener today; in her second start of the season, she used herself up chasing the unbeatable Princess Royal, who was also in the opener today; she finds a more lucrative spot here and switches to turf, a footing she has handled well enough in the past.

KADLEY missed by inches with a late run at seven furlongs two starts ago in a peak effort; most recently, she experimented with a route and was done by mid stretch; she goes long on turf here and does have three grass winning siblings.

I LOOK INCREDIBLE had a vastly improved performance second time out this season when shifted to turf by Jennifer Shafer; she was up close between rivals and took over in the stretch under Contreras and was clear; she looks to double up.

PHIL'S GLORY was in a key race May 22nd and landed fourth beaten two lengths; a winner came back to score big on the turf and both the fifth and sixth place finishers have come back with explosive wins; she now goes to turf with blinkers on and looks to be a contender.

MARY SUE WELOVEYOU attracted a claim March 5th at Gulfstream when second best for \$12,500; she was relocated here May 14th in a protected spot; not much was expected and she finished sixth; now that she gets down in value, she should begin to prosper again with the blinkers on; Hernandez has been attracted in this spot.

D'S BENEFACTION was asked for a response last time and stayed willingly at this distance to be third behind a well regarded winner; she takes on somewhat tougher here; she rates a look for Santino DiPaola.

DANCE ON STAGE is getting her first race since August 1st; trainer Ron Sadler has been doing well with runners off the shelf and Husbands does know this one from last summer on turf; she goes on Tapeta with a big drop in value at six furlongs.

R FLEET FOOT a homebred for Iris Bristow, is by the popular, Arch Hall, and will try six furlongs at first asking here for Gerald Seymour; she has worked at a half mile on a regular basis getting ready.

MEGALIN CANDY had good turn speed last time in a race at five furlongs but she wilted against a well regarded first time starter and was finally third; two starts ago at this distance, she ran well in second with Pasture Curfew behind her in third.

LAILAS PRINCESS caused significant interference leaving the gate in a turf race last time when she broke outward and crowded runners; she was finally beaten only six lengths in an ok effort; she moves to Tapeta with a drop for \$12,500.

PASTURE CURFEW came three wide from the second flight making a move last time and was finally third; that was an improvement over her opener when she was one spot behind the runner up, Megalin Candy.

YOU'RE MY DESTINY attracted a claim at Tampa March 17th and for new interests, was a distant fourth here last time at a route; she turns back to a sprint.

BLOSSOM D'ORANGE comes to this locale for Team Valor International after competing in South America where she was a stakes winner; she has been moved to the stable of Mark Casse and has been here for an extended time; she worked from the gate May 26th in 59.4bg; Husbands who has been aboard in the morning, gets the call in this North American bow at six and a half furlongs on turf.

CHIRINGUITA had a booming outside rally to win on the turf at Gulfstream December 31st and came right back February 4th with a similar type of race where she hung; she had a letdown in her latest at Keeneland but was in against a key winner, Antonoe, who recently won the Grade 1 Just A Game Stakes at Belmont for Chad Brown; she now gets in against more her own kind and shortens in distance.

SPARKLES' GIRL has tried the turf in the past with fringe efforts; she was in the Ballade Stakes last time where she finished a half length behind the third place finisher, Code Warrior, who came back to win the Hendrie; she worked recently in 1.01 and now goes to the turf.

RESERVED a winner in Tampa in January, came home April 30th but lost in double digits against a key winner on Tapeta; she now goes to turf seeking her third win on the lawn.

VEAISHA encountered a slow pace in her June 4th seasonal bow and her off the pace experiment did not work; she finally finished seventh at low odds in the same race where Bella Figura was better in fifth; she now moves to turf for the second time and did have a runner up finish on the grass last September.

STREET CASH handled the turf very well for a first allowance win at this distance last November when she rushed from off the pace; she had positive recent prepping June 3rd in 1.00.4 for Dan Vella.

BELLA FIGURA won her previous two events with deep stretch rushes and this turf course is ideal for that style; most recently, she encountered some difficulty at the head of the lane and the rider claimed foul against the winner but that was not upheld; she did have a good late gain in that race.; Emile Ramsammy rides.

SALTY BREEZE departed consecutive out of the money finishes on turf to go to Tapeta last time for the second time in her life; she ran a good race but she had every chance to win it, yet, settled for second; she now goes to turf and two starts ago on the turf at Keeneland, she was beaten ten lengths by, Antonoe, a recent Grade 1 winner.

CALL ME WALLY was getting his second start of the meet May 27th and fell out of contention early then closed four wide with every chance to win it but was third while Salsa Bay was second; he worked quickly June 10th in 59.3 on the training track.

IRON SHORE changed his running style to begin this year and it paid off with a late running win; for new connections following a claim last time, he used the same patient approach and won again; he is up in value here.

WORBOTHOR came here last November and had a wake up run when a rousing second with a rally and both the third and fourth place finishers came out of that race to win; he started this year at Finger Lakes with just a five furlong run as a bridge race to get ready for this at seven furlongs.

FLOWMOTION was a promising juvenile on the local scene last year; he had one start in Florida over the winter and ran fourth against his stable mate on that occasion; he has taken more time to try and round into shape and indicates consecutive works in 59.4 for Mark Casse.

LUNAR LIGHT was arguably the best runner in his seasonal bow when he dropped down to take a big edge for just \$10,000 but he lacked some room and missed narrowly; he attracted a claim and now goes for Bruno Schickedanz with a jump in value for Norm McKnight.

IMPERATORE was getting his second run of the season and he was second in a pacesetter event behind a winner who came back to score for \$50,000 on turf last weekend; the late pace was good and he rallied nicely for the runner up portion; he put up a fast recent work on the training track in 47.3.

SALSA BAY was getting his third run off the meet May 27th and attended the pace and made his move to the lead but was passed late by an import runner; with Abraham Katryan now returned, he takes over the training.

FORTIS had a May 21st seasonal bow but couldn't generate enough stretch power; on his best day, he can close quickly.

EXECUTIVE SIGHT had a May 20th seasonal bow, his first start in fifty weeks; he did well to supply the speed but he was caught by a debut runner and finished second at 13-1; Hernandez moves in here for Darwin Banach and they represent a positive jockey/trainer combo.

D'S BEN a homebred, will debut for trainer Santino DiPaola, at six and a half furlongs on turf and does have some grass breeding; he worked on the turf June 11th in 1.02.1 getting ready; he scratched from a race May 26th.

POMMELIN a debut runner is a homebred by Marchfield, who won the Breeders' Stakes on turf; he goes for Judith Pottins and worked recently on the grass.

SEATTLE AFFAIR was close up on turf last October and ran similarly well on Tapeta in his finale; he now goes for Don MacRae in this seasonal bow for Chiefswood Stable and moves back to the grass.

ROCKBARTON a debut runner for Saul McHugh, is by Saffir, who does bring a hint of turf influence; he worked June 10th from the gate in 36.3bg getting ready and has attracted Lermyte.

DANCE FOR PAPA a homebred for Spirit Winds Stable goes for Dan O'Callaghan and had Bahen aboard June 3rd for a gate work in 1.02bg; he has since worked on turf getting ready; his dam loved the grass.

SHAKING THE STAGE is getting his third run of the campaign and looking for his initial share; he has tried sprinting and routing on Tapeta and will now experiment with the lawn with blinkers added.

HOLTZ wasn't a threat last time but he was running on with a reaching stride that should work well on turf; he now goes to the lawn with a stretch out for Renee Kierans.

PERLARANA ran well as expected in his seasonal bow and took support; he lengthens from five furlongs to go six and a half panels on the turf; he worked ok on the turf recently in 48.1.

THESPIS a four year old by Strut The Stage, is a homebred for Esmonde Clarke debuting for Nick Nosowenko; he is by Strut The Stage and worked on turf June 3rd in 1.02.1; Campbell will ride in this launch.

RED CHILL is getting his seasonal bow and will be going to the turf and his sire like the lawn and his dam did also and produced the grass winner, Abby Grace; he tries six and a half furlongs on turf in this return.

SINGANDCRYINDUBAI an auction purchase, debuts for Norm McKnight on turf and is by Victor's Cry who liked the lawn; he has been here for a series of work at five furlongs getting ready and has attracted Da Silva but needs a scratch to draw in.

LEONARD'S BAY will need a couple of scratches to draw into the starting line up; on turf last time, he faded at a longer distance but should appreciate the cutback; he worked recently in 58.4.

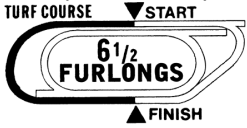

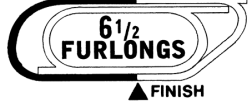
