**FROSTY VIXEN** had a peak performance to start this year on Tapeta when a solid second; most recently, she was done with a furlong remaining when facing Gwendoline H; she moves over to turf for the first time.

**SILVER SIDNEY** won on turf in her second start of the meeting May 20<sup>th</sup>; she had a three wide stalking position and pulled away in the stretch; she looks to build on that strong performance.

**WILD N CLEVER** is a noted speed runner who was hounded by the winner last time and she gradually yielded in the stretch and finished third; she handles turf ok and is strictly the one to catch.

**PRIMORDIA** typically prefers a longer distance but is a four time winner on turf and was on the edges after a wasted speed approach last outing; the shorter distance will allow her to run from off the pace.

**EXTREMIST** had no position of prominence last time in a Tapeta race and now switches to turf where she is a three time winner.

**PULLED THE GOALIE** was planted inside last time and followed traffic until late when room was available and she had some life at that stage to be a tight third beaten only a long length; she will be looking for a more prosperous journey here.

**GWENDOLINE H** has won with such authority in both races this season while effortlessly moving up in value; she had a strong run last time when reserved on the lead and she was once again clear at the end; she gets her second ever run on turf and in her new found form, is looking to continue her streak.

**ONE POUND STERLING** had a May 27<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow for \$25,000 and committed to a speed style over a surface more helpful to closing types and he gave up the lead late and finished a tight fourth; he draws the rail here for half the price.

**JOVIAL JESS** was in a two horse speed race last time and lost out to the winner who dominated the middle and late pace; he comes right back at the same price range and distance.

**TINKER RING** a debut runner for Lisa Burry, is by Where's The Ring and will try a six furlong event here for \$12,500; he has had lots of preps this spring getting ready and Zenteno will have the mount.

**LEGAL DISPUTE** debuted April 30<sup>th</sup> and was pinched early then got going again to reach near contention only to hang; she comes off the shelf.

**COURT APPOINTED** returned from considerable time away May 26<sup>th</sup> and was put into a very difficult situation where early speed was obvious but he finally beat only one runner; for this second start following the layoff, he plunges looking to use his speed more effectively.

**BRADY O'BRADY** debuted last December and didn't threaten for twice the price and was long odds against a key winner on that occasion; he indicates a couple of recent half mile works getting ready.

**KISS UP** attracted a claim over a year ago and made one subsequent start and disappointed; for this first run since last July, he comes in at the same price he was purchased for and competes for one of the hottest stables and Husbands has been secured for the mount.

**MIDNIGHT BREW** is a runner of considerable size who when she gets rolling, she can be quite effective and that was the case in her seasonal bow here for \$20,000 against non winners of two on Tapeta; most recently, she was pinched back early but went to the outside and stayed on well to be second against a strong winner; she now goes to turf, a footing she tried here last autumn without much success; she should enjoy the mile distance.

**EURO PRINCESS** was used along the inside then had little left for the stretch drive May 31<sup>st</sup> against easier on Tapeta.

**LILIES AND ROSES** was able to win a route on turf at Tampa back in March with a late rally in an event where closers dominated; her very next race against non winners of three resulted in a seventh place finish; she sees this turf for the first time and is looking for her third lifetime win on the lawn; she has been switched to the stable of Cole Bennett and has been here for prepping.

**MAY PEN** kept trying last time when in at a low level and she was finally second best against the heavy favourite; she had a big race on turf at Fort Erie last October.

**KATE'S WHISTLE** was on turf June 2<sup>nd</sup> in her seasonal bow in a tougher spot than this and finished about eight lengths back when Dublin Diva was better in third and she meets that one; for this second start, she does take a drop.

**SIERRA ANGEL** showed life on the outside last time in her return and was on the edges for \$9,500; she is up in value here.

**CAPE MIST** returned home from Gulfstream in May in a protected first allowance event at long odds and finished out of the money; most recently when seeking her third lifetime win, she tried a mile on turf and at long odds, finished about six lengths back when Dublin Diva was better in third; she follows that rival in for \$20,000 here.

**IRIS WILL** was ineffective when she last tried turf in October; this will be her seasonal bow and she has been busy with three works already this month getting set to come off the shelf.

**TRIPLE CHOCOLATE** will be trying turf for the initial time and is by Court Vision, a turf source; she has worked five furlongs on consecutive occasions getting ready to come off the shelf after a wide loss last time to start the season.

**DUBLIN DIVA** was getting her third start of the campaign and she moved over to turf and had a solid offering in third; she had some of these in behind her and now drops for \$20,000 looking to capitalize for Mike Doyle.

**MY CANTATA** has been competing at lower levels but a chance to get onto the turf has driven her to this high level with the blinkers off; she has made three local starts since coming from Tampa and most recently gave up the lead for the second consecutive event.

**WINGAWAY** is getting her third start of the meeting and she is dropping sharply and shortening in distance; she faltered as the favourite last time after a middle move at a mile and now goes just six and a half furlongs for \$20,000 for Roger Atfield.

**OLIVIA'S SMILE** is getting her first start since last September when she was a winner for maiden \$20,000; David Garcia has been named.

**LUNA D'AVRIL** has been running on nicely through the stretch for new interests in consecutive events to get runner up placings; she is still looking for her first win of the year; running on turf will be new for her but her style is certainly suitable for this course.

**TIZWAR** makes her way back to Woodbine after a successful stint at Tampa where she won on turf March 12<sup>th</sup> and then finished a tight third there last time when she moved prematurely; the winner on that occasion was Lilies And Roses who was in race three today.

**BEEZIE** was trying to rate while at an elevated level last time but had to settle for a distant fourth prize when Luna d'Avril was second best; she now goes to turf a footing over which she has competed regularly in her career.

**STRING BIKINI** will be seeing turf for the first time; this will be her first try since last October when she was claimed and she now goes for Richard Morden; she has prepped regularly.

**FLASHINTHEPANTS** had speed in her seasonal bow but weakened late; second time out, she raced from off the pace and had a long gain finishing a distant third at this price; she puts the blinkers on and goes to turf for a suddenly hot stable.

**LOOKIN PERFECT** was getting her first start of the year June 2<sup>nd</sup> and she opted for a turf race that featured trouble at the gate; she managed to get up on the pace and control the issue through the stretch with blinkers on; she lasted in front for her maiden win for \$25,000; she comes right back for \$20,000 against non winners of two.

**BOOTS ARE MADE FOR** was looking for room in her seasonal bow for \$20,000 but once the space was available, she had lost her velocity and faltered; she now goes to turf for the fourth time in her life.

**MY ROSEBUD** has had two races on Tapeta to begin this campaign and has been just on the edges both times; she was in against a key winner last outing; she now shifts over to the turf for Carlos Grant.

**ATHENA'S LEGACY** competed June 11<sup>th</sup> and while he lacked early positioning, he came running late through the stretch to be sixth of fourteen; he now extends around two turns.

**AWESOME JOEY** had his debut May 26<sup>th</sup> and was ridden up inside to challenge and finally finished fourth beaten three lengths; when the runner up was declared a non starter, he gained a position; he came back and worked on turf recently in 1.00.1 for Dan Vella; he stays on Tapeta.

**WILLY'S CASTLE** had a positive enough opener at seven furlongs in April when on the edges against a key winner; second time out, he went to turf in a key race and was out of the money; he now gets back to Tapeta with a drop.

**AFTER PARTY** broke last and raced widest without threatening June 2<sup>nd</sup> when heavily bet; this will be his second start of the meeting and he is hoping to revisit his good route race of last October when he was second.

**GRIN N' BEAR** was three wide from the second flight last time and with lasix added, he stayed on to be fourth in a seven furlong race; he now goes long and has had interim prepping in 1.14.1.

**CATAMOUNT** went from a sprint to a route last time and stayed on willingly to be third against a front runner in the much slower split; Mosqueira takes over in this spot; he rates a look.

**DRUMCLIFF** used a new and ineffective style last time in a race where lasix was added; he became aggressive on the pace to duel with Plead Guilty and understandably faded; a move is made to Wilson; perhaps a more patient trip will emerge here.

**THE DOCTOR** gained inside June 2<sup>nd</sup> in a route and got the runner up prize with an ok performance for Gord Colbourne; he was in the faster split the time before.

**BLUE WAVE** a debut runner by Giant Gizmo, is going here for Denyse McClachrie and will attempt a route at first asking; he has had an extended series of works at five furlongs; Lermyte gets the call.

**PLEAD GUILTY** is one of several speed sources in the race and at a route in her seasonal bow, he was in a fight with Drumcliff and both runners paid the price late and this one slipped back to fourth.

**NUPOGODI** closed belatedly in a six furlong seasonal bow then second time this year at seven furlongs, he advanced to be third and was given second money when the runner up was declared a non starter; the fifth place finisher won recently; he now goes around two turns from the widest post with a chance to have an impact with his late style.

**YES DARLIN** a winner early at the meet, was able to capitalize on his conditioning edge from Florida then; he ran equally well in his next start but was beaten late in third and the runner up, Guy Caballero, came back to win the Plate Trial; most recently, he shortened back to six furlongs and pursued from behind the leaders but couldn't improve his position late; he draws the tricky rail here.

**ROCK N' CANDY** was beaten late by Bet On Mike in a May 12<sup>th</sup> opener; second time out for new interests, he was more thorough sitting off the early speed of a debut runner and then taking over for a score at even money for new interests; there is plenty of high velocity in this race and his trip may well decide his result.

**NAPAYSHNI** surprised most when he resurfaced as a gelding May 13<sup>th</sup> to win at seven furlongs; most recently, he engaged in a futile pace battle with, Tough Equation, and lost by twenty seven lengths; he gets back to a shorter distance with a switch to Contreras.

**TOUGH EQUATION** had speed pressure on his agenda last time when his late running stable mate was favoured; he was used up in a battle with Napayshni and finished seventeen lengths back; he is on his own today and Husbands rides at the shorter distance.

**BET ON MIKE** added lasix and blinkers for Roger Attfield second time at the meet and made a rider switch to Campbell and managed to reverse form; he beat Rock N' Candy through the stretch; he was scheduled to compete June 11<sup>th</sup> but scratched; he has had an interim work in 48 for Roger Attfield.

**FIRST GOAL** is rapid in the early going and was fully committed to a speed fight last time which he won but he couldn't contain the late run of the winner and settled for second; he is one of several high velocity types in the race.

**PANTHER KEY** is getting his first start since last August when he was competitive for \$20,000 against non winners of two; he is facing non winners of three in this return and will go seven furlongs; he has had regular prepping for Sam Di Pasquale.

**WARLORD** is getting his first start since last December when he was a winner for \$9,500 against non winners of two; he has been prepared at Fort Erie by Norman Tomlinson.

**NIIGON ROAD** was doing well through his opening two races on Tapeta to begin this campaign then experimented with turf last time and was fourteenth beaten twenty five and a half lengths and he stopped in the stretch; following that out of the money finish in a failed experiment, he gets back to Tapeta with a plunge for \$19,000 and Hernandez stays aboard; he should be the pacemaker.

**YORK RANGER** was drafting in traffic May 21<sup>st</sup> but the better ones got away from him and he finally finished fourth but less than a length behind the runner up, Lookingforanewhome; he likes the seven furlong distance and should come forward in this third start of the year.

**VIRGA** made a significant advance May 14<sup>th</sup> but then hung; most recently, he was more patient and raced from deeper in the field and then made his run at the top of the stretch to get away; he survived an inquiry and held on to the lead for \$19,000 against non winners of two; he now tries non winners of three and stretches to seven furlongs.

**GIANT STORM** is getting his first run of the year; he was out of the money in a series of races to close out his last campaign; he begins at seven furlongs here.

**LOOKINGFORANEWHOME** is getting his third start of the campaign; in his second start of the meet, he did well to be second against a winner that was just too good; he indicates recent prepping heading to this event for Paul Buttigieg; he seeks a breakthrough win.

**D'S DOUBLE EAGLE** drafted behind runners last time then made a dash inside and finished second for maiden \$8,000; she essentially goes for twice the price here.

**CAUSE A RUCKUS** is getting his first action since the autumn of 2015; he was runner up at that time for \$8,000; he now goes for Jason Marrocco with Slade Callaghan aboard.

**CLEVER SOUL** was favoured on turf last time but finished seventh beaten about five lengths behind a strong front runner; he moves to Tapeta with a drop for \$16,000 and that puts him in a contending role today.

**ALESSIO** clipped the heels of the fourth place finisher in the early going last time and lost all chance; he is starting over here.

**NORTHERN TRACK** trailed last time for \$25,000 when dropped down; he takes another devaluation here.

**HINDIANNA JONES** is obviously one to consider given his sharp devaluation; he cuts back in distance with blinkers on; he was in the faster split last time and was beaten only five lengths and the third place finisher has come back to win.

**PROFESSOR HARTWICK** has had three runs this season and on a couple of occasions, has yielded the advantage; that was the case last time when out of the money at this price.

**SILENT DANCE** was bumped early last time and didn't recover finishing sixth; this will be his second start this month.

**JIMBO FIVE** started up from off the pace and took the long way around in his June 3<sup>rd</sup> seasonal bow and got fourth money; he has since had some interim practice from the gate.

**LOOKWHOSCRYINNOW** was taken back in a May 27<sup>th</sup> opener at six furlongs and then was on his feet late finishing sixth beaten five lengths; he has a chance to improve in this second start; he rates a look.

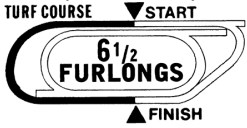
