**ITS A LADY'S WORLD** lacked any prominence in her April 29<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow; like others in here, she is coming down in value; when she did enjoy some prominent finishes late last summer, she had more middle speed and should be more alert today in the opening furlongs.

**AMERITIME** was in a pace battle with two other rivals in her May 20<sup>th</sup> opener and she retreated then stopped; like others in here, she is coming down in value hoping for more production.

**OLIVIA'S SMILE** hasn't started since last September 24<sup>th</sup> when she won for maiden \$20,000 at seven furlongs with a deep closing style under Husbands who rides here for Ricky Griffith; she has been here for a series of works getting ready; she faces older rivals.

**SHERWOOD FORESTER** was in a speed duel last time with Lucky Emerald in a route and backed away then stopped in that event; the blinkers are off for this third start of the year.

**ANGELACREST** is getting her first start since last July when she won for maiden \$7,500 and she utilized an aggressive stalking style then; she indicates a couple of five furlong works in the middle of last month getting ready for John Charalambous who has enjoyed good representation at the meeting.

**LUCKY EMERALD** was in an aggressive pace battle at a route May 13<sup>th</sup> then backed away; she will use the route to sprint angle here for William Tharrenos.

**TUS NUA** was well below her best when she resurfaced following considerable time away May 20<sup>th</sup>; now that she has had a race to bridge that enormous gap, perhaps she can start to go forward.

**MOONLIGHT MALICE** is dropping into a far more acceptable spot in this third start of the campaign except that from time to time, he has experienced trouble getting out of the gate properly; that was the case last time when he was in against a key winner; he devalues; Bridgmohan knows him well.

**TIZ PRIME TIME** was winning nicely from off the pace in routes at Canterbury last year and has been handed over to Kevin Attard for this campaign on Tapeta; this will be his seasonal bow.

**MIGHTY QUINN** woke up second time out last season when going from a sprint to a route but that was later in the season; his seasonal bow April 30<sup>th</sup> at seven furlongs featured some early speed.

**BROADWAY SENSATION** is getting his first start of the year; he has a router's build and did win going long a couple of seasons ago when he last scored.

**FOREVER KRZ** was winter raced in Tampa with a victory going long then came home April 28<sup>th</sup> and was beaten a wide margin by a key winner; he drops into claiming company.

**SHOT FOR SHOT** was getting his second start of the meeting May 17<sup>th</sup> and going from a sprint to a route and it was logical he would be the pacemaker; he gave way gradually in fourth with Hey Big Man in second.

**HEY BIG MAN** has run two good races at the meeting; he stretched to a route last time and used a patient style from off the pace to be second just a length better than Shot For Shot.

**SALVATION SHOW** went long in his seasonal bow and was fifth beaten six lengths when Hey Big Man was second and Shot For Shot was better in fourth; a move is made to Boulanger who had some good rallies with him last year.

**DADDY'S GREAT BAY** has already had a race on turf to begin this campaign and was eighth beaten six and a half lengths at the first allowance level; that was generally a speed race and she was trying an off the pace technique which did not work.

**TANCOOK** was in a reachable spot last time but the winner performed well off the shelf to out rally her and she had to settle for second; she did win on turf for maiden \$50,000 last summer; this will be her second start of the year for Mark Casse.

**MODUS OPERANDI** a one time winner on the grass, has developed strong Tapeta form; she was second in a first allowance route last time when Moonlight Sky was two lengths better in second and she meets up with that one here.

**MOONLIGHT SKY** has never before won on the turf but has often shared on it; she now has a streak of five consecutive runner up finishes going after her local introduction here on Tapeta resulted in a second place finish; Hernandez once again rides for Roger Attfield; she may like this big course.

**KY CAUSEWAY** goes for the hot barn of Kevin Attard; she will be getting her second start of the meet and she moves up in value and goes from Tapeta to turf seeking her first share on the grass.

**PRETTY TO FACED** was at seven furlongs on Tapeta to begin this campaign and closed a big gap far on the outside overcoming slow fractions; she now goes to turf, a footing over which she has shared often.

**PRIMORDIA** likes turf but her last win on grass came at Fort Erie last September; she began this campaign when overmatched against a speed winner in a Tapeta race; she now goes to the lawn.

**PECHE MOBILEE** will compete only if this event comes off the turf and there is rain in the forecast for today; this will be her seasonal bow and she is seeking a breakthrough win.

**TIMBERLINE** would benefit from this race coming off the grass; she beat Ontario sire company in a Tapeta route last time by aggressively stalking the pace and taking over; she is one of two entered for Kevin Attard along with Ky Causeway.

**MILL ROAD** a debut homebred for Anderson Farms and Murette Farrell, will go for Catherine Day-Phillips; he is by Quality Road and from a dam who has already produced two stakes winners including Get Rhythm, who won the Debutante locally; his most significant work came May 27<sup>th</sup> in company with Husbands aboard in 59.1 getting ready.

**AMI'S EXCHANGE** rallied in his opener last October and finished second; in his second start, he opted for a more alert style but had nothing left for the stretch run; he has trained forwardly getting ready for this seasonal bow for Josie Carroll.

**GOLDEN EXCHANGE** debuted May 20<sup>th</sup> and made his move in the middle stages on turf then faltered; he did come back to work May 31<sup>st</sup> in 48.1 getting ready to switch surfaces.

**SILENT JIMMIE** put in some significant training earlier this year and in his second start of the meet, he had a more prominent placing in second at seven furlongs; he will cut back in distance here.

**BEN LOMOND** showed April 30<sup>th</sup> that he is much better running at a target than being the target; he was taken down late after getting the lead in that last race; he subsequently drew post one and scratched and will go here instead in this middle position after an interim work in 1.01.1 where he had good middle speed.

**VAUGHAN** a debut runner for John Mattine, is by City Zip and competes for RCC Racing Stable; under his current moniker, he worked a nice half mile May 26<sup>th</sup> in 48.2b; he had been scratched from an event May 20<sup>th</sup>; back on May 2<sup>nd</sup> he had worked in 1.00; he travels six furlongs in this opener.

**CONQUEST ELIMINATR** has been traded at auction and competes here for a partnership under and is under the care of Martin Drexler; he is a son of Eskendereya; he had Hernandez aboard for a thorough work May 20<sup>th</sup> in 1.02.1 and he was also aboard for a more concentrated speed work May 28<sup>th</sup> at five furlongs.

**ROCK N' CANDY** debuted May 20<sup>th</sup> and was preferred but was beaten in the stretch by a winner adding lasix who ran a peak career race; he attracted a claim and now goes for Norm McKnight and has had a comeback work in 47.1.

**CANMORE** showed little in three starts season but has prepped as if he is an improved runner; Sunny Singh was aboard for a recent gate work in 1.01.1bg and most of his preps this spring have come from the gate.

**GASCONADE** came home to compete April 22<sup>nd</sup> and was an ok third in a speed race at six furlongs; he stretches to a route here with Joshua Navarro aboard once again.

**JUAN STORMY NIGHT** was leading on the outside in a sprint May 19<sup>th</sup> but faltered in a middle claiming event and now goes up in value.

**CHEDINGTON** attracted a claim last November and is getting a belated seasonal bow here for high percentage trainer, Denyse McClachrie; she failed to win in nine starts last season but did take a big drop for her finale when acquired.

**QUEENSTOWN** was able to pass tiring leaders May 17<sup>th</sup> in a peak performance second time out this year for David Borsk; she is a natural route runner who should appreciate stretching out for this third start of the campaign.

**SWEET ESCAPE** had a May 13<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow for \$12,500 and followed the path of the winner and reported in second; she now stretches out for Cole Bennett.

**RINCE TAPAIGH** has been a winner going long here; she began this campaign with a sprint but now stretches around two turns.

**ENCHANTING ALLY** had a troubled trip in her May 5<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow; second time out, she was overmatched at 66-1; now she gets in with her own kind with a chance for a wake up.

**STRUTTIN MY STUFF** did her best running when she altered off the rail to go four wide last time and she moved well for Zeljko Krcmar under Rafael Zenteno; she faces multiple winners here.

**SIERRA ANGEL** has lost by wide margins in both races at the meeting; both the first and fourth place finishers came back from that last race to win; she now stretches out.

**KRZ PRINCESS** was winter raced with success in Tampa and came home May 5<sup>th</sup> to run just seven furlongs for \$10,000 where she was narrowly beaten by Aunt Sue; she now stretches out; she seeks her third win.

**REBEL LIONESSE** trailed the field in a sprint for \$25,000 to begin this campaign at long odds against a key winner; she takes a most dramatic drop in value and stretches out.

**AUNT SUE** took her third lifetime win May 5<sup>th</sup> when she came home from Penn National and dropped down and rallied three wide from the second flight to get there on time against Krz Princess; she now goes against multiple winners.

**NEVER WORN** returns on a tight timeframe after a race last weekend where he won at six furlongs with his newly developed patient off the pace style; he was judged guilty of initiating interference at the break and was disqualified.

**SILKEN THOMAS** was runner up in consecutive events to start this season then was a flat fourth in his most recent start when Never Worn was better in second; he did come back to work a half mile getting ready for this event.

**DETROIT STEEL** went from an ineffective sprint when in a key race to a route last time where he lost by a wide margin; he plunges in value for \$10,000 and puts the blinkers on and cuts back in distance with Singh aboard.

**CANADA WISE DON** made several contributions to the pace last season but at the most crucial time, he was beaten; he ran the same type of race in his seasonal bow when pressing only to finish a distant seventh; blinkers are on.

**LET'S PLAY** is getting his third start of the campaign and will be dropping in value and shortening in distance.

**ASTERISM** competed generally at much higher levels last season and only late in the season did he drop down; he reportedly now goes for Lorne Richards and has attracted Contreras in this seasonal bow at six and a half furlongs.

**SHOT GUN PHIL** visibly stalled in a May 6<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow and landed fourth for \$15,000; he helps himself by dropping for \$9,500 in this second try of the season.

**TRUE FORCE** an auction purchase, will debut here for Mark Casse; he is by Bodemeister, who is very much in the news currently; he will attempt just six and a half furlongs for \$10,000 and has been here for a couple of recent preps.

**LEWNSKYSWILDAFFAIR** attended the pace from a three wide position last time but then faltered out of the money; he shortens by a half furlong.

**DEXTER ROAD** rallied April 30<sup>th</sup> to finish third when Tough Equation was the winner; most recently, he had a quiet early approach in hopes of a late run but finished just on the edges; he now stretches around two turns and used that tactic to win last November.

**TOUGH EQUATION** came here from New Orleans April 30<sup>th</sup> and won at six and a half furlongs while competing for the claiming portion; it was his second win in a row with blinkers added; he now extends around two turns for the second time in his career hoping for better production than a failed route attempt early in the year in New Orleans.

**ESCONDERA** went from an out of the money finish at Keeneland on turf to a Tapeta route here May 7<sup>th</sup>; he was within range and angled out for the stretch run but went flat and was about three and a half lengths behind Gamble's Citizen in the Wando.

**SPIRIT OF CALEDON** had an excuse here November 27<sup>th</sup> and also in his April 8<sup>th</sup> race at Gulfstream, when he came home May 14<sup>th</sup>, he overcame a fanning incident on the first turn to win going away at a route with Husbands who is committed to ride Berger here; Campbell takes over.

**JUROJIN** has had two ineffective runs at the meeting at seven furlongs but will now stretch around two turns and did win going long in the Kingarvie last September.

**BERGER** a Queen's Plate prospect from British Columbia, had a successful debut April 8<sup>th</sup> at Gulfstream at just six furlongs and following a transaction, moved to the stable of Mark Casse; he had some prepping in Kentucky and has worked three times since relocating here; his opening win showed promise and now he looks to go two turns following about eight weeks off.

**WATCH ME STRUT** stumbled badly into a rival leaving the gate May 7<sup>th</sup> and at long odds, he finished sixth beaten ten lengths; he goes around two turns here after a fast interim work in 59.1.

**GAMBLE'S CITIZEN** was winter raced at Gulfstream but had a poor result; when he came home May 7<sup>th</sup>, he went long and was in contention but hung at the most crucial time in the Wando Stakes; he has come back to work well.

**NAPAYSHNI** started the year a gelding and cashed in at 20-1 at seven furlongs; he will stretch around two turns today in this spot.

**CRUMLIN SPIRIT** was getting her second start of the meet and it was a much improved performance when she rallied to be second in the Ballade behind Blurricane who was also closing quickly to win it; she did leave Code Warrior behind her in third; she has had a good rallying work in 1.01.1 for Mike Doyle.

**MINKS APRISE** wins the services of Patrick Husbands for Roger Attfield; he was aboard for the Bessarabian last November when she got mired inside and then started running late to narrowly miss against River Maid; Husbands was aboard for May 21<sup>st</sup> work in 1.01.1 getting ready.

**RATTATAPTAP** came from California and after considerable time away from the game, resurfaced February 16<sup>th</sup> at Tampa and was a winner as the favourite; her second consecutive event on turf came at Aqueduct last time where she was unable to threaten in a race where a rallier caught the speed; she won an earlier start on a synthetic track.

**CHIC THRILL** was building strong form for Sam-San Farm in the spring of 2016 and early into the summer time; she was close by in the Sweet Briar Too then made one final start on grass in an abbreviated campaign and was shelved after that victory; she has had nice prepping for Malcolm Pierce getting ready for this first race in almost a year.

**BLURRICANE** as the winner of the restricted Ballade last time; she was seventh at the top of the stretch but she was first finally with a five wide advance; with Da Silva aboard Chic Thrill, Garcia will step in here; she worked May 28<sup>th</sup> in 49.2 for one of Woodbine's hottest trainers, Martin Drexler.

**CODE WARRIOR** came here from San Francisco to compete effectively in the restricted Ballade where she stalked early from the inside then got off the rail to reach for the lead only to have both Blurricane and Crumlin Spirit get by here; more room is added here; she has had an interim work with a rally.

**RIVER MAID** started this season with a strong rally in the Whimsical to miss by only a length; she had a letdown performance in the restricted Ballade; a switch is made to Boulanger who was aboard for some good results last year for Robert Tiller.

**MISS ELLA** a Grade 2 winner at Keeneland early in her career, has had just a single start this year and it came at Belmont when she was second best at six furlongs on turf behind a longshot front runner; that should be an ideal bridge race to get her to this Tapeta sprint at six and a half furlongs where she seeks her fifth stakes score; she has been prepping at Fair Hill.

**CACTUS COPY** made her way here for Ryan Walsh for a couple of starts last year including a runner up finish in the Ruling Angel; she responded vigorously that day when passed late by the winner; her seasonal bow came February 11<sup>th</sup> at Tampa where she was below her best.

**JENNIFER LYNETTE** had a spontaneous move at the top of the stretch May 14<sup>th</sup> to get away from second allowance types and she was six lengths the best with high energy; she has a high cruising speed in contention and looks to extend her streak to three in a row for Conrad Farms and Mark Casse; Hernandez will take over in this spot; she went solo in a recent work in 48.4.

**HIDDEN TO WIN** won regularly when she last competed during 2015 but she has missed considerable time and is just now making her way back into the game for Mike De Paulo; she has prepped regularly.

**DUCHESS OF DUKE** has two wins and both have come at seven furlongs with plenty of stretch power; this will be her seasonal bow and she now goes for Barbara Minshall; Garcia who knows her well has been aboard in the morning.

**WESTLODGE INTRIGUE** made a move as if she would threaten from the outside last time but she hung in fourth against the tough Jennifer Lynnette while Conquest City Girl was better in second.

**VEAISHA** is a sparkling middle speed performer who won four of seven races last year; Contreras was aboard for all of those victories but is handling Gliding By in this spot and Boulanger rides for Larry Attard in this return; works have been crisp.

**CONQUEST FLEETFEET** had an April 23<sup>rd</sup> seasonal bow and was successful at the first allowance level when setting an easy pace structure; she has kept busy with interim works for Mark Casse.

**CONQUEST CITY GIRL** had some difficulty at the start last time but did some serious running deep in the stretch to be second against her stable mate, Jennifer Lynnette, who was entered in race eight today; she gets a little more room and her late power is to be respected; she can improve.

**SUPER SARAH** is getting her first start of the year and she woke up in her second run of last year for John Mattine; she can contribute to the middle pace.

**GLIDING BY** left turf for the first time in her career to experiment with Tapeta April 30<sup>th</sup> and the result was good; she was second behind a key winner; she has the speed of Veaisa to chase in here and wins the services of Contreras.

**BELLA FIGURA** has had two demonstrative late stretch runs to get wins for high percentage trainer, Alexander Patykewich; she looks to make it three in a row and more room is available with this jump to the next level.

**COPPER FOX** was in the Ballade Stakes at six furlongs last time but gave up positions very late against, Blurrricane, who was in race eight today; speed from the outside should be prominent today.

**PAT DADDY** is a one time winner on turf; he was unplaced against a key winner last time and that one has already come back to win big; he now goes to the grass.

**REBEL MUSIC** is a one time winner on the grass who lost in double digits in his seasonal bow on Tapeta.

**THATLOOKONYERFACE** has been just on the edges in consecutive events and exits a tough event where he hung very late in an improved effort; this will be just his second ever race on the grass for Dave Cotey.

**YOU KNOW JACK** made his bid inside at six furlongs for just \$20,000 on Tapeta last time and was third; he was a fringe player the only time he tried the turf.

**ROCKET PLAN** had a prominent race in the Toronto Cup on turf last summer; his return trip came in a spot where not much was expected but he showed some interest on the outside at the end suggesting improvement is coming.

**TROUBLE IN PHOENIX** finally found room with about a furlong to go last time and rescued a win for \$20,000 when dropped down; he has shared twice on turf in four career appearances on that footing.

**AYE AYE CAPTAIN** has one share in three trips on turf but no recent wins on any surface; he had every chance to win his return race April 29<sup>th</sup> but hung at the most crucial stage; he remains a contender.

**THAT'S A STRETCH** can supply a late rush on turf on his best effort; this will be his second start of the campaign and he now goes to the lawn with his favourite rider, Contreras.

**TERRA XPRESS** lost in double digits May 19<sup>th</sup> in his return and now goes to turf where he was a winner at 62-1 last October.

**LAST CLASS TO GO** was winter raced at Tampa and competed here at nine furlongs on Tapeta recently in a good race when fourth; he seeks his third win on turf.

**NO RISK NO REWARD** scored on turf again last year; this will be his first start of the campaign and he worked recently on the turf with Ryan aboard getting ready to return.

**NIIGON ROAD** perfected his galloping style to win May 14<sup>th</sup> on Tapeta at a route; he takes up another challenge here going to turf for the first time and Hernandez gives him a vote of confidence.

**ARTHUR'S PASS** handles turf just fine but has yet to win on it; his seasonal bow was generous as he finished third against a heavy favourite and he stayed well; Husbands moves in as Wilson is handling Golden Spear.

**GOLDEN SPEAR** handled this turf course well last season and took a victory in September; he was winter raced at Gulfstream on the edges and should enjoy coming home to this big surface.

**TIGER PAW** was winter raced on the turf at Gulfstream and was a fringe player; he may well appreciate the wide open space of this turf course in his local introduction.

**DAMASCUS ROAD** was at too short a distance May 5<sup>th</sup> and his lack of turn speed was costly but he finished second and was claimed; he did run well on turf in New Orleans two starts ago.
