BEL AYR BAY is a career sprinter who will experiment with a route; she is bred to be a stayer and has continued on well in her races while in contention; she exits a speed race where she was second to the 4-5 favourite; she is doubled in value for this event.

I WANT S'MORES had a May 6th return to the races at six furlongs and was involved in some bumping at the start then was finally about six lengths back; she is up in value for a chance to go two turns.

DIAMOND VISION had a May 29th seasonal bow but that proved to be much too difficult a sprint contest for her; she did have a third place finish going long last November for \$20,000 and will stretch out here for \$15,000.

OFELIA GIRL had a May 14th seasonal bow for \$12,500 where she attended the pace but the winner turned out to be too dominant and she reported in second beaten a length; she is up one level for this second start of the meet for David Bell.

ABOGADA a homebred for Frank Huarte, has now had two sprints where she has stayed on relatively well and she looks logical to extend to a route here; Contreras moves in and lasix is added.

SHEZTENTHEHARDWAY was fanned in the second flight approaching the turn May 5th and lost her momentum; she will extend in distance here and did have a runner up finish last September going long in a peak career performance.

SPANISH RIVER is seeking his initial win on turf in this his ninth try on the grass; his seasonal bow May 27th offered some speed but he was fanned wide on the turn and lost his momentum against a key import winner; he gets a quick return with a sharp drop.

ULTRAFLAME showed up with a drop in value and front bandages added for his April 30th seasonal bow which was a fringe try; when he dropped for \$25,000 last time, he broke last then came around runners as if he would win but was finally a tight third at even money; his only trip on turf was a good one in the Bold Ruckus Stakes last year about this time.

MONEY TALKS has yet to win on turf but handles the turf well; he was on grass recently where he made a premature move to the lead then was beaten late by a deep closer; Husbands will take over here; he doubles in price for a chance to get onto the lawn at a sprint which represents a turn back in distance for him.

RED FEVER has very recognizable speed and it was on display in his seasonal bow to win a starter event; second time out, he tried to steal in front but was reeled in late and finished just behind Ultraflame; Speedy Fox uses the same aggressive style; he rates respect.

SPEEDY FOX likes the turf and is fast; he attracted a claim from his seasonal bow from the Norm McKnight stable when on the edges; he was on the edges last time when he committed to the front end; he now gets over to turf seeking his third win on the lawn.

COSMIC CHARLIE was in for just \$7,500 last time and for an opportunity to go to the turf, he jumps in value and does like this footing; lasix is added and Dacosta now rides.

TALE OF RONIN used a new and more patient style for a victory May 19th making his move in the stretch to pass rivals as the favourite; he had given up the lead in his previous event; he now goes to turf for just the second time in his career and is hoping his newfound prominence will continue on the lawn.

DAN THE TIN MAN has yet to win on grass but has been a frequent winner in his career at difficult levels; he won twice late last season; he gets his seasonal bow for Ricky Griffith and Campbell knows him well.

EASY BID debuted May 22nd at seven furlongs on turf and fell out of contention early then showed some interest deep in the stretch; more room is available here.

SEEWILL had a couple of early starts this season and showed promise in her first try of the campaign but wasn't as good second time out; perhaps getting to turf will be the answer and Garcia returns after a one race absence.

LIDDYUP finished third in a May 13th introduction to Woodbine; she is a daughter of English Channel a distinct turf influence and now she gets to go over to the grass with Husbands aboard once again.

BRIGHTER IDEAS moved far on the outside last outing in a Tapeta route when stretched out to be fourth while Boo was better in second and that one is here.

RHOSGOBEL had an excuse in an April 22nd seasonal bow but recovered to be third; she was looking for room last time when seventh; Contreras moves in and she stays on the grass.

COURT ORDER had a May 13th seasonal bow going long on Tapeta and was within range but couldn't improve significantly in the stretch and hung when Boo was much better in second; she now moves to the turf for the first time and her dam won the grass.

READY'S PRINCESS has run well in both races this season and was on the turf last time where she stayed on nicely to finish third and that makes her a contender.

COURT REPORTER had a new off the pace style last time and lost contact with the field early but moved willingly late to be about a length behind Ready's Princess in fourth.

BOO handled herself well when she came home from Florida to compete here May 13th but she was used in the middle stage when the pace was quite hot and she couldn't resist the bid of the winner and gave up the lead late; she handles turf just fine and is a logical one to move back to the grass.

FLASHY'S LEGACY is working with quite a pedigree and getting on turf for the first time should be a help in this seasonal bow; she did show some potential last November on Tapeta.

THATS ONE COOL CAT was bumped at the break in her debut last summer and that race was excusable enough; she came back to the race in September and made a bid but hung; she now goes to turf and her dam loved the lawn.

I GOT SILENT EGO showed some progress in her seasonal bow at six and a half furlongs on Tapeta; she gets to go over to turf now and is a daughter of Silent Name, a grass influence.

REVERSE attracted a claim from the Casse stable and now goes for high percentage trainer Alexander Patykewich; she doubles in price here off her big win May 12th where she zipped away as the favourite; Hernandez now rides.

SASSY OMBRE had Boulanger aboard for a recent work in 48.4 getting ready for this third start of the season in hopes of continuing on better; she has attained good striking position in both races but has lost momentum in the stretch each time.

DEEP BLUE SEA was perfectly handled by Garcia to win two starts ago when edging away in her second start of the campaign; Garcia was on the winner last time and Hernandez moved in to guide this one in second spot; she now competes for the claiming evaluation in this event for non winners of three for Conrad Belaire; she competes for Mort Hardy.

SAN NICOLA STORM lost in double digits May 12th in her seasonal bow which was dominated by a classy winner; for this second start of the campaign, she makes a move to Mosqueira who has had some good recent rides.

GREEN JUSTICE a promising three year old filly, has been full of determination in both races this season and won as the favourite when doubling up last time at seven furlongs; she scales back in distance for this non winners of three event.

BELLA FABIANA attracted a claim from her seasonal bow when second and for new interests last time, she was fourth against a key top pair and she rates a look because of her recent improvement.

CLASSIC TALE has been able to win two of her seven lifetime starts and closed out her abbreviated campaign last year with a win in her second start of the meet; this will be her first try in about fifty weeks and she is currently under the care of Kathy Patton and Husbands has been named; she has prepped regularly.

SUGAR JONES was good when she started her campaigning last year and her opening three races were a highlight; she begins this year with some renewed vigour after a work May 27th in 1.00.4 with Contreras aboard and he rides.

GREEN FREEDOM had a big win last time and Wilson rode her perfectly from just off the pace with a strong winning move on the turn as the favourite; she now tries non winners of three.

GINGER CANDY is getting a first start of the campaign here and she has had a victory in each of her opening two campaigns; Bahen rides from the outside.

BABY LET'S DANCE had a positive debut but faltered in her final two races of last year; she now competes for Marco Mesic and has been getting ready on the training track; she drops sharply for this return.

GET SAUCY took a plunge in value May 12th for her seasonal bow and took support and had some prominence against a front running winner but slipped back to fourth; she attracted a claim by Scott Fairlie and now goes up two price levels.

FROST QUAKE is getting her first race since June of 2016 when she was without momentum with a drop in value; the blinkers are off.

TALLIEVISION debuted June 22nd of last year on turf and was just on the edges and the third place finisher has since done well; for this first try in fifty weeks, she plunges for \$12,500 for Ralph Biamonte and moves to Tapeta at five furlongs.

UNETHICAL had expected speed in her debut May 20th but was overwhelmed when challenged by a preferred winner and she retreated to fourth; she competes for a stable to does well with the drop down angle and she should appreciate the much easier company.

MEGALIN CANDY has early speed but Unethical uses the same quick style; she was beaten out late at six furlongs at this price range last time and now goes shorter.

HALYARD an inexpensive auction purchase, is by In Summation who did very well early in his career; her dam has produced five winners; she competes for Nick Gonzalez in this opener and goes short with just a couple of published works.

INSIDE RING was under some pressure to get good positioning last time then retreated in the lane; the winner has already come back with a good race; she drops in value.

ARCTIC MIA competes for a jockey/trainer combo who scored Friday with Virga; this one can be considered on pedigree alone being from the same dam who produced, Ted W, a solid local competitor; Bahen rides from the outside in this opener.

SKIPPY IS BACK has won at minor sums but has done it with some authority and has benefitted from her winter conditioning in Florida; she now takes on a tougher challenge; she must extend in distance from the rail.

LIGHT MY PATH is getting her first start since January when she was second at Penn National in a first allowance race and she used a deep closing style; she did win here with late power last year for \$10,000 when getting her second and third career wins.

GEOCENTRIC scratched Friday from a race against some tough opponents and will settle in here; she began her campaign for \$25,000 in against a winner who took an enormous edge and she finished only five and a half lengths back; in this second start, she now gets down with her own kind.

EDGEHILL ROAD came off the shelf for \$10,000 May 19th and ran a strong race to be second but was completely overshadowed by the stretch power of Skippy Is Back; she must meet that one again today in this second start of the meet but should be more thorough at the longer distance.

OLD VALYRIA came home from a stay in New York to go into a protected race April 21st and when that event was out of the way, Campbell understandably stayed with her when she dropped into the easier spot for \$15,000; she received a perfect outside stalking ride for her fourth win; she entered recently for \$8,000 but scratched and is right back here for \$15,000 ; Husbands is now aboard.

CAPTURE YOUR HEART ducked to the rail early and lost the rider May 5th; she comes right back at the same price with Contreras now aboard and from the outside post this time.

RANKHASPRILEGES is a welcomed visitor for high percentage trainer, Elliot Sullivan who has had some good representation at the meeting; he was a distant fourth in his latest at Mahoning Valley in a race dominated by the top pair; he worked recently at Fort Erie.

FINAL OFFER was getting his seasonal bow April 28th but he was in such a difficult race in a starter event which was dominated by a winter raced winner; he looks to start all over now by dropping in for just \$10,000 for hot trainer, Marin Drexler.

ANOTHER BID encountered a very good late pace last time in a seven furlong race but after waiting behind rivals, he made a good move in the stretch at seven furlongs; that should be a good bridge to get to this longer race.

MIND MAGIC competed against several of these last time and finished fourth as he angled out and made a gain but Flying Echo was best and Uncorked Spirit was second while Sea Of Silence was third; Da Silva rides in this second start of the meet.

SEA OF SILENCE was getting his second start of the meeting and he had significant improvement with a drop for \$9,500; he was moving mildly on the outside through the stretch in third beaten just two lengths when Uncorked Spirit was in second and Flying Echo was the winner; Mosqueira takes over

PISTON BROKE was well handled by Contreras who stayed inside with him and waited for an opening and then flew away from his opponents when getting his third lifetime win; he will look to keep his record perfect this year as he goes in against multiple winners.

FLYING ECHO received a strong winning ride from Crausaz last time; he moved off the rail and caught up when Uncorked Spirit was stealing away and then guarded the advantage late.

GOLDEN RIDGE should be ready now that he has had a couple of sprints to kick off this season and the stretch out around two turns, serves him well.

UNCORKED SPIRIT like others in here, was dropping out of a starter event for his second start of the year and he woke up and narrowly missed when Flying Echo beat him; most recently, he used a sharp sprint race to get ready for this stretch back to a route.

HEY BEAR picked an outside path when trying to loop runners May 22nd and hung and attracted a claim and now goes to the stable of Alan Bird.

CAPE ZAVATA was off his feet and beaten a wide margin in his latest on turf for \$15,000; he drops and moves to Tapeta at a sprint.

DO THE MATH came home to Woodbine May 12th for Elliot Sullivan and had a strong race finishing in a tie for second for \$11,500 behind a strong closing winner; this stable does well with runners second time following the layoff.

GOOD LOOKING LEO started the year with a thirty seven length loss against Hey Bear; he has been moved back to the McKnight stable for whom he did win last season; he has been trying to build momentum ahead of this second start of the year.

RUNAWAY PEPPER came home from Florida and in all three races, has been a fringe player; he attracted a claim last time and now goes to the stable of Kerry-Mark Sookram and Hernandez will stay aboard.

YER BLUES wakes up occasionally and in his finale last December 2nd, he was in the runner up spot at enormous odds against Cape Zavata; this will be his seasonal bow.

DR. HARKNESS was in a speed duel last time with the runner up and the winner rallied and this one slipped back to third in an ok effort at one price higher.

MATTANGEL is getting his first start of the year and goes for Julia Carey who does well with runners off the shelf; he has good late energy on his best performance.

WICKSTEAD went smartly to beat non winners of three in his previous event and the runner up has since scored; most recently, he closed with a rush but too late for \$6,000 and was second beaten a neck by a winner who has repeated.

SPLASHY GIRL attracted a claim when facing her own gender last time and she was second narrowly beaten; she now goes against the boys for Lorenzo Robinson.

WINSTANLEY was going for new interests off the claim May 12th at seven furlongs and was reaching up to challenge in the stretch when the outside flow closed sharply and he was left with a faltering fourth prize; he drops back to his claimed price
