**TETHRA'S MAGIC** had trained quickly heading into her latest when traveling seven furlongs in the Lady Angela and she was fifth beaten four lengths without having an impact at 34-1; now that she gets back with her own kind in this small field, she has a chance to return to better form.

**SILVER RING** got in against a small group of rivals May 17<sup>th</sup>, yet, couldn't keep pace in mid stretch and then finished third while her stable mate, Red Explosion, was better in second; she has since had a work on the training track for Sid Attard.

**MY RAY OF SUNSHINE** was getting her second start of the year May 17<sup>th</sup> and finished fourth, one spot behind Silver Ring in a race at six furlongs where Red Explosion was the runner up and that one is also here.

**KHAWLAH** had a win for maiden \$40,000 last November and dominated that claiming group; her finale was a double digit loss; this will be her seasonal bow and she tries non winners of two for Steve Attard.

**RED EXPLOSION** can perhaps go forward in this second start of the meet; she ran adequately despite a troubled trip in her May 17<sup>th</sup> return to the races; she finally got room in the stretch when angling outside and she salvaged second money while her mate, Silver Ring, was third; she has had an interim work in 1.01.1 getting ready for Sid Attard and meets just five rivals here.

**CRUMLIN QUEEN** had a likeable seasonal bow but her second start was a disappointment; she stalled on the outside; she has had a quick interim work in 1.01 for Mike Doyle.

**REIMBURSE** is a four time winner on the turf and usually has one or two races between each victory; she won back in December and has had two races since where she has been unable to sustain her positioning; she has a good style for this event which is top heavy with speed types; Boulanger rides for Mark Casse.

**PULLED THE GOALIE** had perfect positioning on Tapeta last time but hung at the most crucial time and finished out of the money; she is a one time winner on the lawn and now shifts to the grass.

**WOVEN LADY** was getting her second run of the season May 21<sup>st</sup> and dropped for \$25,000 and finished third against the front runner, Britannia Penny, while on the tougher footing outside; the last time she tried turf in September of 2016, she was a stalking winner and she gets back to the lawn here with Husbands.

**REAL COAL** likes to go fast in the early going but faded when she tried turf last October and has had a series of sagging trips since then although she has had consecutive in the money finishes to start this year; her speed approach did not work on Tapeta last time; this turf course has been quite kind to speed this year.

**BRITANNIA PENNY** dropped in and took an edge in her seasonal bow and as expected, won at a tiny price; her challenge now is going to the turf, a footing over which she has faltered in the past; she looks to double up for Sid Attard.

**ALLWEHAVEISNOW** got down on the tougher footing inside in a difficult first allowance race last time and faltered out of the money; in third was Real Coal and she is here; she has had time for interim prepping.

**SILENT TREAT** is a stakes winner on this course but hasn't won a race in an extended period; she has developed more of a stalking style which should work nicely against the speed of, Real Coal, and Britannia Penny and she should have a perfect outside trip here.

**BEST OF THE BOBS** has been able to hang around the edges in recent events and was fifth beaten four lengths last time; the winner has already come back to do well and the runner up had a subsequent good event; he should be able to outstay many of these.

**HINT TO WIN** came here from Turfway May 5<sup>th</sup> and went too quickly on the front end then had no resistance in the stretch; the blinkers are off for this second local start.

**TUCKER'S TOWN** had frantic speed on the pace May 17<sup>th</sup> in a five furlong contest but was finally fifth beaten eighth lengths; he helps himself by coming down in value.

**HELISSIO SARASOLA** comes out of turf racing at Laurel where he has been beaten wide margins in recent races; he was here for a turf race last September where he backed away; he competes at a reduced evaluation here on Tapeta.

**MILWAUKEE SAINT** had a May 5<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow and fell out of contention early and did not threaten; the blinkers are now added.

**IM A KEEPER** a homebred for Bruno Schickedanz, will debut here with Husbands aboard at just five furlongs; he did have earlier prepping in Tampa and has had some gate works locally.

**AVE CAESAR** came from Gulfstream to compete April 16<sup>th</sup> and finished an ok third for \$12,500; he was boosted in value last time where he lost in double digits.

**CORRYVRECHAN** joined in a driving duel on the lead with the runner up last time and both runners paid the price and he finally retreated to tenth; changes today including, a big drop in value and the addition of lasix; Hernandez gives him a vote of confidence.

**AWESOME AT LAST** had speed but no resistance last time for \$7,500 when returning after time away; this will be his second race off the shelf.

**ZDENKA** hasn't won in an extended period but does handle the turf ok; this will be her seasonal bow for Robert Gerl and Ryan will ride; she indicates a series of five furlong works getting ready.

**NINETEEN SIXTEEN** made a move to go up inside last time and finished fifth beaten eleven lengths for \$20,000 against non winners of two; she has had interim prepping and now goes to turf for the second time in her career seeking her initial share on that footing.

**SHE'S NO MEENY** has campaigned twice this season and at lower levels with good results; in her latest, she came five wide as if she would win but she finally couldn't get by and that extended her losing streak; she is a one time winner on grass and has two other shares on the turf.

**BREW BY YOU** started the year in a difficult spot and was sixth beaten twelve lengths; with the drop for \$20,000 and the shift to turf, Rainford takes over for Scott Fairlie and she looks better suited here.

**DOUBLE EX'S** was traveling too fast on the pace at a route last time for \$9,500 and faltered; she is a one time winner on the Fort Erie turf and sees this turf for the initial time.

**BABY GIRL BURT** had a May 26<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow with a drop for \$19,000; she had some pre break issues in the gate; a slow pace developed and she rated behind and then finished fifth beaten eight lengths; she has a chance to improve in this second start of the season and now goes to turf for the initial time; the shift to turf is a profitable stable angle.

**MAGIC SKYS** has handled turf well enough in the past; this will be her seasonal bow for a high percentage trainer and she deserves respect in this return which comes with Hernandez aboard.

**VIVA FOREVER** took sharp support for John Cardella last time and did not disappoint with power in the stretch to draw clear for maiden \$15,000; she now goes to turf for the initial time; the shift to turf is a good angle for this stable.

**SOLON'S WARNING** was in a slowly run race on turf last time and backed away after an early pursuit along the inside; that should be a good bridge race to get her to this spot for just \$20,000 where she seeks her second win on the lawn for David Bell

**SUNNY'S RAINBOW** was close up in his seasonal bow in a strong performance; most recently he typically ran well but was third beaten less than a length when he raced outside and behind and Who's Got It was second; he draws the rail here and has had interim prepping for Mike De Paulo; Hernandez rides for the first time.

**WHO'S GOT IT** looked every bit a winner last time in his second start of the meet but couldn't get by a longshot speed winner and he had to settle for second narrowly beaten and was just in front of Sunny's Rainbow; this will be his third start of the year and his form has now hit a peak for Mike De Paulo.

**BUTLER'S PICK** showed some maturity last autumn when he was able to win from off the pace and he used the same style to double up May 21<sup>st</sup> in his seasonal bow when getting his second lifetime score; he now looks to make it three wins in a row.

**DAMASCUS ROAD** came home from New Orleans to compete on Tapeta; his long stride helped him produce a good rally but he was out finished by the winner who has already come back to win again; he attracted a claim and now goes for double the price for Norm McKnight; he has had an opportunity for interim prepping.

**BELIVEAU** gets his first start since last summer when he was beaten off in a Tapeta try for \$40,000; he does have some back class and is fresh again now for Mark Casse; Husbands rides in this seasonal bow.

**LOW IN THE FOREST** raced on the better footing inside in his seasonal bow, yet, lost positions late in the same race where Who's Got It was second and Sunny's Rainbow was third; the blinkers are on; he has had an interim prep for Elizabeth Elder.

**CHIRICAHUA SIGNAL** had a May 14<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow at this distance but was on the tougher footing outside and his late run left him fourth beaten two lengths while Who's Got It was second and Sunny's Rainbow was third; he hopes to move forward in this second run of the meeting and he has an opportunity for a couple of interim works.

**BEAR SKINNED** had a sharp run in his seasonal bow when narrowly beaten; second time out, he stalled on the turn but then had some late interest when beaten about five lengths while Who's Got It was second; Contreras now rides.

**BUTTERFLY STRIKE** lost a duel to the runner up in his finale December 2<sup>nd</sup> and attracted a claim for half this price; he goes for Mark Fournier and gets the widest post after recent preps; the blinkers are on.

**ETHICAL FUNDS** is a durable type who has won all of his races on the grass; he is a galloping type who showed in his second start of the year that he has now come to form and he is hoping for a better trip on this more wide open course after a fringe try against Conquest Boogaloo and Pumpkin Rumble.

**WHERE'S THE WIDGET** disappointed in his May 22<sup>nd</sup> seasonal bow in the Steady Growth Stakes, a race he had won easily last year; in that return, he lost a speed duel to the third place finisher and that set it up for a couple of closers; he now makes a visit to the turf, a footing over which he won the Bunty Lawless last year; Contreras will now take over for Ralph Biamonte.

**BANGKOK** had a resolute win the Valedictory Stakes last December at a mile and three quarters under perfect handling from Wilson who moved him to the outside for the victorious stretch drive; the runner up has already come back to win this spring; he competes for Gail Wood and Dr. Ruth Barbour and goes for Phil Gracey in this seasonal bow which comes at ten furlongs on turf and he is a two time winner on the lawn; Wilson was aboard for a solid work May 22<sup>nd</sup> with a good closing kick in that prep.

**CONQUEST BOOGALOO** needed a start in April and by the middle of May, he was ready to go again and captured a second allowance event on Tapeta beating Pumpkin Rumble; he is seeking his first ever win on turf although he has run well on the grass in the past.

**PUMPKIN RUMBLE** was a newcomer to Woodbine May 17<sup>th</sup> when he finished second in a Tapeta race and he was digging in through the stretch to the outside of Conquest Boogaloo; a switch sees Hernandez take over here for Kevin Attard.

**SECRET PASSAGE** was brought here from Oaklawn Park, no doubt to be part of the turf program for Pin Oak Stable; he is a son of Curlin and from a dam who has already produced eight turf winners, yet, this will be his first try on grass; his arrival here April 29<sup>th</sup> came in a race against, Are You Kidding Me, and he finished at the back; he competes for Malcolm Pierce with Da Silva aboard.

**LONDON TOWER** is looking to revisit some of her best form from 2015; she slumped last season and was below her best in her seasonal bow this time around against difficult opponents including the third place finisher, Kasuga; she has had an opportunity for interim prepping; she now goes from a sprint to a route and has handled this distance well in the past for Steve Owens.

**LUCKBE TANYA** started this campaign April 30<sup>th</sup> in a seven furlong event and is much more comfortable around two turns; she hung against a key winner in that opener but now gets to go long; a shift is made to Hernandez for Mark Casse.

**MEADOW ROSE** looked good here last autumn winning a first allowance race and her initial try of the winter time at Gulfstream was solid; she had a letdown in her most recent try there against a winner who has repeated; perhaps getting back to Tapeta will be the answer; she has been freshened for Nick Gonzalez; competes for Stronach Stables; she is one of two in here by Ghostzapper.

**KASUGA** came home from Gulfstream to use her speed in a seven furlong race here April 30<sup>th</sup> where she ran out of fuel late against a key winner who has come back to score; she also met a key group May 21<sup>st</sup> and gave up the lead very late; she now stretches around two turns where her speed should dominate the pace; she is the one to catch.

**GAMBLE'S GHOST** was good about this time last year with a victory in the Selene and a nose loss in the Oaks; she had an April 23<sup>rd</sup> seasonal bow at Keeneland and with that race out of the way, she has been here for a series of works for Josie Carroll for Ivan Dalos; Contreras takes over around two turns.

**TURN TO REALITY** was a good earner last season with a win and four other shares; this will be her seasonal bow and she goes directly to a route to open this campaign; with her long time partner Olguin now retired, Husbands will take over for Stuart Simon.

**CONQUEST DYNASTY** had a stop off race at Gulfstream in March and then came here April 30<sup>th</sup> but retreated after attending in the middle stages in a race where Kasuga was much better in third.

**GIANT PULPIT** is a runner of considerable size and seven furlongs was a restricted distance for him in his debut but he did finish fifth of eight and now has a chance to run a longer distance on a more wide open turf which should suit his inordinate build.

**CONQUEST SWAGGER** had a May 14<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow at a route and a front runner dominated; he chased the pace but gave up some positions late and Catamount was better in third; he now goes to the turf and is bred for the lawn.

**SONNET BOOM** debuted May 20<sup>th</sup> at six and a half furlongs on turf and from the inside post never did gain a position of prominence; today's longer distance should be helpful; he is certainly bred for the grass.

**GIZMO JONES** goes for Robert Tiller who has already enjoyed success on turf at the meeting; this one had a May 14<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow where he moved to the lead at the top of the stretch then tired late; the third place finisher has come back to win; he now makes a move to the grass and is from the same dam who produced, Mr. Online, a nine time winner on the grass.

**THE OTHER BREEZE** a debut runner for Hopefield Farm, is by Malibu Moon and from a dam who was a five time winner on grass; he is working with stamina prospects; he travels a route at first asking and on the turf for Sandy McPherson

**LASER FOCUS** got onto the turf in June of 2016 and finished just on the edges in what was an improved race; he makes his way back after about forty nine weeks away and now competes for the claiming portion; he travels a route on turf for Chiefswood Stable.

**LAST WAN** is certainly bred for the turf; he had an April 30<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow sprinting on Tapeta when beaten about six lengths by a winner who has repeated; he now gets over to the grass.

**OCEANOGRAPHIC** debuted on turf but the speed of the winner was too much and he finished eighth beaten ten lengths while Sonnet Boom was in behind him; he is certainly bred for grass and should appreciate the longer distance; he has had an interim work on the grass.

**GREENFIELD** handles turf just fine with five runner up finishes to date; his seasonal bow May 14<sup>th</sup> came against a dominant speed winner on Tapeta and he chased in the middle stages until he grew weary; he should be tighter for that experience and now goes to the lawn after interim prepping.

**CATAMOUNT** will compete only if this event is run on Tapeta and he has had two starts on that footing at the meeting with fringe tries both times; he did finish in front of Greenfield last time.
