**DISCREET DAN** is one of two newcomers in the race and is a homebred for Joseph Baldesarra and also competes for Dennis Baldesarra; he is from a dam who was a route winner and she has produced four winners; he will travel just six and a half furlongs here from the rail post for Mike De Paulo and has posted a series of fast works.

**AMI'S EXCHANGE** debuted October 29<sup>th</sup> in a race that was belatedly taken off the turf; at seven furlongs on Tapeta, he got in behind rivals and then raced greenly and when he had a chance to win it in the stretch, he laid in which compromised his chances; he must be more thorough in this second start.

**SPRING EDITION** raced well in his previous event on turf to get second money; most recently, he went to Tapeta at seven furlongs where he set the pace and then finished third; the winner went on to be second in the Coronation Futurity; he came back to work quickly November 12<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.1 for Beverley Chubb.

**MO GEE** was understandably made the favourite October 30<sup>th</sup> when he debuted but his preferred stable mate won it easily by ten lengths; he reported in second after breaking poorly and moving far on the outside; he should perk up second time out for Mark Casse.

**COLTON'S CORNER** competed last time in a race that belatedly came off turf and he set the pace then drifted out at the top of the stretch with the lead and eventually hung.

**STREET LEGAL** had a good speed race at six furlongs two starts ago when third; most recently, he pressed the pace but faltered; he goes farther here; he had a recent fast work on the training track in 47.1 for Gail Cox.

**WE CAN DANCE** is one of two debut runners in the race and competes for Nick Gonzalez from the widest post; he was an auction purchase by Divine Park from an unraced mare; his big work came October 25<sup>th</sup> in 1.00b getting ready; Campbell has the mount.

**OFFICE IN THE SKY** has the best most recent race to her credit with a runner up finish October 30<sup>th</sup> when dropped down to compete for maiden \$20,000; she fought the elements with an off the pace run and missed narrowly while Frugal Franny was fifth; she goes a furlong farther.

**SYDNEY'S SPIRIT** is getting her first start since 2014 and she did have some prominence during that brief campaign; she has had a series of works getting ready for her current conditioner Lisa Burry and drops in for \$23,500 with blinkers on.

**DIVA ON A DIME** had a mishap on the turn November 2<sup>nd</sup> when coming off the shelf; it appeared her rider lost a stirrup at that point; she drops in for \$25,000 with Johnson aboard once again.

**FRUGAL FRANNY** had a peak race two starts ago when she showed speed at six and a half furlongs only to be displaced late by a preferred winner who was debuting and the third place finisher came back to score; most recently, she came off the shelf and opted to cut all the way back to five furlongs where she lacked any speed at all in a change of style, yet, she rallied belatedly but not as well as Office In The Sky who was second in that race; getting back to six furlongs, may present her with an opportunity to be more closely positioned to the pace.

**SWEET RETREAT** a debut runner for owner/trainer Nick Nosowenko, is by Limehouse and from a Langfuhr mare and will attempt six furlongs at first asking; she has used the gate regularly getting ready and Moreno will ride in this launch.

**FLEEK** a homebred for Jus Luk Stables, is a daughter of Langfuhr and from a dam who was a two time sprint winner whose current juvenile, Hopping Not Hoping, has already won twice including the Shady Well Stakes; she will debut here as a three year old at six furlongs from the widest post; her main works have come on the training track while her gate works have come on Tapeta for Reade Baker.

**UNCLAIMED TREASURE** steadied to the inside of Diva On A Dime when that one had an issue midway of the turn last time then tried to get going again but couldn't regain her momentum; the outside may provide her with a better trip.

**ENCHANTED** attracted a claim when dropped down for \$20,000 last time and she finished fourth after a premature move; the winner came back to capture an allowance race and the third place finisher came back to win big for \$16,000; she nestles in this optional claiming event from the rail going long for Kevin Attard.

**NIIGON'S BAY** debuted on turf and closed belatedly; second time out, she stepped up to face maiden special company where she made a strong but premature move and then hung in the stretch when the winner dominated; she looks to go forward in this third career start.

**RAINBOWS AHEAD** had a useful performance two starts ago on a giving turf course where she slipped back late; most recently on a yielding turf, she again faded; the seventh place finisher has come back to win; she now goes to Tapeta at a route.

**SUMMER MAGIC** lacked room at the quarter pole last time and was delayed; a switch is made to Wilson with this stretch around two turns.

**DATING SOPHIE** competed last time in a race that totally belonged to the winner; she was behind in double digits; she goes from a sprint to a route.

**GYPSY JAZZ** was in this category in her previous two events with positive fringe results; she went up into a maiden special event last time and was only sixth while Niigon's Bay was fourth.

**STATE JEWEL** has had many chances and when she has dropped in for a claiming evaluation in the past, her production has improved; she was third last time in a turf event and now goes to Tapeta around two turns.

**TRAJECLY HIPP** raced well in this category last time at nine furlongs; she advanced outside to finish in third spot and the runner up has already come back with a good race.

**MORE THAN BANDEAU** dropped in for \$6,250 October 26<sup>th</sup> when coming off the shelf and ran well with a deep rally at this distance to be third but Leading Wild had a better stretch presence to win it and is here.

**EXTREMIST** was used up in a pace duel two starts ago with the third place finisher Just Coz; most recently, she used a more patient off the pace approach and late money showed for her and she won it at the last moment with an outside rally; she now shortens to seven furlongs.

**SWEET BREW** departed an out of the money finish on turf and went to Tapeta with a big drop last time to face some of these but that was a quickly run race and she was only eighth beaten seven lengths; did have some of these in front of her; she was able to produce about this time last year.

**DUFFINS** was ridden up into contention last time but couldn't improve her position at the most vital time when facing a key winner who dominated.

**CHIA LOVE** departed an out of the money finish on turf to go to Tapeta for \$12,500 last time; it was a quickly run race and she was beaten only three lengths in a good effort; the runner up has come back to win for \$8,000 and now she drops for \$10,000.

**BEAR'S PRIDE** is the big question mark in the race; she missed time from August through October and when she returned, she disappointed on turf for \$37,500; she now drops sharply for \$10,000 with the move to Tapeta; she did win on Tapeta just about this time last year with a drop when departing an out of the money finish on the grass.

**MISS VICTORIA** a frequent winner in the past, has endured a more lean campaign with just a single victory; she faced several of these last time and was beaten only four and a half lengths with an outside move; she rates a look.

**LEADING WILD** had a two race winning streak at seven furlongs; she attracted a claim October 26<sup>th</sup> and elected to run only five furlongs last time and ran out of ground despite a superb late try; she stretches out a quarter mile for this event.

**BIG BROWN BROOKSKI** was out of the money on turf two starts ago then plunged in value and moved to Tapeta for a wake up performance last time but was third beaten a couple of lengths in that hotly contested event in excellent time; she came four wide with every chance to win it but had to settle for third; the runner up has come back to win; she fits.

**MADDISONS PASSION** has lost in double digits in recent races here; he was reserved back early last time when changing his running style with blinkers off; the blinkers go back on here; the fourth place finisher has come back to win.

**GENTLEMAN JACKSON** had a nice eighteen point increase in production November 6<sup>th</sup> when dropping down and winning for \$6,000 with superior velocity; he flew away from the other speed and Move Over was too late; there is more room available here; True Executive is a potential pace source.

**NOTALONEINHISHEAD** is a two time winner facing multiple winners in this spot but is only one of two in the race for John LeBlanc Jr. along with the more likely Phil's Cocktail.

**RUNAWAY PEPPER** had an eighteen point increase in performance September 28<sup>th</sup> when clear at the end for \$6,250 and he attracted a claim by Pat Parente; a comeback race for \$8,000 last time, saw him close on the outside of a key speed winner and he wasn't far out of second spot; mired in behind him in seventh that day was Gentleman Jackson and both the sixth and third place finishers also came back to win.

**MOVE OVER** was introduced here October 12<sup>th</sup> and chased the pace and faltered; a new approach was used last time from off the pace and he was driving on the turn trying to improve his position when Gentleman Jackson was already gone; he did well to finish second; he has something to offer here and rates attention.

**TRUE EXECUTIVE** returned from considerable time away November 4<sup>th</sup> and revisited an old habit of racing wide and he was ineffective in that key race; he has made enough good adjustments in the past that have made him a wake up prospect.

**PRETTY MASTER** chased the pace of Gentleman Jackson last time then grew weary in sixth.

**IRUSAN** was running from off the pace last time and closed belatedly in sixth beaten five lengths in an ok try; he is winless for the campaign.

**PHIL'S COCKTAIL** had a zesty performance two starts ago when chasing Hemlock Channel; he went right back after that key rival last time and slipped back in fifth beaten just two and a half lengths; he now plunges in value to go for half the price of his latest with a chance to have an impact.

**MACHITO** is certainly worth considering; he had consecutive tough events against the difficult Hemlock Channel and then faced another key runner last time when Courtville beat him back into fourth; he runs for half the price of that event in hopes of his second win of the campaign here; he can be competitive.

**WINSTANLEY** opted for a speed duel with Gentleman Jackson last time and he retreated to be fifth at the end when Move Over was also better in second.

**KAYEZ** was at Fort Erie last time for \$5,000 against non winners of two when a distant third.

**YER BLUES** backed away two and a half furlongs from home last time when Gentleman Jackson was widening and Move Over was second.

**UNIKAT** had his two race winning streak on turf snapped when he moved to a first allowance race last time at a mile; he was returning from a freshening; he was one paced through the stretch; this will be his second race following the layoff.

**ROYAL INTRIGUE** was in the Bunty Lawless Stakes on turf last time and was eighth beaten six lengths and the fifth place finisher, Ethical Funds, has come back to win; he did win big on Tapeta two starts ago when getting his third lifetime win and he handled this distance quite well.

**TERRA XPRESS** dropped in to win for maiden \$20,000 two starts ago and his performance was better than most expected; when he went to turf last time, he doubled up in an unexpectedly good performance at 62-1 for Sandra Dominguez; he dominated the pace in that first allowance upset.

**PRIMORDIA** a six year old mare, succeeded earlier this year on the turf at Fort Erie; she tried the River Memories here at a mile last time and was only six and a half lengths back.

**MOZART MELODY** was waiting for room last time then found a space and moved inside to end in a tie for third when Terra Xpress was the winner on turf; he had won big on turf the time before for a maiden score.

**CHIEFROLL'NTHUNDER** is a two time winner this season and finished second last time against a late running longshot who beat him at the last moment; Campbell is off to handle Big Yum and Wilson will take over here.

**CLEOPATRA'S STRIKE** is just a one time winner but that was a demonstrative score two outings ago and he came right back with a good race when second narrowly beaten last time; he moved to the outside of Cito to get the lead but the winner passed him from the outside at the last moment.

**ARTISTICO** came off the shelf October 29<sup>th</sup> and finished on the edges without threatening in an Ontario sire turf event and now goes into open company.

**BIG YUM** an import here October 28<sup>th</sup> was able to catch up with the faltering speed of the eighth place finisher and that one has already come back to win; he was finally six lengths clear at the end and clearly enjoyed the giving nature of the turf course here in that local introduction; he is very hopeful the race will stay on turf but deteriorating weather is expected.

**CITO** is one of several in here hoping the race comes off the grass and will compete only if this event is run on Tapeta; he has had four consecutive good races including a third place finish last time when beaten less than a length and he was just in behind the difficult Cleopatra's Strike.

**BROADWAY SENSATION** has lost by wide margins in recent events at lowers levels than today's event; the blinkers are off.

**GRAY PHANTOM** was out of the money on turf September 30<sup>th</sup> but dropped down and was in the winner's circle on Tapeta last time and took sharp support; he moved from last on the turn to be clear at the end with a significant outside gain; he remains at the same price on Tapeta looking to take his third lifetime score; Boulanger rides Rhythm Blues.

**TIMBERLINE** had a big win for \$19,000 two starts ago and was claimed at the same price range last time when she slipped back to third; she enters against the boys here with blinkers on for new trainer Kevin Attard.

**GIANT STORM** had an ok late move last time when dropped in for \$20,000 while shortening to seven furlongs; he was finally sixth beaten seven lengths by a key winner who was dropping down; he now goes from a sprint to nine furlongs.

**RHYTHM BLUES** had a series of good route races heading to a turf race last time where he got in against a key winner, Big Yum, who was entered in race six; he closed a big gap from twelfth to be third; the eighth place finisher from that race, Impetuous Act, has since dropped for \$19,000 and he is using that same technique, shifting away from turf and going to Tapeta for exactly \$19,000.

**MISS TIAGO** a four year old filly, had a bold run from the furlong marker home last time to be six lengths the best with Husbands aboard for \$10,000 against non winners of two; she faces the boys here against non winners of three.

**SLEEK IDEA** is a two time route winner this season and was only six lengths behind in an Ontario sire race on grass last time which was taken by Terra Xpress who was entered in the previous race today; he now finds an intermediate level for \$20,000 on Tapeta.

**DR. PHILAN** was running on nicely last time for \$10,000 and galloped out strongly suggesting he likes the nine furlong distance; he attracted a claim and now doubles in value.

**CROWN PRINCE** is worth considering following his out of the money finish on turf last time and his plunge here to go to Tapeta; the eighth place finisher from that race, has already come back to win for \$19,000 on Tapeta.

**AUTUMN SONG** was introduced here from Edmonton November 5<sup>th</sup> at just six furlongs and had outside speed against a hot pace and finished sixth beaten only three lengths; he now goes from a sprint to a route and drops for \$20,000; with Boulanger aboard Rhythm Blues, Contreras takes over here.

**PUNTROOSKIE** had a peak performance when winning the Bold Venture Stakes back in the summer time; he battled to the outside and he was roused in the stretch to beat a very difficult runner up who came out of that race to have a big win in the \$300,000 Gallant Bob at Parx; most recently in the Ontario Jockey Club Stakes, he had an inside position against Stacked Deck who was better to his outside; the fourth place finisher from that race, Calgary Cat, has since been first in the Nearctic and fourth at the Breeders' Cup in the Turf Sprint; he competes for Michael Lay, Mike Loughry and D-Mac Racing Stable.

**PINK LLOYD** was in a restricted stake last time at seven furlongs and may well have been best but had to settle for fifth beaten two and a half lengths after lacking room at a crucial stage; Husbands has been enlisted for Entourage Stable.

**COMMUTE** competes for Gabe Grossberg and Sagamore Farm; he had a smart win two starts ago overcoming a slow departure from the gate to rally best at this distance; most recently, he went to turf for the Labeeb Stakes where he was aggressive in the middle stages but the better ones got away from him late; he moves back to Tapeta at six furlongs.

**STACKED DECK** won this race last year at the expense of Passion For Action; he has had two different blocks of races this season with just a single win and that came in the Ontario Jockey Club Stakes at the expense of Puntrooskie; Calgary Cat was behind him on that day but then came back to beat him in the Nearctic; he hopped at the start in that event then took over the pace but was beaten at the last instant and the winner has since gone to the Breeders Cup to be fourth in the Turf Sprint; he applied himself nicely in a November 13<sup>th</sup> work with a rally in 59.3; he is a homebred for Bruce Lunsford.

**JACKS ESCARPMENT** won the Kenora back in August and was tight behind Commute in his next start; seven furlongs proved too demanding in the recent Overskate when he slipped back against Touch Of Disney; he had a nimble work November 10<sup>th</sup> in 49.2; he competes for John K. Caulfield.

**PASSION FOR ACTION** has had a wonderful season for owner/breeder Ben Hutzler with three stakes scores; his form slipped in the Woodbine Mile and he was only on the edges at best in the Nearctic; he worked with Contreras aboard November 13<sup>th</sup> going smartly in 1.00.4.

**COLLEEN'S SAILOR** was subjected to a very difficult pace ordeal two starts ago and understandably fatigued; most recently, he had to compete in the exact same early pace time and again weakened at the most inopportune juncture and finished third behind Commute; Moran was aboard for a recent good work in 48.2 for Solo Racing Ltd.

**BOREAL SPIRIT** competes for ShayD Lane Farm; he was in the Overskate last time where he had a clear lead of a length and a half but he faltered late against the winner, Touch Of Disney, and now goes shorter.

**TOUCH OF DISNEY** a homebred for Bruno Schickedanz, was successful in the restricted Overskate last time at seven furlongs; he was last midway of the far turn and went outside and rallied best in spectacular fashion; he will cut back to six furlongs here.

**COCA INN** was a surprise October 10<sup>th</sup> when returning from a layoff; she beat Ontario sire runners at this distance by streaking to the lead and she was home easily in 57.3; she will try and repeat that performance in open company.

**GEOCENTRIC** dropped in for \$12,500 last time in a seven furlong event but her chances were compromised when an aggressive runner up took the advantage away from her, yet, she came back and secured the lead late; she attracted a claim and now goes for Ross Armata at only five furlongs. **SPLENDID GLORY** was intent on being in front early last time but the early pace was too scorching and the fourth place finisher who set the early pace was exhausted late; she also slipped out of the money after that early chase.

**DAWNMINO** gets a chance to go just five furlongs here and that might prove ideal for her; she has indicated some hanging tendencies at the longer distances and is looking for a breakthrough win; seven furlongs was beyond her preferred distance last time and she hung at a crucial time; Contreras once again has the mount.

**UNSEEN ANGELS** was unlucky last time and finished third beaten a half length; she will shorten all the way to five furlongs and did win at this distance much earlier in the year with good speed; she is showing a more mature style now for Norm McKnight.

**SHE'S A RINGER** drafted behind runners last time with hopes of a stretch gain but was finally fifth of ten; she departs an out of the money finish on turf to go to Tapeta at five furlongs.

**LETTER FLY** is a noted speed runner who narrowly missed at this distance in an open allowance event in April; it was her best effort of the year; most recently, she won a five and a half furlong event when dropped in for \$16,000; she was traveling short on the turf while going right handed; she has been freshened and lands here with a chance at five furlongs on Tapeta.

**REAL COAL** raced well last time for \$20,000 when seeking her third career victory but she moved to the inside of the eventual winner and weakened late; she now goes shorter.

**MARILYNS LAST LOVE** had a good race at five furlongs at Fort Erie in July; she came off the shelf here recently to be a fringe player and will now shorten in distance.

**ATHDARA** handled this distance just fine when winning in a right handed turf event last time for \$20,000; she has been freshened and now returns now in a first allowance event looking to utilize her velocity; she rates a look.

**D'S DOUBLE EAGLE** wasn't a factor last time but showed some life in the stretch when sixth beaten five and a half lengths for \$7,500; there is a little more room available here.

**NEVER WORN** had post position twelve last time and that made it difficult but aggressive speed was obvious in a six furlong race before he faltered; he did have an excuse in his previous event; he will now extend to seven furlongs.

**MY PERFECT DIAMOND** took a double drop in value for \$16,000 last time and rated behind the leaders but an outside rival put pressure on him and he clipped heels and lost his momentum and was finally fifth of twelve; he now drops for \$10,000 and Husbands gives him a vote of confidence.

**SPEND A PENNY** wasn't far away for \$10,000 last time when advancing from twelfth to be sixth beaten five lengths; Courtisinsession was in second; more room is available.

**R SILVER HALL** was at six furlongs last time and advanced from thirteenth to be fifth in an ok performance for Gerald Seymour; he gets more distance here.

**COURTISINSESSION** raced well at this distance back in September; most recently with a drop for \$10,000, strong support showed for him and he was moving well in second in that event; he now extends out to seven furlongs for Barbara Minshall.

**MILWAUKEE SAINT** is a debut runner for Bruno Schickedanz and was an inexpensive auction purchase by Milwaukee Brew; he goes for Norm McKnight and has had regular prepping getting ready; Alderson gets the call.

**GOLDEN JIGGS** had an excuse last time when lacking room through the stretch and he finally finished tenth beaten about nine lengths; he can improve.

**JIMBO FIVE** had an ok sprint two starts ago once he got some correction after his troubled beginning, he was able to rally and finish fourth for \$19,000; most recently, he was in a key race at a route and both the first and third place finishers have come back with big wins; he drops in value and shortens in distance.

**CHEROKEE KNIGHT** lacked any speed when he debuted October 26<sup>th</sup>; he gets Moran for this second start.

**CASE IN POINT** had speed positioning on the backstretch last time but wandered in a bit then had nothing left for the stretch drive.

**SCHLOSS SCHNEEBERG** had a good enough race on turf at Fort Erie two starts ago when third; most recently, he fought on the pace with the winner and the fourth place finisher then faltered; the winner came here recently and finished eleventh for \$9,500.

**ARCHER TRIUMPH'S** was trying to follow the move of the winner around the turn last time but that one got away from him and he slipped back late; the blinkers are off and he drops down and shortens in distance.

**REGAL CHALLENGER** was at six furlongs last time and was reserved early but couldn't quicken through the lane.

**HEAVEN'S SAKE** made a rush on the rail last time and got into contention through the stretch but hung late; he now shortens from a route to a sprint.

**R BOOTS HALL** set a pace that was rather quick last time and after overcoming some early difficulty, he made his present felt on the middle pace before faltering.
