MY ARCH ENEMY was starting for the second time October 29th and moved from a route on turf to a sprint on Tapeta; she was used in an all out speed battle with the eventual winner, Tulsa; her stable mate came on to be second while she landed a tiring third; that stable mate has already come back with a good race; she now dips in for \$50,000 for this third career start.

KATRINA'S WAY had a big excuse in her debut; she broke abruptly to the outside from the widest post and her rider lost his right stirrup at that point; she could not get back into contention; she has had an opportunity for interim workout activity and now adds lasix for this second start.

VANITY PROJECT ran well to be second last Wednesday for maiden \$32,000; she set the pace with her robust frame and ran willingly after being displaced by the heavy favourite and she landed second; she is up in value here and is one of two in the race for Robert Tiller along with Lookin Perfect.

FOR U MIKE competed last Wednesday and was delayed behind a wall of runners and when she got loose for the stretch run, the best ones had already achieved prime positioning and she had to settle for third prize while Vanity Project was second; she is up in value.

CONQUEST RAPIDUNO has been in such difficult races the past while that today's drop back down to her claimed evaluation opens the door for a better performance; she could not keep up in the Natalma and was in a difficult maiden contest last time which was dominated by a preferred winner; she will now sprint on Tapeta with the drop and she has had interim workout activity.

LOOKIN PERFECT a debut runner, was an auction purchase and is by Lookin At Lucky, a multiple Grade 1 winning juvenile; she has had regular prepping getting ready and is one of two in the race for Robert Tiller along with Vanity Project.

LADY BRIE debuted for \$50,000 November 2nd and fell out of contention early then finally finished an ok fourth and the runner up has already come back to beat both Vanity Project and For U Mike in a race last Wednesday.

ITSTARTSWITHADRINK debuted November 9th for \$20,000 and drafted in behind runners at long odds; he made his way outside into the clear on the turn and was able to rally best under Chris Griffith for Nick Gonzalez; he now doubles in price but rates respect.

I'LL TAKE THE CAKE competed in both the Natalma when tenth and the Mazarine when eighth and was long odds in both events; her most recent race gives her standing here; she was sixth beaten about four lengths and the winner, Mythical Mission, was third in the Princess Elizabeth while the fourth place finisher from that last race, Ghostly Presence, came back to win the Princess Elizabeth; she drops out of that key race to run for \$40,000 but she goes against the boys.

SILENT VISION was bothered at the break by the sixth place finisher last time and then advanced from last to be fourth against a well regarded winner while Boys Club was second.

MUCHO PASO improved twelve performance points second time out to win with a drop for maiden \$20,000 with lasix added; he controlled the pace but the runner up rallied well; he doubles in price here.

BOYS CLUB was in against an overwhelming favourite October 14th for \$32,000 and did well to chase in second; he is up one price range here.

RED AT LAST was delayed in traffic last time but got loose in time to salvage a win for \$25,000; he was dropping down for that event and adding lasix and the money showed; he got there just in time.

SIGNATURE HEART is a difficult to evaluate off that last poor effort; he laid in and didn't have much focus in the Clarendon Stakes; he had taken a maiden win the time before at six furlongs in a good clocking with some authority while in front; a shift is now made to Kirk Johnson with this drop for \$40,000.

DYLAN has been given a freshener since October 2nd when fourth in a first allowance event and the top three in that event were all well regarded and the winner came back to be third in the Clarendon; he drops for \$40,000 and is one of two for Nick Gonzalez in the race along with Itstartswithadrink.

CONQUEST SWAGGER attracted a claim by Bancroft DeSouza July 24th and made it back to the races November 6th with a gallant pace try but was going too quickly on the lead and understandably fatigued in third; he doubles in price here for this second race following the layoff.

BIG DADDY BEAR competed on Tapeta early in the year and has avoided the surface ever since that time with races at Fort Erie and then a five race series of turf events here; he had some good results on those races on the grass up until his last start when he weakened and was a distant ninth; he now drops for \$40,000 and makes a shift to Tapeta.

DRUMCLIFF ran adequately last time in this category when stretched around two turns; he camped inside and finished fourth; Wong retains the mount for Ian Black.

INTO THE FUTURE came off the shelf September 25th in a six furlong race on the turf; that was a good bridge event to get him to a race for \$32,000 on a drop last time where he had a tentative trip because of traffic issues; he now goes from a sprint to a route and is up in value.

RINGO CLASSIC raced just fine two outings ago against a key top pair and landed third and a repeat of that race would serve him well here; most recently, he had a bit of a letdown in form when facing some of these; he raced inside from the second flight and was sixth beaten five lengths while Mick The Conqueror was third beaten only three lengths.

GREENFIELD raced four wide from the second flight initially and then three wide from the second flight in contention last time but gave up a couple of positions late and finished just in behind Mick The Conqueror and just in front of Ringo Classic; perhaps he can move up a few lengths in this spot.

MICK THE CONQUEROR had every chance on turf two outings ago and closed as the favourite to be second; most recently on Tapeta, he was between rivals from the second flight and he advanced to finish third behind the 3-5 favourite and he kept both Greenfield and Ringo Classic in behind him in a race that points him out as a leading contender here.

CAPTAIN SIDNEY is a debut runner and is a homebred for John Curtis and Gino Panza going for Roy Jones; he is from the same dam which produced the useful, Jean's A Lady; he just recently picked up his training program when moving out to five furlongs for a couple of useful works.

HARDCASTLE opted for a speed style November 12th over a surface much more helpful to closing types and he understandably faded; he does get to drop in value which helps his cause here and he does get to shorten to just five furlongs.

DANCEFORACQZ competed in this category last time and was twelfth beaten eight and a half lengths without threatening; he cuts back in distance and adds blinkers.

WAR EXECUTIVE had some nice production earlier in the year but his last couple of events have been generally unproductive; most recently, he was fifth beaten six lengths for \$9,500 against non winners of two after a four wide approach and a middle move; he shortens to just five furlongs.

A BIT OF WHO DO won last Wednesday by jumping out to the lead immediately and controlling the issue under good handling from Alderson who stays aboard here for Preston Ferris in this non winners of two event which is also at five furlongs; he rates a look.

ROXY'S BREW opted for a speed style last time over a surface more helpful to closing types and he understandably could not carry on but he was finally fifth of fourteen in a race that had some merit.

KAT'S GOOD SCOUT was a maiden winner two starts ago; he won the pace duel; most recently, he opted for speed over a surface much more helpful to closing types and he gave it up late and finished eleventh; he cuts back to five furlongs which was the winning distance of his previous race.

OLD SAINT PIETRO was at five furlongs last time and settled in behind rivals but didn't furnish a significant stretch charge against a key top pair when facing multiple winners; now he faces only non winners of two in hopes of a wake up.

ELMO SHRUGS was in against a key winner last time and opted for speed when closers were dominating and he finished next to last.

EXECUTIVEGUTS drew in from the also eligible list last time and post fourteen was difficult; he did break well and get an early position of prominence but he could not keep up when the closers took the best prizes.

KAYEZ was third at Fort Erie last time and the top two were well regarded and the runner up has already come back here to win.

DAZZLING DEPUTY a maiden winner two starts ago at six furlongs, went against non winners of two last time and had a four wide approach with every chance to do well but landed just on the edges; that fringe try is good enough to recommend him as a contender.

NICK 'N' DALE was behind in double digits two starts ago for \$10,000 and then was boosted in value last time and showed some sharp early speed; he now cuts back a quarter mile and drops in value.

HE'S NO SAINT has been competing at sprint distances but will now go in a route race; he dropped for \$10,000 last time and closed willingly but at only six furlongs; he had a difficult post in that event; the rail can be beneficial here with the stretch out and he has had experience around two turns in the past.

SHOT FOR SHOT used a different style last time and settled off the pace and then was able to provide an ample stretch drive to beat non winners of two for \$10,000 at this distance; he now faces non winners of three.

SKYDIGGER ANDY had a big win at Fort Erie for just \$5,000 two starts ago; when he was tested here last time, he wasn't able to keep up and Mighty Quinn was better in third.

MIGHTY QUINN was getting just his second start of the season November 9th and he made a nice move forward in form; he had a wide approach on the backstretch and surprisingly stayed on well at 63-1 to be third beaten a length and a half; he did have some of these behind him.

FINAL OFFER went from a sprint to a route November 9th and stayed on quite well to be fifth beaten three lengths when Mighty Quinn was better in third; he has produced several fringe efforts since a score back in July; he rates a look.

PLAYMETHEBLUES is certainly one to consider; he took a big drop October 5th when in for \$10,000 at only seven furlongs; he was trailing in the run around the turn then closed outside to be fifth beaten just a length and a half; he will now go from a sprint to a route and has freshness as an asset.

SALVATION SHOW has run similar races in consecutive events with significant late gains as if even more distance would be appreciated but he remains at the same venue with a chance to have an impact here with his late energy.

STRIKE ME AGAIN came to the top of the stretch out of contention last time and lashed out when briskly asked for his best; a switch is made to Callaghan here.

REALLYLIKETHISONE had the perfect ride to win two starts ago when rating off the pace until the stretch and then moving forward to win his third in a row; most recently, he opted to stay close to a faster pace and he weakened at the most crucial time; because he is a three year old, he is allowed entry here to try older rivals who have yet to win three races.

SILENT HUMOR is without a win in recent times; he had an extensive stay at Fort Erie this season where he did come close in September.

UNBRIDLED MAJESTY was a big winner at Fort Erie two starts ago; in a race dominated by ralliers there last time, he shortened to a sprint and finished third.

MATTANGEL was in for a low claiming evaluation two starts ago when he ran a peak race at seven furlongs; he was a tight third; most recently, he stretched to a route where he was not a factor; he cuts back to six furlongs for this event. **BALDUR** went from seven furlongs to a route last time and was part of an aggressive early pace and understandably had little left for the stretch drive at a low evaluation.

TROUBLE IN PHOENIX moved to this level November 2nd when returning from time away and had a four wide approach but the winner moved early on the rest of the field and that was the difference; this one was finally fourth; the blinkers are on for the cut back to six furlongs.

COURT SAVVY was a successful import here for the Ralph Biamonte stable November 11th in a six furlong maiden contest on Tapeta; he was locked in a pace duel with the eventual runner up who could not keep a straight course; he persisted along the fence for West Point Thoroughbreds; he now moves to an Ontario sire event and remains at six furlongs.

BEAR SKINNED attracted a claim for a low sum two starts ago when narrowly beaten and for \$19,000 last time, he was out of the money when he stalled on the turn; he is up in value and he cuts back in distance.

FORTIS was a winner for \$20,000 two starts ago when beating non winners of three with an eight wide sweep; most recently, he was in this category at seven furlongs where he came far from the outside and he narrowly missed in a good race and had Trouble In Phoenix well behind him on that occasion; he shortens back to six furlongs.

BOLD HOPE did not break well November 2nd and that gave birth to a new off the pace style which worked well; he came from thirteenth to win it at the end at a low sum; he is jumping in value here.

WHO'S GOT IT was at five furlongs in this category last time and had a mild outside move and finished third beaten two lengths when Ratface Macdougall was a length and a half better in second; he moves out to six furlongs here.

RATFACE MACDOUGALL a noted speedster, was second in this category last time at five furlongs; he overcame a bobble at the start and then was sent to the lead and had the advantage until quite late when a stalker went by him; he must go six furlongs here.

FOXY PHIL trailed early last time then tried a move in the stretch but hung on the edges; he goes farther.

BEAR'S ROMEO sat tight to the pace at an inexpensive level last time but couldn't improve his position.

REGAL MARK is an obvious one to consider here; most recently at six furlongs in this category, he stayed close to a pace that was quite quick; he won the front end battle but lost out to a late closer; he remains a strong factor from the outside for Kevin Attard.

BEYOND SMART attracted a claim September 28th and will now return at one level higher following a freshening; he indicates a couple of November works getting ready for Mark Fournier; he is seeking his initial win of the year.

HAMPSTEAD HEATH has been close by in three consecutive events on turf including the Halton Stakes two starts ago; most recently, he used a drafting style behind rivals and missed by only a length while Big Bazinga was better in second; the winner was unplaced here on Friday; he makes a rare night appearance and moves off turf to Tapeta with a drop for \$20,000.

TAKE BACK YA POILS a four year old filly, beat the boys back in September at this price; most recently against her own gender, she faltered as the favourite for the second race in a row.

MALIBU WOOD took on the role as a pace chaser last time but the winner got quite emboldened; he tired from the unsuccessful pursuit of the winner and faltered in seventh; he had carried on more thoroughly at Fort Erie two starts ago.

PUGSLEY won his first race of the campaign October 30th; he found the perfect spot dropping in for \$16,000; he encountered the second and third place finishers who battled each other on the pace; he edge by on the outside at the last moment; he is up one level.

MYTHOS returns home to Woodbine for Stronach Stables; he won on the Tapeta surface in June at Presque Isle; for this return, he gets to plunge for just \$20,000 and rejoins the Sid Attard barn.

BIG BAZINGA seems to be sitting on a top effort; he won earlier in the year after benefitting from his Florida campaign; he returned from time away September 11th and ran strongly for \$32,000 when narrowly beaten in third with Pugsley second; most recently, he was again narrowly beaten and he had Hampstead Heath just in behind him; he shifts off turf and back to Tapeta with a plunge for \$20,000.

GRENFELL showed a touch of interest at the end but was much too late in his most recently try for \$40,000; the winner galloped away on the front end; he runs for half the price and gets his second start following the layoff.

MOONSHINE MARTINI was close by just two starts ago for \$23,500 and earned a high performance rating; the winner, Eminent Force, was a smart winner here on Friday; most recently, he competed against some of these when chasing a difficult front runner for \$37,500 and he finally finished fourth; he now goes for \$20,000.

DIVINE DANCE was able to win an Ontario sire event October 16th despite being blocked into the stretch; when he found room he rescued the event and the runner up has already come back to win an Ontario sire race.

HABEMUS PAPAM was exhausted in a pace duel two starts ago and faltered in the stretch; most recently, he was again at the first allowance level and was racing off the pace with no positive results; he finished ninth and the eighth place finisher, Damascus Road, has already come back with a big win; he plunges for \$20,000.

SOMBRERO DE COPA took his first win in an extended time in September when he dropped in for \$15,000; since that time, he had tried extended distances but in his latest, the pace was much too quick for the marathon; he was used up; he will now drop for \$19,000 and shorten to a mile and a sixteenth. **ENTWISTLE** attracted a claim for \$20,000 in early September but has not produced for his new interests; the winner of his most recent race, came back to win here Friday; for the first time in his career, he will join the lasix program; he does have the benefits of a couple of fast recent works for Tino Attard.

ESPIRITUGANADOR was a longshot last time at a route for \$7,500 but after breaking ok, he stumbled and then was taken up abruptly and that had him out of contention.

FINE GRIT had a good race under the lights November 9th when battling to the outside of the eventual winner who reclaimed the advantage from him deep in the lane and he had to settle for second spot and had Hythe and King Of Angels in behind him.

SARAN IS AWESOME has been moved over to the Dominguez stable and will now go from a sprint to a route with a drop for \$7,500 in hopes of a wake up.

ASTERISM made a move inside last time when facing some of these and was finally sixth beaten five lengths while Fine Grit was second.

HYTHE was starting for only the second time November 9th; he made a move inside to get into contention and closed well when repositioned outside and was just a length behind the runner up, Fine Grit; the stable has had success with sons of English Channel in the past.

CLOUD BANKER is getting his first start since the spring time and has switched to the stable of Mario Williams; he gets to drop for this event and indicates just a single work.

BAREFOOT COVE is one of two for the Casse stable dropping; he was galloping at the back for \$20,000 last time and finally finished ninth without threatening; he now goes for just \$8,000 with Boulanger.

FAINNE GEAL had a quiet run down the backstretch last time but couldn't generate any enthusiasm late in the race.

FO'C'SLE seemed to be out of control heading to the first turn last time and checked and lost all momentum as the favourite for \$20,000; he finally finished seventh beaten ten lengths; he now drops from the \$20,000 mark to go for \$8,000 and Husbands gives him a vote of confidence; he can wake up.

KING OF ANGELS dropped in for \$8,000 last time and was delayed on the turn but once he was positioned outside in the stretch, he did some late running as if he would enjoy more room and he gets it here with Campbell now aboard.

THE CHEEKY CHARMER had a tentative approach two starts ago when he failed to threaten; most recently, he followed behind runners in the march down the backstretch and was finally fifth beaten four lengths while Fine Grit was second.

NOT POSITIVE showed some early initiative here for \$20,000 last time but faltered and then stopped; that was a key race from which the winner came back to win an allowance race on turf and the third place finisher came back to win big on Tapeta; he drops sharply off the wide loss.
