CANADIAN CLASS was able to take a maiden score two outings ago at seven furlongs when stalking aggressively and taking over to beat Sir Bronx who is here; most recently, he was running from farther off the pace in an event against non winners of two at this price and finished just on the edges after a mid stretch move; he gets to cut back to six furlongs which gives him a chance to concentrate his late power.

MAJESTIC SLEW made his way home after an out of the money finish at Parx and dropped in for \$40,000 but he elected to go against non winners of three when seeking his second win and that worked against him late; he was passed at the last moment by a couple of two time winners and he had to settle for third when strong support showed for him; he now comes in against non winners of two; his aggressive style may put him in conflict with Front Nine; the blinkers are off.

CRUSHIN IT ran well for \$20,000 two starts ago with every chance to win but he was used up winning a pace battle and gave it away late; most recently, he did not come out of the gate effectively then closed a gap from eleventh to be fourth in a race run in significant time; he has a chance to be more thorough here.

SIR BRONX couldn't quite handle Canadian Class two starts ago; he was favoured last time in the right spot to put away a reluctant runner up; he was well ridden to victory; Boulanger takes over here because Contreras is riding in Kentucky today.

OPENING REMARK was stifled by the difficult inside post last time in a first allowance race at 66-1 and was beaten six lengths by Touch Of Disney who came back to win the Overskate; he has met a series of key winners but now gets in with his own kind with a chance to wake up.

MC CULLEY was in the same most recent race as Canadian Class who was fifth beaten two and a half lengths while this one was at the back; he committed to a hectic pace duel with a half in 44.1 and then retreated to last.

FRONT NINE has been aggressive with his style in recent events and gave up a long lead two starts ago; most recently, he again gave away a clear advantage when in for half this price.

ANOTHER BID was forced to scratch from a race November 11th and will go here instead; he has been out of the money in recent events but dropped back down to the \$8,000 mark last time and was fifth beaten six lengths when Millioninthemaking was second and Sea Of Silence was third.

GRAND MIXTURE beat the bias last time by running on the lead and going all the way to defeat non winners of three; he was able to establish easy early fractions and that was his ticket home; he now faces multiple winners for \$8,000 in search of his third win of the campaign.

CLASSY KID was in for \$6,000 last time trying to repeat but he finished seventh beaten six lengths; he did not corner well; he will now go from a series of sprints to a route.

MIND MAGIC beat non winners of two in his previous event with a deep closing style and used the same approach last time to benefit from the existing trends and he won late to defeat non winners of three; he seeks his fourth win of the campaign here and no goes against multiple winners.

COSMIC CHARLIE is hard to look beyond he is taking another devaluation; he dropped for his latest but finished fifth in a key race won by Pugsley; he runs for half the price of that event in hopes of getting his second win of the campaign and his first route win this season.

CAPE ZAVATA was in for \$6,000 last time; he kept going with some vigour to be third beaten just a length and a half when he cut back to seven furlongs; he now goes for Krista Cole and lengthens to a route.

MILLIONINTHEMAKING was second best last time for \$6,000 when getting his second start following a layoff; he couldn't hold the lead late after aggressively chasing a pace that was too quick; he was softened up late; Crawford retains the mount.

SEA OF SILENCE was close by three starts ago and then was third in his next start; in his most recent try, he attempted a deep closing style but wasn't a factor when Millioninthemaking was second.

MAY PEN has lost by wide margins in recent events; she was behind early last time from the inside.

I CANNOT FIND IT is a three year old with three lifetime wins and is facing some older rivals who have yet to win three times; she slumped in her latest in this category when sixth beaten three and a half lengths but was in against a key winner; Thalias Fire was just a length better in that event.

JUST LET LOOSE returned from time off following a Fort Erie campaign to come here November 16th but trailed in that event and was finally tenth.

IRIS WILL was in too tough a race last time even though she was dropping down; the top two finishers were both taking key drops; she finally finished eighth beaten ten lengths; she takes a more substantial drop here for just \$9,500 and stretches from a sprint to a route; she won going a route earlier.

SIERRA ANGEL had no impact in a race for \$9,500 when dropped back down last time and Thalias Fire was better in fourth.

TEATOE tipped her hand in her previous event when she improved to be fourth beaten a length and a half; the improvement last time was significant and it wasn't a surprise; she edged her way into the clear and won easily and then survived a claim of foul by the third place finisher; she now takes on non winners of three.

TAP O'THE MOUNTAIN dropped sharply to ensure a victory September 16th but was second narrowly beaten and then converted next time out; she went into a protected race last time where she ran quite well but she gave up two positions very late; she now drops back for \$10,000 which puts her in the running here.

PONAGE attracted a claim for \$10,000 September 25th and since that time, has been at protected levels and has run quite well to finish on the edges; it is just a case of being at her best for today's drop back to her claimed price; she fits.

THALIAS FIRE campaigned here November 6th and ran well with a late inside move suggesting even more room would be helpful but she remains at the same evaluation and distance.

SLEEK IDEA is a two time route winner this season and was only six lengths behind in an Ontario sire race on grass last time; he now finds an intermediate level for \$20,000 on Tapeta.

CROWN PRINCE is worth considering following his out of the money finish on turf last time and his plunge here to go to Tapeta; the eighth place finisher from that race, has already come back to win for \$19,000 on Tapeta.

BROADWAY SENSATION has lost by wide margins in recent events at lowers levels than today's event; the blinkers are off.

MISS TIAGO a four year old filly, had a bold run from the furlong marker home last time to be six lengths the best with Husbands aboard for \$10,000 against non winners of two; she faces the boys here against non winners of three.

RHYTHM BLUES had a series of good route races heading to a turf race last time where he got in against a key winner, Big Yum, who won again Sunday; he closed a big gap from twelfth to be third; the eighth place finisher from that race, Impetuous Act, has since dropped for \$19,000 to win and he is using that same technique, shifting away from turf and going to Tapeta for exactly \$19,000.

TIMBERLINE had a big win for \$19,000 two starts ago and was claimed at the same price range last time when she slipped back to third; she enters against the boys here with blinkers on for new trainer Kevin Attard.

DR. PHILAN was running on nicely last time for \$10,000 and galloped out strongly suggesting he likes the nine furlong distance; he attracted a claim and now doubles in value.

AUTUMN SONG was introduced here from Edmonton November 5th at just six furlongs and had outside speed against a hot pace and finished sixth beaten only three lengths; he now goes from a sprint to a route and drops for \$20,000; with Boulanger aboard Rhythm Blues, Nelson takes over here.

GIANT STORM had an ok late move last time when dropped in for \$20,000 while shortening to seven furlongs; he was finally sixth beaten seven lengths by a key winner who was dropping down; he now goes from a sprint to nine furlongs.

THUNDER POINT is a one time winner facing non winners of three; his big win came with a new rider taking over last time for \$20,000; a new and better style developed with a move from far off the pace to win quite easily at a route; a move is made to Ryan for this race.

UNCORKED SPIRIT stayed close as a slow pace developed October 26th but when the middle fractions heated up, he fell out of contention against the winner, Hemlock Channel.

CAT ZAPPER was one paced at seven furlongs two starts ago when Hemlock Channel was the winner; he shortened to five furlongs last time where he closed vigorously from the outside to be third beaten a long length and he had momentum; he gets back to seven furlongs and goes up in value.

HEMLOCK CHANNEL has now won consecutive events for trainer Norm McKnight with Hernandez aboard and now drops a level with Kirk Johnson being named for this event; he narrowly beat Rocco Point two starts ago and lines up beside that one.

ROCCO POINT gets his first start since a narrow loss against Hemlock Channel at the beginning of October; that winner has already come back to score again and is here; he has been quite busy with three consecutive works in November getting ready to come off the shelf for Lorne Richards.

CUMMINGS ROAD took a rare win October 16th for \$20,000; most recently, he slipped back when taking sharp support for \$25,000 and at 6-5, he finished last, yet, only five lengths out of it; he now gets to drop for just \$10,000 and Husbands stays aboard.

ATYPICAL dropped for \$12,500 last time and he was able to wake up while taking inordinate money against the difficult Courtville whom he chased around the track and landed second.

SNOWY LEGACY got into a pace fight last time around the turn with Hemlock Channel and could not handle that rival and backed away for his second consecutive out of the money finish; he has been freshened a month and now comes in at a lower level but must meet Hemlock Channel once again.

PRETTY MASTER competed last Sunday but stalled along the inside and wasn't a factor.

COURTVILLE has won two of his three races and was in for \$11,500 last time when the slow pace structure played to his front running strength; he comes from the outside here looking to double up at seven furlongs.

SILVER SIDNEY was coming off a route race and surprisingly found herself close to a half mile in 44.4 but she couldn't continue in the stretch in that protected spot; she was in this category at a route two starts ago where she finished close by in second.

THE MINK MILE was at seven furlongs against Ontario sire company two starts ago and had a lot to do and finished seventh beaten three and a half lengths behind San Nicola Storm, who is here.

GARAFRAXA was in this category at a route two starts ago and was reserved back then tried a rally in the stretch but was beaten three lengths; when she tried this distance last time, the opposition was too good.

ALLWEHAVEISNOW a winner three starts ago at this distance on Tapeta, came close to winning last time at six and a half furlongs on this footing; she is a three year old with three lifetime wins; she fits.

PATSY'S STAR attracted a claim September 10th when lowered but she did not produce; her new interests got a victory out of her with a peak performance November 4th; she improved to be three lengths the best against Ontario sire company; she is a three year old now looking for her fourth lifetime win and she dips in for \$40,000.

CAPTURE YOUR HEART dropped into the right spot last time but got softened up in an early duel with the seventh place finisher; she attempted to steal turning for home but was caught by another who was using the same drop down angle; she is back up to the level of her previous race.

SAN NICOLA STORM came down the outside of the track September 28th to beat Ontario sire company; most recently for \$40,000 in this classification, she closed nicely on the outside but hung right at the end and Allwehaveisnow, was better in second; Mosqueira takes over while Husbands handles Patsy's Star.

ARCH TIGRESS has competed only on turf to this point but will drop down and move to Tapeta for Ralph Biamonte with Boulanger aboard; she is a two time winner in this opening campaign.

ELGIN drops in for a claiming evaluation now after a wide loss at a route last time; she will shorten to just seven furlongs and comes from the outside post.

FROSTY VIXEN was in a middle claiming event last time against limited winners but that event was dominated by a strong favourite and she finished seventh; the runner up, Allwehaveisnow, was in race six today and could provide a reference.

ATHDARA was stranded last Sunday when the races were cancelled; she has picked a race here against Ontario sire runners; in her latest, she dropped down to take an edge and won for \$20,000 in the non winners of two category; both career wins have come right handed on the turf over short distances; she goes to Tapeta here at six furlongs.

PRINCESS ROYAL can be a strong pace factor; she has freshness as an asset; two starts ago, she raced from just off the pace to make it tight in behind the runner up, Another Girl; she has posted some quick works this month getting ready to come off the shelf.

COREY'S BEST has committed to turf for recent events and ran well two starts ago at a distance beyond her best when fourth; when she shortened to seven furlongs last time, it was understood that she would be more thorough and she ran a peak race to be third beaten only two lengths by a key winner; she now looks to transfer that enthusiasm over to Tapeta where she has yet to win.

PRIZED BOURBON committed to a speed style last time and that had her against the bias which helped rallying runners; the top three all came from off the pace and when she gave up the lead late, she was finally fourth; Ryan takes over.

BUCKDEN HOUSE had an excuse for just \$10,000 last time when she steadied into the turn but she then followed the rallying winner and reported second.

DONNAS SWEET HEART was against the bias when she opted to go up and set the pace last time and she understandably grew weary late at seven furlongs; she is up in value but she shortens in distance.

ANOTHER GIRL would appear to be the logical one here but she has only a single score this season; most recently, a slow pace developed which dragged her up towards the front which is not her preferred style; she landed third as the favourite against Patsy's Star who was in race six.

WINNING SMILE returned from considerable time away November 6th and was perfectly handled by Contreras to come up the rail and beat the favourite; he is in Kentucky today and Husbands will take over here.

PUNTROOSKIE had a peak performance when winning the Bold Venture Stakes back in the summer time; he battled to the outside and he was roused in the stretch to beat a very difficult runner up who came out of that race to have a big win in the \$300,000 Gallant Bob at Parx; most recently in the Ontario Jockey Club Stakes, he had an inside position against Stacked Deck who was better to his outside; the fourth place finisher from that race, Calgary Cat, has since been first in the Nearctic and fourth at the Breeders' Cup in the Turf Sprint; he competes for Michael Lay, Mike Loughry and D-Mac Racing Stable.

PINK LLOYD was in a restricted stake last time at seven furlongs and may well have been best but had to settle for fifth beaten two and a half lengths after lacking room at a crucial stage; Husbands has been enlisted for Entourage Stable.

COMMUTE competes for Gabe Grossberg and Sagamore Farm; he had a smart win two starts ago overcoming a slow departure from the gate to rally best at this distance; most recently, he went to turf for the Labeeb Stakes where he was aggressive in the middle stages but the better ones got away from him late; he moves back to Tapeta at six furlongs.

STACKED DECK won this race last year at the expense of Passion For Action; he has had two different blocks of races this season with just a single win and that came in the Ontario Jockey Club Stakes at the expense of Puntrooskie; Calgary Cat was behind him on that day but then came back to beat him in the Nearctic; he hopped at the start in that event then took over the pace but was beaten at the last instant and the winner has since gone to the Breeders Cup to be fourth in the Turf Sprint; he applied himself nicely in a November 13th work with a rally in 59.3; he is a homebred for Bruce Lunsford.

JACKS ESCARPMENT won the Kenora back in August and was tight behind Commute in his next start; seven furlongs proved too demanding in the recent Overskate when he slipped back against Touch Of Disney; he had a nimble work November 10th in 49.2; he competes for John K. Caulfield.

PASSION FOR ACTION has had a wonderful season for owner/breeder Ben Hutzler with three stakes scores; his form slipped in the Woodbine Mile and he was only on the edges at best in the Nearctic.

COLLEEN'S SAILOR was subjected to a very difficult pace ordeal two starts ago and understandably fatigued; most recently, he had to compete in the exact same early pace time and again weakened at the most inopportune juncture and finished third behind Commute; Moran was aboard for a recent good work in 48.2 for Solo Racing Ltd.

BOREAL SPIRIT competes for ShayD Lane Farm; he was in the Overskate last time where he had a clear lead of a length and a half but he faltered late against the winner, Touch Of Disney, and now goes shorter.

TOUCH OF DISNEY a homebred for Bruno Schickedanz, was successful in the restricted Overskate last time at seven furlongs; he was last midway of the far turn and went outside and rallied best in spectacular fashion; he will cut back to six furlongs here.

REAL COAL raced well last time for \$20,000 when seeking her third career victory but she moved to the inside of the eventual winner and weakened late; she now goes shorter.

SHE'S A RINGER drafted behind runners last time with hopes of a stretch gain but was finally fifth of ten; she departs an out of the money finish on turf to go to Tapeta at five furlongs.

UNSEEN ANGELS was unlucky last time and finished third beaten a half length; she will shorten all the way to five furlongs and did win at this distance much earlier in the year with good speed; she is showing a more mature style now for Norm McKnight.

LETTER FLY is a noted speed runner who narrowly missed at this distance in an open allowance event in April; it was her best effort of the year; most recently, she won a five and a half furlong event when dropped in for \$16,000; she was traveling short on the turf while going right handed; she has been freshened and lands here with a chance at five furlongs on Tapeta.

DAWNMINO gets a chance to go just five furlongs here and that might prove ideal for her; she has indicated some hanging tendencies at the longer distances and is looking for a breakthrough win; seven furlongs was beyond her preferred distance last time and she hung at a crucial time; Olguin takes over.

NORTHERN KISS lost her momentum in her second start which came in the Ruling Angel Stakes; she did not keep up with the flow; most recently, she was tried on turf and finished far behind at long odds; the fourth place finisher, Duchess Of Duke, has come back to beat some of these; she departs an out of the money finish on turf and goes to Tapeta for Blair Miller.

MARILYNS LAST LOVE had a good race at five furlongs at Fort Erie in July; she came off the shelf here recently to be a fringe player and will now shorten in distance.

COCA INN was a surprise October 10th when returning from a layoff; she beat Ontario sire runners at this distance by streaking to the lead and she was home easily in 57.3; she will try and repeat that performance in open company.

DEEP BLUE SEA was too aggressive last time chasing a hot pace along with the second and tenth place finishers and paid the price in the stretch when she ran out of fuel; a cut back to five furlongs gives her an opportunity to use her best style from off the pace here.

SPLENDID GLORY was intent on being in front early last time but the early pace was too scorching and the fourth place finisher who set the early pace was exhausted late; she also slipped out of the money after that early chase.

DANCE WITH ME BABY drew the difficult inside post last time and had a poor departure from the gate which proved costly; she rushed up to get the early lead then faltered and eventually stopped; she has a chance to do better here with the cutback to five furlongs and the drop for \$9,500.

EARLY RINGALING was forced to scratch here November 11th and will line up in this spot for \$9,500 against non winners of two; she did have a win at Fort Erie back in July at five furlongs.

DANCIN CASSIE had a good opportunity two starts ago at five furlongs and she was challenging close by in mid stretch and wasn't far away at the end; the eighth place finisher came back to win; in her latest when stretched to six furlongs, she offered early prominence.

VIRTUELLE was a winner two starts ago at five furlongs for \$9,500; most recently, she committed to a more aggressive style on the pace against faster fractions and finished just on the edges; she deserves a chance if she can work out a stalking trip.

MYSTIC MEMORY came wide off the turn in her debut November 12th and then lost momentum; she is down in value and she shortens to five furlongs in this second start.

SPANISH TRICK had post thirteen last time and rushed to an early lead but had nothing left for the stretch drive; she had won on the turf at Fort Erie in her previous event.

HARBOUR GRACE had an excusable trip two starts ago; most expected improvement last time and she did run willingly until quite late when in contention and was finally beaten only three and a half lengths; the blinkers are now on; she travels just five furlongs.

BEAUTY PHIL had a good race two starts ago but a complete letdown last time after she was used on the lead and had nothing left for the stretch drive.

BEEZIE had an excuse last time; she could not find room on the inside; she is seeking a breakthrough victory and she is winless in recent years.

ESSENCES BEST is getting her first start since July 2nd when she had early speed but retreated against better; that was her only start of the campaign; she indicates some works over short distances getting ready.

BIG TIME NANNY ran well enough two starts ago to win for maiden \$7,500 when taking over the pace from the outside; most recently, she found herself in eleventh turning for home but did well to finish fifth beaten only four lengths in a race that qualifies her; the winner has come back to score for \$10,000.

SHE'S NO MEENY had a good enough race on the turf at Fort Erie two starts ago when second but had a letdown performance there last time.

WEEPWIDOW was just on the edges on the turf at Fort Erie last time when She's No Meeny was in second and that one has been entered.
