TWO TRIBES a homebred for Frank Di Giulio Jr., is by the popular, Union Rags, a winner of both the Grade 1 Champagne and Belmont Stakes; this one is from a dam who was a three time stakes winner; she has worked from the gate on a regular basis getting ready and has attracted Da Silva.

VIA ANN was stuck on the also eligible list November 19th and scratched; she will begin her career here; she is a daughter of the Grade 1 sprinter, Street Boss, and is from a stakes placed dam; she is a homebred for Borders Racing Stable and goes for Dan Vella; she had a useful trial November 12th in 48 getting ready.

HONEY'S TALE had a prompt debut at Fort Erie in September but a local introduction October 29th saw her behind early but she did show a touch of interest in the stretch in a race dominated by speed runners; she came back to work well November 13th in 1.01.1 for Michaela Neubauer; lasix is added and Husbands is ushered in.

FRESH PRINCESS a homebred for Tony Gattellaro, is by the Ontario sire, Giant Gizmo; she has had a variety of works dating back and had some speed in a trial November 13th in 47.2 getting ready; Alderson rides in this launch.

GOLDRUSH GLORY debuted July 23rd at long odds from a wide post in the My Dear Stakes and stayed close early; she has had a variety of works for this comeback and showed speed in a move November 12th in 1.00.3; she is well related for speed and Campbell once again has the mount for Kelly Callaghan.

WHIP ME INTO SHAPE debuts here for Buttigieg Training Centre and Gus Vlahos; she is bred for speed by Yes It's True; her quickest work came back on November 5th in 1.00.3; she has had two half mile works since then.

SPUN FROM GOLD is a well bred individual by Hard Spun who was a Grade 1 winning sprinter but also second in the Kentucky Derby; this one is from an undefeated Smart Strike mare; she will debut from the outside here for Robert Gerl; she had a quick work back on October 23rd in 47.4.

GIGANTIC BREEZE is a likely candidate to wake up in this spot; he departed consecutive out of the money finishes on turf to drop for \$40,000 last time where he was fifth beaten six lengths against a front runner in a race that featured a good late pace; he now runs for half that price and Boulanger moves in.

COMEDY GOLD is without current momentum; he was out of the money on turf two starts ago and out of the money against Ontario sire company last time when Iron Shore was better in second.

YOU KNOW JACK is making some changes today in this second race following a layoff; he goes from a sprint to a route and adds blinkers with Da Silva now aboard; in a recent seven furlong race, he was not a factor.

I DELIVER has been up and down the class ladder and has been a confirmed fringe player; he finished a couple of lengths behind Iron Shore when both engaged in a losing pace battle November 12th and he was finally fourth.

IRON SHORE was generally experimenting with a route November 12th when he was coming off a peak effort at seven furlongs for \$9,500; he jumped in value and went on to the lead and was pressed by I Deliver using a style that was not effective over that surface and a late runner took him down but he did finish second in a race that qualifies him nicely.

BEAREAGLE won in slow time for \$9,500 at six furlongs last outing and will now extend in distance and jump in value.

BIG RED BUGSY came off the shelf following considerable time away November 12th at much too short a distance; that race can be an ideal primer for him; he now goes from a sprint to a route with a chance to wake up; he exits a highly rated race which was taken by a longshot winner who dominated.

STONEHART RIDGE is making changes today in this second race following a layoff; he comes down in value after a five and a half length defeat at a route last time when Eye Of The Lion was in second.

DEXTER ROAD has been in protected events in all three performances and did have an adequate route try two starts ago; he shortened back to seven furlongs for a chance to race on turf last time but that event came off grass at the last moment; he showed some speed and then finished sixth and the fifth place finisher, Colton's Corner, came back to win big on Sunday's card; he rates a chance.

CALL ME GIZMO stalled at the quarter pole last time in a seven furlong race; he has been switched to the stable of Amber Mayers and will go up in value and stretch out here.

STOP THE PARADE a debut runner for Joe Walls, is bred to be a stayer top and bottom and her dam has produced a couple of useful two turn winners; he will try a route at first asking here with Alderson aboard and has had regular prepping.

HE'S A BREEZE debuted October 19th at long odds in a protected race at seven furlongs and couldn't generate any velocity; with the drop in value and the extension in distance, he is likely to go better here.

JIM BANNON'S JOURNAL NOVEMBER 26/2016

ROCHESTER debuted at tiny odds July 3rd at home at Presque Isle at just five furlongs and that was a speed dominated race and he couldn't get going at 2-1; he now drops in value for \$32,000 and extends in distance for Ron Potts and Wilson will be aboard.

CRY IN THE WILD dropped in for a tag November 4th and went better in third behind a predictable winner with Eye Of The Lion about a half length better than him in second; changes are made here; he adds lasix and blinkers in his rematch with Eye Of The Lion; he fits **EYE OF THE LION** raced well enough in his debut when third; second time out, he moved to the \$40,000 mark where despite laying in, he stayed on to be second behind a preferred winner and kept Cry In The Wild behind him in third; Campbell takes over as Hernandez sits out.

FIERY BEAR had a good enough race two starts ago against Ontario sire company when second; he was also protected last time against key rivals but didn't keep up and now plunges for Nathan Squires with Simon Husbands aboard once again.

SURPRISINGLY PERFECT has found some tough company to date; in his latest, he finished ninth and the winner came back to be third in the Coronation while both the third and sixth place finishers have come back to win; he now drops for \$32,000 hoping to use his stamina; stable rider, Moran moves in here.

CANNA RED is seen as a main factor here along with Starship Sabrina who beat her back into third last time; in that last event, she had the difficult inside post and faded after an early pace challenge over a surface more helpful to closing types; she had win the time before at six furlongs and directly behind her was Starship Sabrina.

LEEN AND CLASSY competed at just five furlongs last time when a stout fourth beaten two lengths; she drafted behind rivals then produced a rally; she has two wins.

SILVER SHASA is a two time winner this season and both victories have come at Fort Erie; she was fourth here last time when Cloudwatcher was better in second.

BELLA HUMOR competed last time in a race that had plenty of speed types and she moved from behind a very fast pace to rally in third; she had generally picked five furlongs and won at that distance two starts ago but must go six furlongs here.

JEAN'S A LADY ran a good race last time; she moved off the rail and chased home Starship Sabrina when second beaten two lengths.

CRAFTY GIZMO is without current momentum after consecutive wide losses; the blinkers are off.

SPLASHY GIRL like some others in here, has only two lifetime wins but is facing multiple winners; against limited winners last time, she was on the edges against Lo And Behold.

LO AND BEHOLD took her third lifetime win last time and handled the five furlong distance adequately enough although she drifted out menacingly into the path of the third place finisher last time but was allowed to keep the victory at 34-1. **CLOUDWATCHER** was at this distance last time at one price lower when a rallying second against a front running winner in a race that gives her some standing here.

STARSHIP SABRINA had to overcome trouble last time when winning first time off the claim for Bill Tharrenos but she showed very good recovery power; she was clear at the end; today she gets the outside which should provide her with an ideal trip.

VIVA FOREVER has had trouble in her last couple of events at low levels and has been out of the money both times; she is up in value here.

CARBON INPRINT debuted November 18th at just five furlongs against a preferred front running winner and didn't really have a chance to get into that event because of the goodness of the winner; she now extends to seven furlongs which plays more to her pedigree preference.

I LOOK INCREDIBLE can be considered; at only five furlongs last time, she was involved in the early mix with the top two finishers and was used up and settled in fourth in an ok effort; the third place finisher, Beau's Beauty is here; she will extend from five to seven furlongs.

COURT REPORTER debuted November 6th at six furlongs and was used for some early positioning but couldn't get into a position of prominence and was finally eighth with Hailey's Prize in second; she goes farther here with the blinkers on.

TWENTYTWENTYCREST competed in a cold wind November 11th around two turns and embarked on a front running mission that failed; she finished far behind; she now adds lasix and cuts back in distance.

TYPICALLY dropped down and came off the shelf November 16th and ran better than anticipated advancing from sixth to be second and she threatened the winner but couldn't get by; she comes right back at seven furlongs but is up in value here.

SKY VISION is worth considering; her opener came at only five furlongs and she was tentative between runners when an opening closed on her; she finally finished sixth with Beau's Beauty in second and I Look Incredible in fourth; she has been busy with two five furlongs works in the interim and now adds lasix for the extension all the way out to seven furlongs for Stuart Simon.

SAM'S CROSS is one to consider; she was in a key race two starts ago; she woke up when stretched to seven furlongs and despite laying in, she finished fourth; most recently, she embarked on a two turn race where her round stride seemed to work; she managed to pin a key rival in and then went after the strong favourite and finished second; she cuts back to seven furlongs with blinkers on and Husbands follows her there.

JIM BANNON'S JOURNAL NOVEMBER 26/2016

HAILEY'S PRIZE has been second in all four races to date; most recently, she was in against a rival she knows well and that one used a new and more patient technique to run by her in the stretch; she was finally second beaten a length and a half; she will be running farther than ever before but that looks adequate.

VIENNA BY NIGHT made a move on the outside at the top of the stretch last time and was finally fourth against a couple of speed runners at six furlongs for \$32,000.

BEAU'S BEAUTY cut back from seven to five furlongs last time and stayed better in third; she now extends back to seven furlongs and worked recently with Bahen aboard in 48.2 for Debra Rombis.

WEALTHY SHIPMAN was in against the boys for a chance to run on turf last time but runners from the back had very little chance in that race as speed carried; she sprints on Tapeta for the first time since May.

REMEBEL has been nibbling at the edges in her last two events in this category; most recently, she was fourth just a neck out of third and she gets to shorten by a half furlong with Moran now aboard.

SUPER SARAH fell out of contention in the run down the backstretch at six furlongs last time but wasn't far away at the end in eighth beaten four lengths when Remebel was third; she worked November 18th in 35 for John Mattine.

GREEN DOCTOR ruled on the grass in consecutive big victories during September and was dominant; most recently, she went into the Fashion Stakes as a longshot on Tapeta and engaged in a pace fight with Veaisha and gradually fell out of contention; that was a key race from which the third place finisher came back to win the Bessarabian and the first place finisher last time, came back to be second in the Bessarabian; she has had an opportunity for a series of works since that last loss; she meets Veaisha once again.

CASABLANCA KISS was pulled out of an early duel last time in hopes of settling but went right back into the battle and slipped back at the end on turf; in a starter event for \$40,000 two starts ago on Tapeta, she offered good middle speed and finished second to Veaisha who is here.

IMPOSSIBLE TALE was getting her second start on Tapeta at the meeting November 11th and there was some progress; she finished just in behind Remebel; she had an outward trip and galloped out well; she goes a bit shorter here but can progress.

PEGGY O is an upset possibility; she raced well in this category September 17th when second best only to be gifted the victory when the eventual first place finisher made a mistake and was disqualified; most recently, she had a troubled trip when unable to find room at a crucial time and she was finally out of the money; she has had a couple of recent works at a half mile getting ready for Catherine Day-Phillips.

VEAISHA seems to be a constant theme running through this race and has won four of her seven starts this year for Larry Attard; most recently in the Fashion Stakes, she engaged in a heated pace duel with Green Doctor and both paid the price; she slipped back to fourth; River Maid from that last race, came back to win the Bessarabian; she has kept active with works on the training track getting ready for her appointment with Green Doctor.

SHOW SHAPE made a move up the inside last time for \$40,000 on turf but was blocked and lacked room until very late then moved on nicely to be fourth; she sprints on Tapeta here and did win in early summer time at this very distance on this surface.

CRY HAVOC makes changes today; she will now drop for \$10,000 going in below her claimed price and she will stretch from a sprint to a route and change to Singh.

AMBER BREWSKI went from a sprint to a route last time and made a move in the middle stages then hung and finished out of the money; the fourth place finisher from that race, Teatoc, has come back to win.

VIVA NEVADA had an excuse last time when she got in behind rivals and was delayed but was finally seventh beaten only three lengths while Zdenka had a better finish in third; a shift is mare to Mosqueira.

MISS STEFFI had the distinction of beating maidens twice in a row but her first victory didn't count as she was disqualified; however, she was full value for her most recent try when she rallied to a clear lead before the runner up made it tight late; she now tries non winners of two.

HARLAN'S RINGS is without current momentum and has dedicated herself to route racing in four consecutive events.

UNION CONQUEROR was committed to the Fort Erie meeting and had a third place finisher there at a route in September but closed belatedly last time for just \$5,000.

GRETNA GRACIE was reserved back early in a seven furlong race last time then showed some life on the outside; she now goes from a sprint to a route.

ROYAL DEL MAR had difficulties last time; she lacked room on the turn and then closed belatedly as the favourite; she will be looking for more racing luck here and has a chance to wake up.

MAXIMUM ENTROPY makes changes here with a substantial drop for \$10,000, the blinkers are off and she goes from a sprint to a route; she went long in her previous event and raced adequately in fifth for twice today's price.

ITALIAN BEAUTY was preferred when she won October 28th but her comeback race was a tenth place finish; she drafted behind runners hoping for a big stretch charge but it didn't materialize; she now goes from two recent sprints to a route.

DEVILISH STYLE is one to entertain; she has done well in recent runs at seven furlongs and will now attempt to stretch to a route.

GOLD DIVER will be attempting the stretch out from a sprint to a route; she had earlier two turn experience and was ineffective.

SAN NICOLA BREEZE was running late at six and a half furlongs last time and now gets a longer distance with the stretch around two turns.

SLI'S HALO was in for \$5,000 at Fort Erie on turf last time where she made up lengths relative to the pace; she did go long here in this category in the summer time with a positive fourth place finish.

ZDENKA is deep into her career with one lifetime victory and she is winless in recent times but did come close two starts ago at a route in this very category.

SWEET CITY WOMAN connected at a route September 24th but hasn't been as good since and visibly hung last time.

TOUCH OF DISNEY won the Overskate October 29th at seven furlongs and was patient sitting in last place and then moving forward in the stretch on the outside; he will now go two turns for the first time in his life; he is a homebred for Bruno Schickedanz going for Norm McKnight and Moreno rides; he rates a look.

WHERE'S THE WIDGET has a string of first place finishes tracing back to October of 2015; he accounted for the Steady Growth here in the spring time beating Freitag and won the Bunty Lawless on turf recently by again dominating the pace; the fifth place finisher has come back to win; he moves back to Tapeta and has continued his prepping for Ralph Biamonte; perhaps his biggest obstacle today will be the speed coming from the outside of Nevae's Valentine which could impact him.

FREITAG is looking for his initial stakes win; he has stepped out of restricted company for recent events to try the best in the class finishing second against Are You Kidding Me in the Durham and third last time in the Autumn; that winner was seeking a spot at Churchill; he now moves into Ontario sire company with a chance to rally at what should be a hot pace and Garcia takes over.

BORN IN A BREEZE attracted a claim last time when he came awkwardly off the final turn and into the stretch; he has had an opportunity to come back and work promptly in 1.01.1 with a final quarter in 24.3; he now goes for Dan Vella.

CITO was in a first allowance event last time where he rallied from about seven lengths back and missed narrowly against the late running Maxsmiraclejourney; he is seeking his initial win of the campaign.

THOR'S ROCKET won the Vice Regent two starts ago at a route on Tapeta; most recently, he acted up prior to the break and that seemed to have an unsettling impact on him; once the start was taken, he broke poorly and was eliminated; he had a fast work November 8th in 1.00.1 with Moran aboard and he now rides for Paul Buttigieg.

KEEN GIZMO has been the runner up in consecutive events; most recently, he did his best running once the winner went by him and then he relocated outside into a clear path to chase that one; he now goes from a sprint to a route which should be a significant help; Contreras rides for Josie Carroll.

MAXSMIRACLEJOURNEY competes for the interests that have done so well with Calgary Cat, also a claimed runner; he came five wide into the stretch last time to take a first allowance event when he was going from a sprint into his initial route; he was perfectly handled by Contreras who is aboard Keen Gizmo here and Wilson will take over in this spot for Kevin Attard.

HOT KISS has been a significant earner with seven wins and \$348,000 in the bank but she has taken just a single stakes score; she came very close in the Maple Leaf when battling between rivals and then moving well to the inside through the stretch; she missed by inches; she can be a stamina force here.

NEVAEH'S VALENTINE is the wild card in this event; he has had a couple of big wins this season and a couple of narrow losses as well; his velocity instincts can have a real impact on the race and perhaps he will challenge Where's The Widget on the end.

WEST L. A. GIRL was beaten a wide margin in the Damsel Stakes at a mile on grass then took time off and returned November 13th with a significant run; she came from last place at the top of the stretch to beat Ontario sire runners at a route on Tapeta; she now goes into open company.

GIOVANNA BLUES was dedicated to turf in her opening four races for trainer Michael Dickinson but came here November 12th to try Tapeta and was heavily bet at 3-5; she made a smart backstretch move to get into contention and then gained control through the stretch in a race where blinkers were added; with Da Silva aboard Marsantropist, Husbands will take over this prime mount.

BILKY BLUZ continues to finish on the edges and that was the case last time when dropped in for a tag when Crack That Whip was the winner; she reported in fourth beaten three lengths behind that one; Wilson was aboard for a good recent work in 1.00.4 for Kevin Attard.

THIS IS MY NIGHT was out of the money on turf recently when unable to stay on through the stretch after getting good early positioning; two starts ago, she sacrificed herself in a significantly fast middle pace battle with Marsantropist who is here.

JADEMARIE can pick up the pieces; she had a significant stretch rally two starts ago to be third just a length behind in this category and was second best last time as the winner began her rally earlier; the race was set up nicely for closing types when This Is My Night and Marsantropist set a middle pace that was too quick for the leaders to continue.

HURRICANE MIMI is getting her first start since October 9th when she was out of the money on turf; she tried a run from the outside but was disappointing.

MOTOWN MELODY found the right spot November 2nd; she took a big class drop to go in a starter event and she went from a sprint to a route and dominated the front end under Husbands; changes are made here; she faces a much more difficult challenge and some others with good speed; Contreras moves in here while Husbands will be handling Giovanna Blues.

CONQUER THE SKY went long on Tapeta in this classification two stars ago and was only six lengths behind a key winner; most recently, she sprinted on turf and was moving from far on the outside but too late.

SOLO'S WARNING opted for the River Memories last time but was unable to sustain her bid; she has committed to turf in six consecutive runs and did have some good outings through September 10th.

LEMON DROP BELLE was on Tapeta in this category last time but was seventh beaten thirteen lengths when Jademarie was better in second.

CRACK THAT WHIP made a nice four wide march to win it last time and kept Bilky Bluz behind her in fourth; she had switched to the stable of Anne Cameron for that nice victory with Husbands aboard but he is handling Giovanna Blues here and Olguin will take over.

MARSANTROPIST was coming off a big route win on Tapeta two starts ago against Ontario sire company; most recently, she got her head up over the gate prior to the start and that may have had a negative impact on her; she supplied only early speed in a fierce middle pace fight with This Is My Night when going too quickly; she retired as the favourite and eventually finished sixth; she gets the outside post here.

MILWAUKEE SAINT is a debut runner for Bruno Schickedanz and was an inexpensive auction purchase by Milwaukee Brew; he goes for Norm McKnight and has had regular prepping getting ready; Alderson gets the call from the rail.

JIMBO FIVE had an ok sprint two starts ago once he got some correction after his troubled beginning, he was able to rally and finish fourth for \$19,000; most recently, he was in a key race at a route and both the first and third place finishers have come back with big wins; he drops in value and shortens in distance.

EXILE TRAIN competed in a marathon at Fort Erie last time but did not keep up and is seeking her initial career share; she shortens to just seven furlongs.

NEVER WORN had post position twelve last time and that made it difficult but aggressive speed was obvious in a six furlong race before he faltered; he did have an excuse in his previous event; he will now extend to seven furlongs.

GOLDEN JIGGS had an excuse last time when lacking room through the stretch and he finally finished tenth beaten about nine lengths; he can improve.

COURTISINSESSION raced well at this distance back in September; most recently with a drop for \$10,000, strong support showed for him and he was moving well in second in that event; he now extends out to seven furlongs for Barbara Minshall.

HEAVEN'S SAKE made a rush on the rail last time and got into contention through the stretch but hung late; he now shortens from a route to a sprint.

SCHLOSS SCHNEEBERG had a good enough race on turf at Fort Erie two starts ago when third; most recently, he fought on the pace with the winner and also the fourth place finisher then faltered; the winner came here recently and finished eleventh for \$9,500.

R SILVER HALL was at six furlongs last time and advanced from thirteenth to be fifth in an ok performance for Gerald Seymour; he gets more distance here.

CHEROKEE KNIGHT lacked any speed when he debuted October 26th; he gets Moran for this second start.

CASE IN POINT had speed positioning on the backstretch last time but wandered in a bit then had nothing left for the stretch drive.

ARCHER TRIUMPH'S was trying to follow the move of the winner around the turn last time but that one got away from him and he slipped back late; the blinkers are off and he drops down and shortens in distance.

MY PERFECT DIAMOND took a double drop in value for \$16,000 last time and rated behind the leaders but an outside rival put pressure on him and he clipped heels and lost his momentum and was finally fifth of twelve; he now drops for \$10,000 and Husbands gives him a vote of confidence.

SPEND A PENNY wasn't far away for \$10,000 last time when advancing from twelfth to be sixth beaten five lengths; Courtisinsession was in second; more room is available.

R BOOTS HALL set a pace that was rather quick last time and after overcoming some early difficulty, he made his present felt on the middle pace before faltering.

SCARLET FORESTER finished third last time for maiden \$7,500 at just five furlongs when he was used on the outside while a front running winner dominated; he is asked to stretch to seven furlongs here.
