TAKE BACK YA POILS is using the drop down angle here; that worked earlier in her campaign for a September 16th win for \$20,000; most recently, she was fifth for \$19,000 and Rince Tapaigh was better in third; she is hoping for a smoother journey in this event.

CHEDINGTON is using the big drop down angle with an out of the money finish on turf last time and now a move to Tapeta; she is without a win or a runner up finish this season but was competitive on the edges two starts ago on turf for \$47,500; she is a two time winner on the synthetic surface.

RUNAWAY BRENDA is getting her first start since September 20th at Fort Erie when she won a route on turf for \$7,500; she now goes for Margaret Denney.

RINCE TAPAIGH exited a win in a starter event to go for \$19,000 two starts ago and she performed well; most recently, she went back to a starter event and had a complete letdown in a race where Rebel Lioness was much better in third.

MODUS OPERANDI has now won two in a row; she beat Ontario sire runners last time when traveling nine furlongs on turf and she lasted in front.

SWEET ESCAPE was able to win at the \$8,000 mark when claimed by Martin Drexler October 19th and for these interests last time went to an Ontario sire event which was highly rated but she finished fifth about six lengths back; she will now return to route racing and finds an intermediate level only \$11,500.

REBEL LIONESS had a good race last time in a starter event under the lights when third and Rince Tapaigh was behind her when a distant fifth; she couldn't handle Sweet Escape at a low level two starts ago.

SCARLET FORESTER has committed to distances much shorter than seven furlongs in a series of races but will now stretch out a quarter mile after a third place finish last time for \$7,500.

FOREST CASTLE came off the shelf October 9th and was well prepared for a big effort which came at a mile on turf but he laid in through the stretch and the lead escaped him and he landed a weakening fourth; his second start following the layoff came on Tapeta last time at a route where he was ambitious on the pace but he did not stay the trip; he now goes for just \$20,000 and shortens to seven furlongs.

DIRECT DRIVE a debut runner, is a homebred for Donald Cober by Dance To Destiny and is from a dam who has produced three winners; he has prepped at Fort Erie, here on the training track and also Tapeta getting ready for Robert Gerl.

REGAL CHALLENGER finished last in a race for \$9,500 last time at six furlongs and will go up in value and out in distance.

AREOCENTRIC a debut runner for Bruno Schickedanz, is a three year old full brother to the local winner, Geocentric, who is in race seven; she was at Fort Erie earlier this season working at two week intervals and has had one local gate work since being relocated here for Julie Robillard; he is asked to go seven furlongs.

DISTINCTIVE STYLE finished third last time for \$30,000 at this distance in a race that can qualify him here; he moved after the winner took off and followed that one's path but was beaten five lengths.

BIG GILLETTE was in a heady speed battle with the last place finisher November 18th and when that one slipped behind, he had the advantage to himself then faltered in the lane and finished fourth at 6-5; he drops for \$20,000; the blinkers are off.

VINTAGE TIME took the plunge for \$12,500 last time and raced well with a rally to be second but the winner was stepping up from only the \$8,000 mark to beat him.

BOURBON BLUES debuted for maiden \$19,000 October 30th when traveling just five furlongs and was eleventh in the early going; she managed to weave her way through the field and move up to be fourth beaten three lengths behind a front running winner; she is now doubled in value and she extends by a length and a half here.

MESSY MARIE competed against some of these last time where the late pace faltered and she got closer in fifth beaten two lengths when Roxy Red was third.

JUPITER'S EAGLE competed in the same most recent race as some of these November 6th when she debuted at six furlongs; she moved outside and was finally sixth beaten just three lengths when Roxy Red was third.

GRAND INDIGO is getting her first start since October 17th of 2015 when she was second in a seven furlong event unable to hold the lead; she has had lots of prepping getting ready and has been on Tapeta lately where she worked from the gate November 20th in 1.02.4bg for Roger Atfield; she is a homebred for Chiefswood Stable.

GRAND FORTUNA closed up against some of these November 6th in a race against Ontario sire company when the late pace faltered and she was fourth beaten only a long length and was just a half length behind the third place finisher, Roxy Red.

KATHERINE'S WAR is getting her first start since 2013 and she was off form at that juncture; she makes her way back for trainer Mario Williams; she was prepping regularly through October 16th and had a subsequent work November 13th in 49.4bg.

RAINBOWS AHEAD had her big chance to wake up last Sunday when she dropped into this category and departed an out of the money finish on turf; she ran on the lead but went too quickly when pressed by the fourth place finisher; she then faded at the most inopportune time and was finally fifth as the favourite; she shortens to six and a half furlongs.

ROXY RED went from seven furlongs where she faltered to six furlongs where she stayed in contention last time against several of these and was third beaten less than a length and had several of these behind her.

REBEL MUSIC competed against several in here last time when he dropped significantly to go for only \$10,000; he advanced from twelfth to be second but the winner came back Wednesday to finish seventh; the ninth place finisher from that last race has come back to win and beat some of these.

HAYWIRE had a good late gain last time when dropped from \$20,000 in for \$10,000; he landed an ok fourth when Rebel Music was second; that was a change in style for him after being sacrificed on the pace the time before.

SEIZE THE BAY is one to consider; he ran well for \$10,000 three starts ago; he subsequently went into a key race October 16th where he lacked room; most recently, he was positioned in a marathon where he attended a pace that was much too quick and he failed; he now falls in for \$10,000.

DZALA was getting his first start of the year November 12th and finished tenth without threatening; the fifth place finisher came back to win on Wednesday.

SIMON'S SIESTA showed a touch of interest late in the stretch last time in this class when Rebel Music was better in second.

SEEDAVALLEY was used from the second flight along the inside to get a prominent position last time but had nothing to offer in the stretch.

MILWAUKEE FLASH is certainly one to consider here because of his freshness; after two sprints where he was outrun, he went to a route last time and had a significant wake up which was not unexpected; he now looks to come right back in a quick timeframe and produce another peak performance.

BARNEY COME HOME had some useful sprint races where he wasn't far away September 9th and October 11th; nothing was expected last time when he was in a protected race against a key winner; now that he drops for \$10,000, more is expected.

PLEASE PLAY AGAIN was aggressive in the early stages last time but had little left for the stretch drive when Milwaukee Flash was second.

MR. BANDULOU offered speed in a sprint last time but the top four had closing bids and he weakened to seventh.

HIGH SOCIETY was aggressive to be up on the pace but finished at the back last time in this category.

PISTON BROKE has been freshened since the close of the Fort Erie meeting and has been here prepping; he is winless for this campaign but has attracted Contreras in this spot for Allen Desruisseaux.

TOLL THE BELL is an interesting entrant worth considering; he was in a race for \$19,000 last time that earned such an inordinately high performance rating that it is understandable that he lost by eleven and a half lengths; he will now stretch around two turns with the plunge for \$9,500.

NORRIS LAKE started up on the outside last time but was finally sixth of fourteen without threatening.

BUBBA BOY can be considered here; he made a premature move from off the pace November 19th and looped to get the advantage then was passed by two rivals deep in the stretch including the second place finisher, Milwaukee Flash.

WARLORD showed some life in the stretch last time in a six furlong race and will now go much farther.

MASTER MACDUFF debuted October 30th and checked when inconvenienced in a chain reaction of interference; he finally finished a troubled fifth against a dominant speed winner and Confidentiality was second; he indicates a couple of five furlong works this month getting ready.

GORDIE MAC debuted for Dan Vella at six furlongs November 5th and was on his feet and moving forward at the end suggesting a longer distance would help; he came back to work on the training track recently in 1.01.1; he is reportedly using lasix today.

SILENT JIMMIE was starting for the second time November 5th and at six furlongs, he looked like a cinch to win with a furlong remaining; he zoomed to the outside of a couple of others but he hung in third beaten a neck as the favourite; he will now extend in distance.

GIZMO JONES has alternated between sprints and routes and continues that pattern here with a cutback to seven furlongs; in his latest going long, he gave up the lead late and landed third beaten less than two lengths; he performed well enough at this distance two starts ago when just on the edges.

FIRST IN CLASS was in for only \$20,000 when he came off the shelf last time and gave up the lead very late when beaten just a half length.

CENAR is by the popular, Society's Chairman, and debuted back on October 9th at seven furlongs and closed late from far on the outside; the winner came back to score; he has had an opportunity for lots of preps for Mike De Paulo; Campbell stays aboard.

WHERE'S THE GOLD was at six furlongs last time and once he was around the corner, he was more comfortable and finished fourth; he will now extend in distance and does have the benefits of a recent work getting ready.

SPIRIT OF CALEDON opted for a wide open maiden contest at a route last time where he was trying late and he finished only five lengths back; he now comes in against restricted company at seven furlongs and was on the edges at this distance two starts ago; the route to sprint angle is a good one for the Pat Parente stable.

PLEAD GUILTY debuted November 5th at six furlongs and from an outside post, he closed mildly; more room is available here.

CONFIDENTIALITY hopped at the break and that proved costly in his October 30th opener; he jumped up into the race at five furlongs and was second against a strong front running winner; changes are made here; lasix is added and he travels an extra quarter mile; he rates respect.

NORTHERN TRACK competed under the lights October 26th for \$20,000 and was a distant but willing fourth.

SPLIT MY PANTS debuted November 5th and took the widest possible path and when asked for his best with a furlong remaining, he came forward in fourth with Silent Jimmie two lengths better in third; the stretch in distance should be helpful and he has had an interim gate work in 49bg.

GOODOLDHOCKEYGAME has been out of the money in a series of races since the spring but has been freshened and indicates a couple of fast recent works getting ready to return for Robert Tiller; he manages to nestle into this event for non winners of two other than maiden or claiming because he is without a victory since last autumn.

ULTIMATE DESTINY was in for \$40,000 going long last time and did well from the second flight to move up and get the place award against a front running winner; he will try and shorten a quarter mile here.

CONSTANTINO is without a win over his last five races but he had a pair of wins in the spring; he is a popular off the pace sprinter who fits nicely with this group; he was third in his latest when speed was carrying and his off the pace kick was neutralized; he has an extra half furlong with which to work.

SAN NICOLA THUNDER encountered a slow pace last time and that carried him on the lead until late and he was finally third in a seven furlong race that came off the grass; both wins this season were sprint races on turf with Da Silva aboard and he takes over here.

KNUCKLE CURVE ran a sensational race in the spring of 2015 at Belmont when home in 1.09.1 on the dirt; he had a win this spring at Penn National on the dirt but has been absent since then; when he showed up here, he went to the training track for a work November 16th in 46; he now competes for David O'Connor.

NASHVILLE KNIGHT was ready to go off the shelf November 18th; he moved over to the turf and scampered away in front and was caught only late; he looks to take that enthusiasm over to Tapeta and he does handle the synthetic surface well.

FRENCH QUARTER was in a quickly run race at six furlongs last time and speed horses dominated; he found himself a length and a half off the late run of the third place finisher, Constantino.

TED W found himself in an awkward spot in the Overskate Stakes last time; he was mired on the rail and when a rival could not find adequate space to advance, he was laying on this one; he finally finished sixth beaten five and a half lengths; he did win for \$40,000 at this exact distance two starts ago with a good trip when he improved twenty five performance points first time off the claim.

GENEROUS CONSORT was in a tough first allowance event last time from a wide post and never did enter contention but earned a high performance rating after her outside trip; she had been in against key winners previously; she seeks relief here for \$16,000.

STRAWBERRY SCARLET was game to win a route race two starts ago for \$23,500; most recently, she was trying to double up but the winner got by from the outside very late at the \$19,000 mark; she will cut back to six furlongs and was running well at that distance back in September and is now at a reduced evaluation.

SWEET CORINNA dropped low enough to ensure a victory November 6th and won it on the front end with Boulanger who has opted for Strawberry Scarlet here; she now goes for Scott Fairlie and shortens to a sprint.

NO SOUP FOR YOU was at the back at the break October 15th in a six and a half furlong event in a difficult first allowance race taken by a key winner; she now seeks relief dropping sharply for \$16,000.

SWEET BREW dropped in for \$10,000 last time and scooted up the rail into contention but couldn't improve her position deep in the stretch; she is up in value now.

GEOCENTRIC had deteriorating form but woke up last time when dropped into the right spot by Norm McKnight and she produced her fourth win of the campaign and attracted a claim by Ross Armata; she did well in that last event to salvage the win.

DANGEROUS PURSUIT came from Edmonton to compete here October 22nd in a quickly run race and after a speed contribution, she did well to finish fourth beaten three lengths by Geocentric; most recently, she went to turf where not much was expected and now she is back on Tapeta; she rates a look.

KAY'S GRACE is a question mark here as she is of unknown status currently; this will be her first race since August; she was forced to scratch September 17th; she was on the edges in a solid display in her latest at the second allowance level and now she runs for just \$16,000.

ELTONINADRESS has won four of five races in Edmonton this season; she has been freshened since August and now nestles in here for \$16,000; she has had previous action on a synthetic surface with positive results.

KATALOX tried to steal the Clarendon Stakes with a furlong remaining but was caught very late by a second time starter from the Casse stable; still, he earned a significant performance rating and comes right back at six furlongs for Ricky Griffith; he competes for Racing Canada Inc. and Debmar Stables.

WELLABLED comes in for Carolyn Wilson and goes for high percentage trainer, Larry Rivelli; after capturing the Grade 3 Arlington Washing Futurity in Chicago, he doubled up in the Fitz Dickson Memorial at Presque Isle over Tapeta; most recently, he was in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita and was in a pace fight with the winner, Oscar Performance, and gave up several positions late; he has had an opportunity to work in 46.3 at Hawthorne in Chicago getting ready for this cutback to six furlongs on Tapeta.

UNCLE B improved second time out and made all of the running for a six furlong win in 1.09.4 and was hand ridden the last twelve jumps; he has been busy with a series of works on the training track for Nick Gonzalez; he competes for Lou Tucci and Martha Gonzalez.

SAILING HOME was preferred when he debuted October 30th and he did not disappoint as the second choice while his mate was favoured and finished second; he was ten lengths the best in 1.09.3; since that time, he has had consecutive fast works at five furlongs in 59.3 for Mark Casse; he competes for Conrad Farms and Husbands once again has the mount in this second start.

UNDULATED ran from off the pace in a winning debut at Laurel on turf going short; second time out there in the Laurel Futurity, he fought with the third place finisher and beat that one late but was passed at the last moment; he comes in for Cathal Lynch and competes for M M G Stables; he is well bred by Curlin.

CHIEFROLL'NTHUNDER is back on a quick timeframe after a race last Sunday on turf when he got in against a highly regarded winner and couldn't handle the middle speed of that rival and weakened to be fourth after the chase; he had indicated gameness at a mile on turf the time before; he now switches to Tapeta as a speed component going around two turns.

ARTHUR'S PASS has had three consecutive runner up finishes; in his latest with Olguin aboard, he could not handle a dominant speed runner on turf and that one has already repeated; he gets back to Tapeta and had a peak performance on this surface two starts ago.

GRAY PHANTOM was out of the money on turf two starts ago but dropped down and went to the winner's circle on Tapeta October 16th; he came from last on the turn to win it in exciting fashion with Boulanger aboard who is once again up at this higher level.

CITO is certainly one to consider given his good race last time in this category when third beaten less than a length; the winner rallied and the runner up has already come back to be a stout second.

DR. HARKNESS is looking to make some adjustments here with a jump in value and a switch to a route; his lone win of the campaign came going right handed on turf.

FORESTER'S DESTINY did not have a clean trip two starts ago and landed on the edges beaten a length; most recently when he jumped to this level at seven furlongs, he ran strongly in third; he is now asked to go two turns and Contreras moves in.

EKATI WILDCAT is getting his first start since September when he was behind in double digits on turf; he had won big on grass the time before on a yielding surface; he will now go to Tapeta and worked on this surface November 16th in 1.00.3 for Roger Attfield.

AWESOME FIVE is a career sprinter who will now stretch out; he had a big race last time for \$40,000 against non winners of two; he was narrowly beaten when a torrid pace weakened right at the end but he couldn't reach top spot.

BEAR AT LAST beat Ontario sire runners with a perfect trip November 12th to take his third career score; the time before, he was surprised late when the winner found room at the last instant.

SOROKOLITIS was a winner two starts ago at Fort Erie but had a letdown performance there last time when on the edges against the 6-5 winning favourite.

PHIL'S COCKTAIL dropped into a likely spot November 20th except that the heavy favourite, Gentleman Jackson, ruled that event; he was a threatening presence behind the winner through the stretch but gave up a position late; he attracted a claim and now goes for Steven Chircop; he rates a look.

RUVEE is without a victory this season and is without a share in his last several tries; he was on the edges against Tevez last time.

DAN'S REVENGE handled this distance well enough in his previous event to finish on the edges when he had a challenging trip and the winner was disqualified for interference against him; most recently, he ran well when just behind Tevez.

GENTLEMAN JACKSON beat the bias with a big speed approach last time and kept Phil's Cocktail in third; he has taken consecutive wins at low levels while aggressively marketed and finally attracted a claim last time; he now goes for Mike Wright Jr.

DO YA WANNA had speed last time but was used up in a duel with the eventual tenth place finisher and then faded to ninth.

SHOGUN RUA was pulled up November 11th; he has had a few weeks since that incident and does indicate a training track work November 18th getting ready to come back.

DREAM ON JOHNNIE fully committed to speed November 11th in a five furlong event alongside the eventual eleventh place finisher then faded to eighth.

FEW WHITE HAIRS opted for a stalking trip behind a wall of rivals last time and finally finished about five lengths behind a key winner who was disqualified; he is in the mix.

GOLDEN RIDGE typically picks longer races than this and was at a route last time when he pressed the pace into the stretch then stopped; he shortens to six furlongs.

STAY DETERMINED is one of two in the race for Dorothy Gentner along with Mr. Honey Badger; his race here October 30th featured good speed for \$10,000 and he was beaten only five lengths finishing on the edges in a tie with Few White Hairs.

TEVEZ made his own racing luck November 11th when he found an opening at the top of the stretch and was perfectly handled by Pinto to catch up with the leader deep in the stretch for his seventeenth lifetime win; he has often handled this distance well and will now stretch out a furlong; Ryan now rides.

WARBRED was moving from the outside on the turn last time but finally finished five lengths behind Tevez and now goes farther.

MR. HONEY BADGER did not produce when here in the spring but did win on the Tapeta surface at Presque Isle October 6th; he has been freshened since that ninth career score.

SCOTTY'S EGO had the inside post last time and made a move on the rail from off the pace but was finally seven lengths behind in that Ontario sire event; he drops sharply now to go for \$7,500.
