**SPRING EDITION** competed at six and a half furlongs November 20<sup>th</sup> after returning from a month away and was locked into a two horse speed race which he lost narrowly to a longshot winner; he will now attempt to go two turns on the quick comeback.

**GAMBLE'S CITIZEN** was second best in his debut at seven furlongs then stretched out second time and added lasix; he was the 6-5 favourite and moved in the stretch as if he had a chance to win in but he lacked room at a crucial stage and finally had to settle for fourth beaten two and a half lengths; he remains a strong contender.

**CLASSIC FORCE** debuted October 29<sup>th</sup> and had early prominence in a race that came off turf but he backed away; he applied himself in a work October 25<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.2 with a good reaching stride and now goes farther.

**CANMORE** a homebred for Chiefswood Stable, is bred to be a stayer and stretched out last time but finished sixth when Gamble's Citizen was better in fourth; he had an interim work November 24<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.3 for Mike De Paulo.

**SOUTHERN GREATNESS** returns as a gelding; he missed the break last time and was never in contention and that was a letdown compared to his previous good race at a route where he set the pace; he worked November 19<sup>th</sup> with Husbands aboard in 1.01.2 getting ready to come off the shelf.

**MORE PERFECT** a homebred for Charles Fipke, is from his Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf winner, Perfect Shirl, and will go here for Roger Attfield; he has had plenty of prepping in company; Hernandez rides with blinkers on.

**RAYREADY** has been in consecutive routes without threatening although he did stay close to the early pace last time before finishing eighth; the third place finisher has since scored.

**DIVINE AMI** a homebred for Ivan Dalos, is from a dam who was a three time route winner and this one will debut at a route; he has had plenty of works in positive times getting ready and Boulanger will ride.

**CLUTCH CATCH** debuted October 29<sup>th</sup> for Sam-Son Farm and post twelve was an obstacle but he finished an ok fourth; he must take up the widest post once again here but should be that much better in his second start; the runner directly behind him, Colton's Corner, came back to beat Spring Edition recently.

**STARLING'S LAW** was introduced here October 10<sup>th</sup> and ran on the edges in an ok race on turf when Spin The King was the winner; most recently, she found a more acceptable spot and dropped for \$25,000 with a shift to Tapeta at six furlongs; he moved very well in the stretch to be second against Midnite Poppa who is here.

**PERFECT TAY** was on turf last time at a mile and was in a bit tight then backed away late; he finally wasn't too far behind at the end and the runner up has come back with a nice win; he goes to Tapeta and fits; Wilson has won with him in the past.

**MIDNITE POPPA** came here from Edmonton to win big November 2<sup>nd</sup> for \$25,000 and he was claimed; for new interests last time, he was put into a difficult spot at a route and made a good middle move then was done by mid stretch; he now drops for \$32,000 and shortens back to a sprint.

**SPIN THE KING** has done some nice running on Tapeta in the past and did win on turf for \$40,000 two starts ago; most recently, he wasn't as good for \$40,000 at seven furlongs and he backed away and now moves to Tapeta.

**FOREST BROTHER** has been out of the money in a series of events; he was in for \$37,500 last time when he closed a big gap on turf to be on the edges; he now shifts to Tapeta.

**DAN THE TIN MAN** dropped down to take an edge for \$16,000 two starts ago on Tapeta and rallied best; he doubled up in a starter event last time which featured a very fast clocking and he rallied precisely; he goes for \$32,000 on a jump now trying to rely on his good current form; the seven furlong distance is a challenge for him.

**CREEPING BARRAGE** trailed inside November 19<sup>th</sup> and was finally about ten lengths back in a first allowance event; he drops down and goes farther.

**HEUSTON** competed at only five furlongs on the turf at Churchill last time where closing types dominated and he was just five lengths behind; he came here in unproductive form August 5<sup>th</sup> to win at a mile on turf; he has had production on a synthetic surface in the past; he competes for Conor Murphy.

**RUN TO THE BANK** had the elements against him last time; he was off the pace when slow fractions were set and he finally finished an ok fourth beaten four lengths; Husbands once again has the mount and this time, comes from the outside post; he likes the distance

**UNBRIDLED PIPER** had a close up finish on Tapeta in late August and in two October starts on turf, he handled himself well with a maiden score and a tie for third last time; he moves back to Tapeta here for Chiefswood Stable.

**PARTY AT EIGHT** got in behind a wall of runners two starts ago and was delayed; he shifted to Tapeta at seven furlongs last time where he came running through the stretch from fourteenth to be sixth with an inside advance but the winner was dominant and that first place finisher, Roxy's Vision, is here; he stretches out.

**GAZCADER** had an awkward departure from the gate last time when trying to double up but circled runners on the turn and stayed willingly to be third; he comes right back under the same terms.

**TIMINGISEVERYTHING** dropped in for \$10,000 last time and cut back in distance and had such a significant edge on that group that he rallied from fourteenth to win it easily; the fifth place finisher has already come back to win; he attracted a claim by Mike De Paulo and now goes back up to the Ontario sire first allowance level.

**FRITZIE'S BOY** was quite good on turf last time to be second best; he slumped in his previous event on Tapeta but has the benefits of a couple of good recent works on Tapeta getting read for this shift in surfaces.

**HOCKEY** had a complicated trip two starts ago when third and seemed to be an obvious one last time but he encountered difficulty on the first turn when a downed rider was in his vicinity and he seemed to lose focus; he is up in value for this event.

**ROXY'S VISION** had such an improved run October 11<sup>th</sup> at Fort Erie on dirt when second; he earned a performance rating here at seven furlongs last time that seemed to be well beyond his potential but he won in smashing style for just \$20,000 and he was thorough; he now looks to jump in value and stretch back out in distance.

**FRASCATI GOLD** made a four wide move from the second flight last time but stalled and was out of the money when Gazcader was second.

**FINAL OFFER** revisited the speed style that he exhibited here so successfully in the spring when he won November 23<sup>rd</sup>; he seemed to enjoy galloping loose on the lead in that event for \$9,500 and he beat the bias and improved eleven performance points for that sparkling victory.

**GRACEFUL DAWN** returned after an extraordinary long time away from the game November 12<sup>th</sup> to compete and was eighth beaten eleven lengths in a sprint; she will now go long in this second start on the comeback trail.

**CATTY REMARK** had an awkward break in her debut November 12<sup>th</sup> but showed significant recovery power to advance and finish fourth; lasix is now added and she stretches around two turns and rates a look.

**MAGIC SKYS** certainly fits with this group with the significant drop to go for only \$12,500; she was in against an impossible favourite last time and while she couldn't keep up there, she finished fourth beaten only seven lengths; she now goes for \$12,500.

**STAR VIXEN** has been moved over to the stable of Sandy McPherson after she went from a sprint to a route on the lead last time but was against the bias and understandably faltered out of the money.

**BOMBITA** was in the same most recent race as some of these last time and was lapped by the winner and then retreated when Ofelia Girl took second with a late rush while she settled for third.

**SWEET 'N' WILD** a debut runner, is a five year old going for Clint Abraham and she indicates prepping getting ready since the middle of October with consecutive works at five furlongs; she will travel a route here at first asking.

**MISS BAO TO U** is taking a significant drop following a solid second place finish at six and a half furlongs for \$30,000 last time; she did have a good effort going long back in the summer time; she will stretch out here for just \$12,500 and Olguin keeps the mount for Mike De Paulo; she fits.

**GOT PUMP** was in a seven furlong race last time where she couldn't get positive positioning and she will now extend in distance.

**SLOVENIA** stayed well last time in a seven furlong race for \$9,500 when she raced close to the pace and made a bid in the stretch then hung taking a minor award; this will be her first route.

**OFELIA GIRL** is worth considering given her late energy last time for \$7,500 when she moved from tenth to be second while Bombita was in third; she did have others in here behind her last time.

**BID'S KID** tried a speed style last time over a surface more helpful to closing types and she couldn't carry on.

**DIAMOND TIME** had no impact at a route last time in the same race where Ofelia Girl was better in second.

**ERIE BREEZE** was beaten only six lengths last time but Ofelia Girl and Bombita both had better performances when in the money.

**GLORIOUS** is certainly one to consider; this will be her first race since September 9<sup>th</sup> when she was third on turf and both the fifth and seventh place finishers have come back to win; it is just a case of how well she is able to do with the switch over to Tapeta; she typically picks turf but now she goes for only \$12,500 with the drop.

**ANGEL'S GATE** was running on nicely at the end last time for \$10,000 at seven furlongs; she did have an earlier route failure but seems to be in better form now for this second lifetime try at a route.

**SUMMER MAGIC** is certainly one to consider given the devaluation today; two starts ago, she was fourth in a sprint when Miss Bao To U was second; most recently at a route, she stayed one paced which is a good sign and now that she drops, she becomes more of a factor but needs to draw in.

**BUTLER'S PICK** has been close up in second in consecutive events but has had difficulty keeping a straight course and that has been costly; he raced to the outside of the front running winner last time and missed narrowly; the inside post becomes somewhat of a challenge but he is capable.

**FULLTHROTTLE KID** was bothered by the fourth place finisher leaving the gate last time and then scrambled to get into the race from behind rivals and finished a weakening fifth; both the second and ninth place finishers have come back to win; he moves off turf and over to Tapeta with a chance tonight.

**CANADA WISE DON** is stepping up in value after a failed attempt at five furlongs last outing; he is encountering too many other good pace runners here.

**THANK PHIL** is a debut runner for Robert Tiller; he was an auction purchase and is by Philanthropist and has had a full schedule of preps leading to this event including a work November 24<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.1; Husbands gets the call in this launch.

**GOLD SHARK** was thought to be in an ideal position last time because of the proposed duel between the top two finishers, yet, he couldn't close effectively enough and landed third beaten almost two lengths; the blinkers are on tonight and that may have him more alert.

**GASCONADE** had a four wide speed approach last time but hung and then fell out of contention; that race was different from his previous event when he was quite smart from off the pace; he now drops for \$40,000 for Dave Cotey and moves to Tapeta.

**DAILY BREW** had a bobble at the gate last time and then got into the running but had somewhat of a stifled trip on the backstretch and was finally fourth when Butler's Pick was second; with a better departure from the gate, he can have more of an impact.

**TRUBAR** a debut runner for Robert Gerl, has stamina on the top of his pedigree and speed on the bottom as his dam won numerous sprint events; he was prepping on the training track the early part of November then came for a gate work on Tapeta recently in 38.4bg.

**BUDDING** figured to be right up on the pace with Butler's Pick last time but chased that one; he seemed to do his very best running late in the race when he got to the outside and his outwardly post here should be helpful.

**SYDNEY BAY** debuted in the same race where Butler's Pick was second and Budding was third and he didn't have much impact at long odds; he has had interim work in 1.00.3 getting ready.

**WARDO** improved significantly second time out; he made a big run at the top of the stretch for \$30,000 to get the lead only to have a preferred runner get by him; he guarded second money late; he is looking to build on that last good race.

**MISSY CRISSY** easily took her maiden win in her second start when she went around two turns and dominated the issue on the front end; most recently in the much tougher Princess Elizabeth Stakes, she was asked to rate inside and then she closed mildly to be fifth while Cindervella was sixth and Crumlin Queen was tenth; Husbands who was aboard for her big win two starts ago, climbs aboard in this more restricted outing; she competes for Harlequin Ranches.

**SASSY OMBRE** has sharp speed and has won two of four races; in the Fanfreluche Stakes two starts ago, she was used up and had nothing left for the stretch drive; most recently with a more tempered approach with Boulanger aboard, she had a more prosperous journey in front to win at 10-1 beating Green Freedom back into third in that first allowance event for Ontario sire company; she must now go around two turns and encounters the speed of Silver Princess; she competes for Gail Wood.

**CINDERVELLA** looked good winning the South Ocean Stakes; she waited until quite late to move and then won it against Crumlin Queen; most recently in the Princess Elizabeth in an attempt to wait for the stretch run, she camped in behind rivals on the turn and then was finally sixth of eleven; she has a chance to rally here; she competes for Frank Annecchini & D'Alimonte Holdings.

**SILVER PRINCESS** won her debut and that was fully expected in a six furlong maiden contest; second time out, she went to the Victorian Queen Stakes where she once again was positioned with a clear lead but she slipped back late and finished third beaten just a length; she trained smartly November 20<sup>th</sup> in 48.1 getting ready to go two turns here for Roger Attfield; she competes for Osprey Stable.

**TETHRA'S MAGIC** a homebred for Eaton Hall Farm, goes for Mike Doyle; she took a maiden win last time at six furlongs when she raced from farther off the pace by design and had a quicker and more thorough stretch kick; she has since worked well in 1.01.1; she now goes two turns for the first time.

**CRUMLIN QUEEN** had a good race in the restricted South Ocean two starts ago when Cindervella was the winner; most recently in the Princess Elizabeth, she was used on the turn for a middle move but couldn't sustain it in the stretch and finished next to last.

**GREEN FREEDOM** was in a seven furlong race last time where she was heavily favoured because of her ability to close but she couldn't catch up with the speed of Sassy Ombre and settled for second beaten a length and a half; this will be her first route engagement.

**ELLAN VANNIN** debuted just recently in a successful opener at six and a half furlongs and will now stretch around two turns from the widest post against these who are more seasoned; once again, Alderson rides for Tony Gattellaro; she competes for Jon Lee.

**STARSHIP GAMBLER** made an inside move from the second flight last time and found room and finished fourth against Extremist with Just Coz second; that was a route event and now she goes just seven furlongs and Extremist has since come back to win and is here.

**THIS IS THE WAY** had a nice little burst at the end last time in a six and a half furlong race to be four lengths behind when Lucky Melissa was second and Forest Pike was third and there is an extra half furlong available; she rates a look for a minor prize.

**QUEENSTOWN** is a noted two turn runner who will shorten to go just seven furlongs; she started a run at the quarter pole last outing and advanced but Extremist and Just Coz were clear and she finally finished fifth.

**EMMA'S LOVE** had to run from off a slow pace last time and finished only sixth at long odds when Extremist was the winner; she shortens in distance here.

**PENNY STAMP** got going too quickly on the pace November 19<sup>th</sup> at six and a half furlongs and gave up positions late when a preferred winner rallied best and Lucky Melissa was second and Forest Pike was third; she stretches to seven furlongs.

**MORE THAN BANDEAU** had the rail post last time and came away in last position and couldn't generate much power in that quickly run race which was taken by Extremist.

**LUCKY MELISSA** was twelfth in the early going last time in a six and a half furlongs race then made an amazing move advancing to the lead with a circling run only to come up shy when a preferred winner ran by her at the end; that good performance points her out as a contender here but she needs a breakthrough win.

**FOREST PIKE** is worth considering; she lacked some room last time but stayed on to be an ok third when Lucky Melissa was two lengths better in second.

**EXTREMIST** has now won two in a row for Norm McKnight; when she won at seven furlongs last time, she came four wide at the top of the stretch and was clear at the end in a good time; she now goes down in value looking to make it three in a row.

**JUST COZ** ran well last time when second against Extremist and went her third quarter in a sparkling 24.1 but the winner edged her out late; she will shorten to seven furlongs here.

**YARMORKA** made an inside move on the turn last time but couldn't continue on in contention through the stretch against a preferred winner when Lucky Melissa was second.

**WILD DYNA** was in for \$6,000 last time against some of these and moved far on the outside and was beaten only five lengths when Lucky Melissa was second; she needs a breakthrough victory.

**HAGGAT HALL** makes a belated comeback for her initial try of 2016 and was without momentum about this time last year; she has trained over short distances getting ready.

**PURELY'S BID** is stretching from five to six furlongs after a belated close last time when fifth of twelve; she has just a couple of shares on the synthetic surface from many tries.

**BEL AYR BAY** was competing at five furlongs last time when she used her speed to get positioning and she carried it well enough to be third when Mahogany Cat was second.

**MISS ANTEAS** was more thorough at five furlongs two starts ago in third than last time at six furlongs when she slumped in seventh and Hazel Meadow was better in second; she does have the benefits of interim prepping.

**EXORDIUM** debuted October 18<sup>th</sup> at Fort Erie at long odds for \$5,000 and had sharp early speed but did not stay.

**ANTE UP AUNTEE** stalled on the outside last time then backed away and wasn't nearly as thorough as her promising opener.

**ZLATICA** had four wide speed last time at five furlongs and continued inside in fourth against a debut winner who won it.

**DISCREET HARMONY** was here for a run November 2<sup>nd</sup> at six furlongs when attending the pace but slipped back when Hazel Meadow was better in second.

**COOL RESPECT** fell out of contention early when coming off the shelf November 13<sup>th</sup> at just five furlongs and is without a career share.

**HAZEL MEADOW** was blocked in her previous event and had to settle for fifth; with blinkers on and a clear run last time at this distance for \$10,000, she was simply second best; she gets to drop one level and Campbell retains the mount for Robert Tiller.

**JOSAI'S ANGEL** scratched from a race November 19<sup>th</sup> and will go here instead; she is without a career share.

**MOLINARO ANNA** stalled along the inside last time in the same race where Boots Are Made For was better in second; she will shorten by a half furlong.

**REDSTRIPECONQUEROR** has lost by wide margins in recent events; she went from five furlongs to a route last time where she did not stay the trip.

**DEPUTY WANDA** lacked some room last time then found some space along the inside and had a significant late gain last time; she rates attention.

**MAHOGANY CAT** took the big drop two starts ago and had speed but no finish; when she got down to this low level last time at five furlongs, she won a pace duel but lost the race very late to a first time starter; she goes six furlongs tonight.

**BOOTS ARE MADE FOR** was a solid second November 19<sup>th</sup> for \$10,000 when running against the speed bias; she was a staying second in her previous race; she will be a threat if she draws in.
