



Woodbine Thoroughbred Handicapping Challenge Quick Reference Guide

What you'll need to play:

- Your account card (to be provided upon Challenge Check-In)
- Your secret PIN number
- Daily Racing Form & Programs (to be provided free of charge at Challenge)
- Your picks!

Tracks which are eligible for wagering in this Challenge:

- **Woodbine**
- **Saratoga**
- **Monmouth**
- **Fort Erie (Sunday Only)**

Please note: Only these racetracks can be bet on. Any bet made outside of these racetracks will result in disqualification.

How to place a wager in the Challenge:

1. Make sure you use the correct Account Card if you have 2 entries (Card A, Card B)
2. Find a Challenge self-serve terminal
3. Swipe Card and Enter PIN
4. Select your track from the list of eligible racetracks
5. Select the race you would like to wager on, if not the current race
6. Select your bet type. The **ONLY eligible** bet type is:
 - **WIN/PLACE (WP)**
7. Select your bet amount → **\$2**
8. Select your horse #
9. If you would like a paper record of your bets, press **“Finish with Receipt”**

Please note: Any bet types or amounts outside of the constraints of the Challenge will result in disqualification. ONLY one \$2 WP bet is permitted in any given race.

There is also a cap on Challenge payouts: Win cap is 20/1 (\$42.00); Place cap is 10/1 (\$22.00). Please note, these caps only affect the Challenge Leaderboard and DO NOT affect the actual payout of your bet, i.e. you will still earn the entire bet payout.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- **DO NOT WITHDRAW** any cash from your Account Card until you are finished wagering, as it will not be able to be re-deposited. Any withdrawals will not be reflected on your balance in the leaderboard standings.
- **ONLY \$2 WIN/PLACE** bets are permitted in this challenge (i.e. WP). Win & Place bet must be made on the same horse.
- **YOU MUST WAGER ON EXACTLY TEN (10) DIFFERENT RACES PER CHALLENGE DAY.**
- **YOU MUST WAGER ON ALL THREE (3) MANDATORY RACES PER CHALLENGE DAY AS PART OF YOUR TEN (10) BETS.**
- **DON'T FORGET** to withdraw the balance of your Account Card before you leave for the day. All cash on the account is yours to keep.
