

5 BKS FELLOW is hopefully going to make the adjustment to the Woodbine track well enough to take a first start score to kick off tonight's 12-race program. He's won twice previously. I favour that part of the profile. The other males have a single win only. Females with two victories are also considered risky by this handicapper. Zeron was the first choice driver but he might stick with Weslynn Legacy.

2 MARYS OUT CRUISIN has a chance to work out an up close trip if Ouellette changes strategy tonight and uses an early speed approach. The off the pace style worked well enough last time but if an early advantage can be had it would be an asset to my way of thinking. I'll use her for the second spot in the predicted order of finish.

7 WESLYNN LEGACY continues to add to her bankroll on a regular basis and one night the third victory will show up. That win would push her up into the next highest category. I'm going to miss out when that next win does show up. She always attracts wagering support and won't offer a price to suit the risk anytime in the near future.

3 THIRD COPY should be in the double digit range from an odds standpoint. I would have to see a price in that range to play any of the one time winner or a female with two victories, which is the case with this mare. I'd consider her as a second option for the win position if I like what I see when Monday night rolls around.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) DOHINI SURFER looked like he should win last time and win he did. Doubling up is a possibility but that result might depend on what the long term outlook is in the mind of the trainer. Baillargeon might be in the mode to score again quickly while the going is good.

(4) HEEZA CREDIT doesn't have much to offer in the way of good current results. That should just about guarantee a longshot price. Moiseyev is one of my "go to" drivers when looking for an upset.

(6) WEDGEWOOD missed a scheduled start on February 13 for reasons unknown to this handicapper. I'll watch tonight since he hasn't been in competition since January 13.

(8) STAGE FRIGHT reduced the beaten lengths substantially last time but didn't improve from a finish standpoint. Maybe tonight she can do better to earn part of the \$19,000 in prize money.

(9) MARABOU could have been rated higher than this. Post 9 was a factor that I didn't care for but with his off the pace style that might not be a major factor. She can win again and not have to change classifications until the third victory shows up.

(10) HERTZ SEELSTER hasn't had very good luck in the post position draw recently. Put him on the list of triactor possibilities as another option. The second victory might be delayed for a while longer.

8 ENCORE SEELSTER gets the call to post what might be a mild upset over the class dropping Power Off and the other six racers that contest this bottom level money won event. I'm thinking that Preszcator will have him prepped for a high level performance. Any kind of racing luck might be all that it takes to get him the winner's share.

7 POWER OFF slides down the class ladder to the bottom rung again. That change should get him lots of wagering support but he has failed recently at this level and more than once. That history makes him somewhat risky if the price is too low. I wouldn't want to put all the eggs into one basket when considering the number one position on any tickets that you might be considering.

4 ILL CALL U BACK is another pacer that moves to the major circuit tonight. He and my top selection both have good current form to offer. Pereira often uses McNair as the driving partner when he races on our circuit. We see that set up again. Only once in six starts this year did he failed to finish in the top three but he hasn't been able to record the first victory yet. He's a playable item.

5 EYE OF DESIRE missed a schedule race on February 11. That extends the time between races. I chose to rate him only as an upsetter and will wait until next time when he has this more recent race to consider. If he shows a suitable performance/result tonight he will look more appealing next time around. Scott Zeron picked up the drive at scratch time.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) BRUSIERS BROTHER had his best production prior to last year when he won only two races and ended with a bankroll of just slightly better than \$30,000. He might have trouble beating them all tonight if some of the competition show up to do their best work.

(2) ROCK THE WIND hasn't given any strong hints that he might win soon. I took a cautious approach when rating him. I might get fooled but he looked like a prospect to earn a small purse share.

(3) PANDA BEAR won at a low level at Flamboro two back. The class rise for his last start made it more difficult for him. This race isn't any easier the way I see it.

(6) RISKY RICH was a well-beaten seventh last time. The start prior to that had the same result. Hudon does fool us on occasion when driving a longshot. What's your guess about that happening tonight? I didn't think so.

4 FRENCHFRYSNVINEGAR should rate as the one to beat even with the gap in her racing schedule. A high profile/successful trainer such as Gillis should be able to prep a talented trotter or pacer well enough to produce a winning performance after a short break and especially so when the competition is not that strong. The excuse is always there surrounding the time off and a start needed. What's your guess?

6 WINDSONG GEANT was able to beat my top selection on January 2 when she started a comeback following a more lengthy break in her racing schedule. There was not much separating the two that night. If she is going to be upset he might be the one to do it. He did get to race at a lower level on January 30 to shorten the gap between races when compared to the one above.

2 SARKOZY debuts for a new team tonight in his first local appearance. He is a bit of an unknown factor. He was scheduled to qualify on Thursday but the qualifiers were cancelled that day and held on Friday. It appears that he didn't make the starting line up that morning. He's a bit of a maybe and might be dropped down to a lower rating on race night.

3 ORDER BY ROOSEVELT hits some tougher rivals tonight. I thought he might beat some of the competition but have to settle for something less than a top two finish. Rating him below the top three might backfire and you might want to consider a spot in some of your triactor combinations for this seven year old. Give trainer Carman Hie high marks for the consistent results and driver Paul MacDonell.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) AMIGO DE GRANDE should be a longshot item again and had to be rated that way. I have to wait on him until the trainer can find an easier situation. This is too tough.

(5) STRONG HOPE doesn't have enough to offer to be considered for a top three result with the competition as it is. The best result that I can predict for him would be a lesser share of the prize money.

(7) IMMINENT RESPONSE had sights set on his second win of the year last week but just failed to last the distance and got picked off by two rivals, one of which is in the lineup again tonight. He rates on a par with some of the competition and could be included in the triactor scheme.

(8) PROTÉGÉ SEELSTER tries for three in a row. The triple will be difficult to produce if the highest rated selections don't falter. Waples picked up the catch driver after MacDonell elected to stick with Order By Roosevelt.

4th Race Selections 5-9-3-6**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL**

5 ROCKNALBERT didn't show much in his debut performance on February 13 as a 66-1 item. Performance/results suited the first start profile. To consider him tonight the guess has to be made about how much he might improve in the second try now that he has one race for experience. He might go forward with a better effort--he might not. That's the risk but we might get a fair price tonight. I'm hoping that Mayotte will drive again but he did have the second option of choosing Nbr 10. I'll gear my top three choices towards the pick 4 wager. A different strategy might be taken for the single race wagers with different selections for the second and third spots.

9 BLISSFULL YEARS had a good enough result in his comeback start on February 13 that I would be willing to give him a good look when selecting win candidates in the first of four races that make up the early pick 4 sequence. He might need a replacement driver. Zeron was a popular item in this race with no less than three to choose from. The others were Windsong Hardrock and Northern Prize. The improved performance over last year's results is encouraging.

3 PLAYIN IT STRAIGHT has off the shelf status that might be enough to cause some bettors to take a pass and wait for another night when he offers a more recent competitive race result to consider. That would be logical but in NW1 contests logic doesn't always hold up. It might be easier to separate those that might be played from those that shouldn't be considered on race night when the observations at that time can be added to the past performance information. For now, I'll give him a top three rating.

6 TALLDARKNHANDSOME is one of three racers in the field that has won previously. He might handle the move to the major circuit well enough to finish up close. He's being partnered tonight by a driver that is often aggressive and has a trainer that has had some success at Woodbine or Mohawk in the past with others on occasion.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) WINDSONG HARDROCK hinted in recent races that his first win might come along at any time. He's another options that cannot be eliminated quickly. Much will depend on what each trainer wants to accomplish tonight and which driver(s) are the most aggressive.

(2) DJ LANCE had his best result in his first start when testing Flamboro Downs competition. He wasn't very successful last time when he moved to Woodbine. I'm going to have to watch tonight.

(4) NORTHERN PRIZE is another racer in the field that has a win. He might be the choice that Zeron makes since he does have a past association with the trainer. He has as much to offer as any of the others.

(7) ABOVE ALL had a compromised trip last time. Can give him a chance to finish higher than predicted but I preferred others as win candidates. A top three result is possible.

(8) KEEP BACK HANOVER had light success in his 2 year old campaign when opportunities were limited to five starts. He scares me enough that if the price is right he might have to be subject of a re-evaluation on race night depending on what we see at that time.

(10) IM SID THE KID had a trip/result to suit the post 9 situation on February 6. If you use only his best results you could consider if post 10 is beatable in your opinion.

Pick 4 suggestion Race 4 (3/5/9) Race 5 (2/3/4) Race 6 (2/6/9) Race 7 (3/7) Options could be expanded in any of the four legs if using the .20 cent wagering format. Playing a percentage wager of 20, 40, 60 or 80% reduces the cost and allows for more choices to be used.

2 CREIGHTON HANOVER got off to a good start when he made his 2012 debut at Flamboro on February when he won as he pleased as the heavily supported race favourite. He has some faster rivals to beat tonight if he is going to double up to stay undefeated on the year. In 2011 he spent time on the O.S.S. grass roots tour. He didn't strike gold but did pick up a few nuggets. How much faster can he be tonight is the big question.

4 PISTON BROKE struck for his third career victory on February 13 on a night when wagering support suggested that a high level performance was expected. He might be right back to win again this night but I am going to try to beat him for the top spot with my top selection and if it works as predicted it should help the pick 4 payoff.

3 TOBINS FORTUNE has been rated higher than this previously. He didn't fare too well when moved to the non-claiming ranks last week. He will have to pick it up tonight to be an impact player. This race offers two wagering options that could produce a jackpot type payoff. The Pick 4 and Superfecta are both on the wagering menu. Maybe?

1 BATTLE CALL ended 2011 with a double digit number in the win column with much of his success taken at the smaller tracks. After two fringe results at Woodbine he could be considered as a triactor or superfecta prospect and maybe for an upset play in the win position if the odds put him into that category again. Post 1 could be tricky. He needs to get off to a good start to have a chance at one of the top prizes.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(5) PICTONIAN FANCYPAS beat all but the winner in two of his last three races with the most recent one taken at this level of competition. Speed will have to improve if the fastest of his rivals can duplicate best speed from previous races.

(6) LUCKY FLIER recorded a 9-for-14 record last year from a top three standpoint. I wouldn't rate him as one of my best choices for the win position but could give him a chance to upset.

(7) SEA ME NOW copped victory number two in his most recent appearance and did it comfortably with Zeron driving. I thought that others looked to better prospects for the win position (at least two of my top four choices). He's the one that I might be underestimating the most.

(8) LIFE OF THE OLD BOY is a third time starter following a long term layoff. The third start angle is one that some handicappers like to use and it does work on occasion. Interested?

(9) JOIN HANDS had poor luck in the post position draw. That means that Waples is going to have to give him a helping hand to overcome that handicap. Your call.

(10) INSANE IN SPAIN was able to secure good early positioning from post 10 last week. He has the same handicap to beat tonight. It might be best to wait for another night.

2 HOMER JAY has talent enough to be considered an option to use in the third leg of the early pick 4 wager. We do have several options that look interesting however and I can't say that he deserves standout status. Some of his rivals are good enough to take the top prize. Anything less than a best performance wouldn't be good enough. Only a slight preference.

6 VACATION DAY found what should have been a winning situation when he tripped to Windsor on February 8 only to fail as the .40 cent race favourite. It was back to Woodbine five days later for a try in a higher classification than this one. His dropping down profile makes it necessary to at least give him a look when considering wagering options. What's your guess?

9 CANBEC FRIDOLIN will probably lose the driving services of Sylvain Filion (Choice might be Roush Hanover). The original rating was in the top three but that will depend on how the driver assignment works out. The replacement, if one is needed, has to be suitable. Moreau might use Jason Brewer. He has done that in the past with others that he trains. He is not a bad fit when competing in this category.

7 A CROWN FOR LINDY had the help of one of Waples ground and energy saving drives when he finished second best on February 6. The same trip tonight would give him a reasonable chance of producing a similar result. Whether that same racing luck can be achieved from post 7 is debatable. Waples will need a break or two to make it work from that spot.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) ROSE RUN LIMO was able to out-finish all but the winner last time. He and Zeron both have to be as good or better tonight to add another top three result to his resume.

(3) QUANTUM VICTORIA is stepping up into a tougher spot as she tries for the triple. It might happen but I'd have to rate her as an upsetter only with the competition as it is.

(4) ROUSH HANOVER missed by inches to the longshot winner last week. That same rival is back to try for a repeat. Both trotters are moving up into a higher category tonight.

(5) PLANET EARTH had previous results that made him a tough to predict winner on February 11. Those that did make the correct guess were well-rewarded with a 36-1 dividend. A repeat is not impossible. Others looked like better options to this handicapper.

(8) SILVERADO DREAM has to drop down into a lower classification before I can consider him for a higher rating. I can wait until that happens. Maybe next time if class relief shows up in his profile.

(10) GO GO RED MARTY can be a factor if the trip is not too difficult from the outside position. Past results against some of these same rivals are good enough if you can get past the starting position negative.

7 MONTE CRISTO has not been able to beat some of these same rivals in recent races. That turnaround could show up one night--hopefully tonight. It wouldn't take too much improvement by this pacer to reverse previous results. Moreau and Fillion just might have an upset in store for us tonight or in the near future. A win wouldn't be a major shocker but some of the competition might get more wagering support again tonight.

3 WOODMERE ULTIMATE ended up being slightly preferred for the runner-up rating in a race where several of the racers have good current form to offer. Another item for consideration is the racing style that has been used by some of the contenders. More than just a couple have been able to establish on the lead or up close positions. MacDonald did a pretty good job with this pacer in the past but he's replaced by Zeron tonight and will handle Elite. Don't know whether that was by choice or not. The driver change is noted but wasn't considered a major item. It turns out that MacDonald is not here tonight.

5 CLIC K is another racer that has recently had a change in trainer from Colin to Corey Johnson. Results have not tapered off with that change so we can consider continued good form. He has been on the lead in each of his last three races. That style might be used again and could work if rival drivers are not applying pressure soon enough. The driver lineup suggests that there might be early action. Winning on the lead might be difficult to do.

6 ELITE is expected to offer a price in the upset range again. He could be included in the triactor scheme as a price boosting possibility. Luc could fool some of the competition with a sit and wait style. I'll rate him in the four slot but you might want to move him up a notch or two when playing the single race wagers.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDERS

(1) INTERMEZZO HANOVER has a license to improve tonight now that he has a tightener following a long layoff. The comeback was good enough when you consider that he raced from post 10. Beware!

(2) LITTLE QUICK struggled in each of his last two races after a win just prior to that. Tonight we have to guess about a possible turnaround. Longshot players might take a look.

(4) MR BIG HEAD handled the class rise last week well enough to chalk up his third career victory for the team of Pentland and Davis Jr. He does have an improved post position tonight when compared to his last couple when results were good. That can only help. Rating him lower than the top four could be a mistake on my part.

(8) MANCHESTER HANOVER had an improved result when there was a driver change on February 13. Can't eliminate him completely when considering top three possibilities.

(9) THAT'S THE LIFE doesn't hit an easy spot and had poor luck in the post position draw for this test at Woodbine. The first choice driver also had the option to choose Clic K. I'll give him a chance to earn a minor award.

7 LONGBEACH TUFFY is an upset top selection that I am going to try with an eye to adding some extra value to the superfecta payoff. I usually like to offer a few longshot choices on each program (more if the mood strikes and the situation looks appealing). His last race improvement is encouraging--enough to make me think that has a chance to beat the expected favourites.

9 HI TECH TONY would help to make for a fairly good exactor return if he and my top selection can finish 1-2 in the order (either way). I'd be willing to take that approach if only as a back up option. Christoforou is very capable of producing an upset and this trotter wasn't beaten all that much last time. It isn't completely out of line to think that he might surprise.

2 UNLEASHED FURY was narrowly beaten last time when Solar Kash had the trip advantage. It wouldn't take too much to reverse that order of finish and we also have the last race winner, Tigre Angus, to throw into the mix. Any one of the three could beat the other two depending on driver strategy. Only a slight preference to this trotter.

6 SOLAR KASH looked like a top contender last week when he did take the winner's share as the race favourite. If he were to repeat it wouldn't be a big shocker. He has a solid record when racing in this price range. Two recent victories when priced at \$12,000 show up in the past performance information that tonight's program offers.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) TIGRE ANGUS was a good to go item when he debuted for the current owner/trainer. He also has two recent victories at this price to make him another contender with a chance to double up.

(3) PRESTO PEGASUS has a bit of appeal as a longshot possibility but I had to rate him lower than the top four. He ended up with Zeron to drive after the first choice opted for his other option.

(4) STANDFORD BRIDGE did get a look when I was considering an upsetter for the second spot. That position ended up going to Nbr 9 but it was a toss up. Be careful!

(5) DABRINA can hopefully race error free tonight. Breaks have been a problem for her. She has talent when able to race without a miscue. Oliver is back to drive tonight.

(8) LOU LOUIS PRINCESS ships in from Flamboro test her speed and stamina over the big track. This trainer/driver team could be dangerous if interested in a longshot play.

(10) B COR TERRY has hit and miss results to asses along with a post 10 handicap. That latter factor was enough to make me think that it might best to wait for another night.

1 FULL CIRCLE KING has been doing everything but win in previous races at Woodbine. He has five in a row never worse than third results. That should be good enough to get him the role of post time favourite is my guess. Hudon doesn't often get to drive the favourite. He should be looking to take advantage of that situation if does happen as predicted.

2 CAMS TUX would be a reasonable choice to consider if trying for the exactor. His post position improvement tonight can only help. Three failures from post 8 or 9 could be forgiven. Waples has a chance tonight to race him up close to the lead and work a ground and energy saving journey. Don't be too quick to write him off.

3 TROTTOWN KING closed a bunch last time to finish second best after having only two rivals trailing at the first and second calls. The same performance tonight would give him a better than average chance to add another on the board result to his summary. I thought he looked to be as good as most in the race and had to rate him in the top three.

5 URGENTLY takes the fourth an final spot in the top group. He's my price boosting option for those that are going to make an investment in the triactor wager. Quite often one of the top three finishing positions does go to a lesser regarded racer. It doesn't hurt to include one like that in the triactor scheme if only as a back up play.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(4) DRIVE EM COWBOY was on the borderline when it was time to decide about a rating in the top group. He'd have to produce at his best rate to play an impact role but it is possible.

(6) BETTORS GREEN hasn't won a race in a very long time as the record shows. Sight were set on a 12-1 upset not too long ago but he missed by one position that day and hasn't been as effective in three follow ups. A maybe vote only.

(7) SURVIVAL GUIDE beat only one rival in each of his last two races, which doesn't do much to boost the confidence. The driver might help tonight. Let's see what he looks like on Monday night.

(8) AIR WEST HANOVER has poor results in his two most recent races. He might look more appealing if racers for Fellow had some success on either Friday or Saturday night. It was reported in an interview on Thursday night that trainer was holidaying. He might be back now.

3 ROETHBLISSBERGER gets a chance in the top spot again. I used him as a longshot play last week but had to settle for second best status that night at 33-1. The price should be much lower this time around if my guess is correct. I like the combination of Waples and Maxwell well enough to go all in this time. It looks like a fairly evenly matched group in leg two of the late pick 4 wager.

4 WILD DRAGON has obvious excuses that can be used to forgive his two recent failures. The break on February 4 was followed up with a post 10 draw nine days later. Moreau and Filion are always dangerous. I'm willing to give him a fair chance to finish in any of the top three positions. Race night observations might offer a clue on what to expect.

1 COOL ROCK miscued on February but managed to finish fourth best only to be set back on a ruling by the judges. Bourassa has hopefully got the problem under control. Zeron will be looking to make amends for that last race result. He won eight times last year but this term has been lean from a win standpoint. Maybe?

8 ROLL ON keeps me thinking that one night he is going to pop u to produce an upset. Show me a price similar to what was offered last time and he might have to be the subject of a small back up wager in the win position. His six win record from 2011 rivals that of any of the competition other than two. Take a look at him before eliminating completely.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(2) ROCK OF LUCK didn't look like one that I could consider/recommend tonight. I'll take a pass and wait for next time if he comes back to try the big circuit again.

(5) DEL RIO SEELSTER races on a weekly schedule tonight. That change should help if you like other factors in his profile well enough to consider as a top three possibility.

(6) DON'T SAY GOODBYE was a non factor a week ago when racing on the heels of a vet scratch (reported sick). The race before that was not that bad when he was the race favourite. Beware of Zeron if the price is in the mid-high range.

(7) JUST ASIGN TO ME was the 2 year old O.S.S. grass roots champ. He won 10 races that year while on that tour. Last year wasn't nearly as good. Some bettors will take an interest.

(9) WAZZUP WAZZUP was best of the bunch last time in his second start off the shelf. Moiseyev might be looking to double up with him tonight. He has to beat the outside position if he is in that mode.

1 BIG TIME ROCKS looks to beat three that finished higher in the order last week. The driver change might help--might not. I'll give him a try in the win position with mid range confidence. He needs a best performance to beat the next two on the list. He might try a style different than the go to the lead strategy that he used a week ago.

7 BAZILLA lived up to his post time favourite status when making his first start for new trainer Richard Moreau and owner Joan Cassell. I always hope for success when a new owner takes over. It worked with this pacer quite well. \$6,500 of the investment was returned in quick order. That amount might be doubled tonight with a second victory.

3 NJS TRICK PISTOL fired a winning shot two back and then was second best a week ago when Bazilla was best of the nine racers that night. Robinson and Davis will be looking to take revenge with a better than average chance of succeeding if he can duplicate or improve on either of his two most recent races. Better include him one way or another in your wagering scheme.

8 LUCKY ENCOUNTER is a longshot prospect that I could consider if the race night decision was to try to beat the expected race favourites. I'd take him on in that role or as a back up at the right price and if I like what I see prior to post time with both horse and driver. The top three selections will be tough to beat but upsets can and do happen.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(2) HIDDEN HALL has not been in competition since early January. That gap in his schedule is enough to make him a risky play against this group of 4 year old claimers, some of which have good current form to offer.

(4) ARTIST LIST was better than my number one choice last week. Numbers in 2011 were not poor by any means. He was 16 times in the top three to give him a better than .500 average. Earnings of more than \$50,000 in 2011 makes him the best in that regard when compared to the competition.

(5) MILLIONDOLLARDAD moves back to the claiming ranks for this try after mixed results against non-claiming rivals. I might be underestimating his chances by rating lower than the top four.

(6) IWISHIWASIRISH has been doing good things at the smaller venues over the last little while. Competition here should be more difficult. A minor purse share is possible.

2 BRIANS TOWN is a hunch play that I am going to try in the finale to head up the superfecta prediction. He gets Davis as the replacement driver. Waples was the first choice but seldom picks against a McIntosh racer when there is a conflict. He handles First After Me. Risk is part of the wagering process and this fella has some of that in his profile. The price should be right if you choose to play along.

7 BEACH BUFF tries to extend his string of top three result with a pretty good chance of finishing in any of the top three positions again. He should be the race favourite this night unless one of the others happens to be more popular than expected. If there is one in that category you might want to take a second look at that rival.

10 FIRST AFTER ME hasn't been a first stringer on the McIntosh team up to this point and is not likely going to make that grade. He isn't out of his element with this field if post 10 doesn't cause any major problems. It is up to Waples to find the solution to beat that handicap. He can do that if the horsepower is there. Triactor/superfecta players need to consider.

4 OK DIABLO was given a double digit morning line quite. He takes on the role of price booster for me. To make the grade he has to combine a better than average performance with a suitable amount of racing luck. One without the other wouldn't be good enough. Rick Zeron might be able to help with a wake up call if he has some luck.

THE FOLLOWING LISTED IN POST POSITION ORDER

(1) DON'T TELL MOM has a profile that says improvement could be seen tonight. The second start off the shelf is from an improved post position. McNair just might have sights set on an upset. Beware!

(3) R CAAN puts a win streak on the line again tonight. His last win was at this same level of competition. Nice to see the success that he is having for his owner/trainer team. He might have more of the same tonight.

(5) CASIMIR LEADER might be one of the rare double up winners after a maiden breaking win. We don't often see that happen but he might be the exception if Menary is ready to step up to the next level in a hurry.

(6) BILLY BASS wasn't on my list of win candidates tonight. I could consider for use in the triactor or superfecta however. Look him over prior to post time and then decide.

(8) AVIATOR SEELSTER needed to re-qualify due to a breaking performance following his qualifier on February 2. He passed the test with a high mark. This stakes racer from last year might surprise.

(9) AMBLE OVER HANOVER would have looked more appealing from a starting position better than post 9. That factor was enough to get him a spot on the wait until next time list.
